FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a concrete float showing my new design;

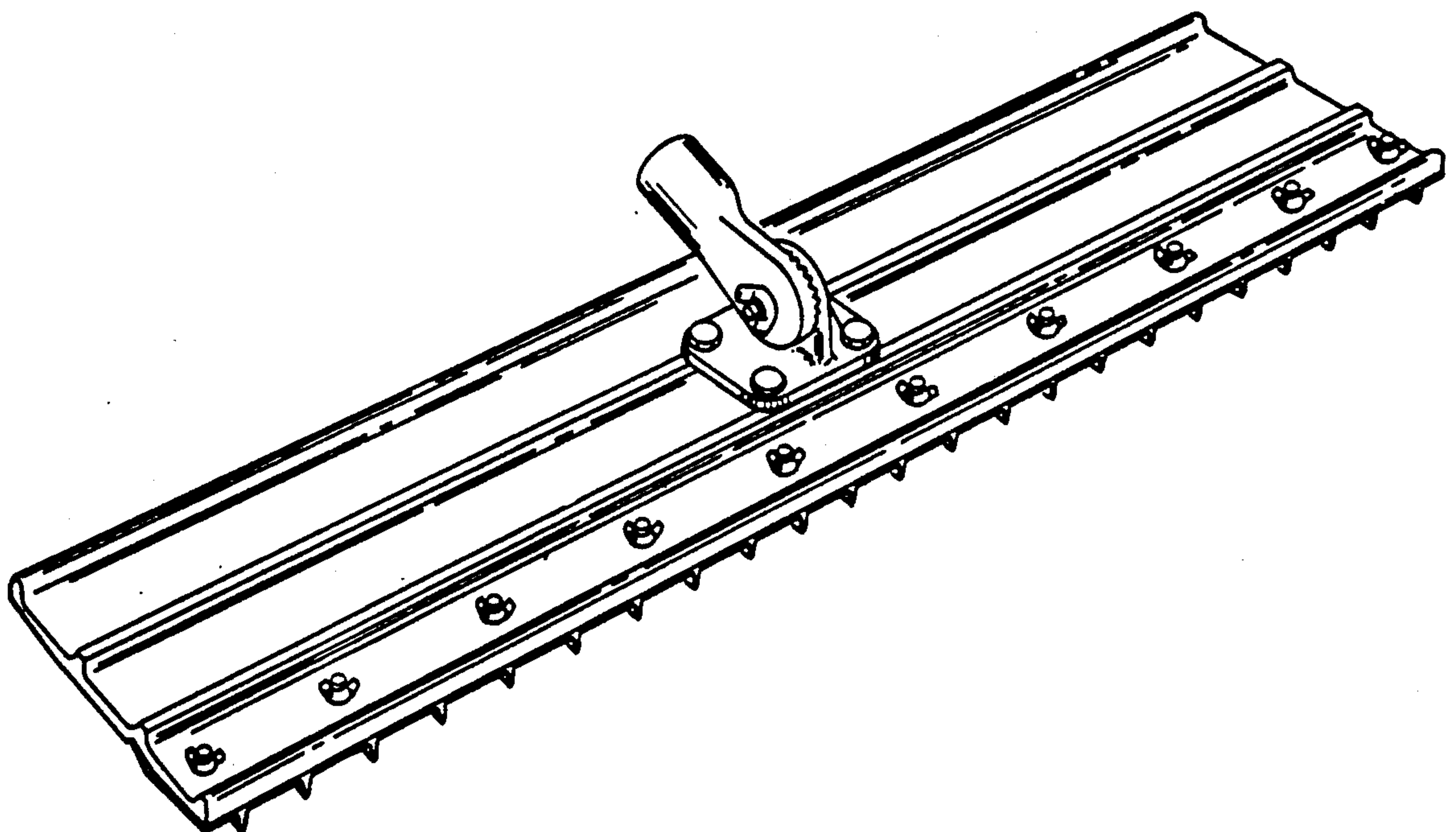
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.





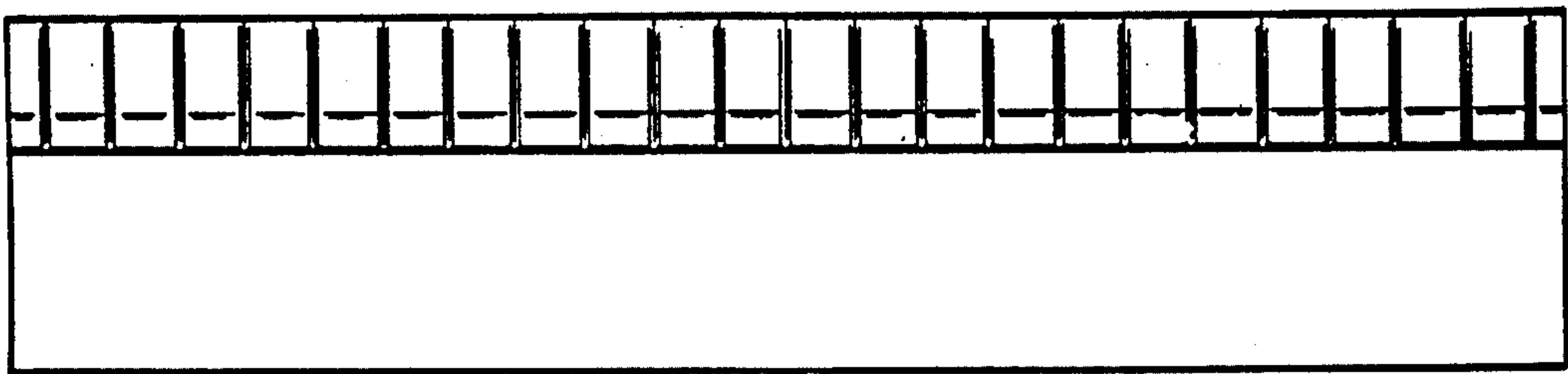

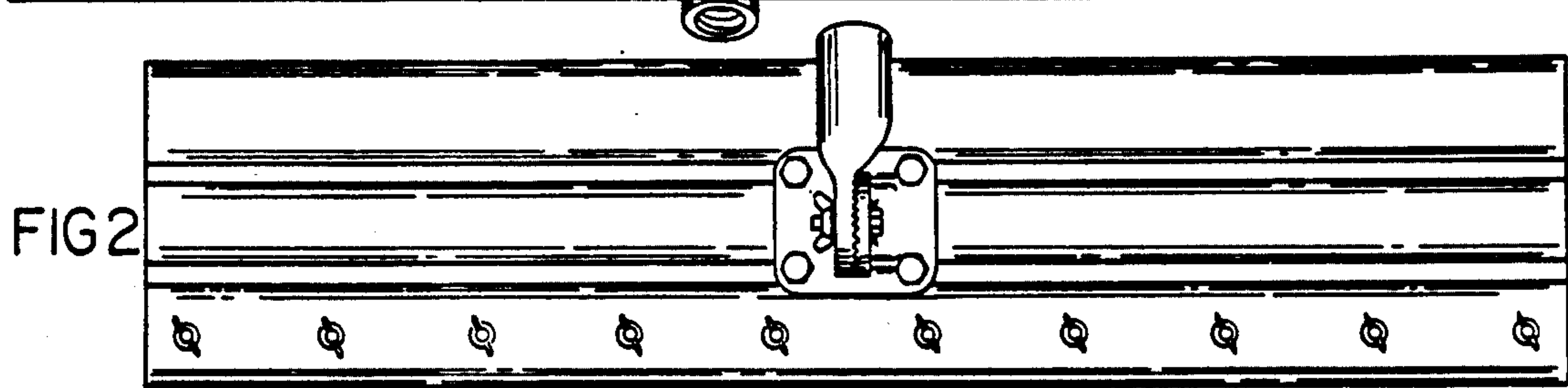

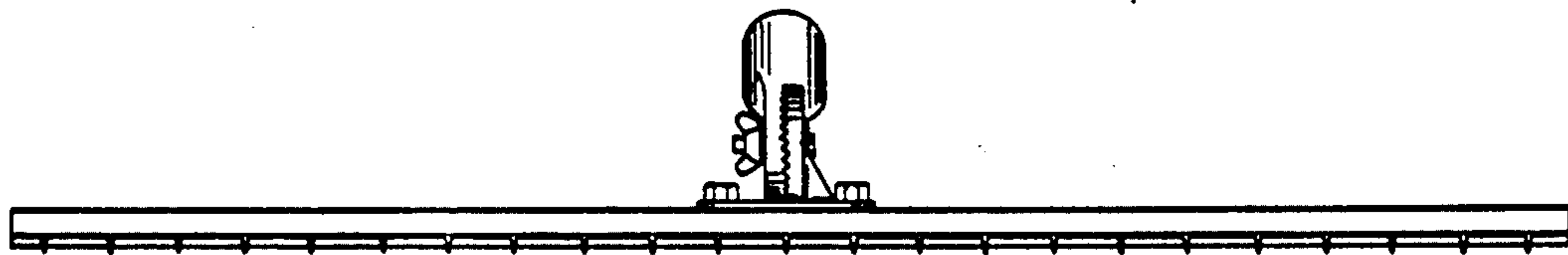

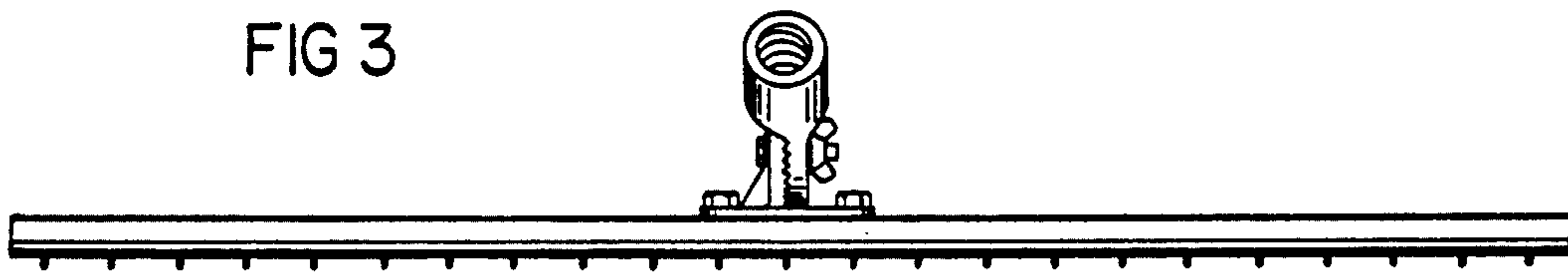

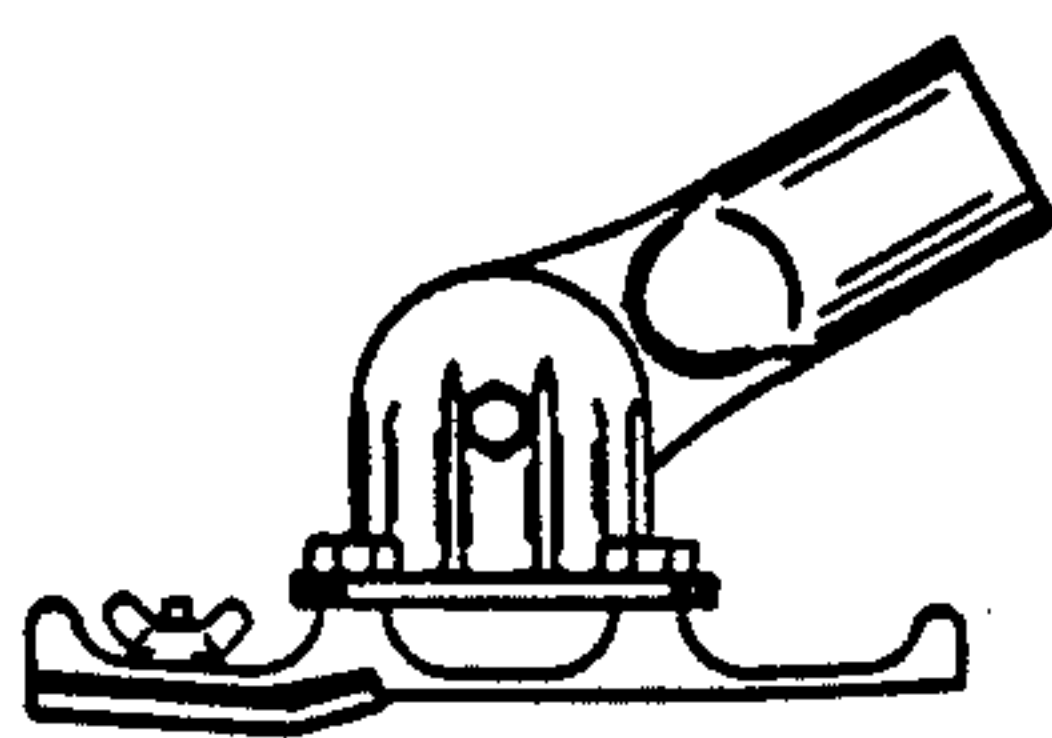

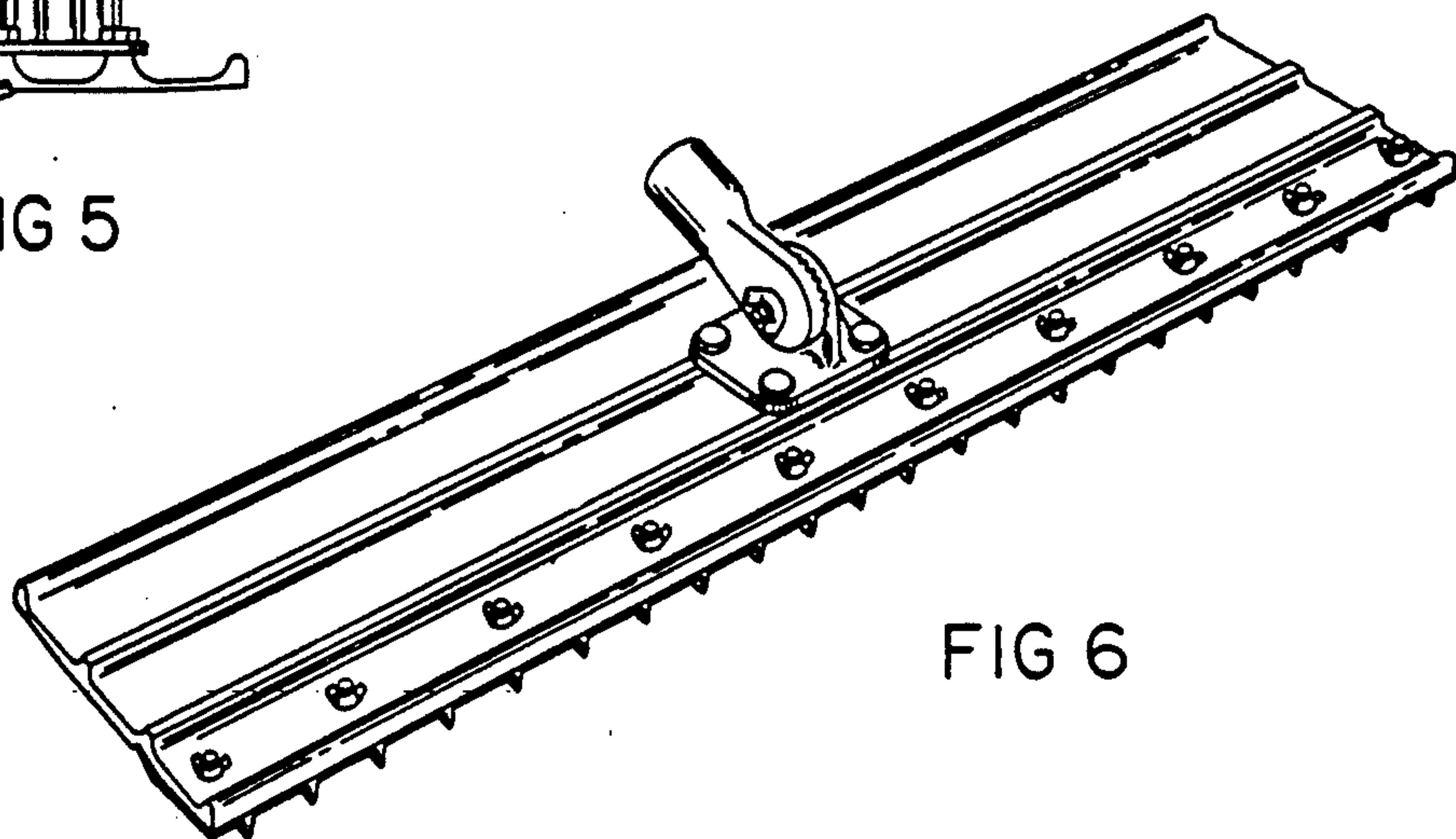
