[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a foot pedal for a physical exerciser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a foot pedal for a physical exerciser showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational thereof, the rear elevational view thereof is a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is another top plan view thereof but without a tread pattern.
The broken line showing of a stepper exercise machine in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
The broken line showing of a tread pattern in FIGS. 1-3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

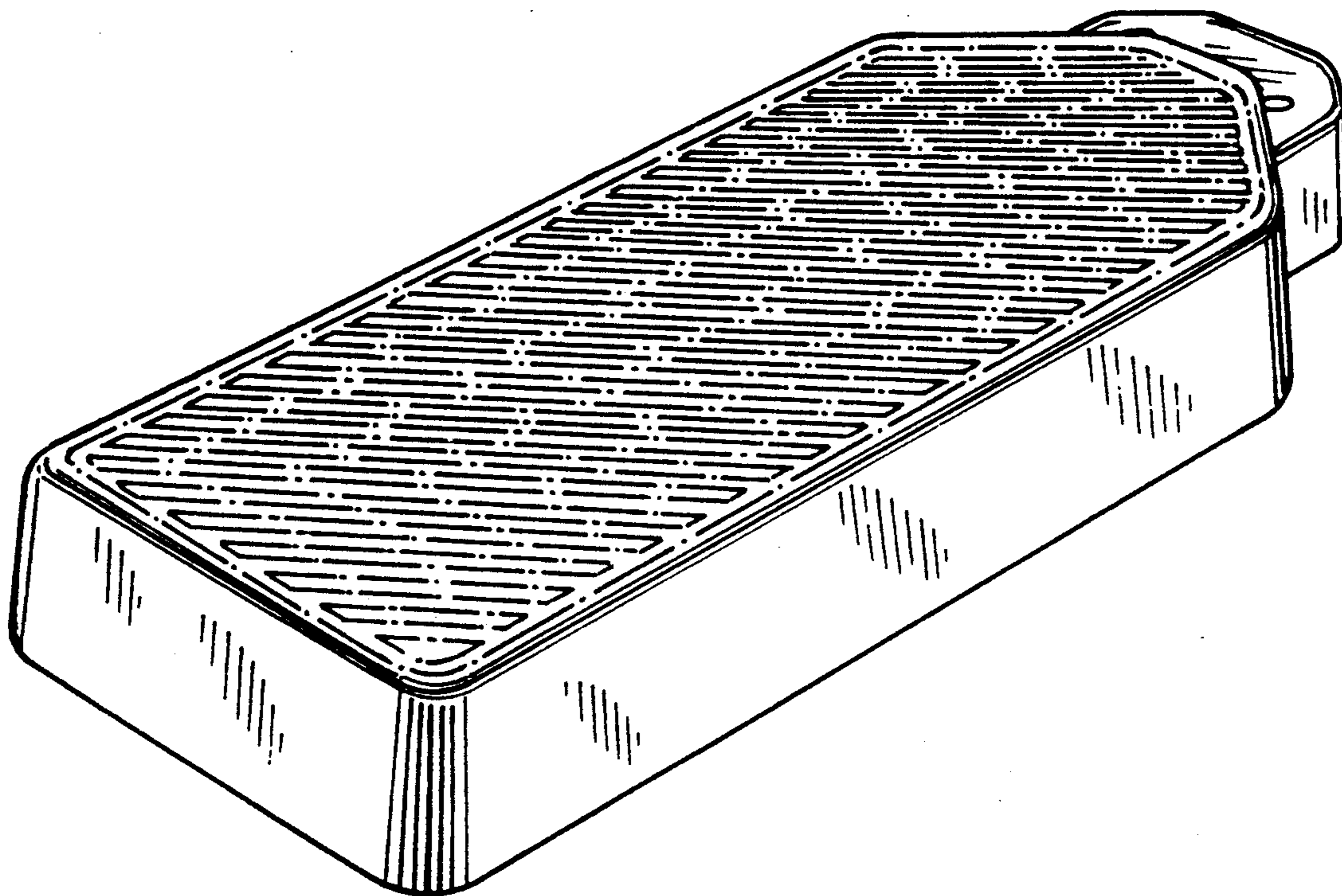

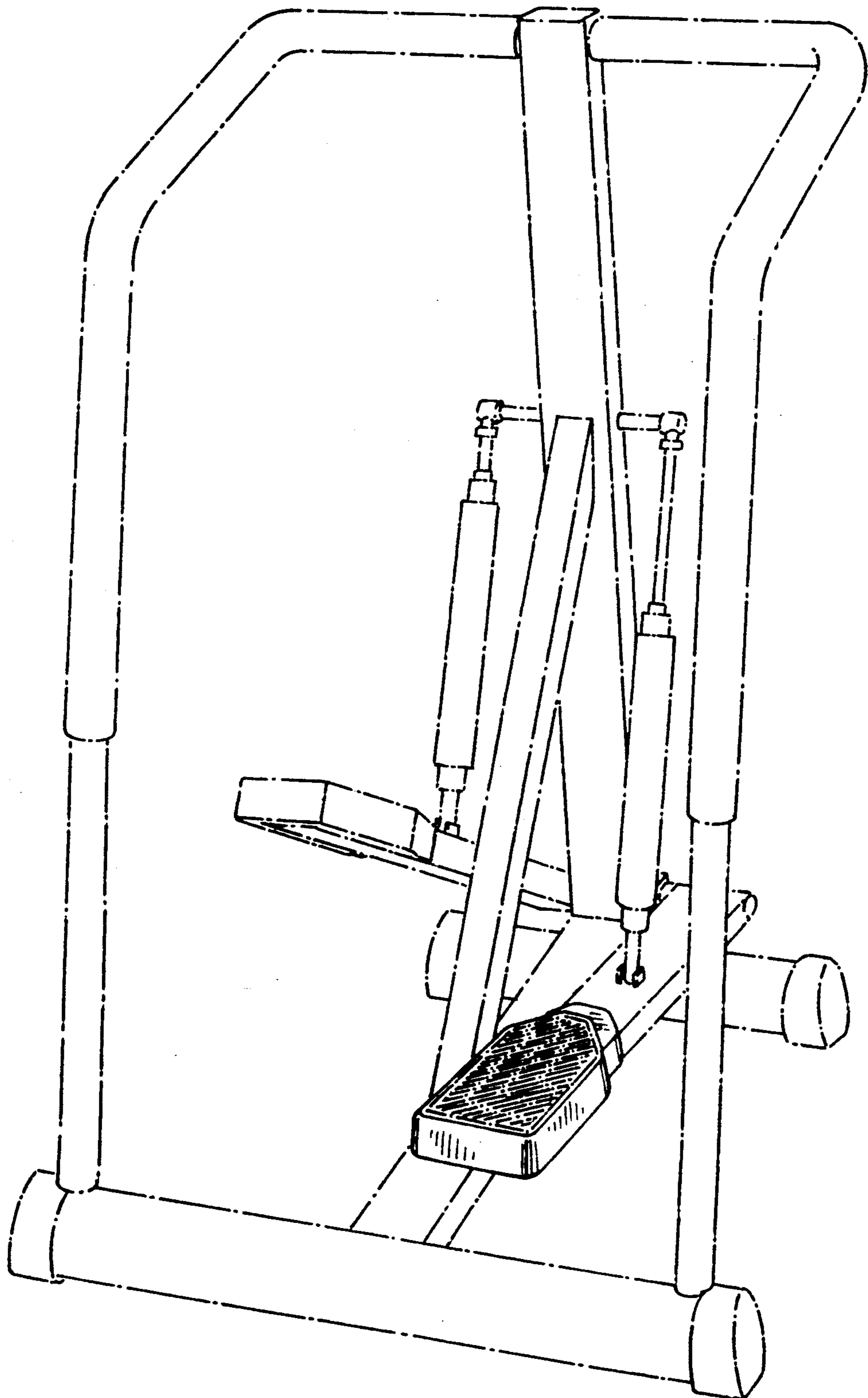

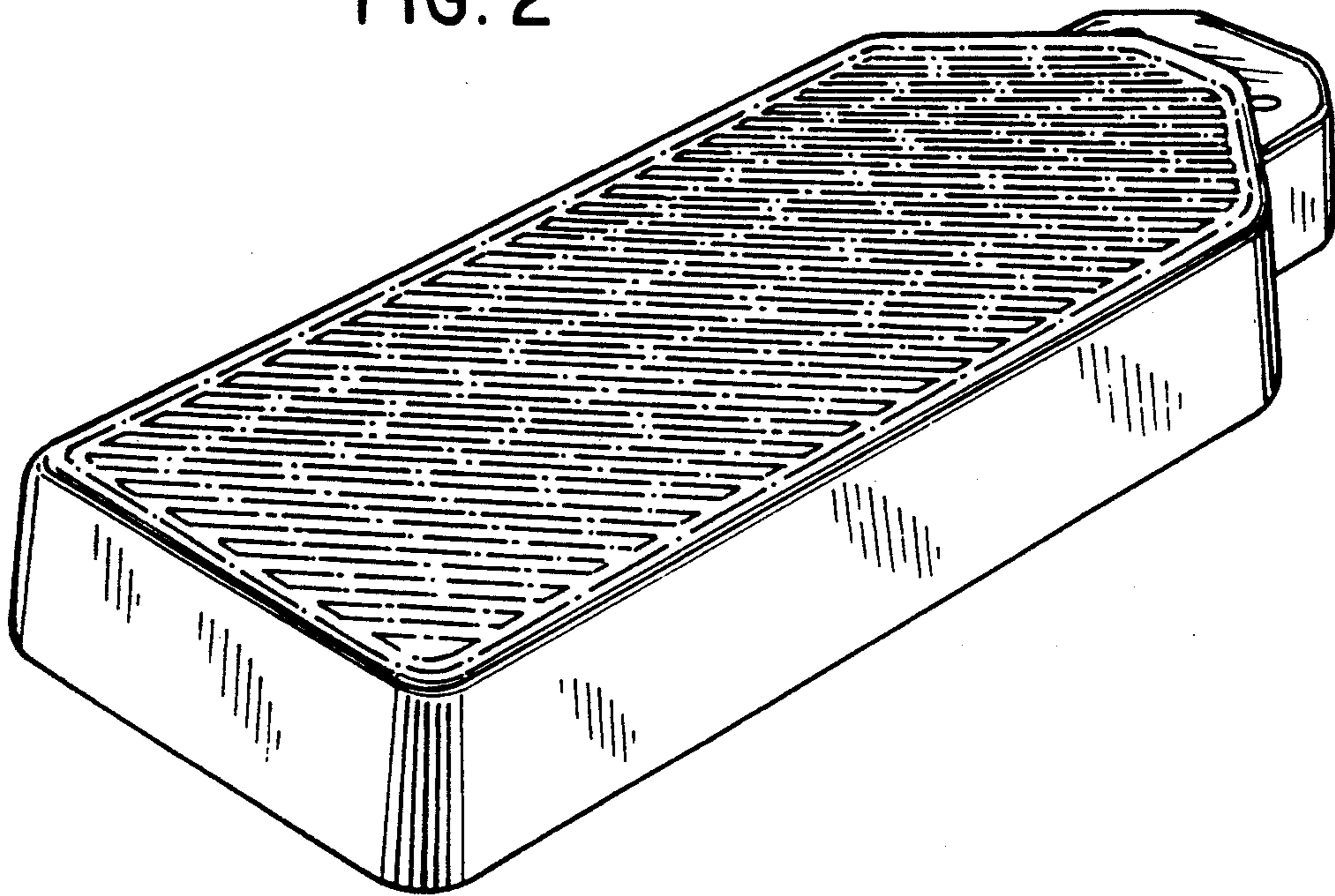

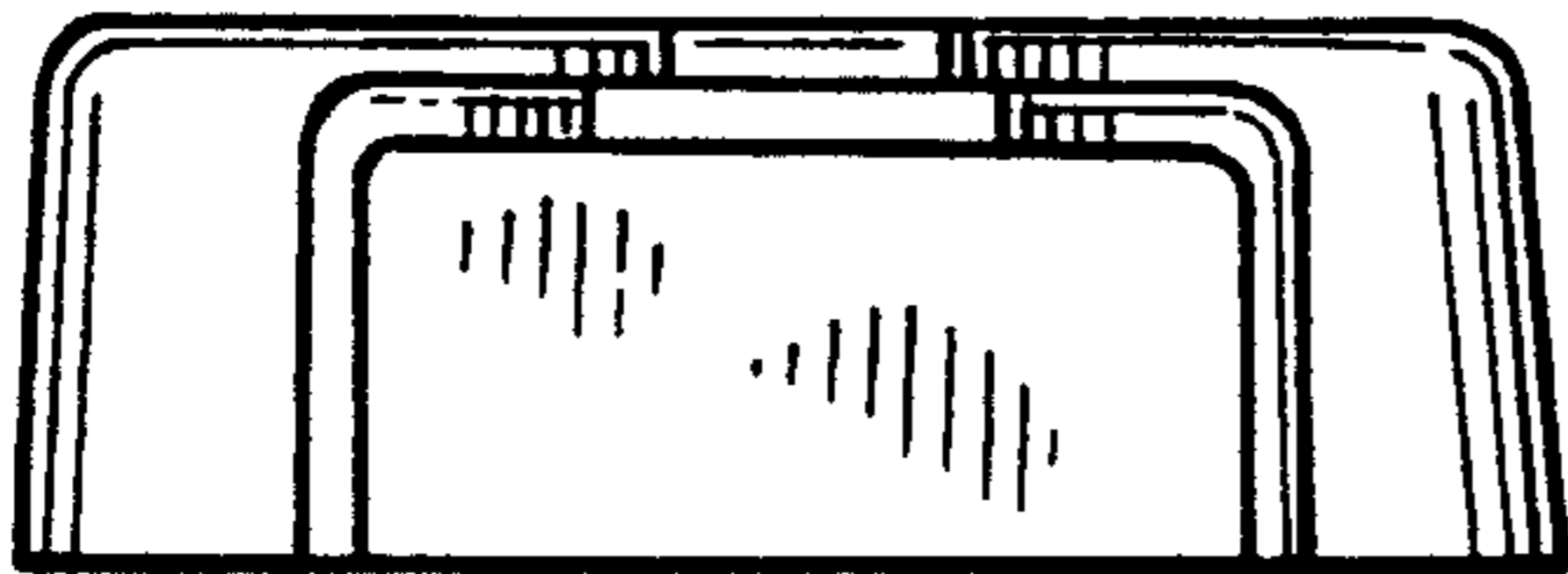

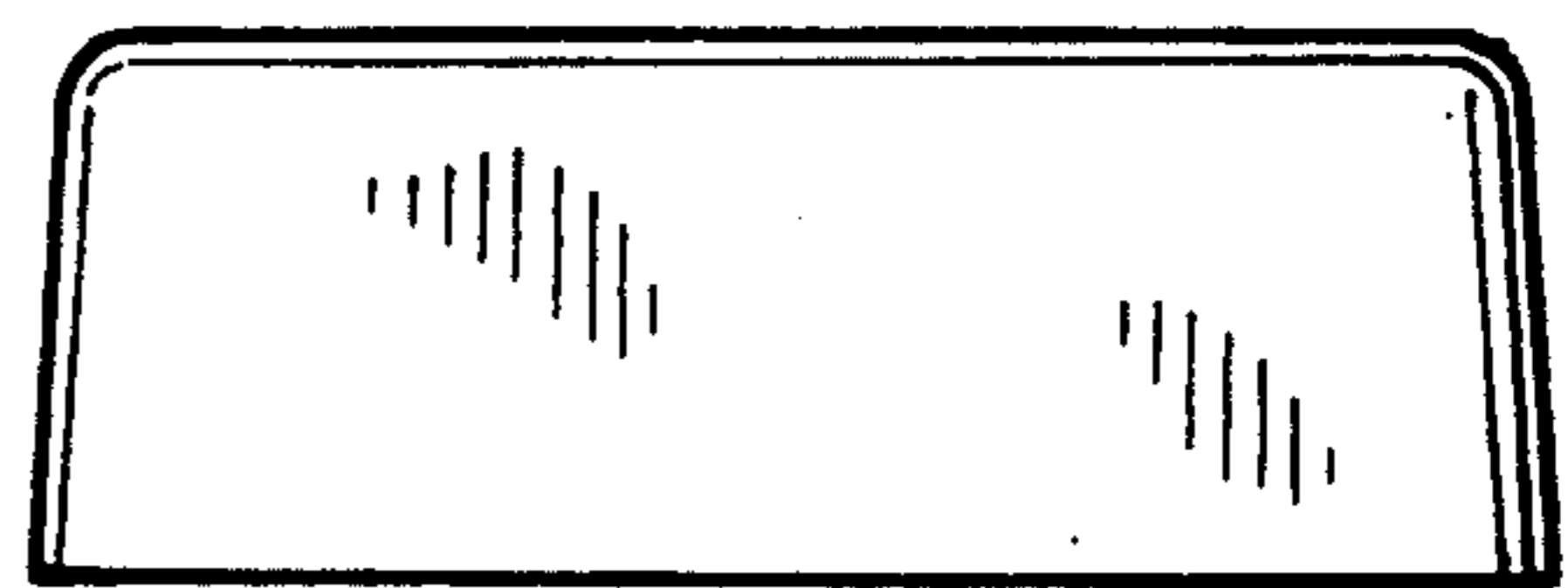
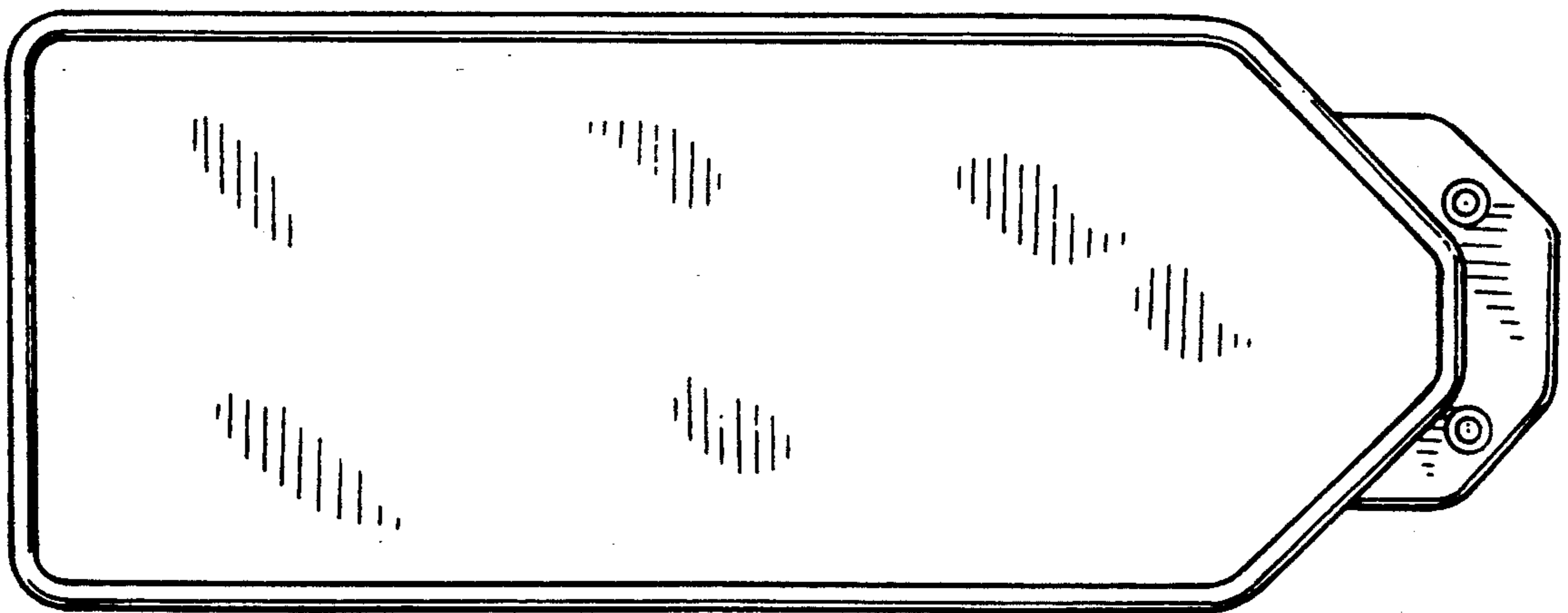

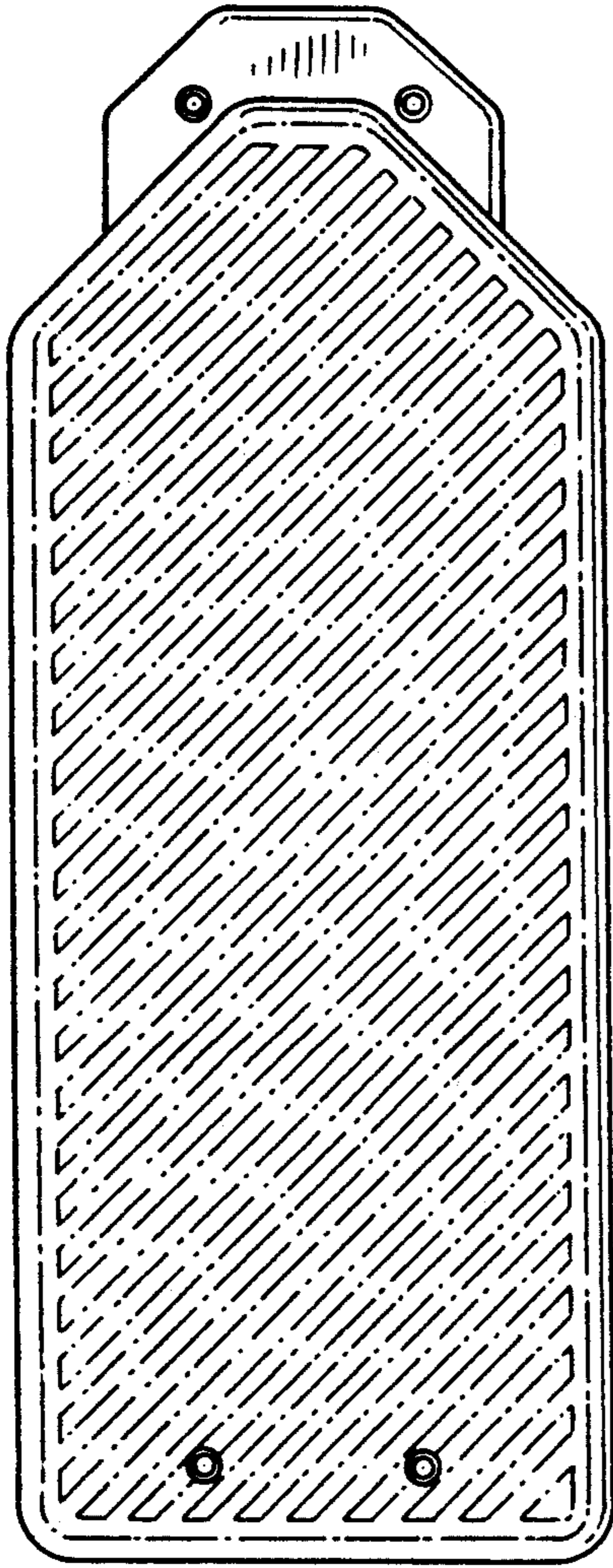

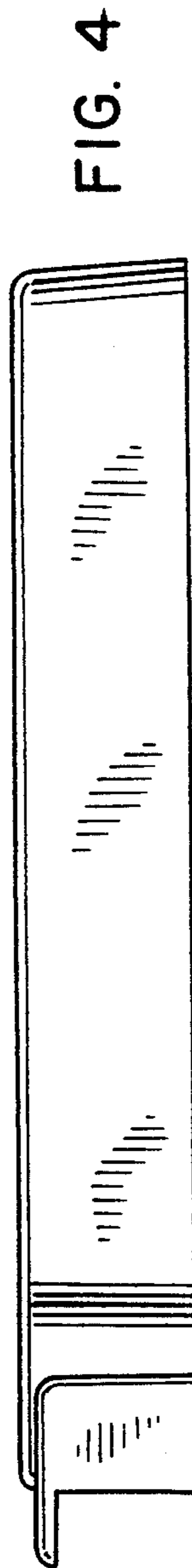

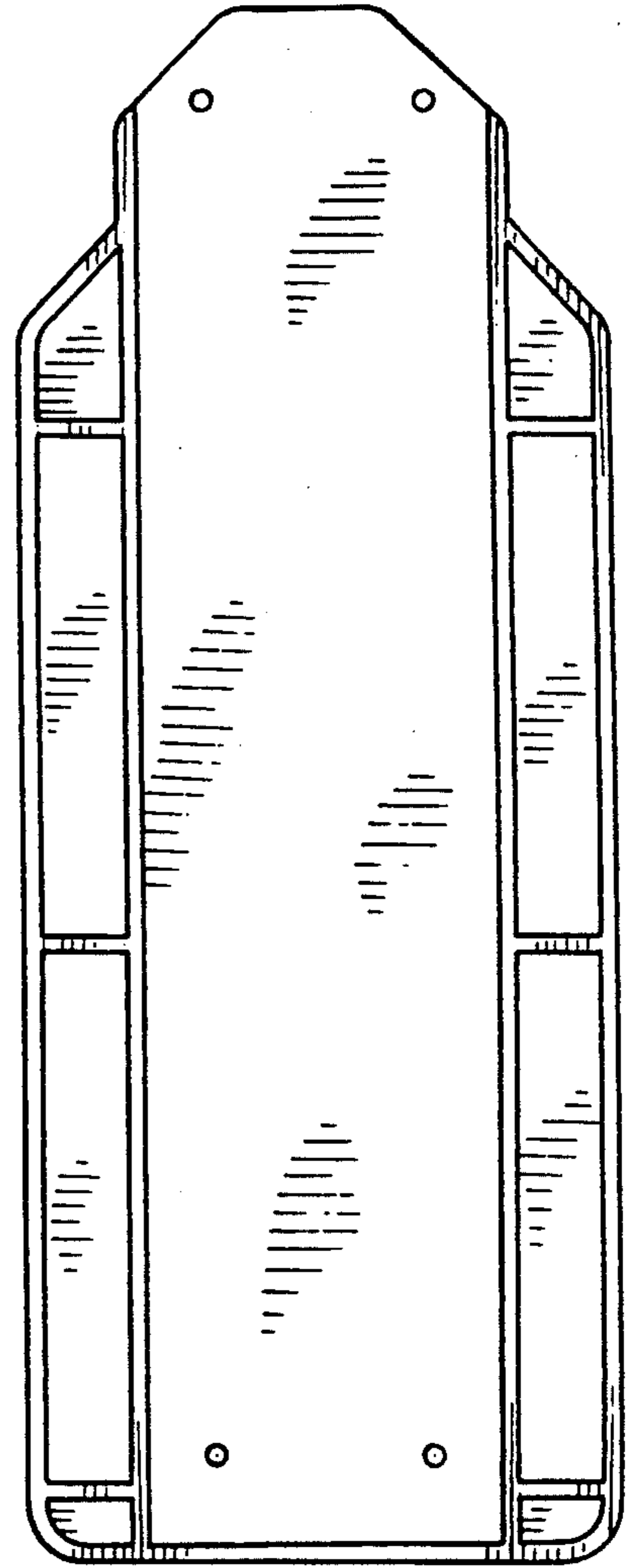
