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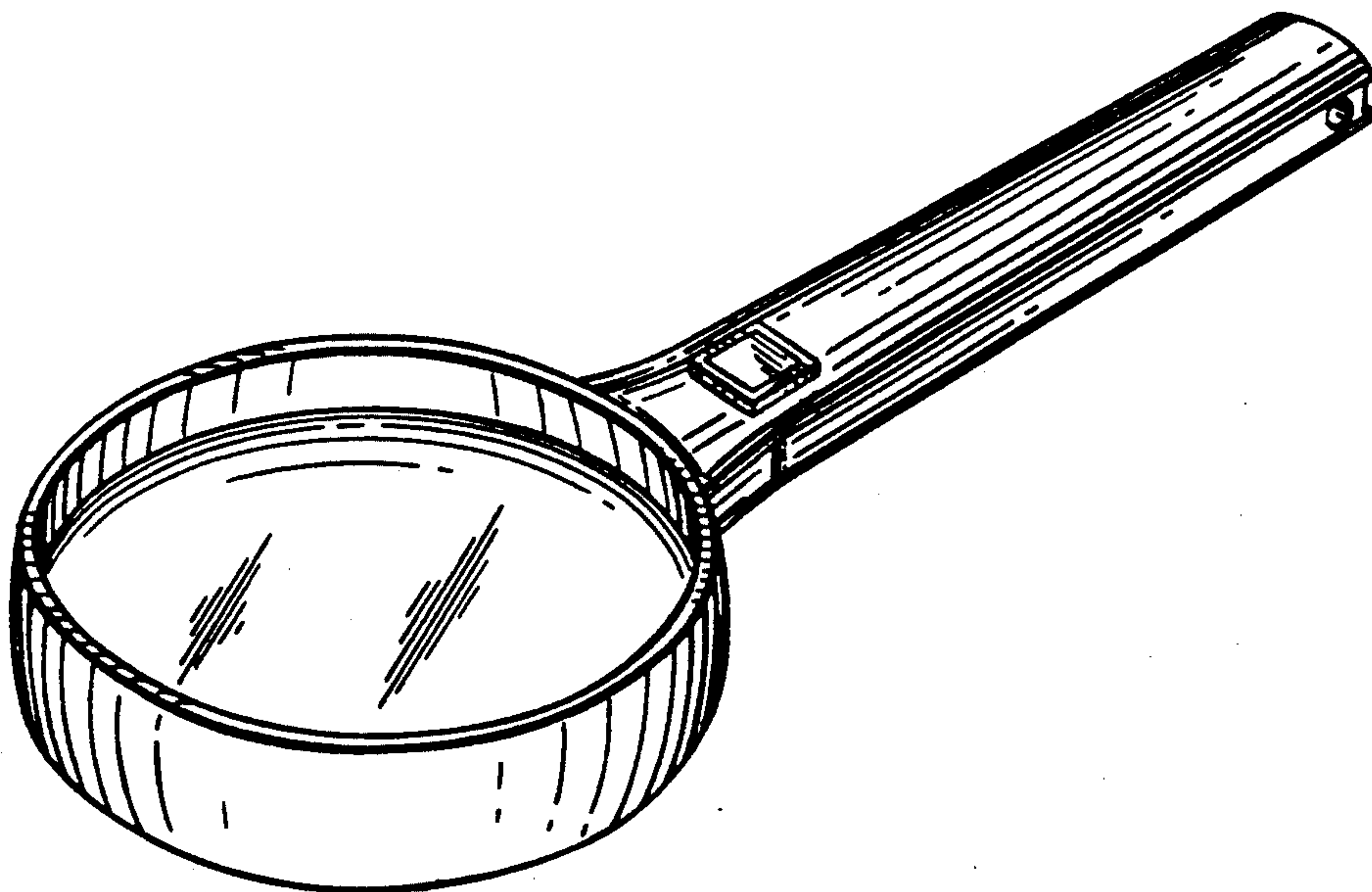

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a magnifying glass, showing our new design;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.



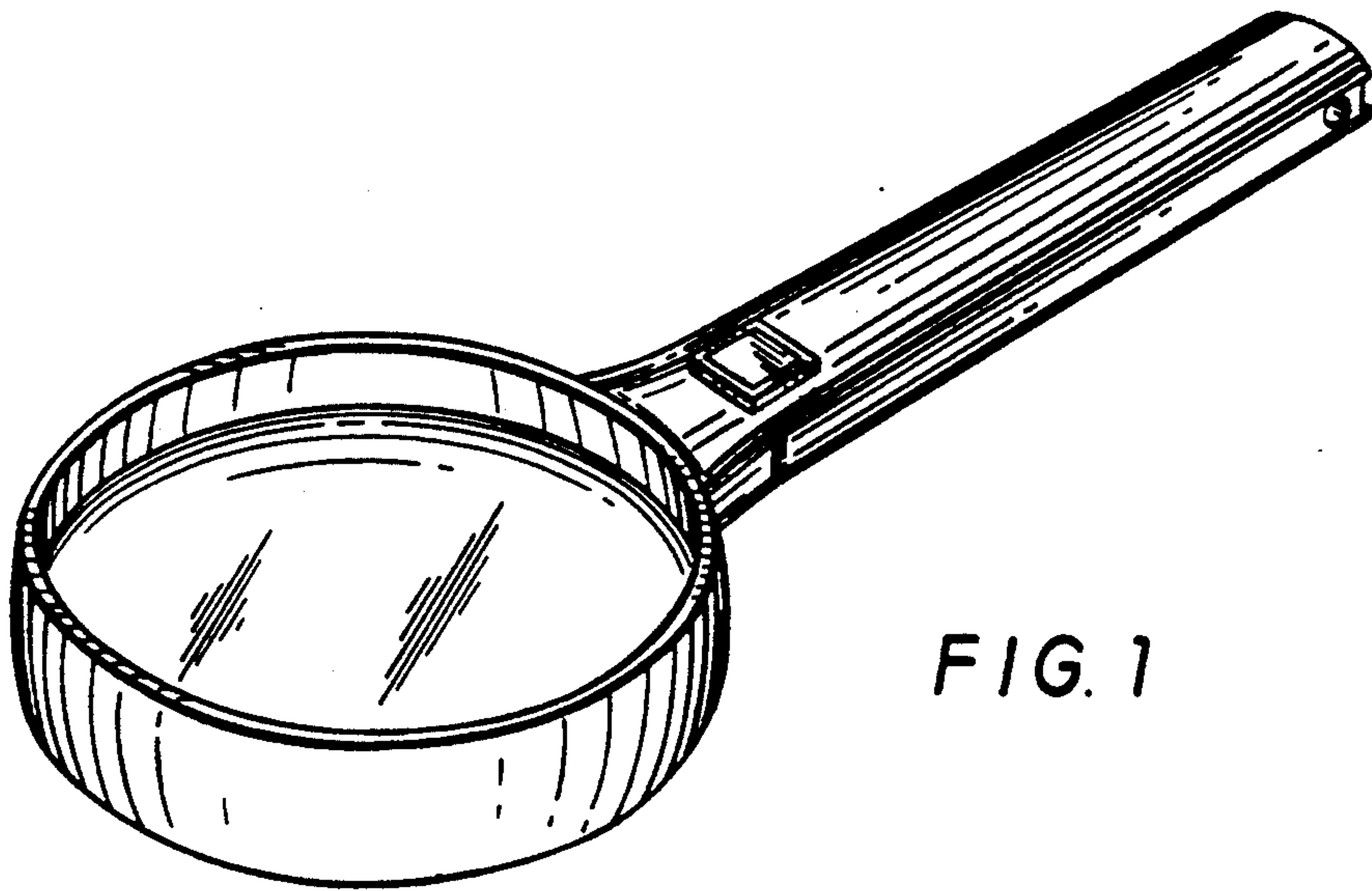

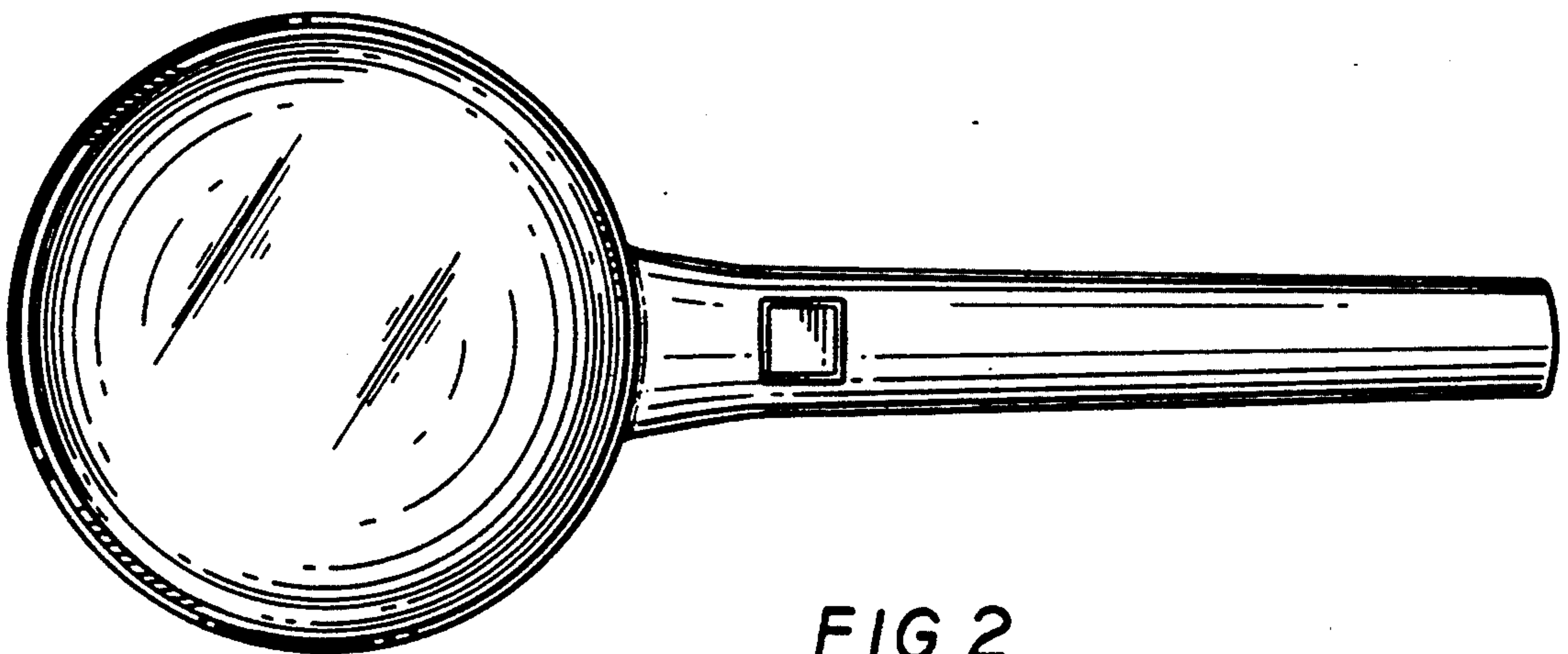

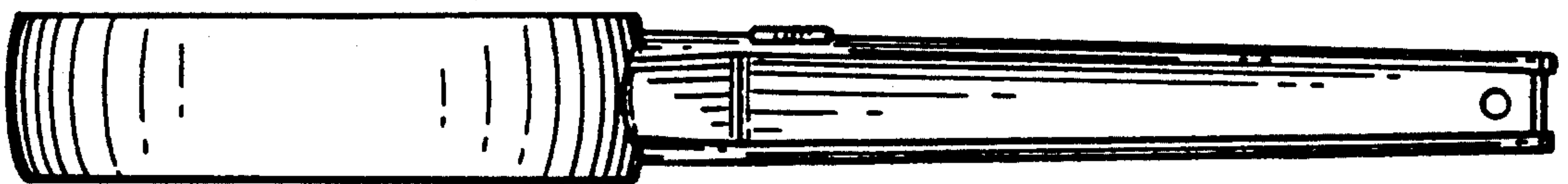

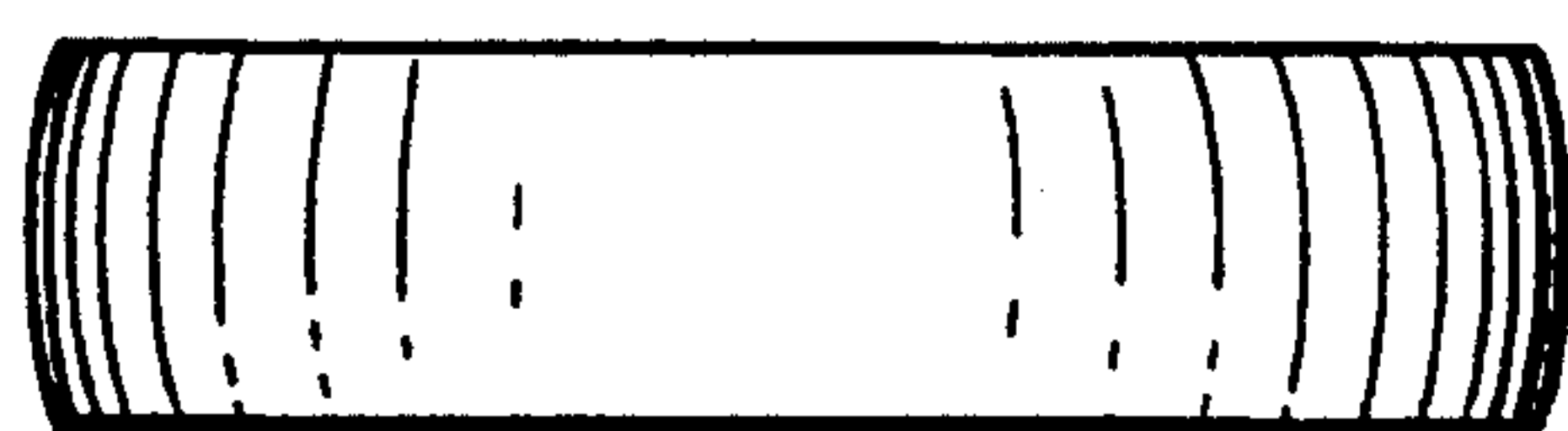

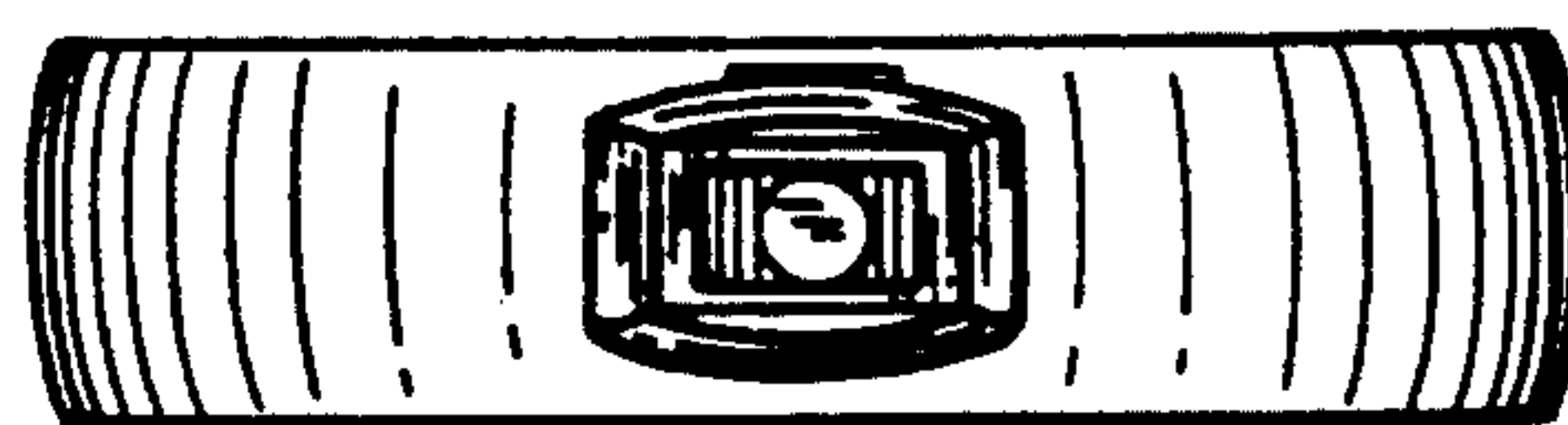

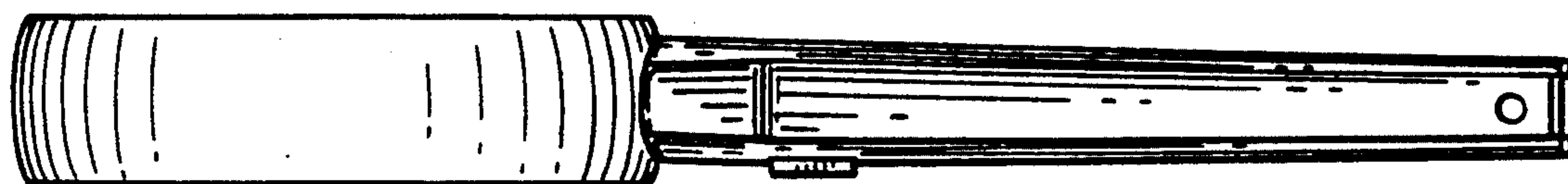

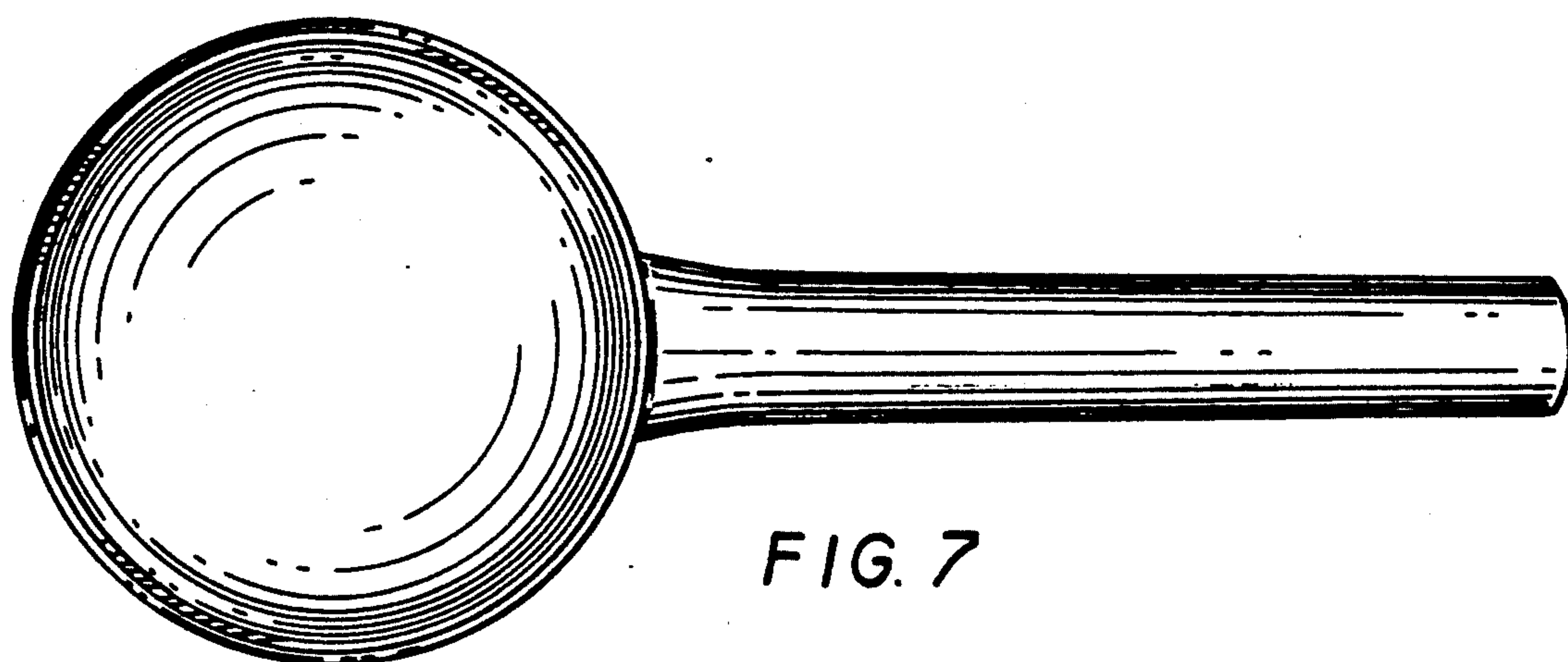
