unornamented;

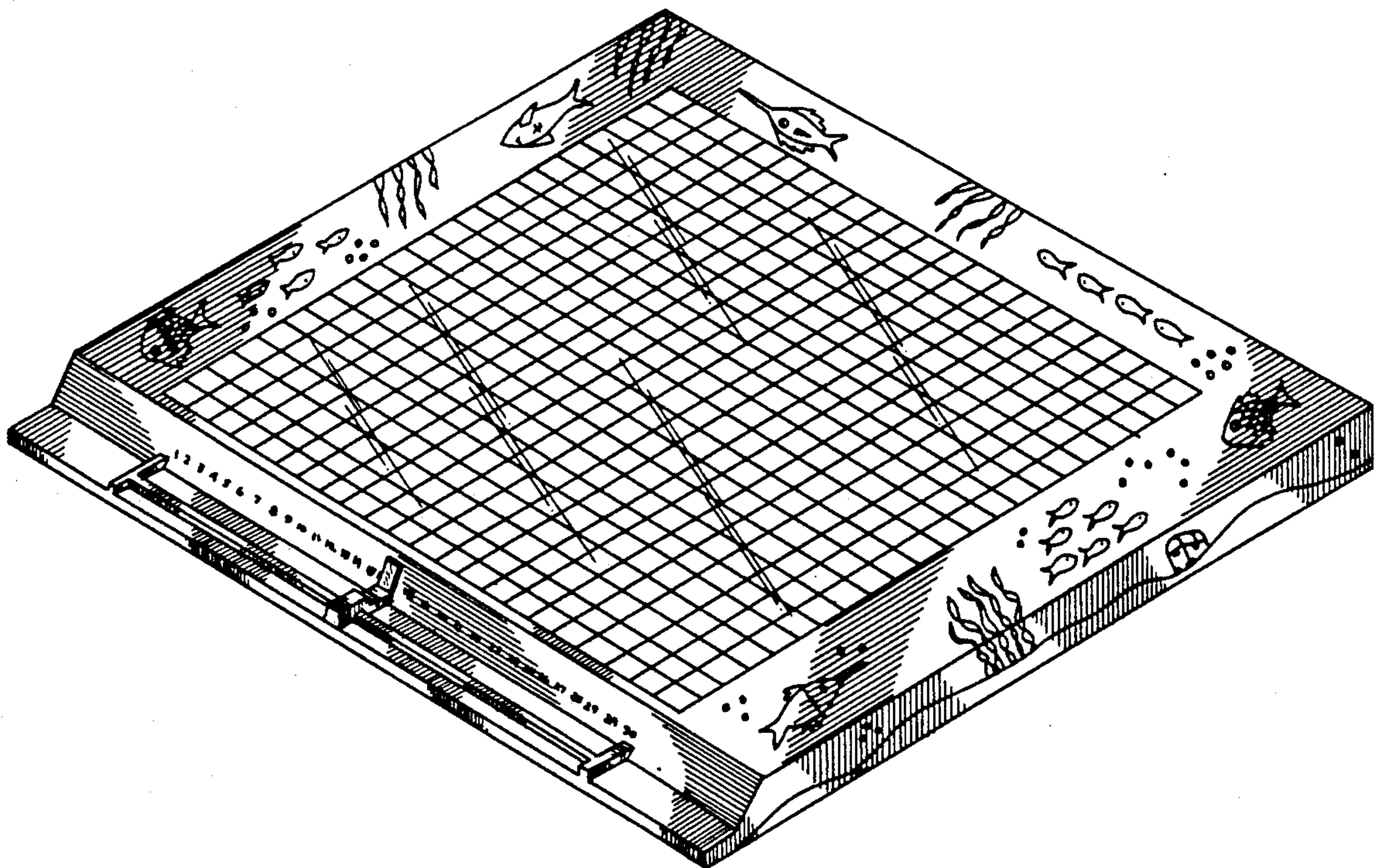
FIG. 2 is a front side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



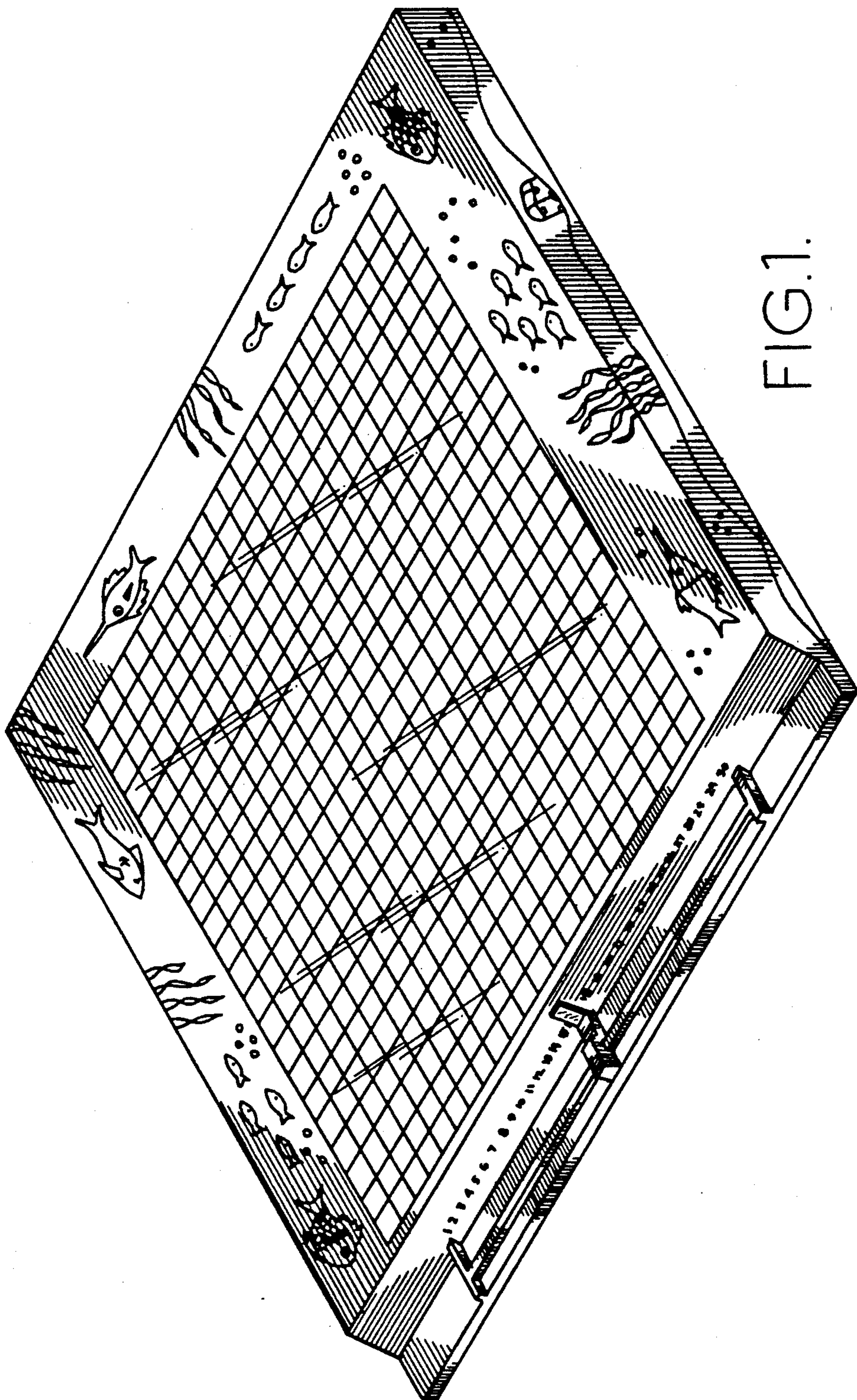

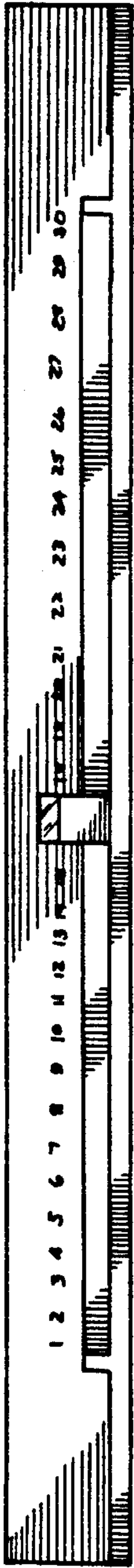

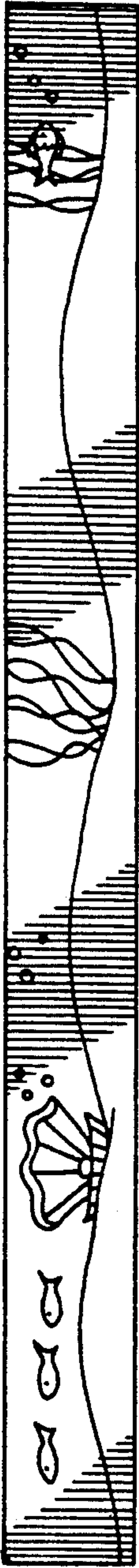

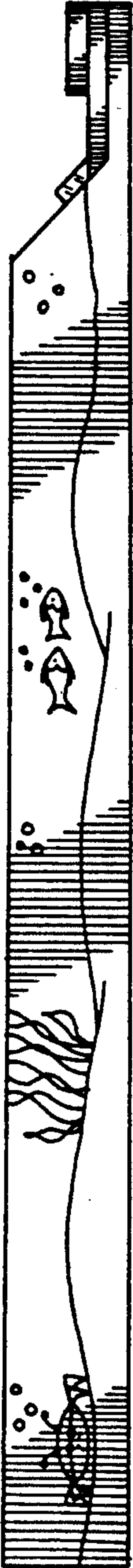

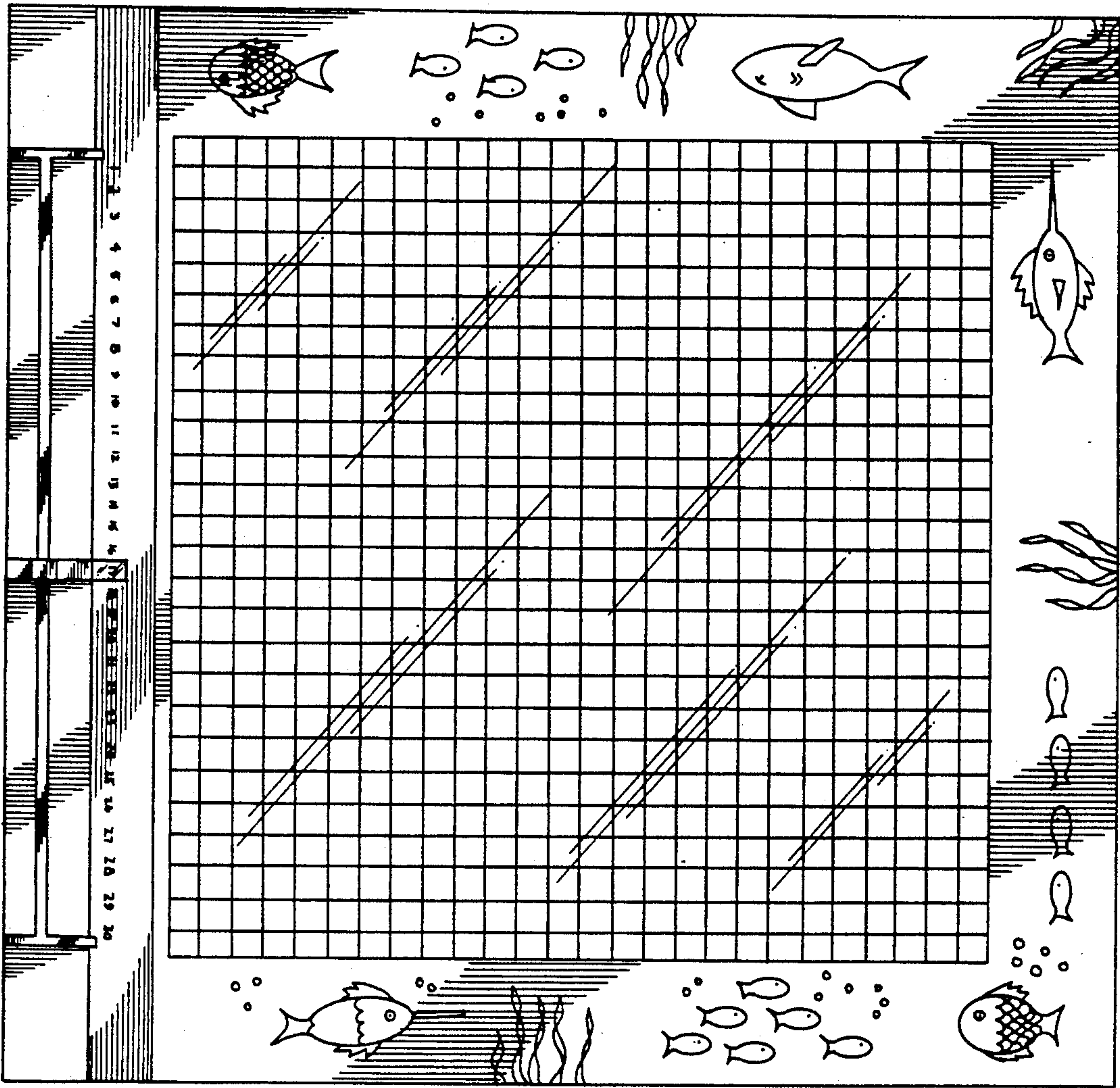
