FIG. 11 is a top plan view of an additional embodiment


of a carrying case showing my new design;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 13 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side is a mirror image;


FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 15 is a rear elevational view thereof.


