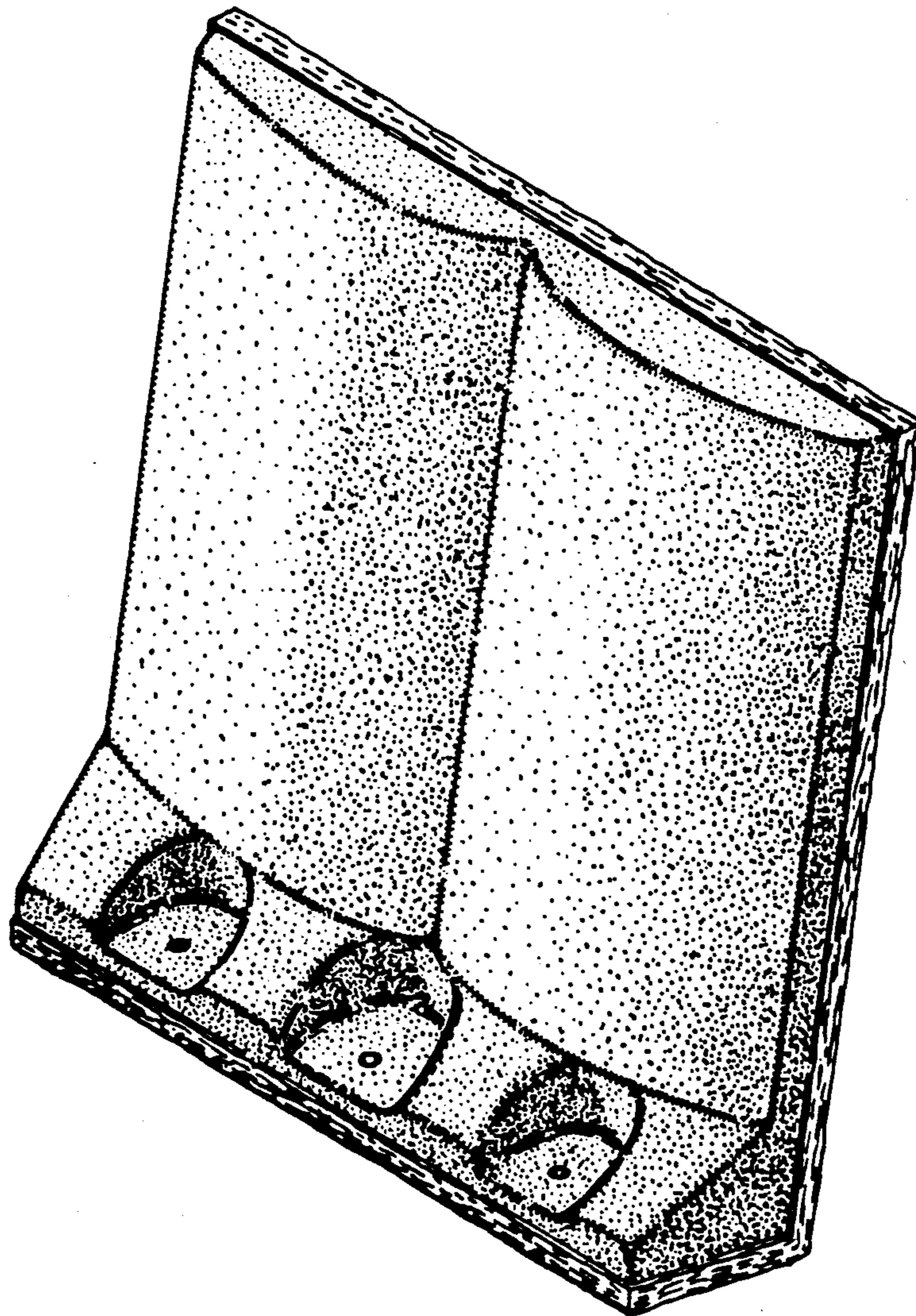
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a grave marker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a grave marker showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof, the broken lines showing religious indicia is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; and,
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view thereof.

The characteristic features of my design include the shape and exterior configuration of the body of the grave marker as shown in the figures described.



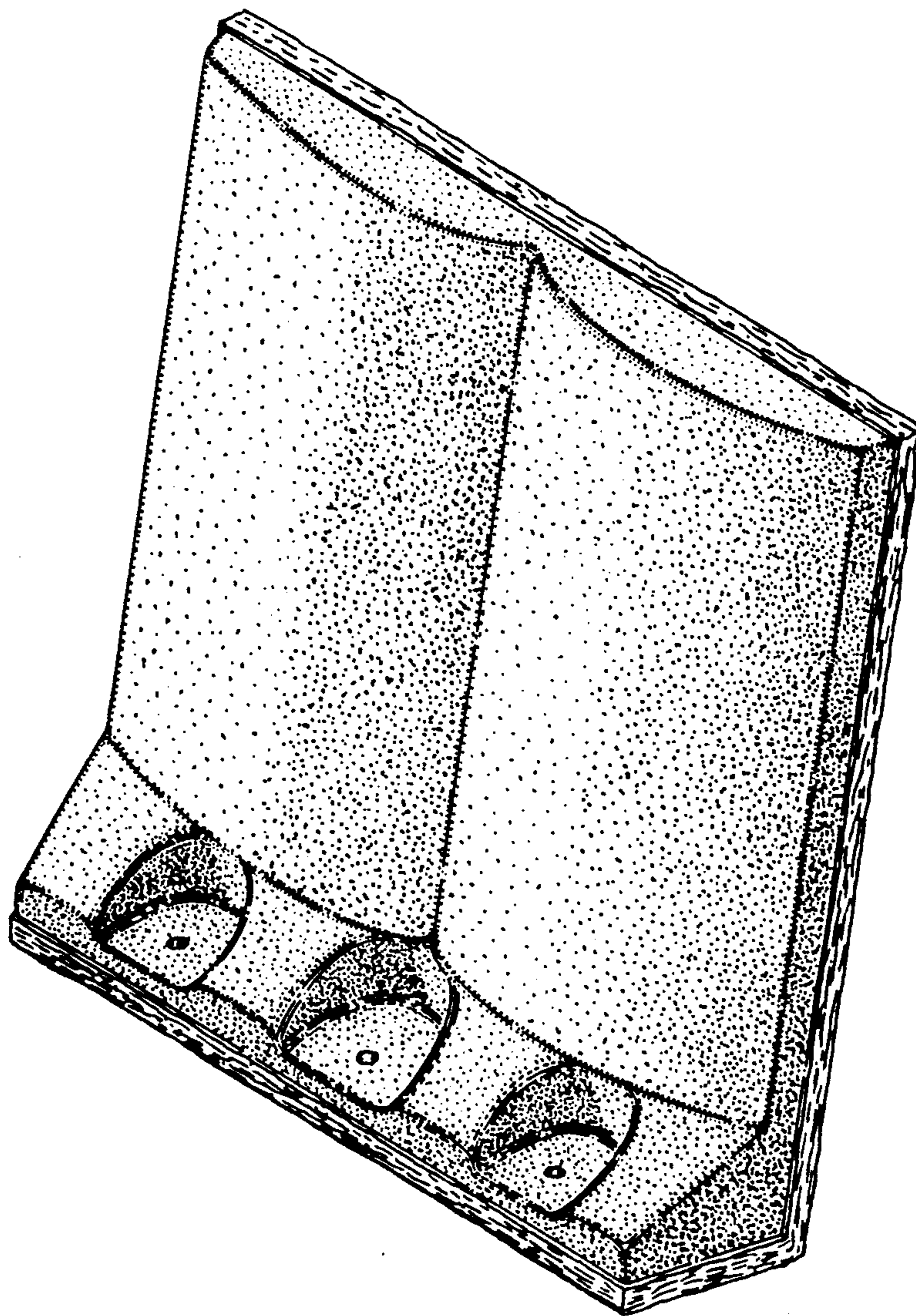

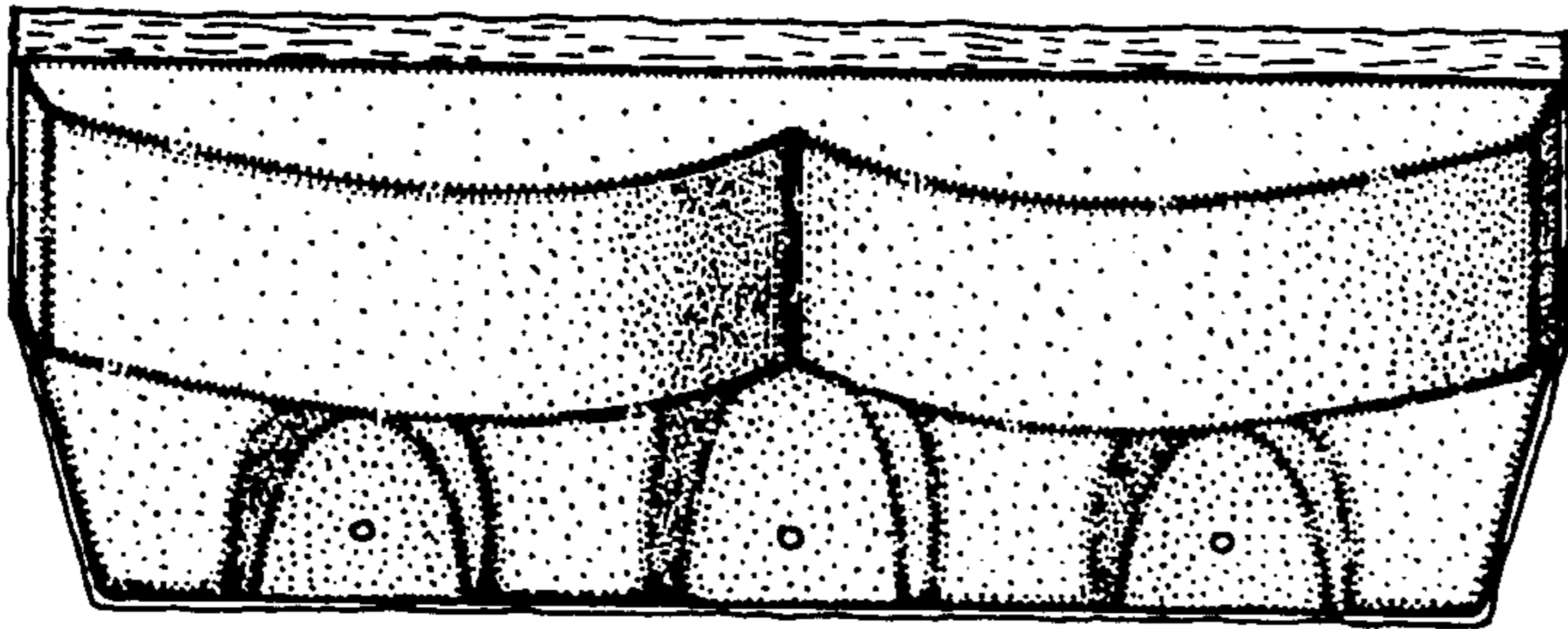

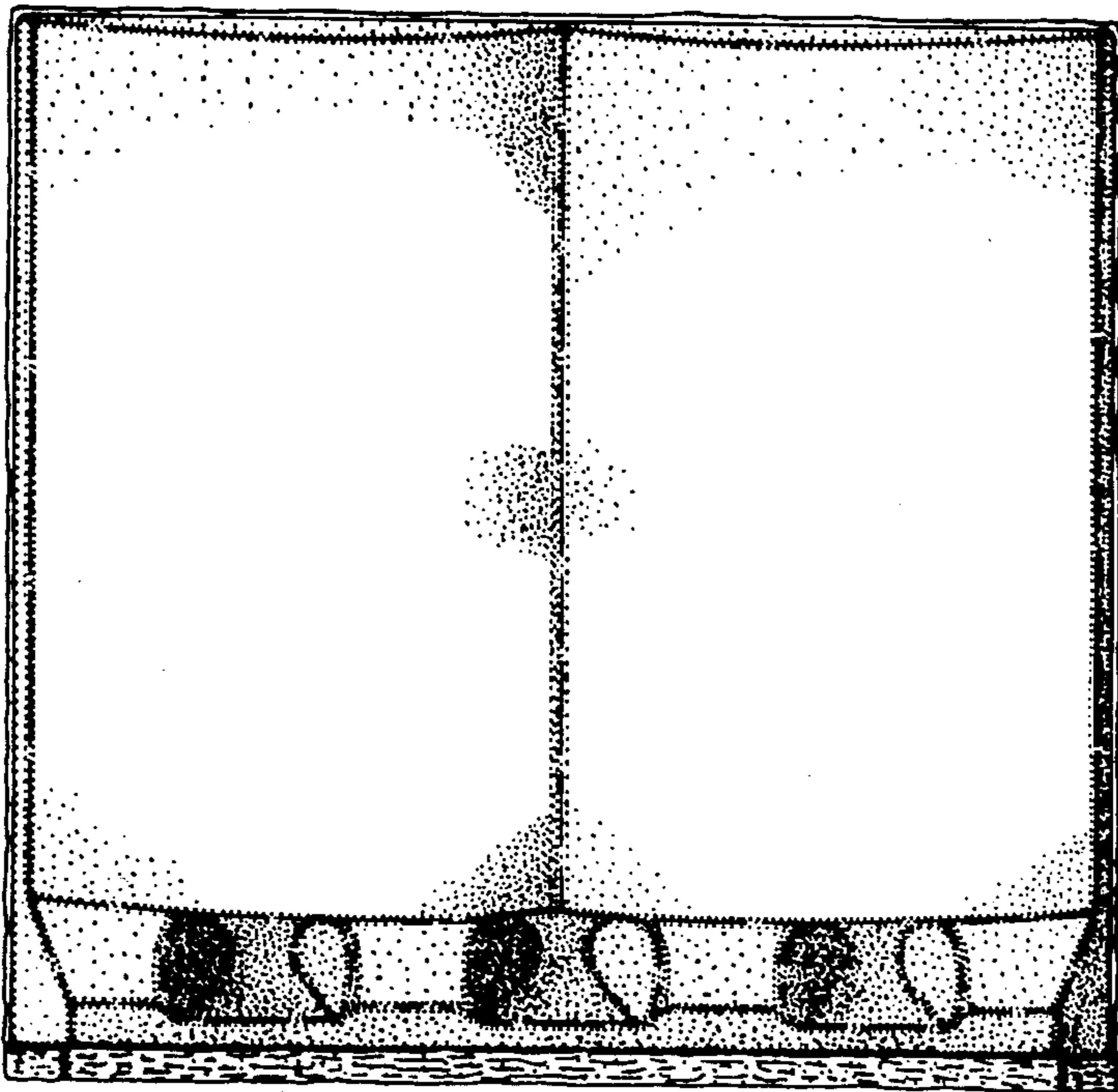

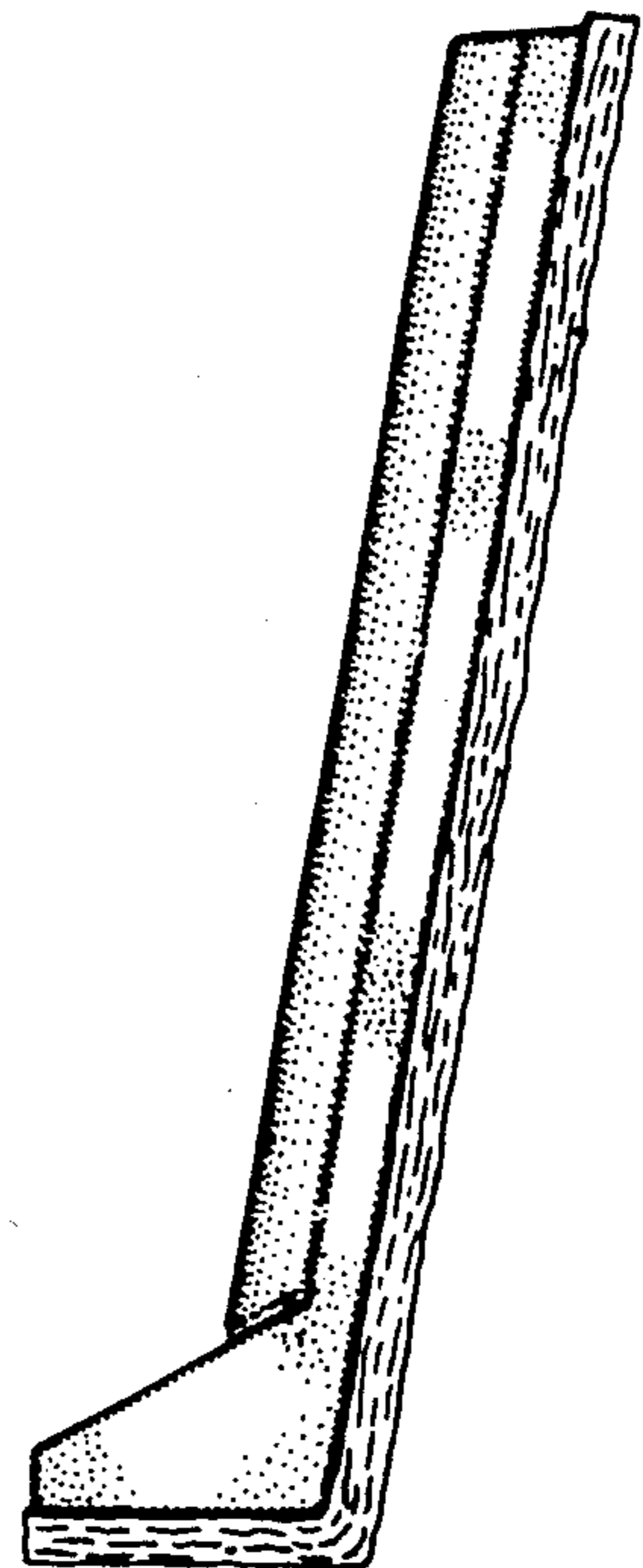

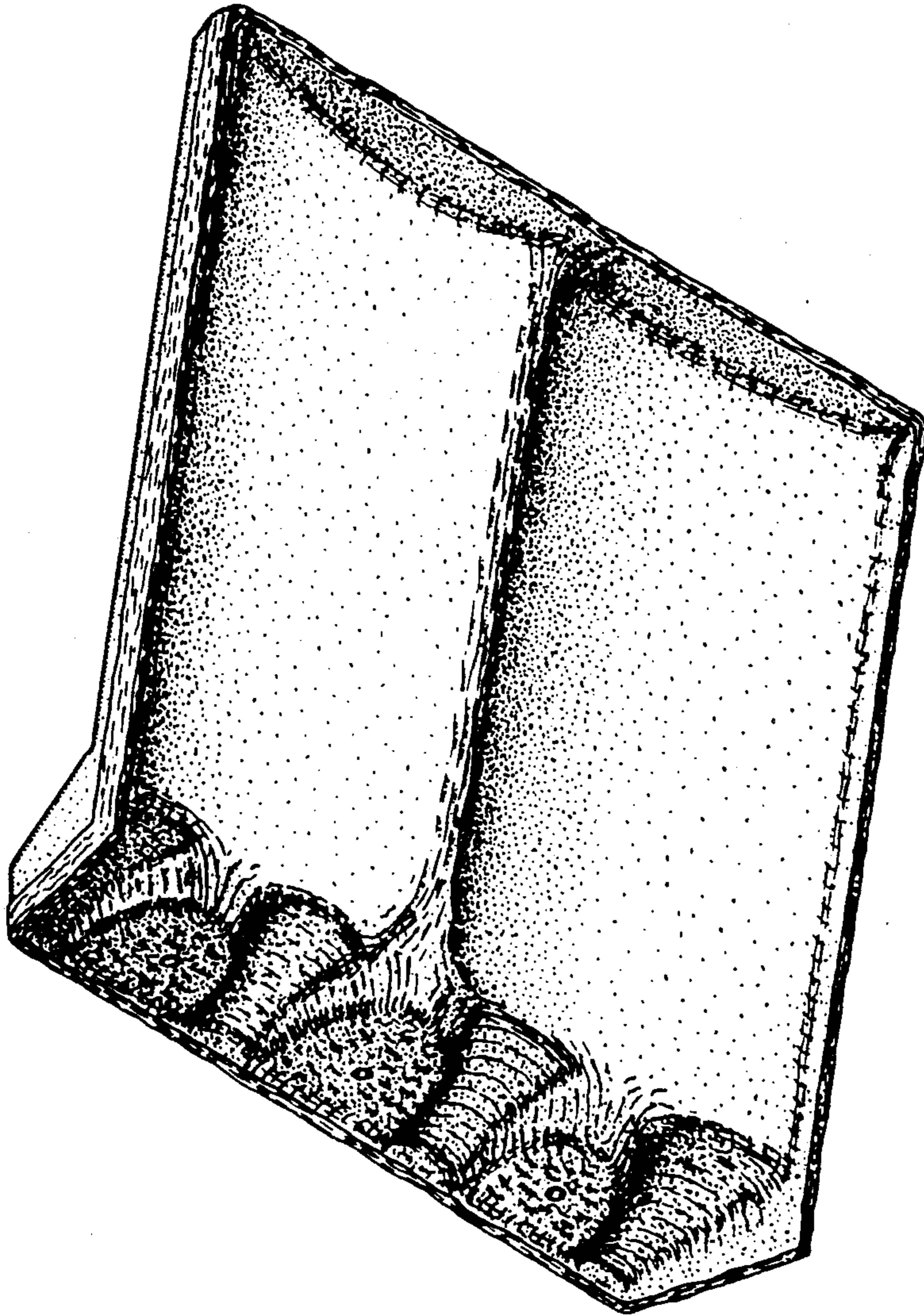

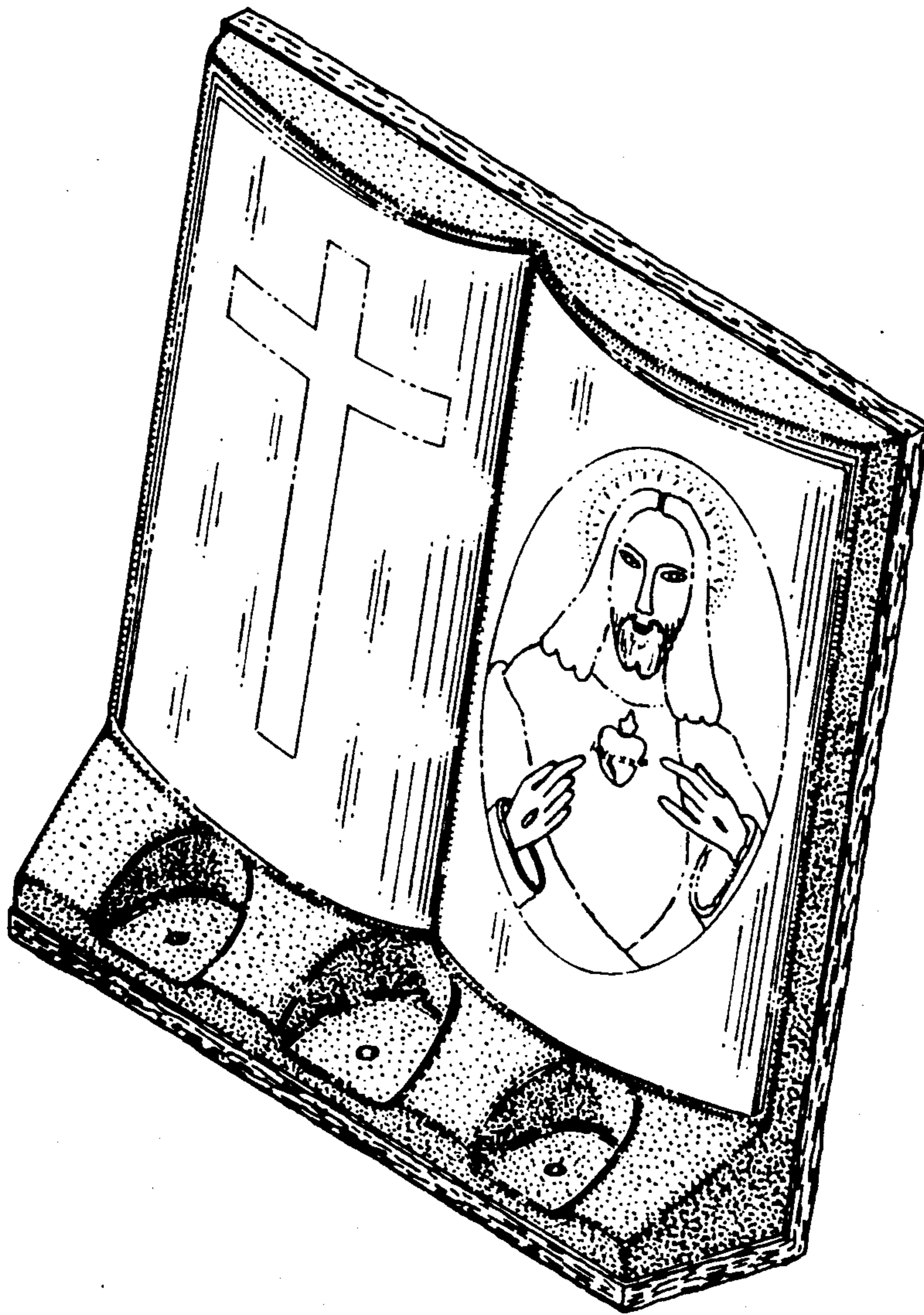

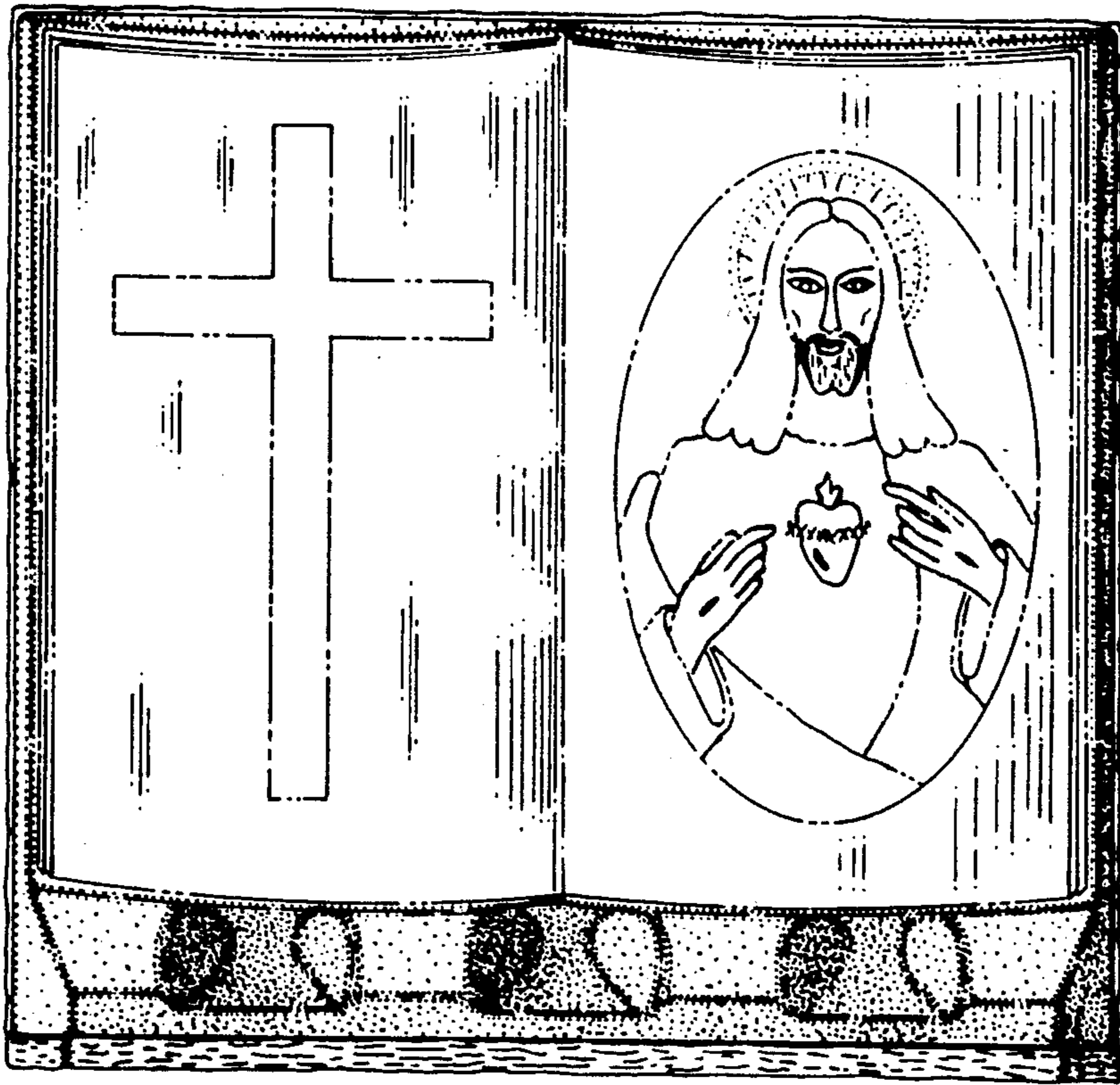
