FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the midsole;

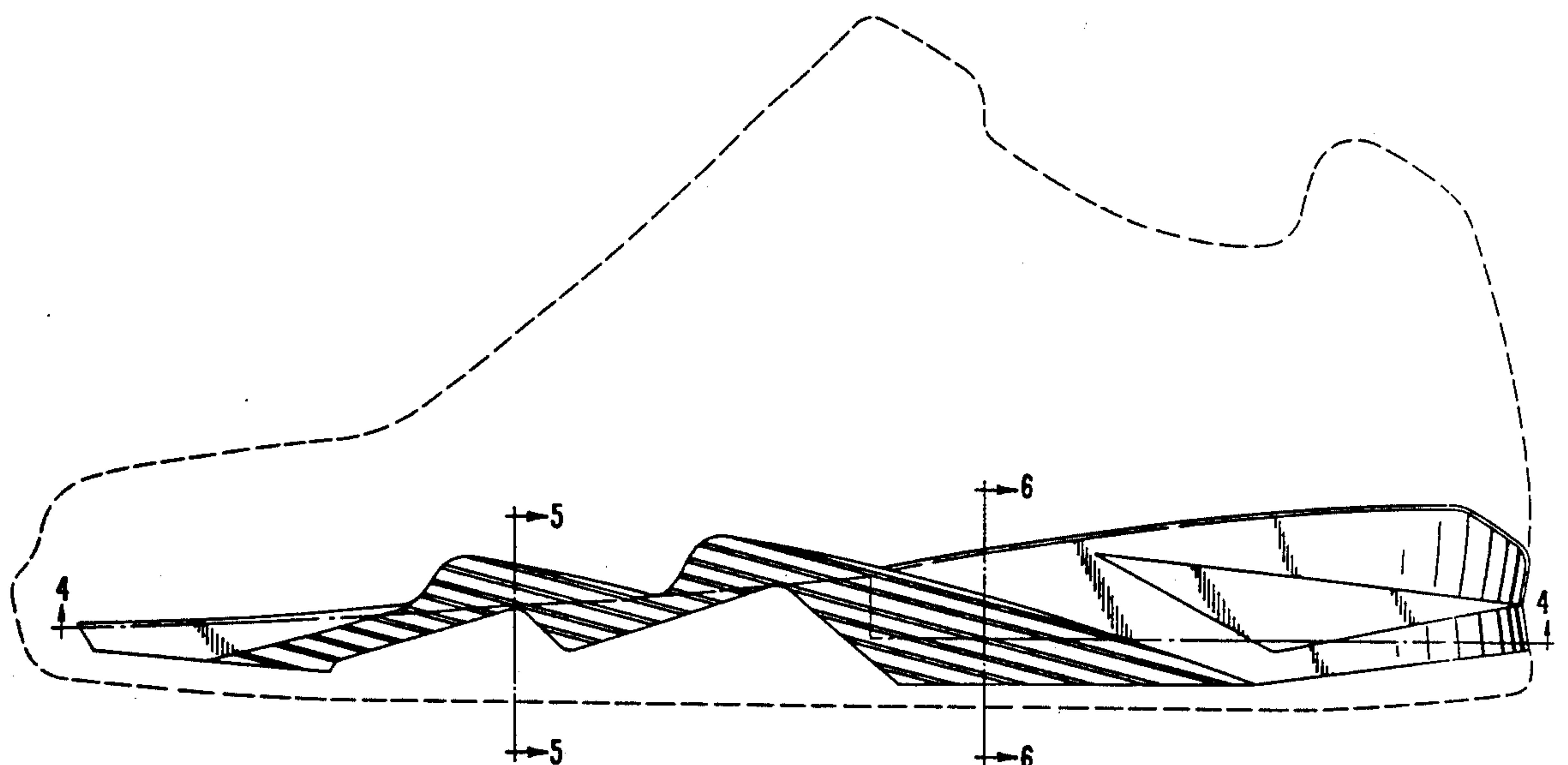
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 in
FIG. 2;

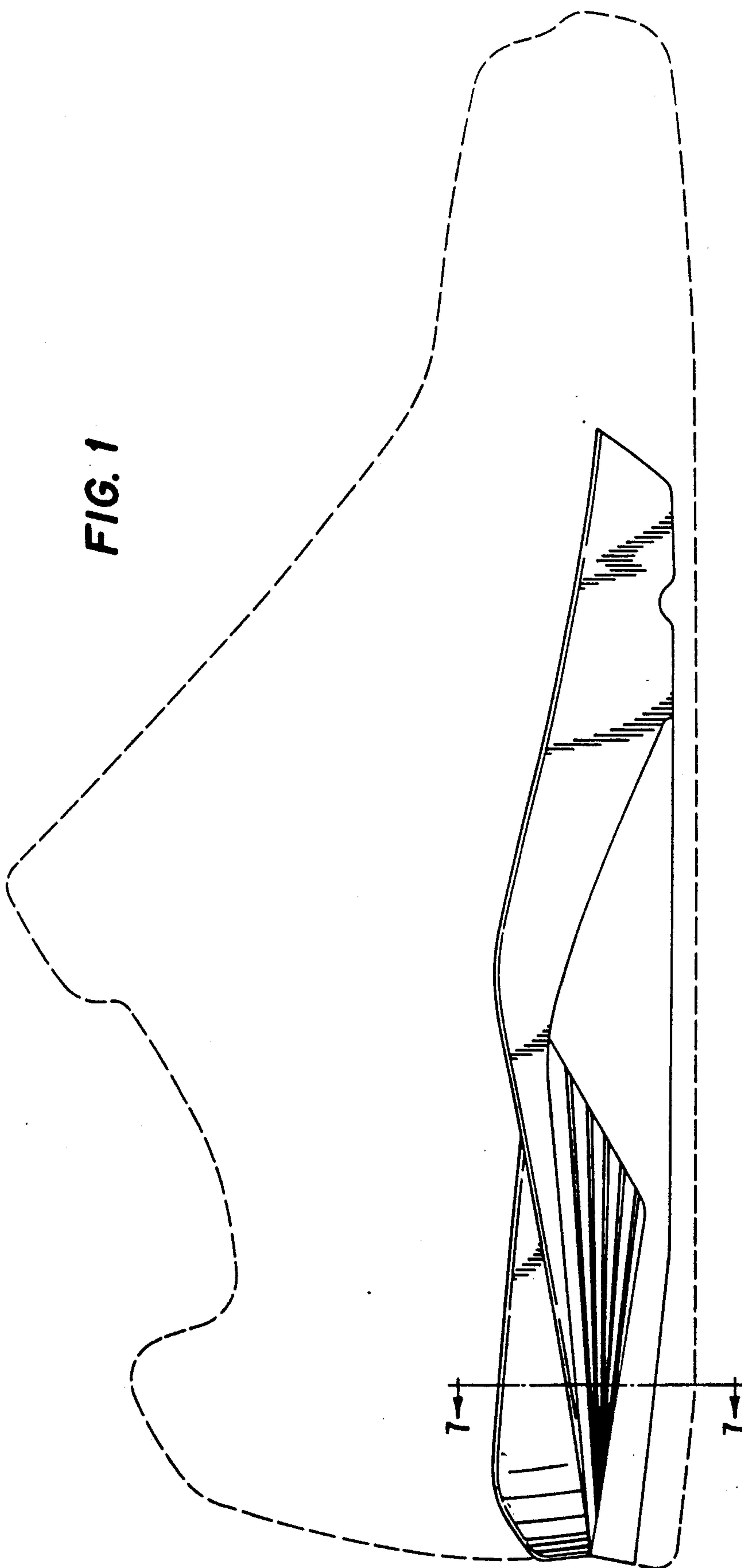
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 in

claimed design.





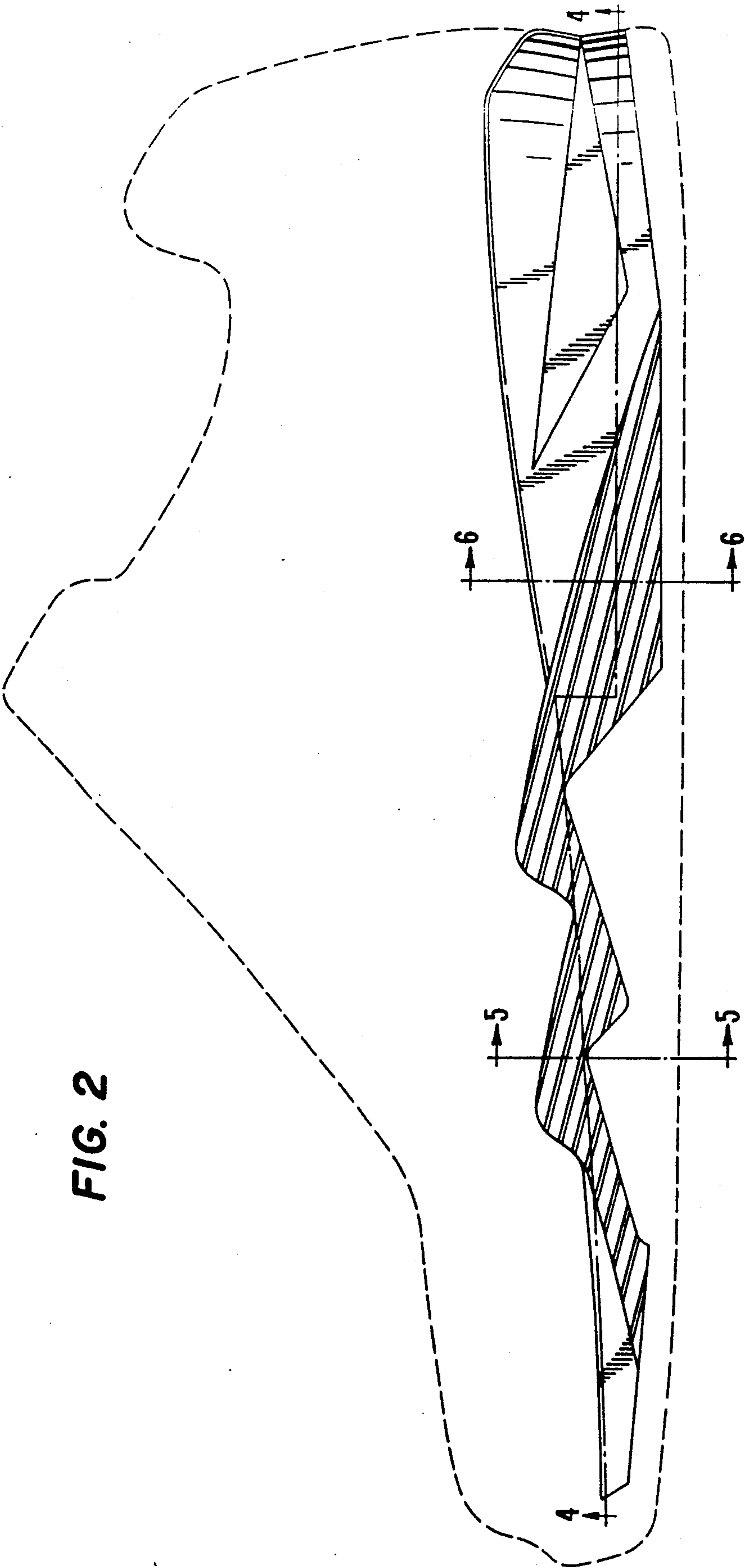

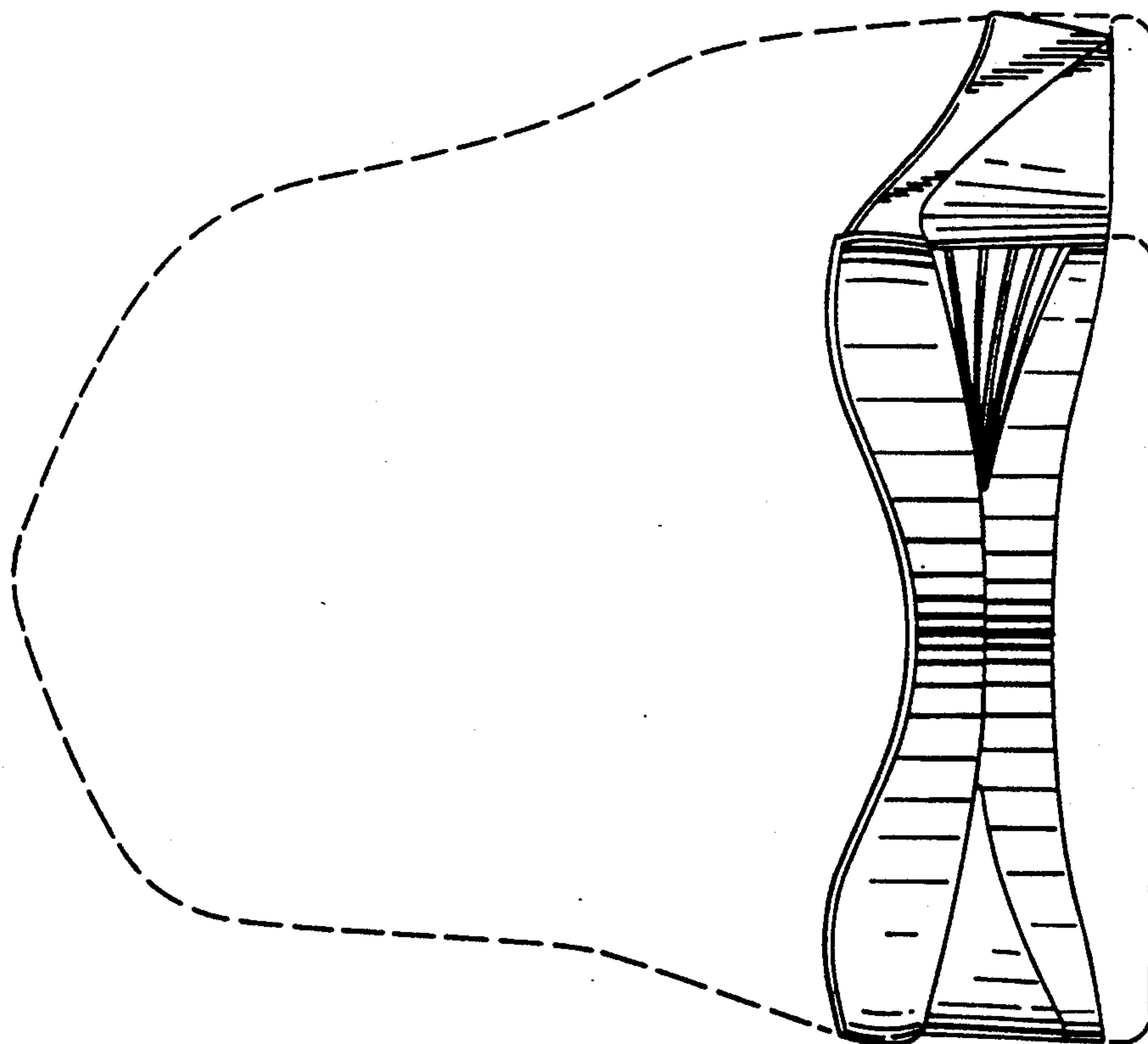
