FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

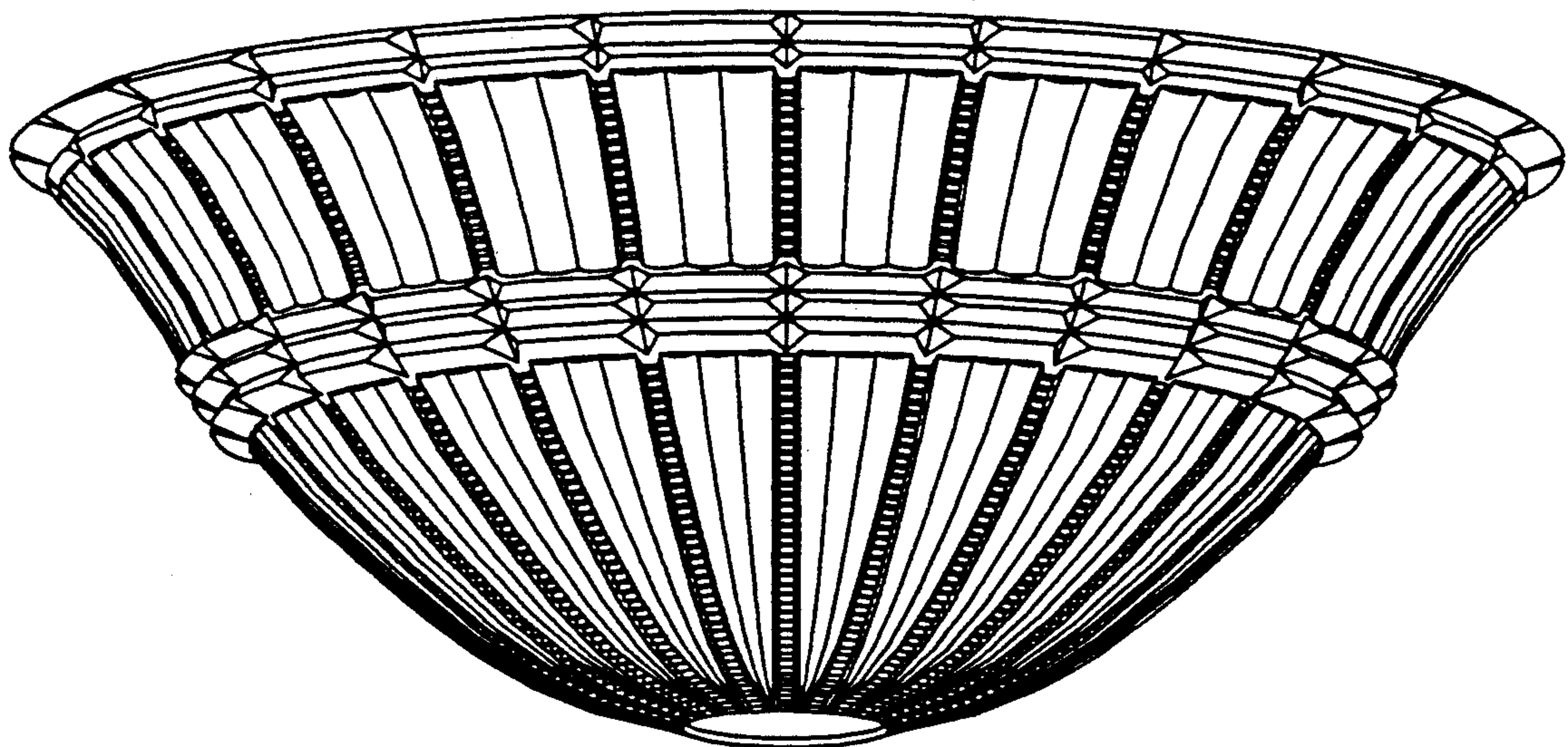
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof.



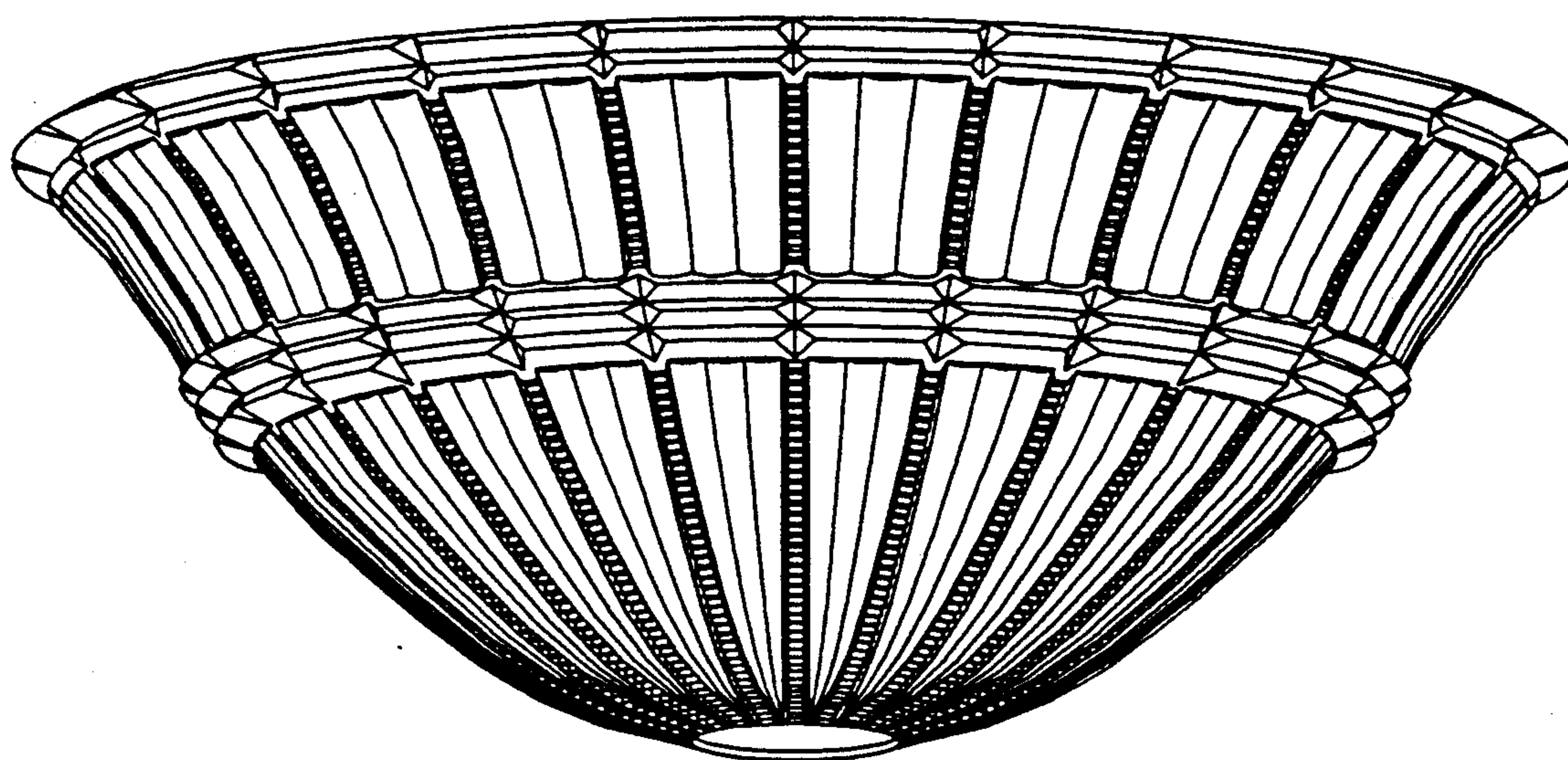

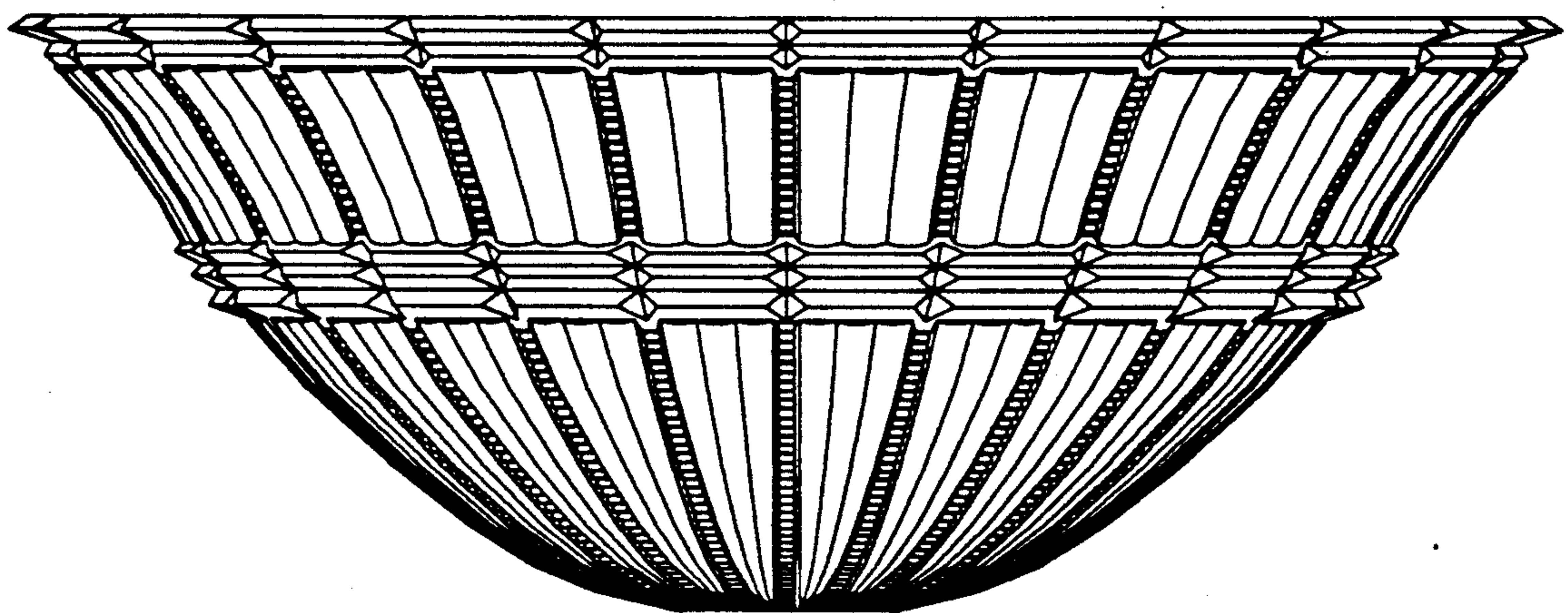

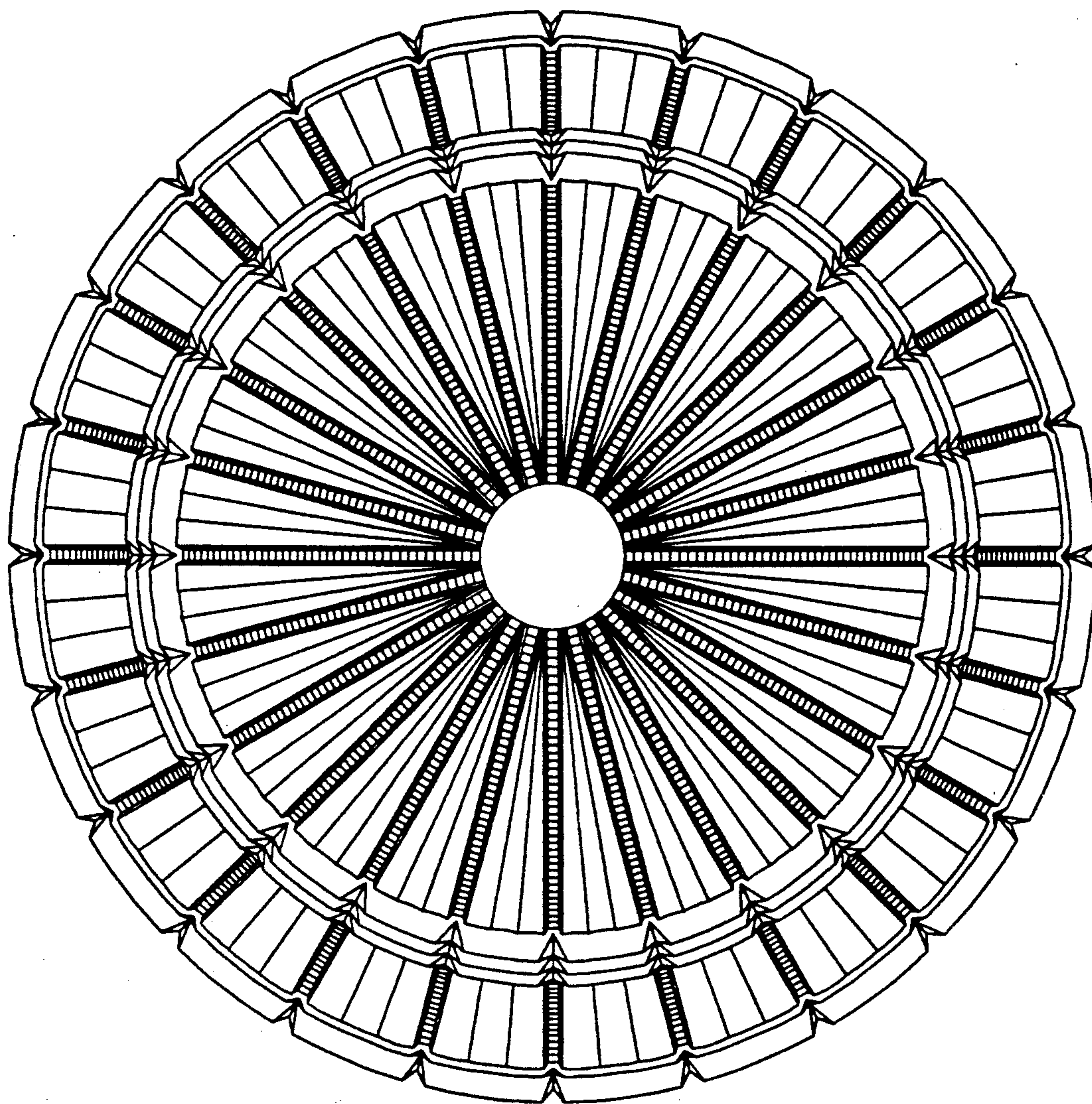

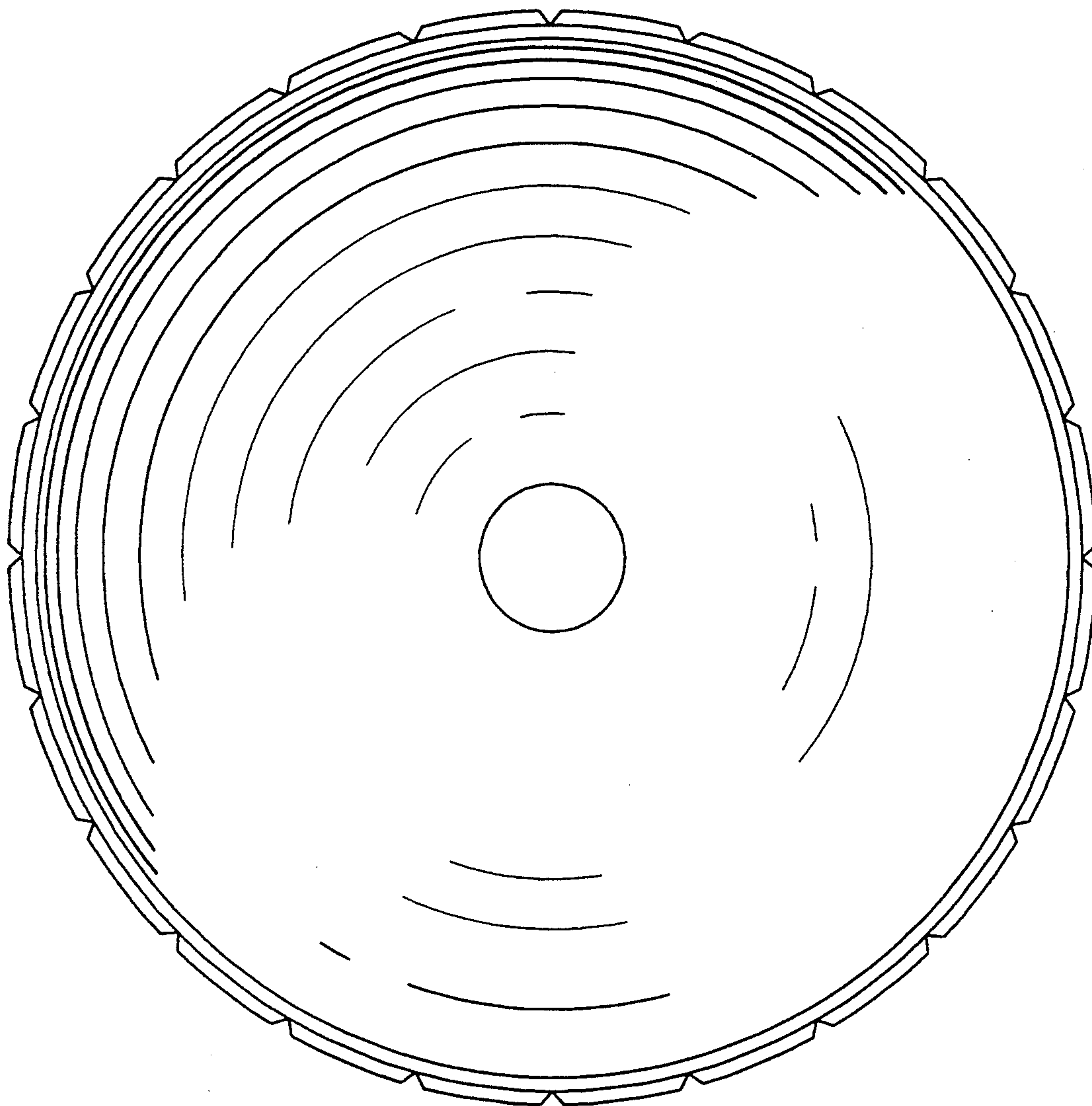

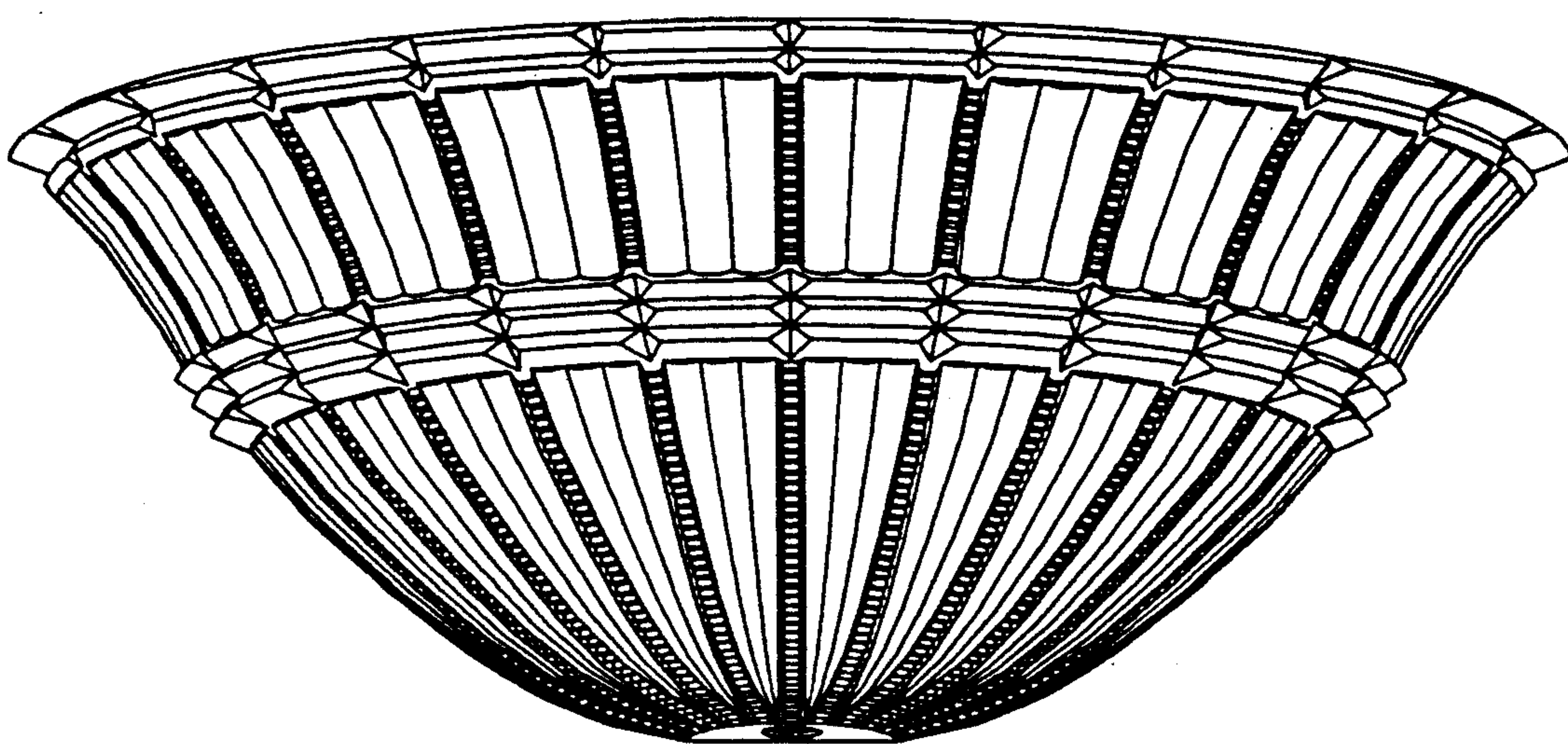

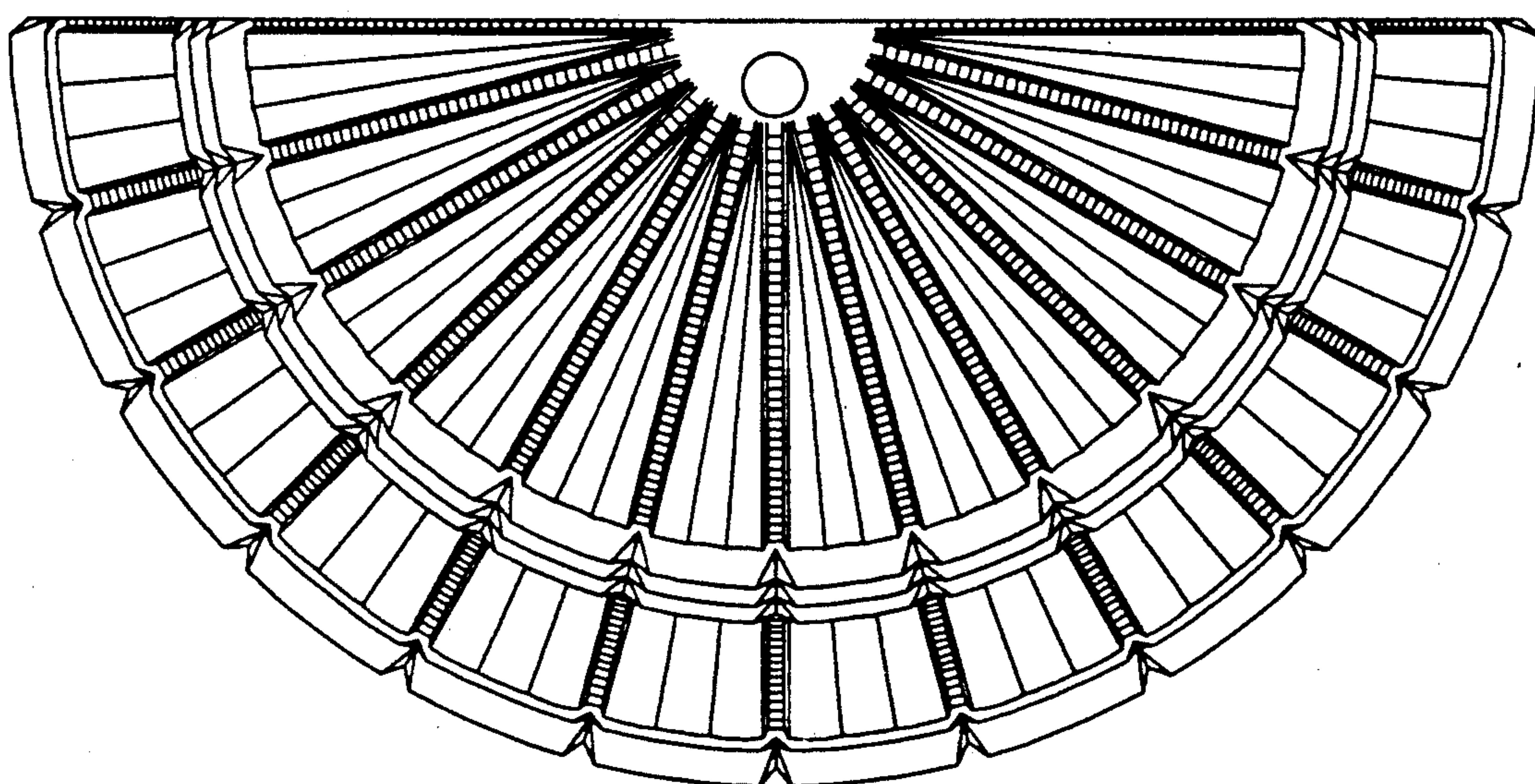

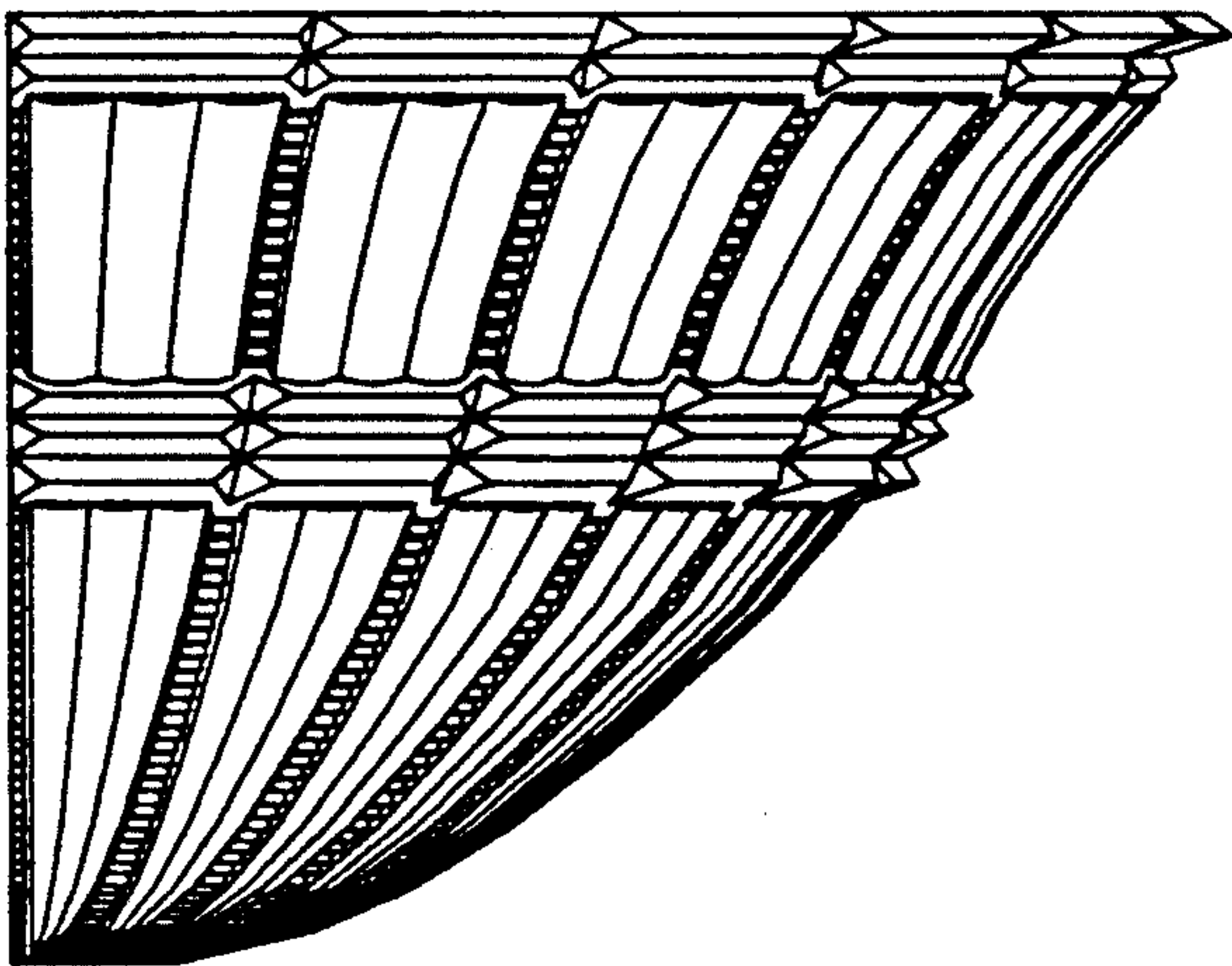

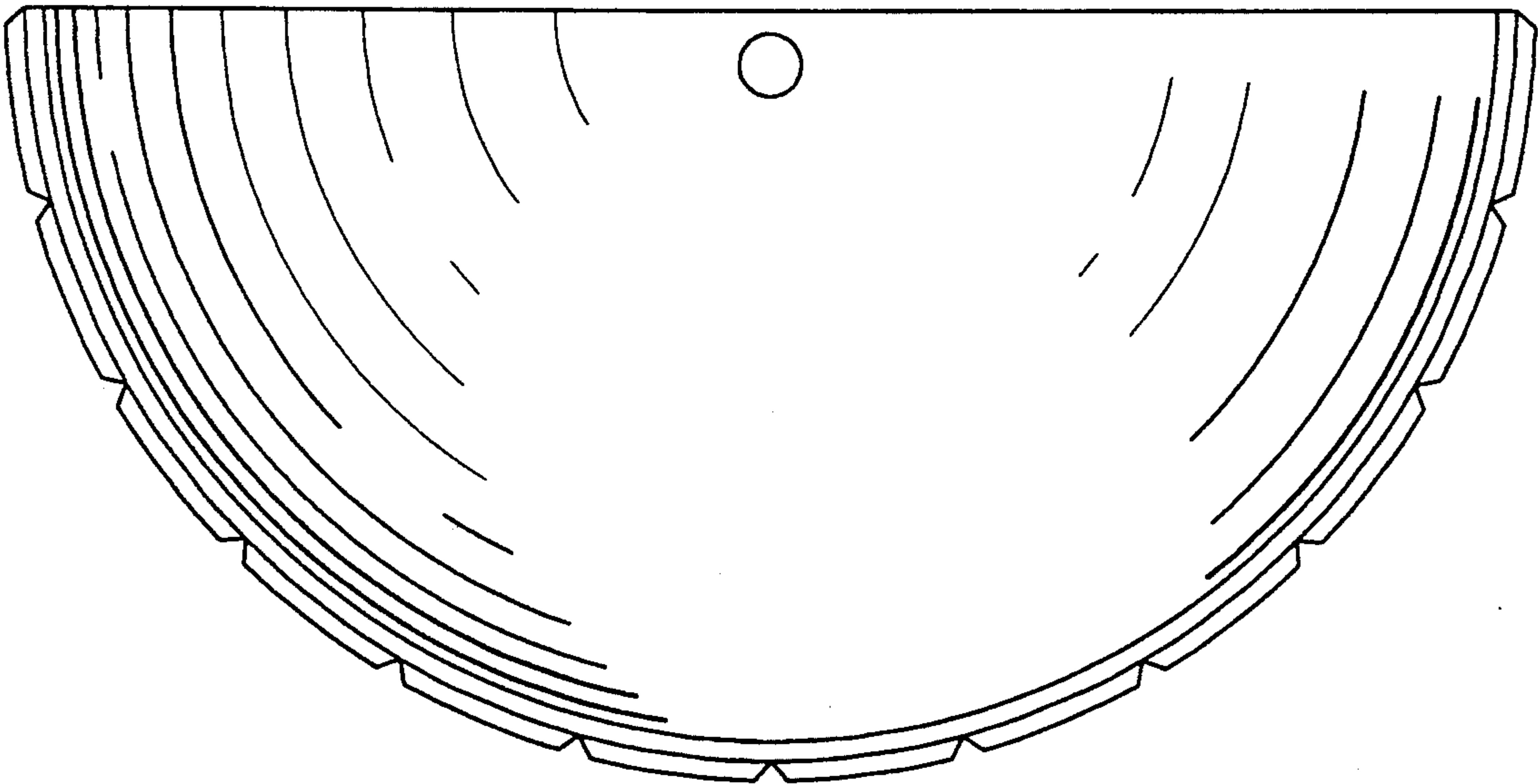
