The ornamental design for a handle for plumbing fixtures and accessories, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a handle for plumbing fixtures and accessories showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of the front shown.

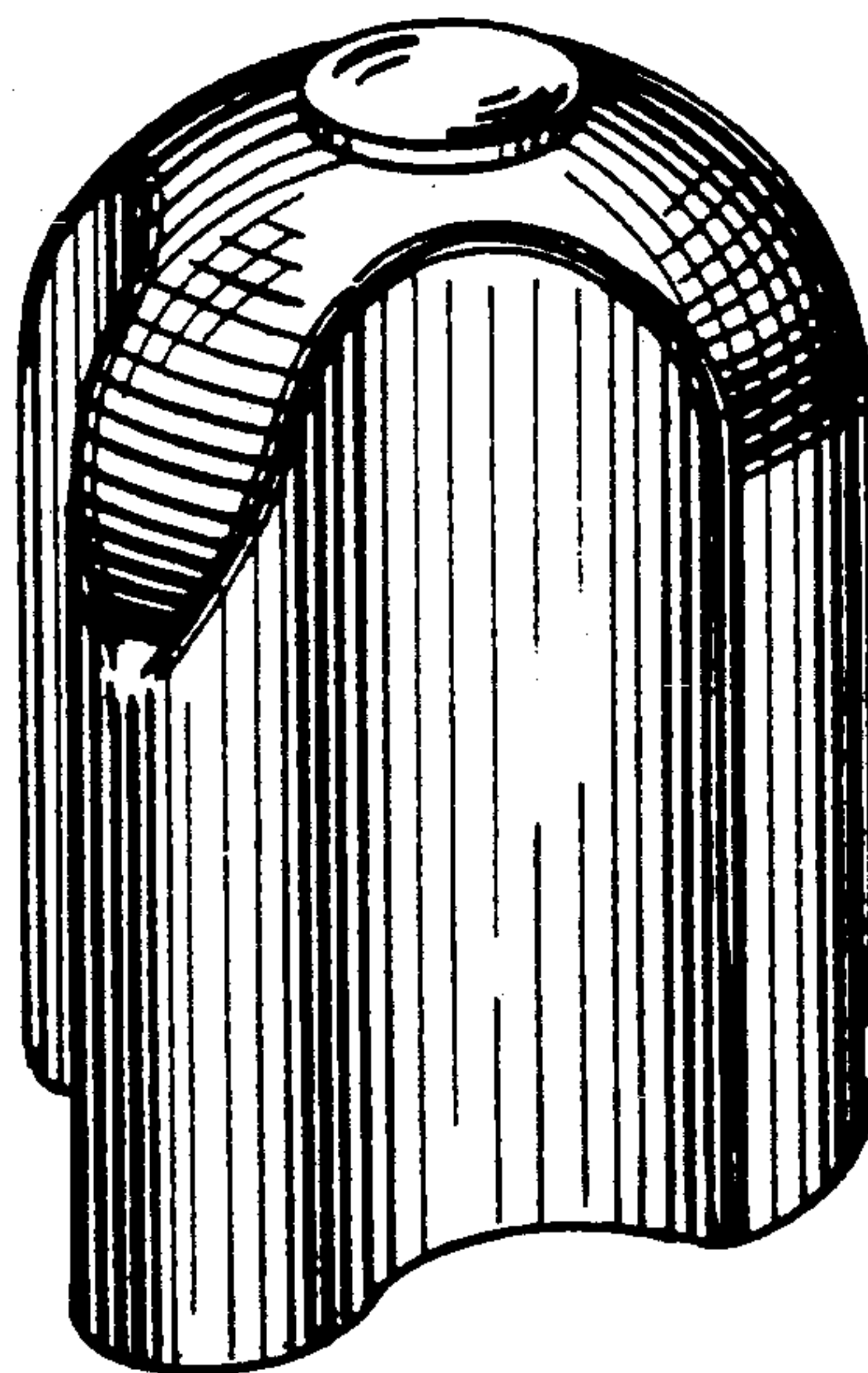

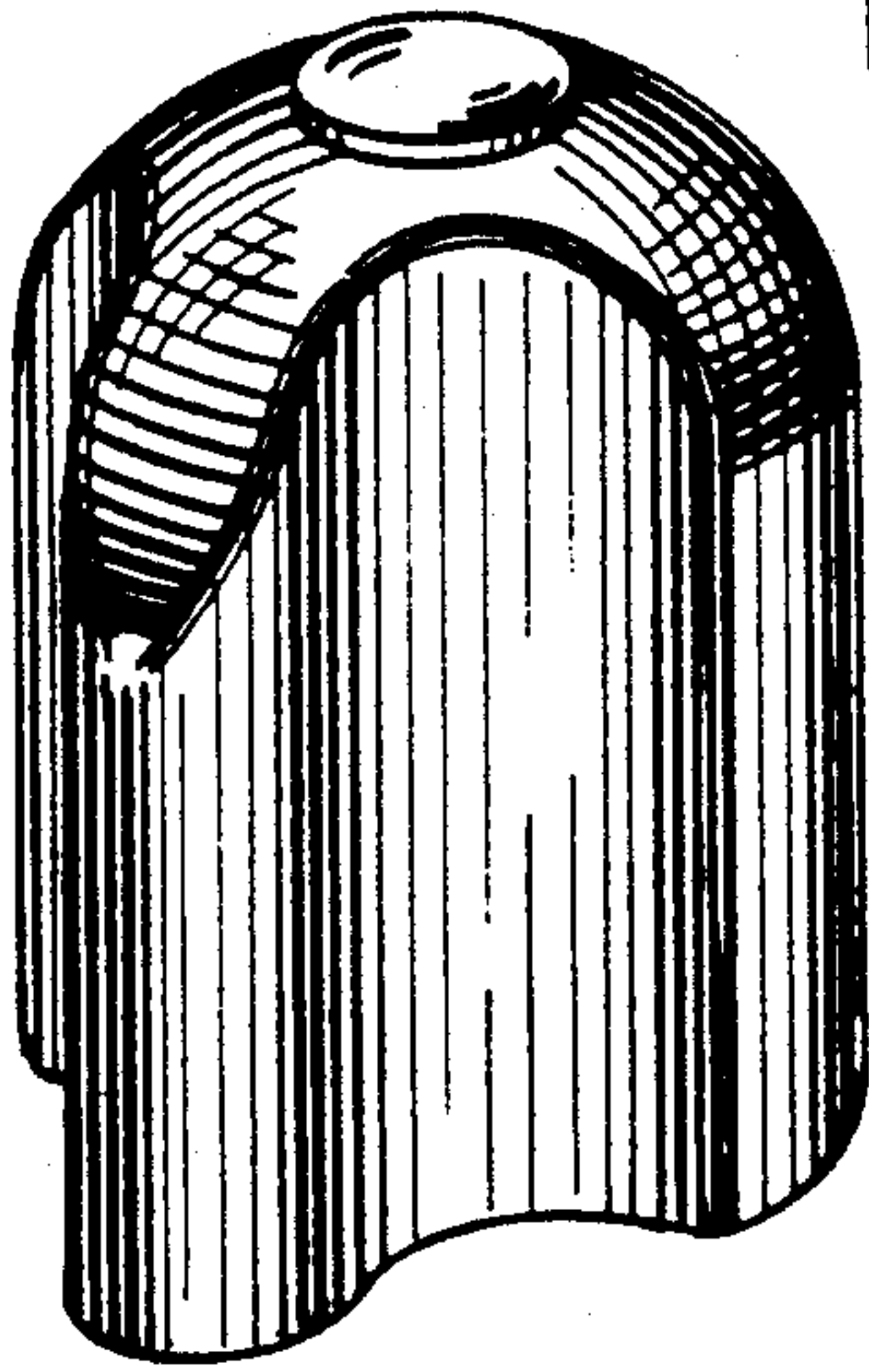

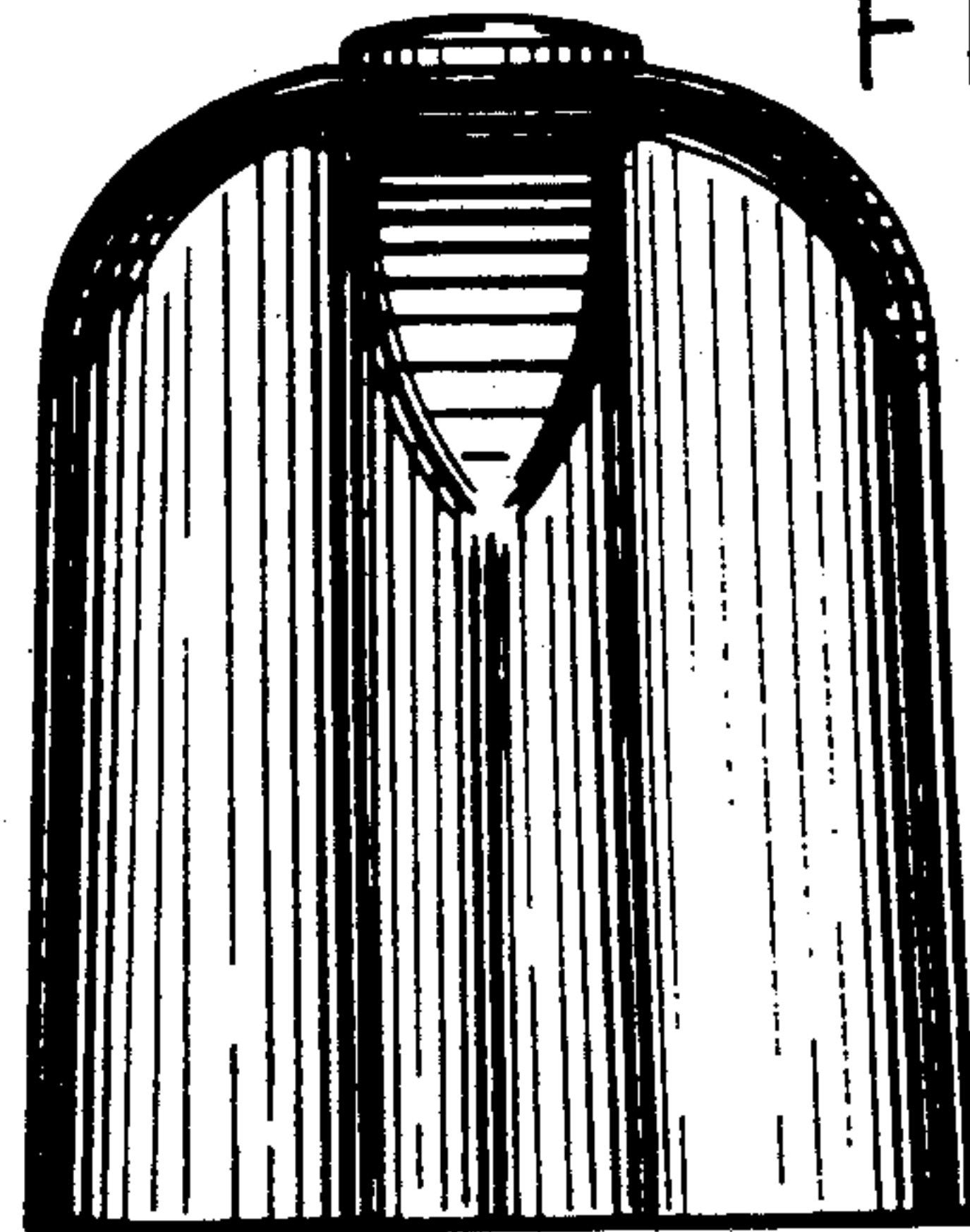

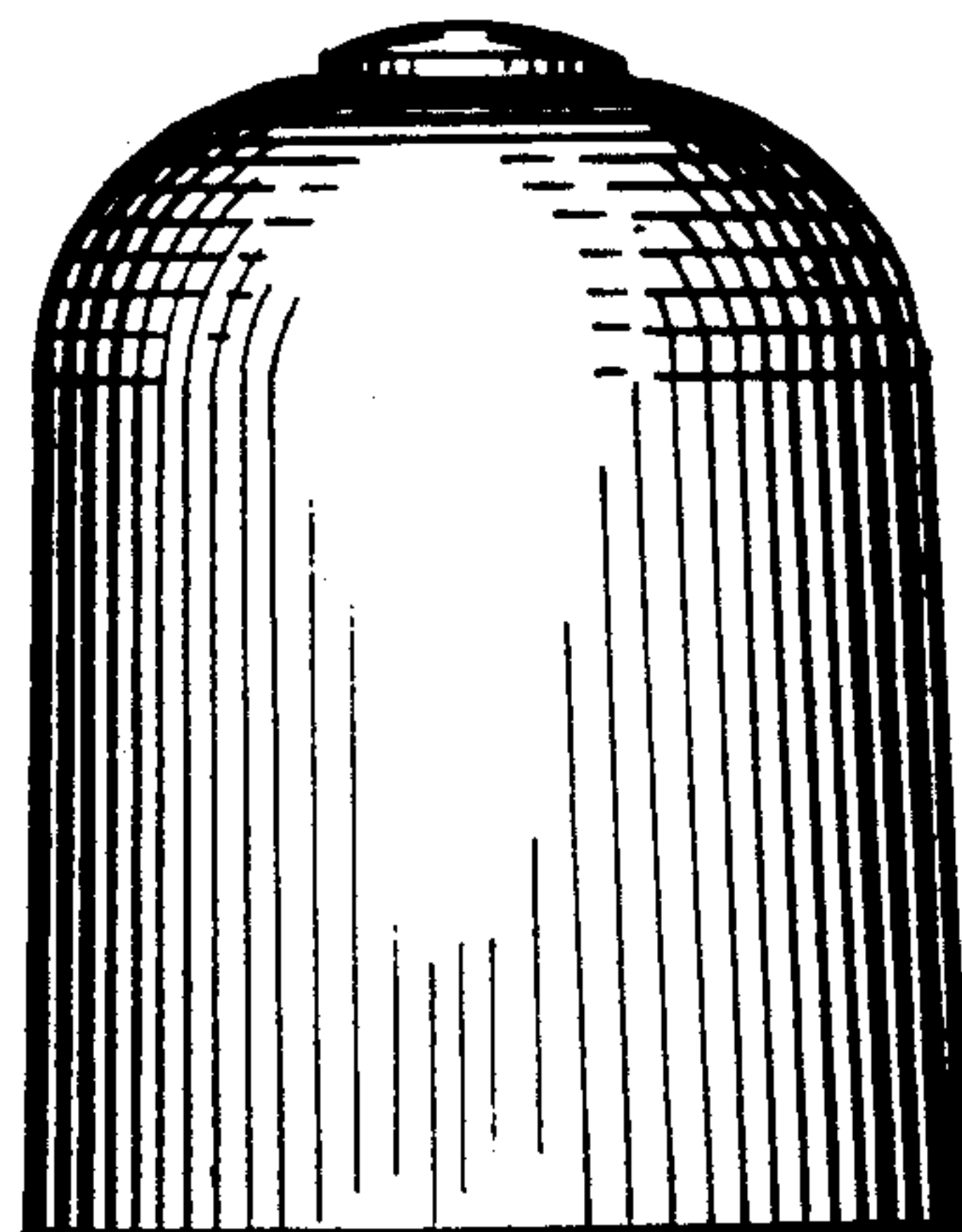

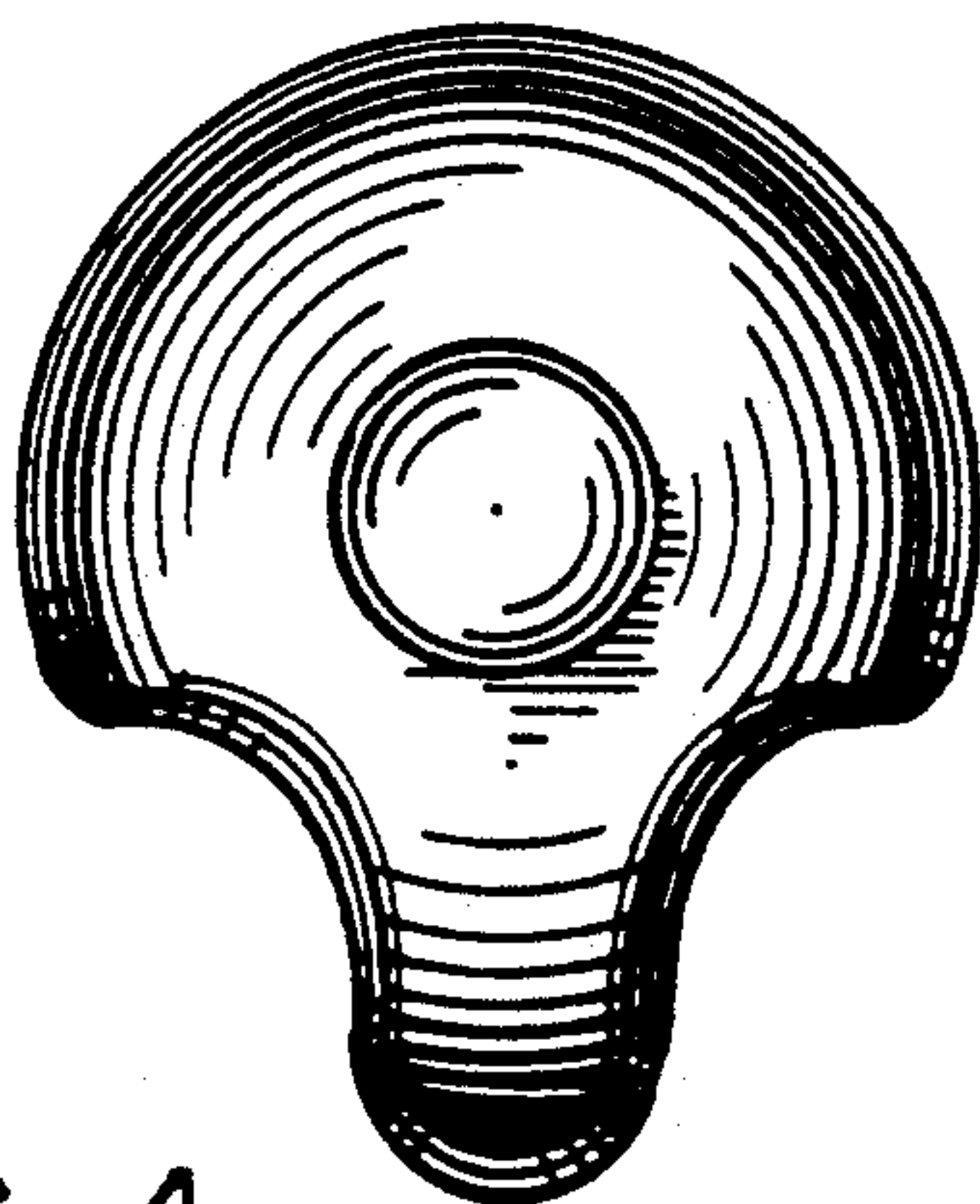
