FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a fishing lure, showing our new design;

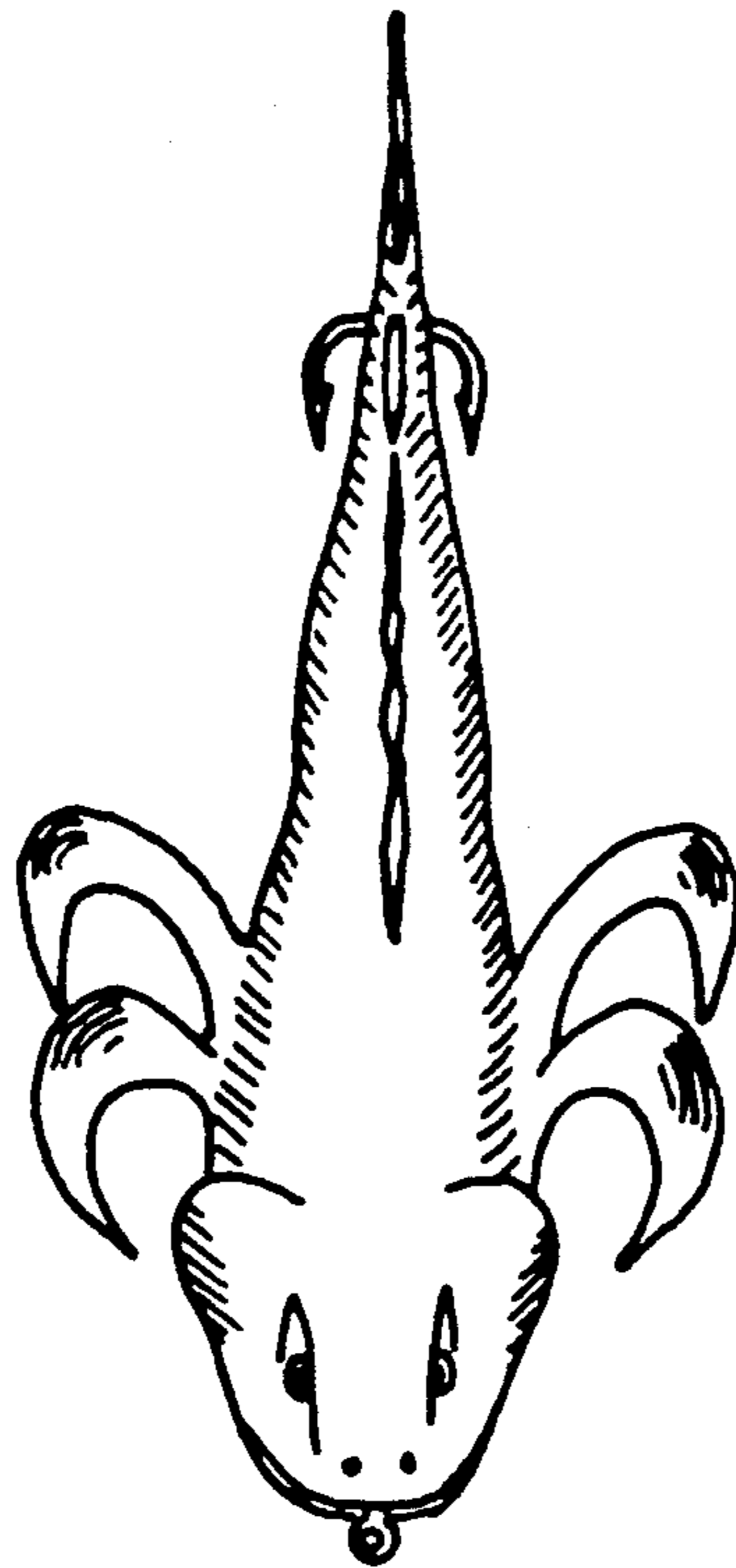
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



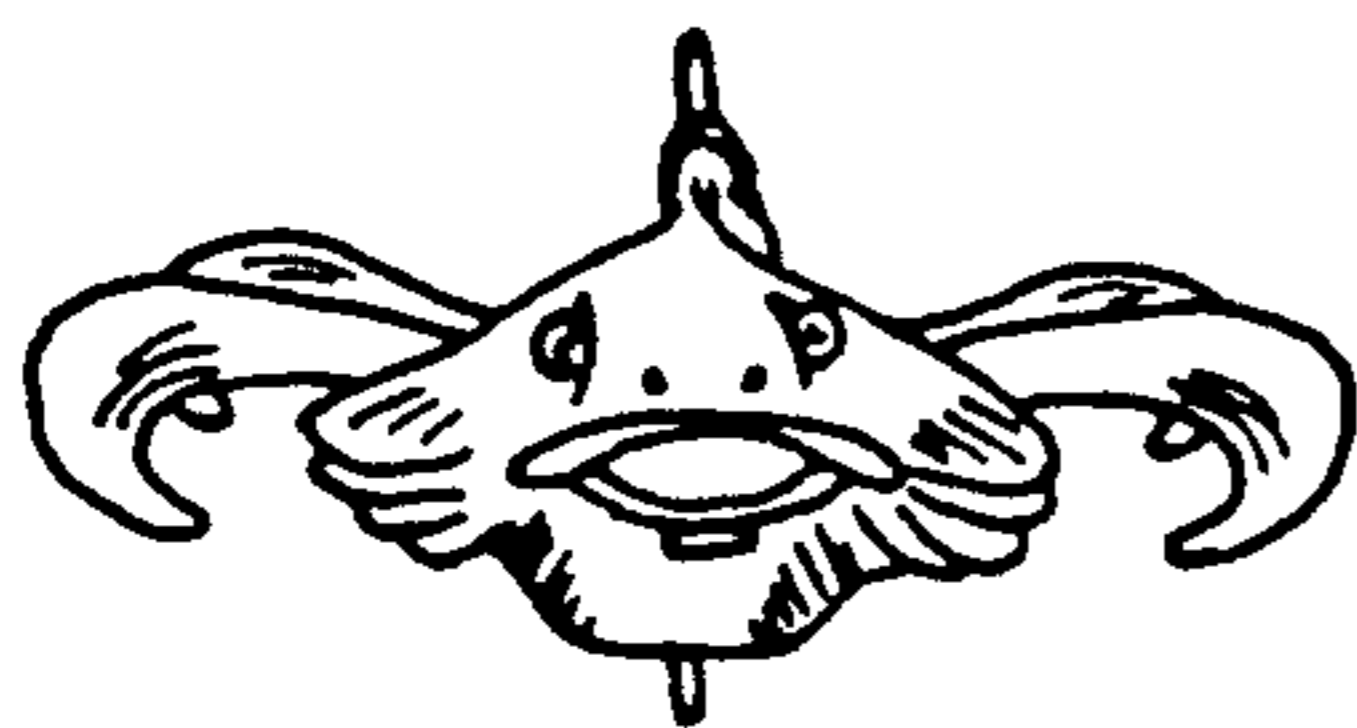

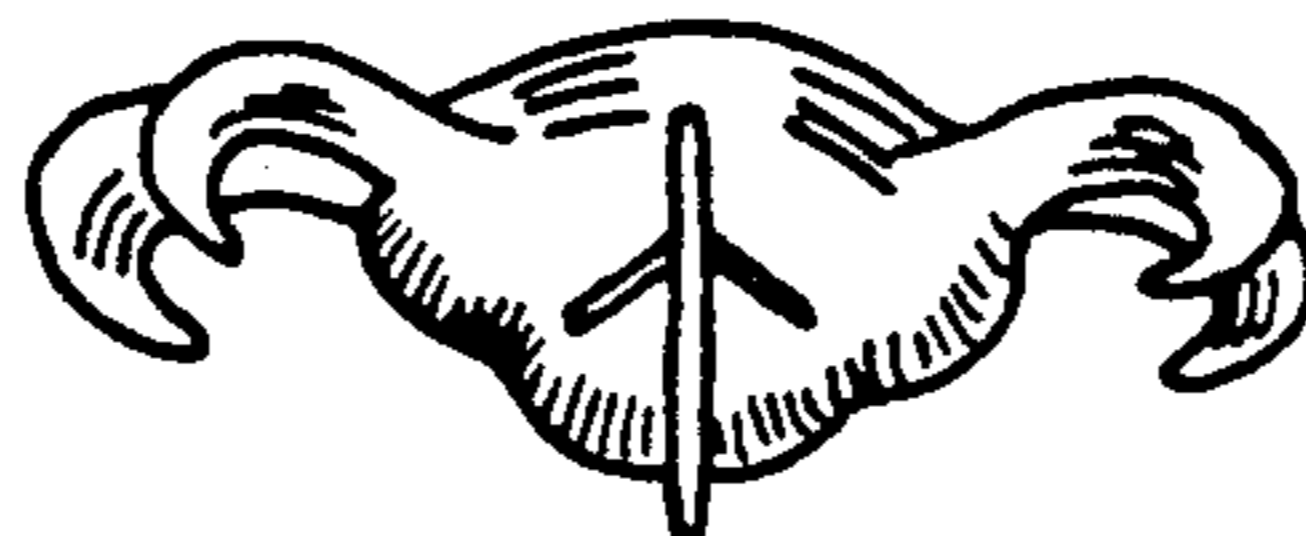

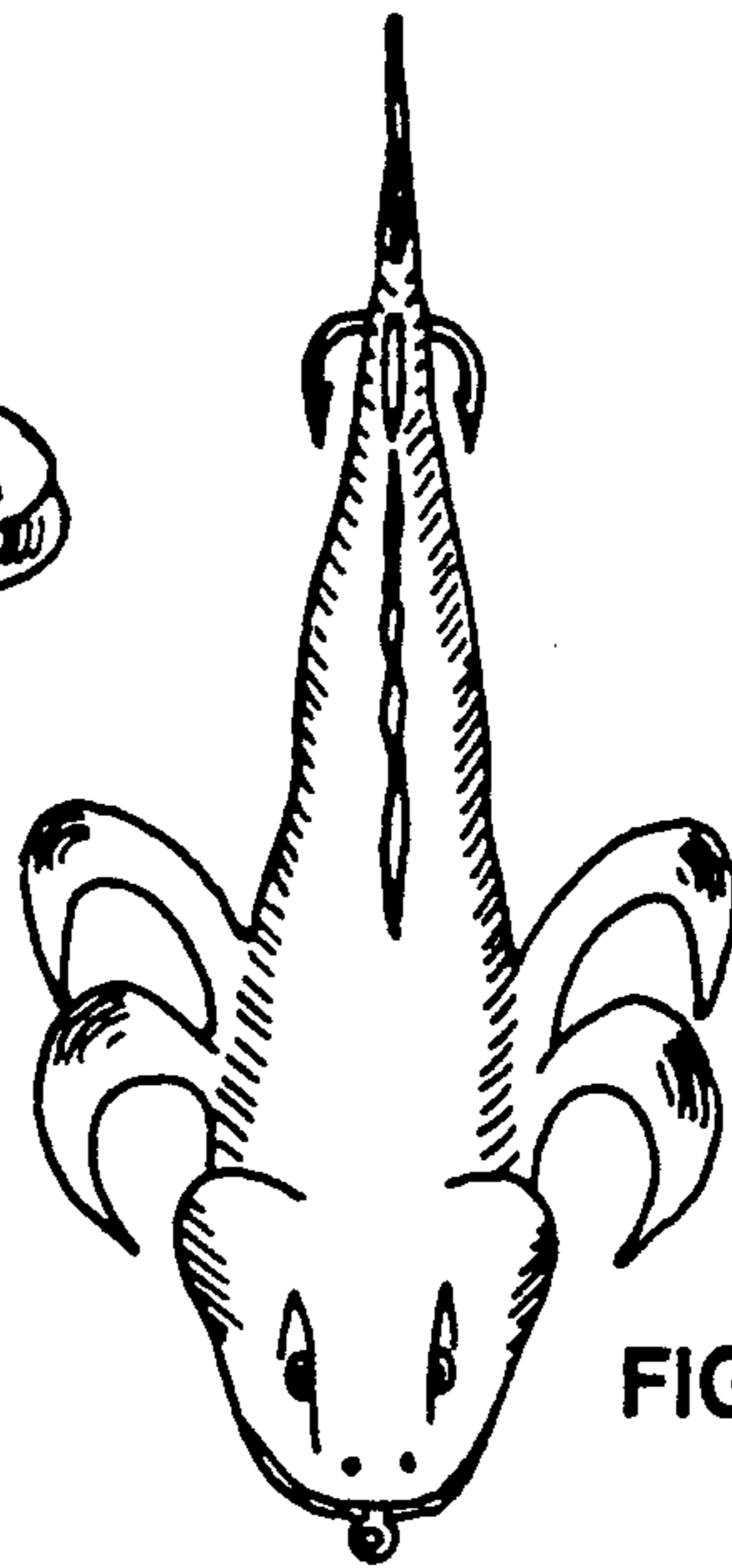

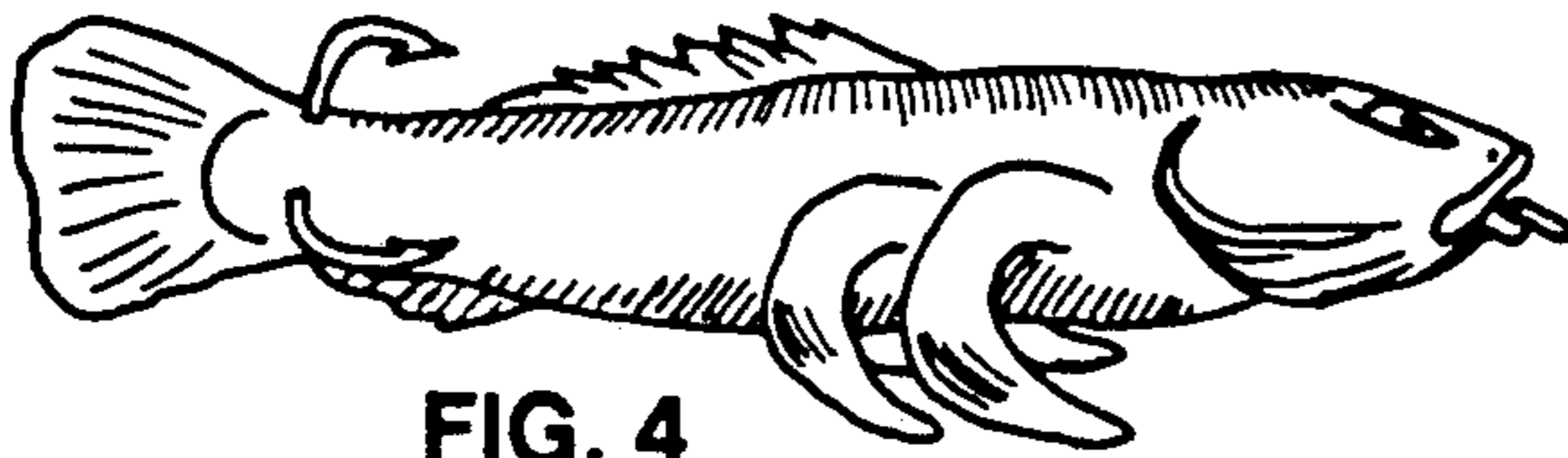

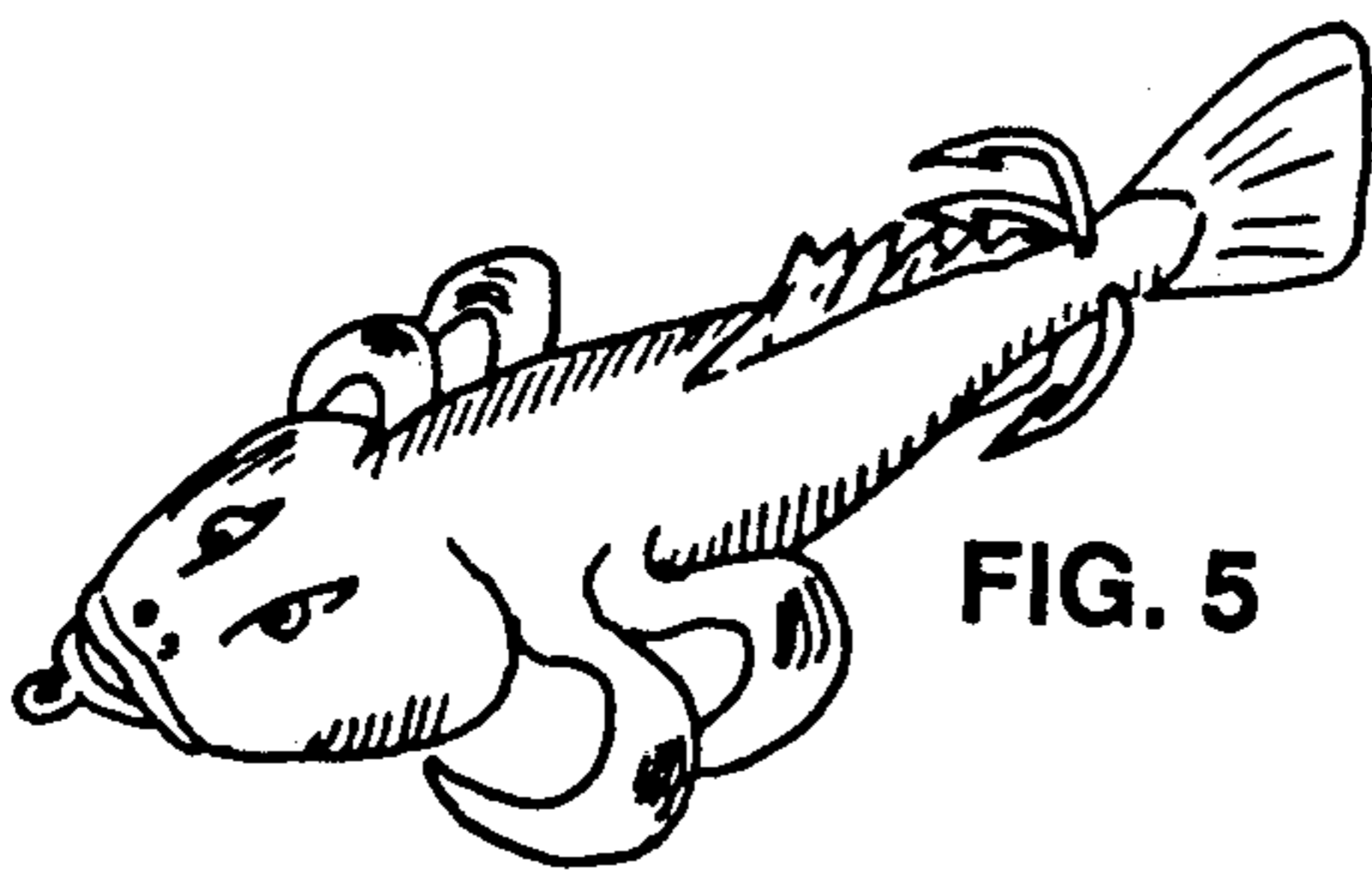

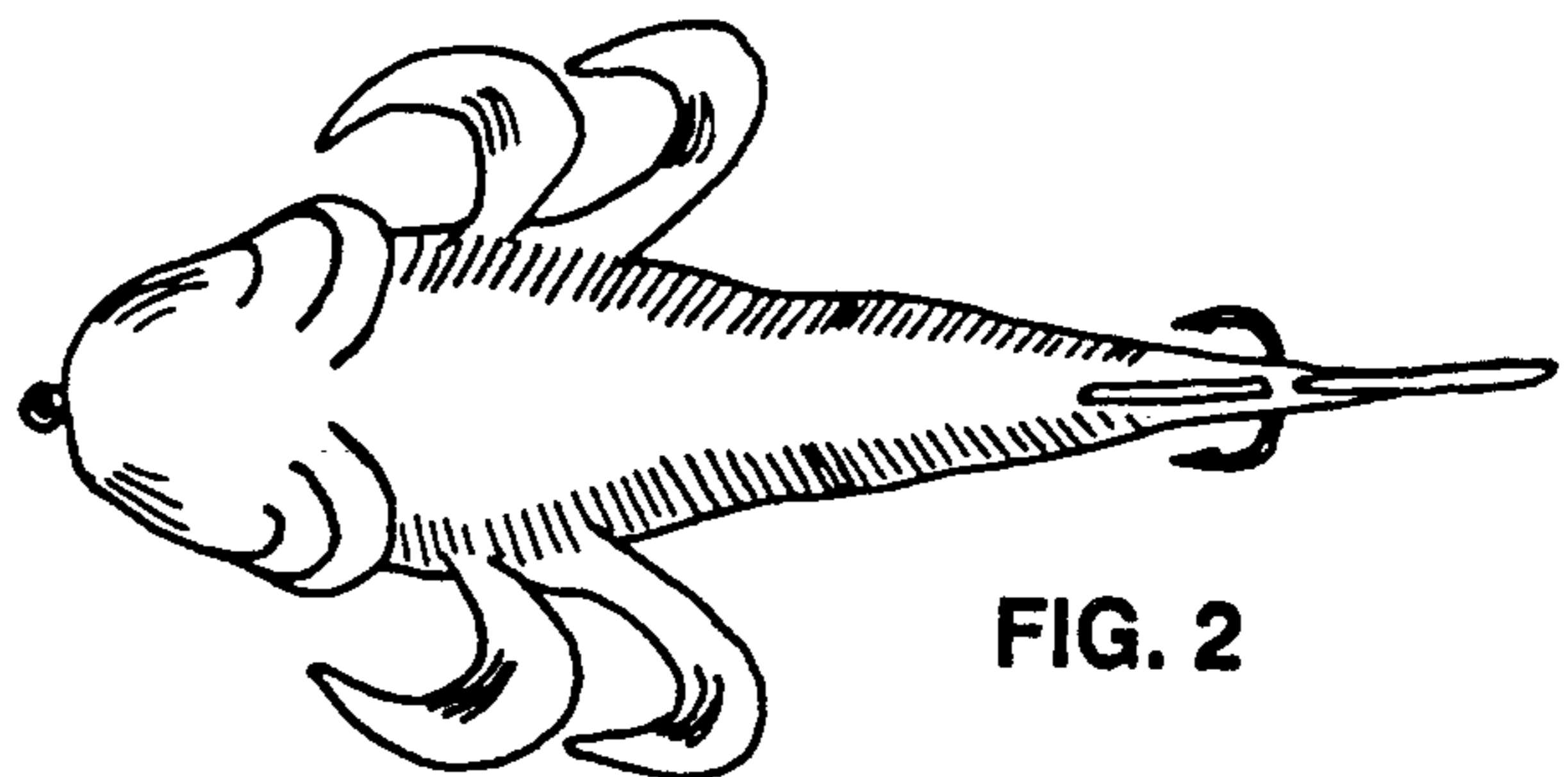
