### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a set of golf club heads, as shown and described.

### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a 3-iron showing a typical low loft angle golf club head which is part of a set of golf club heads embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the toe end thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the heel end thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a 6-iron showing a typical middle loft angle golf club head which is part of the set of golf club heads that embody my new design;
