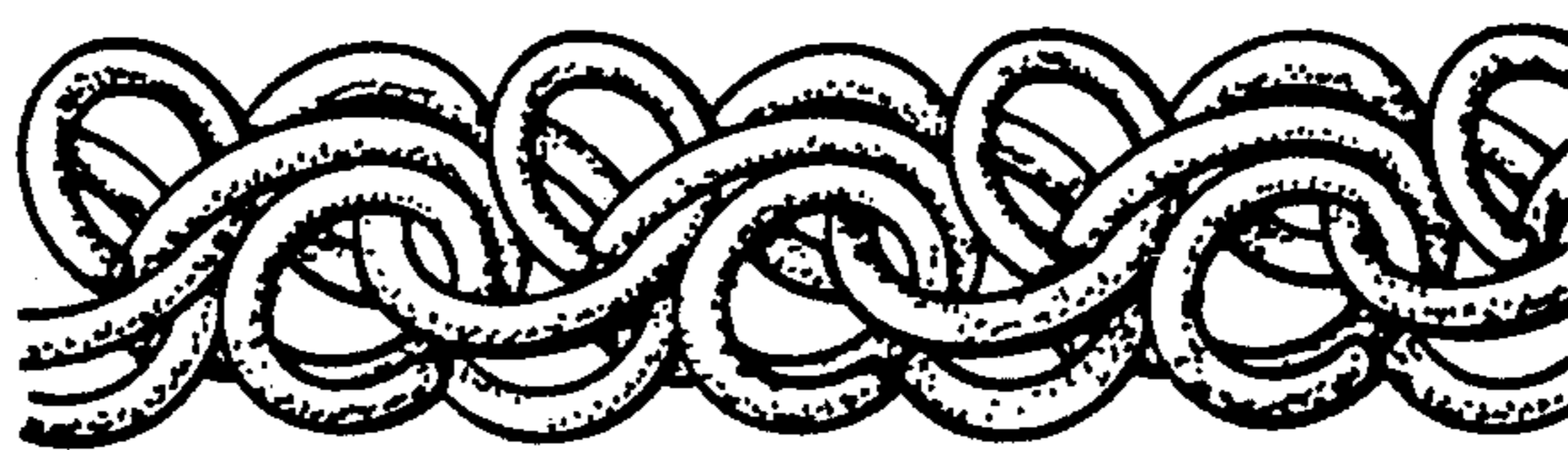

 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 3.



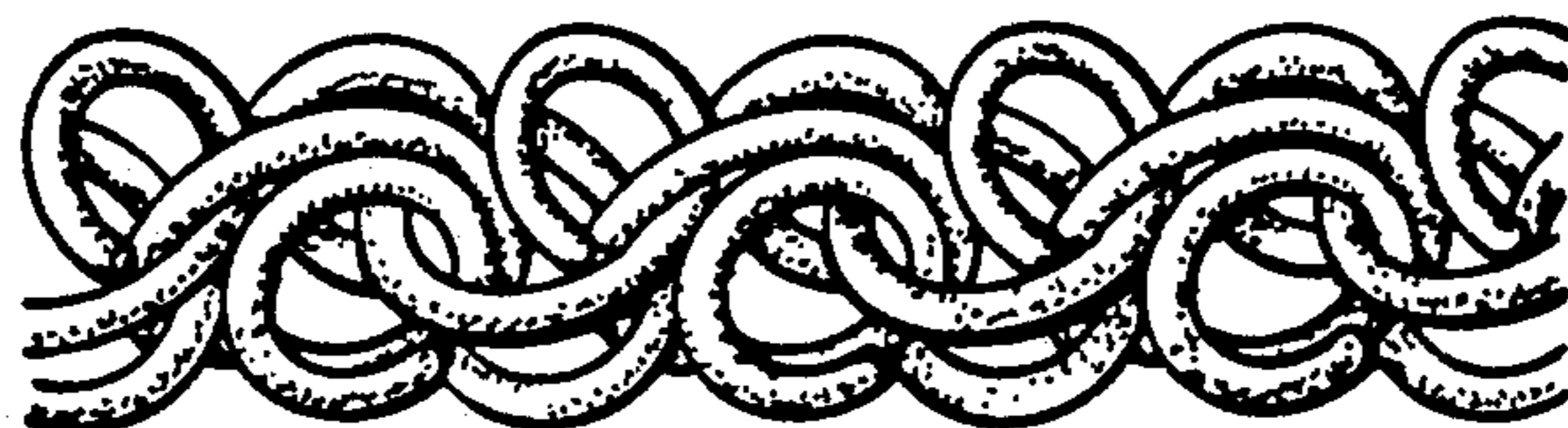
