DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a combined
truck mounted spoiler and camper shell showing our
new design.

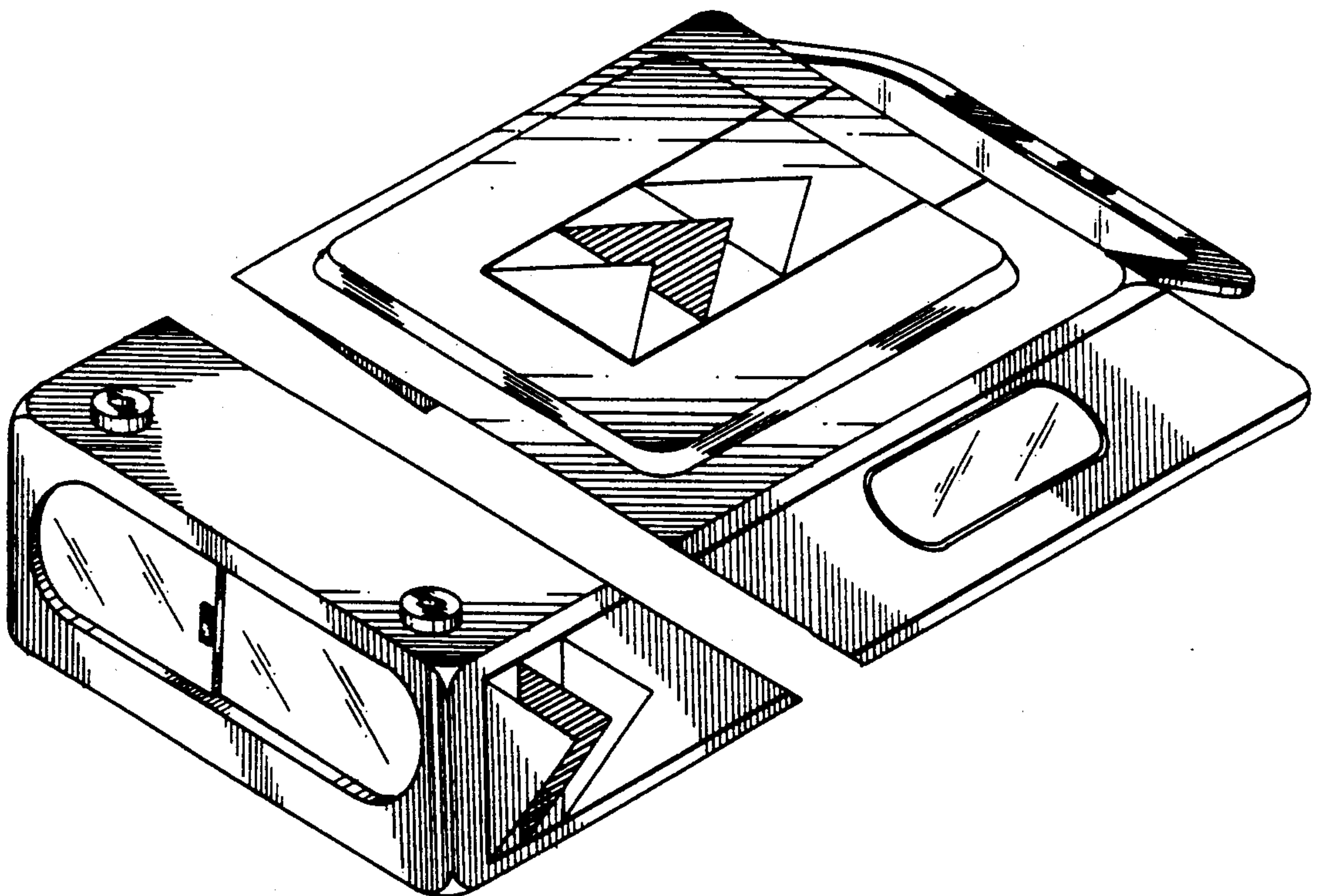
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



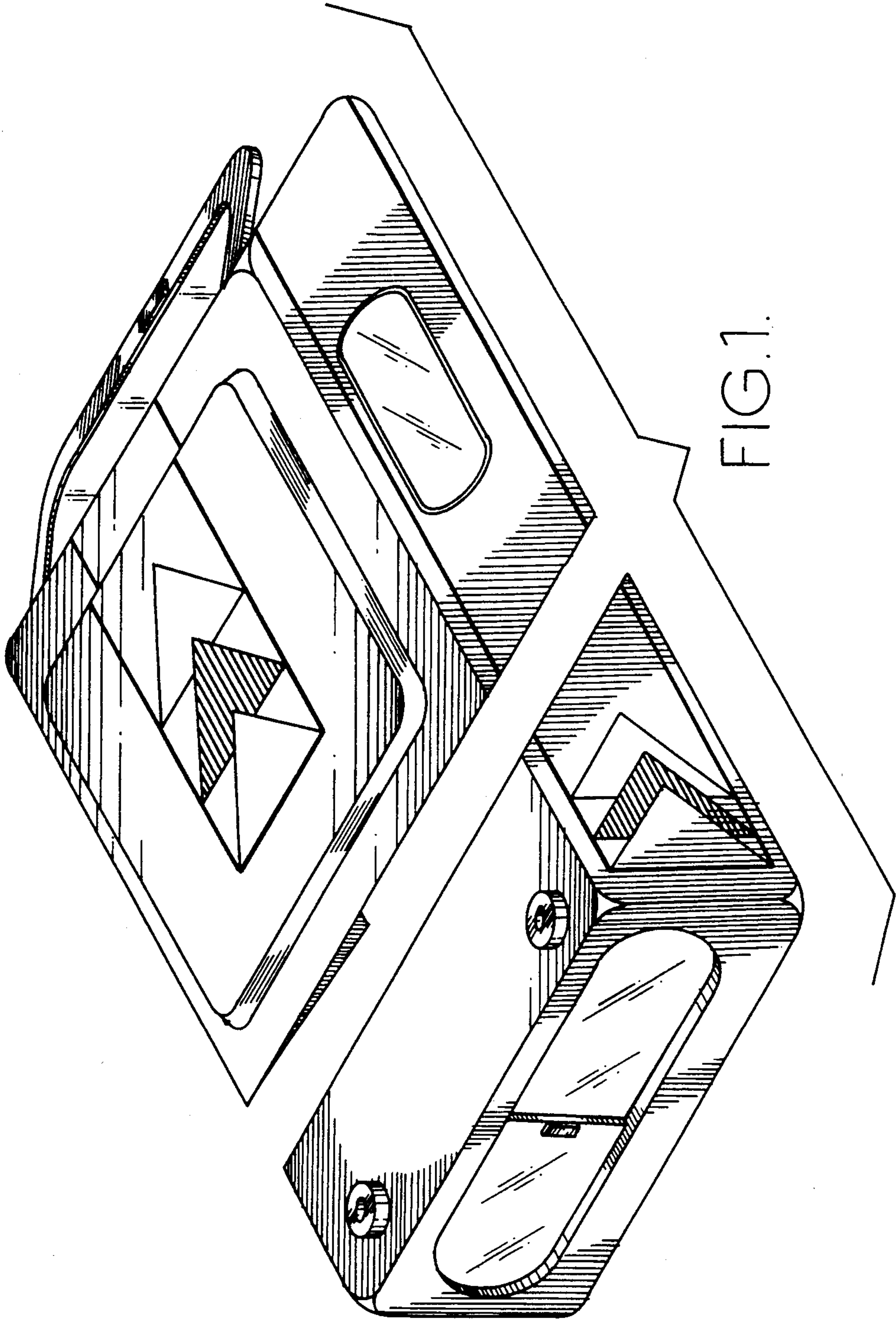

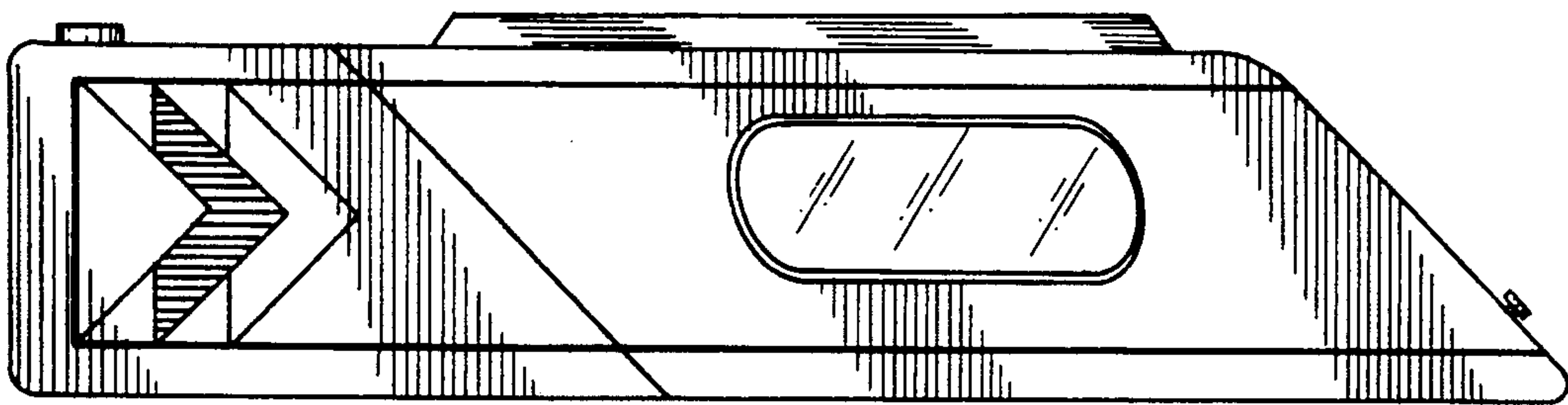

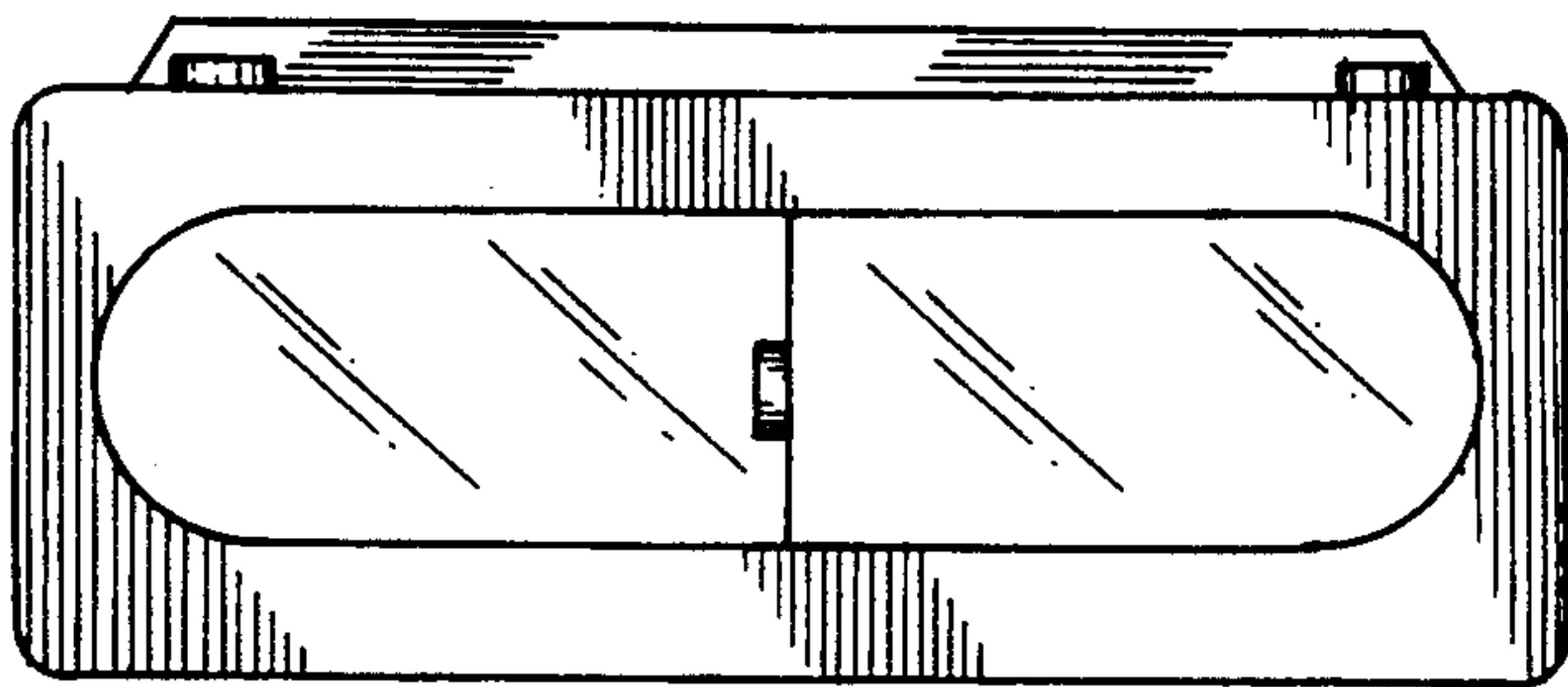

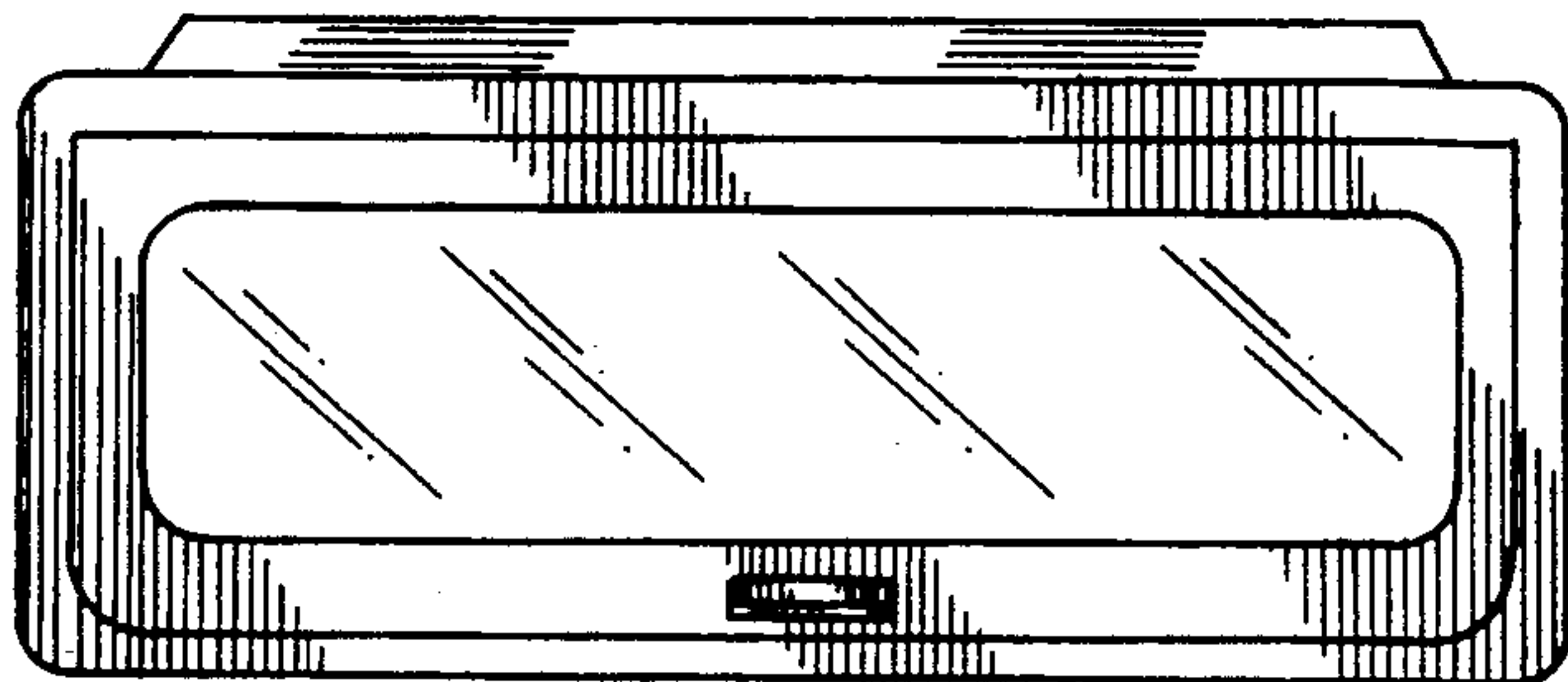

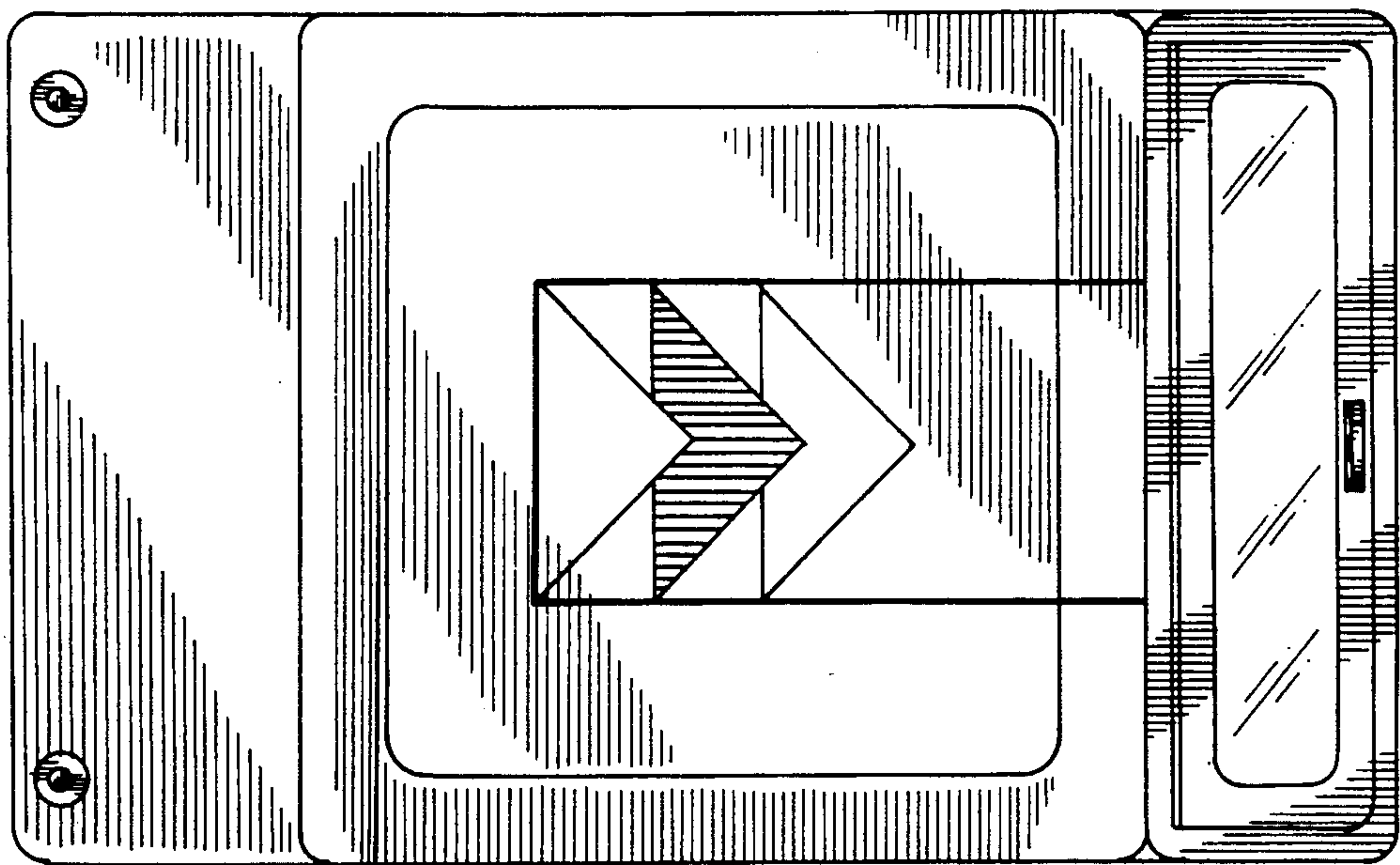
