**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left-front perspective view of a chair showing my new design,  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;  
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view; and,  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.  
The broken line showing in FIG. 5 represents stitching.

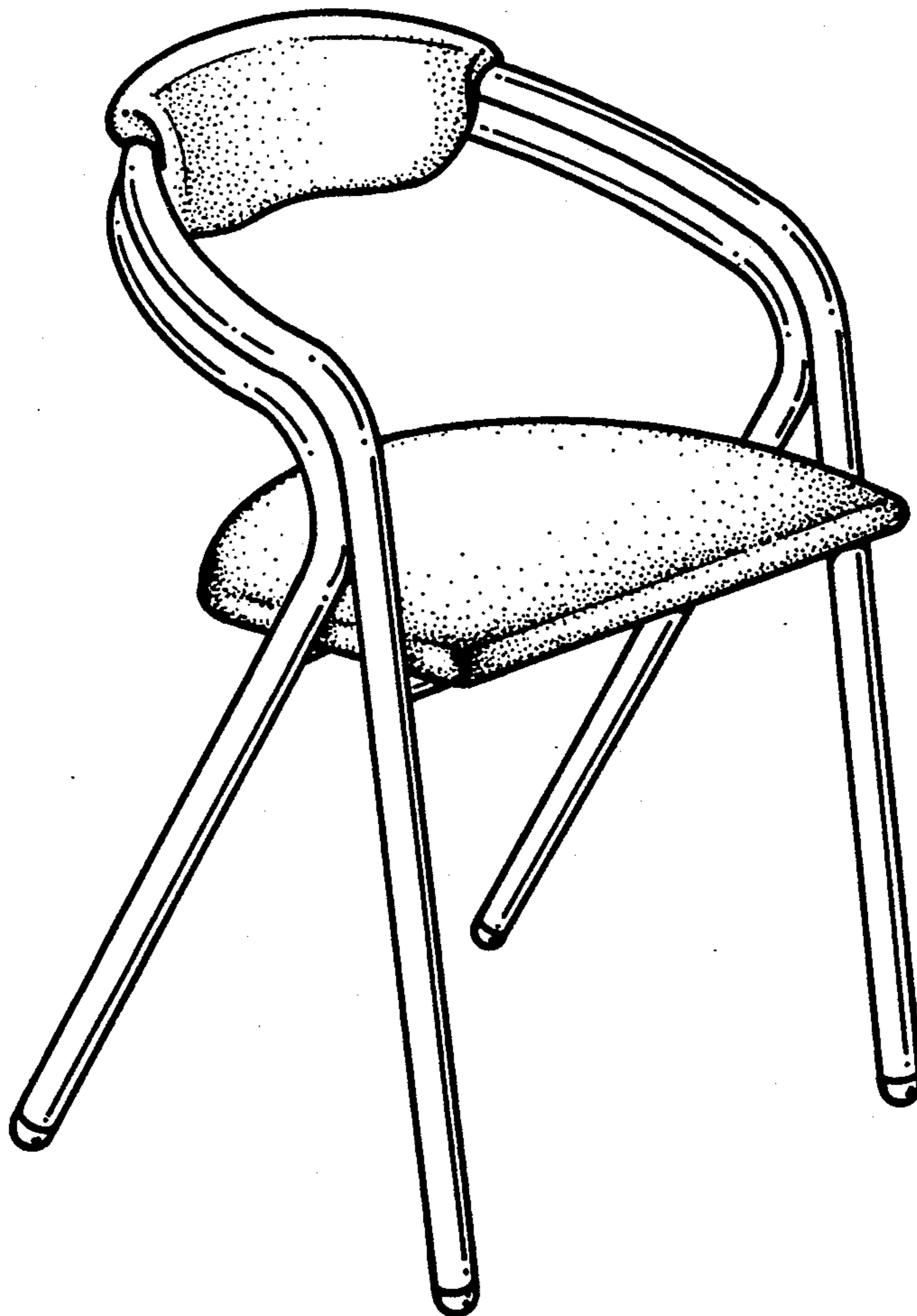

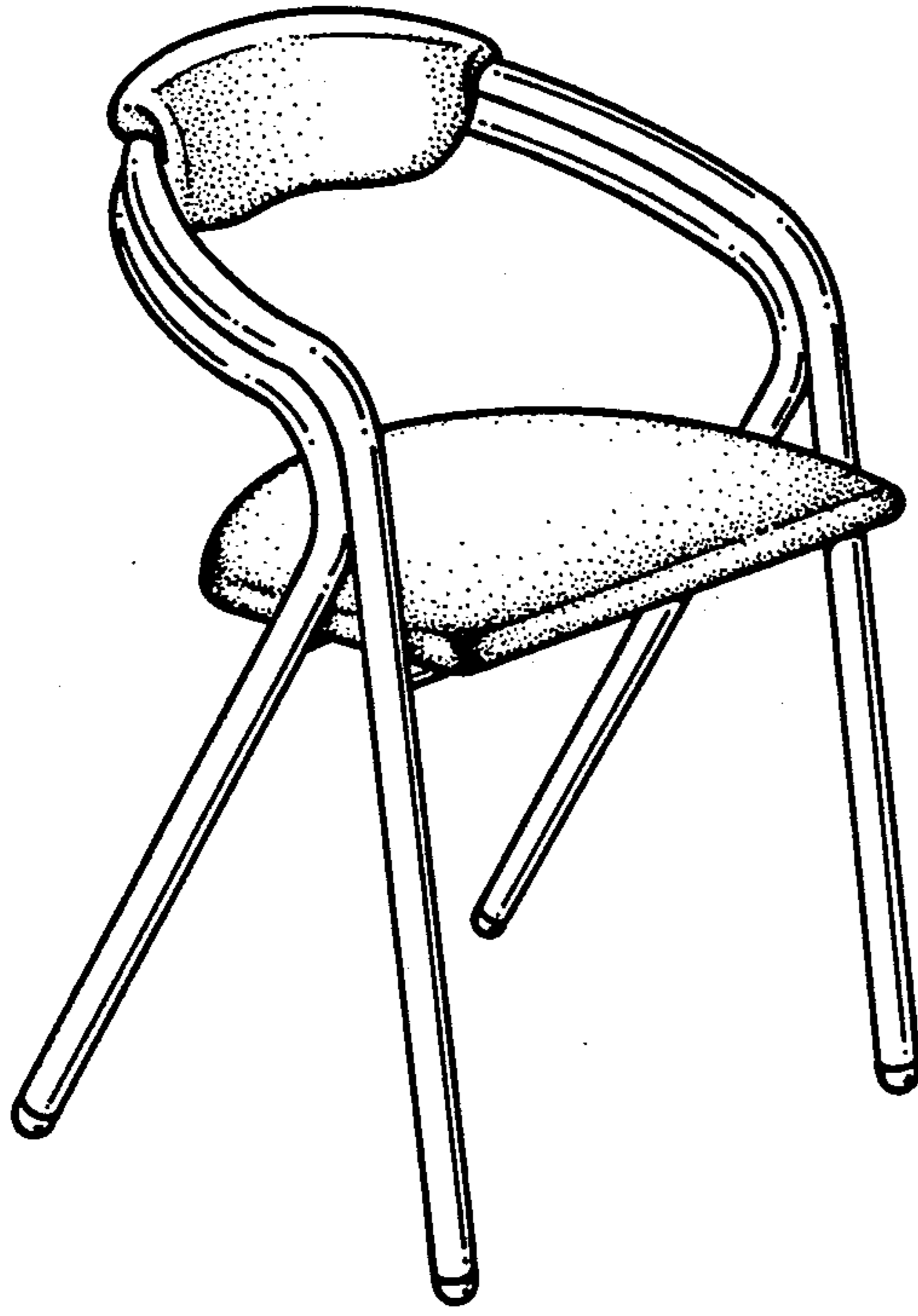

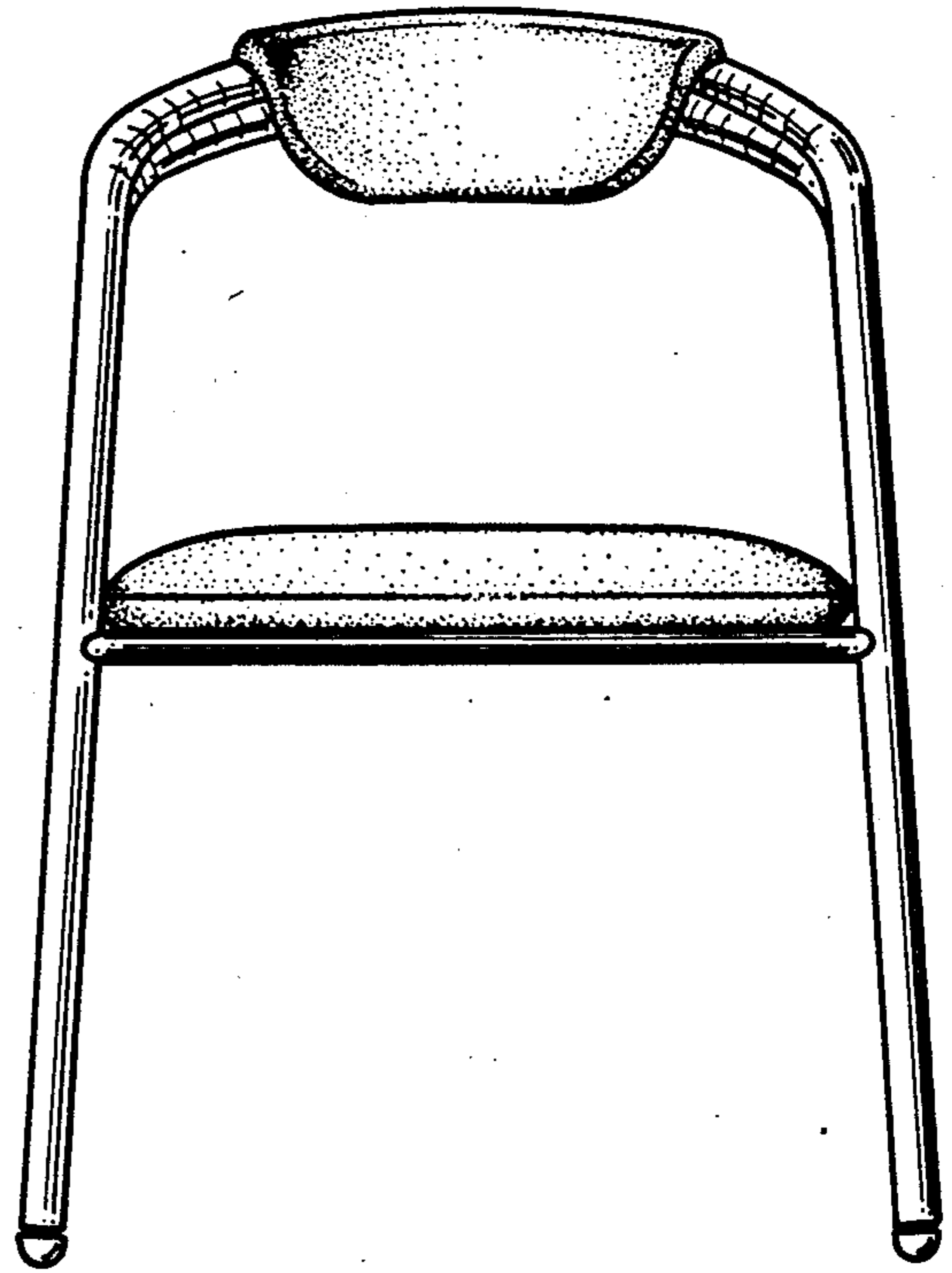

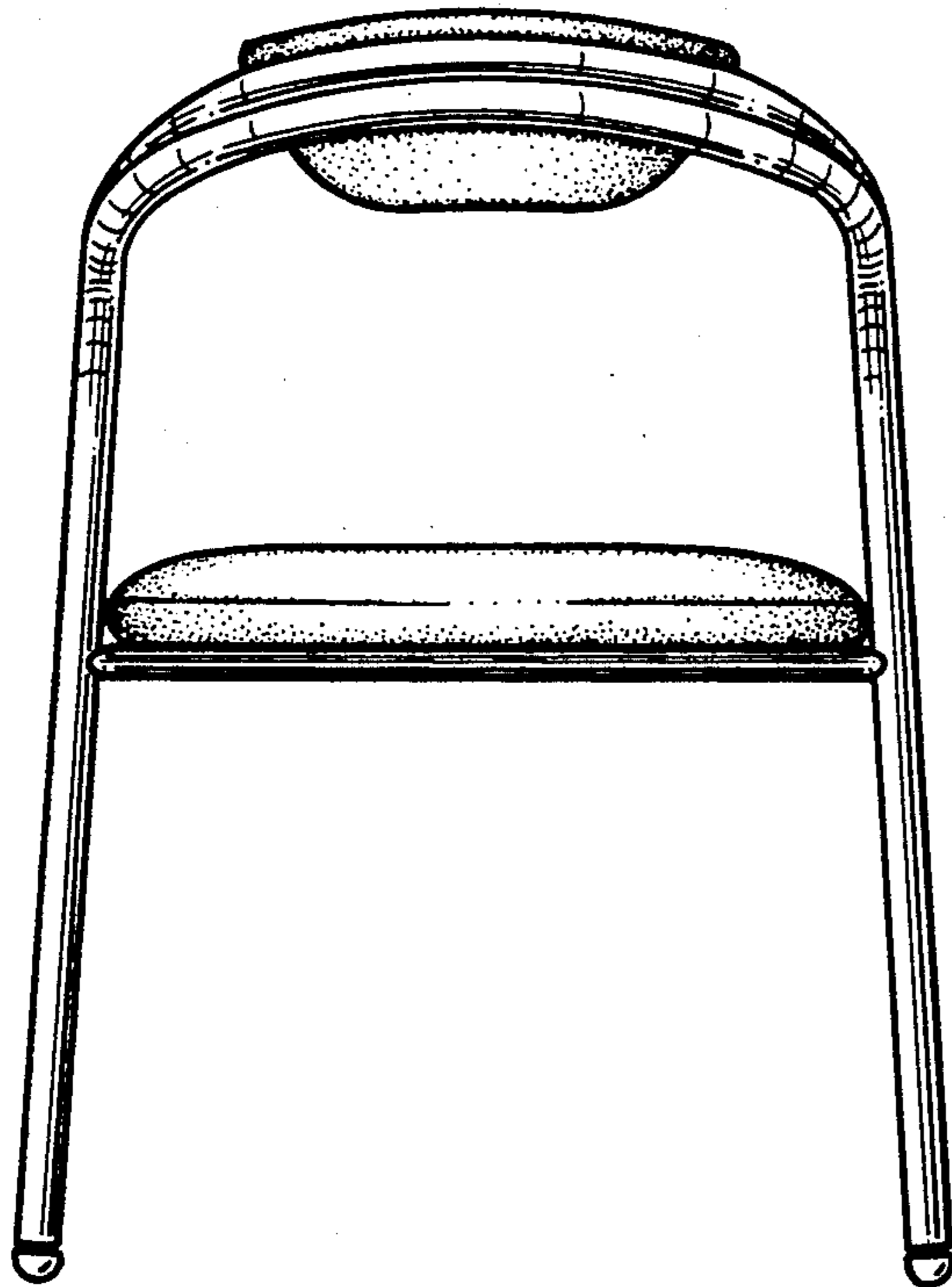

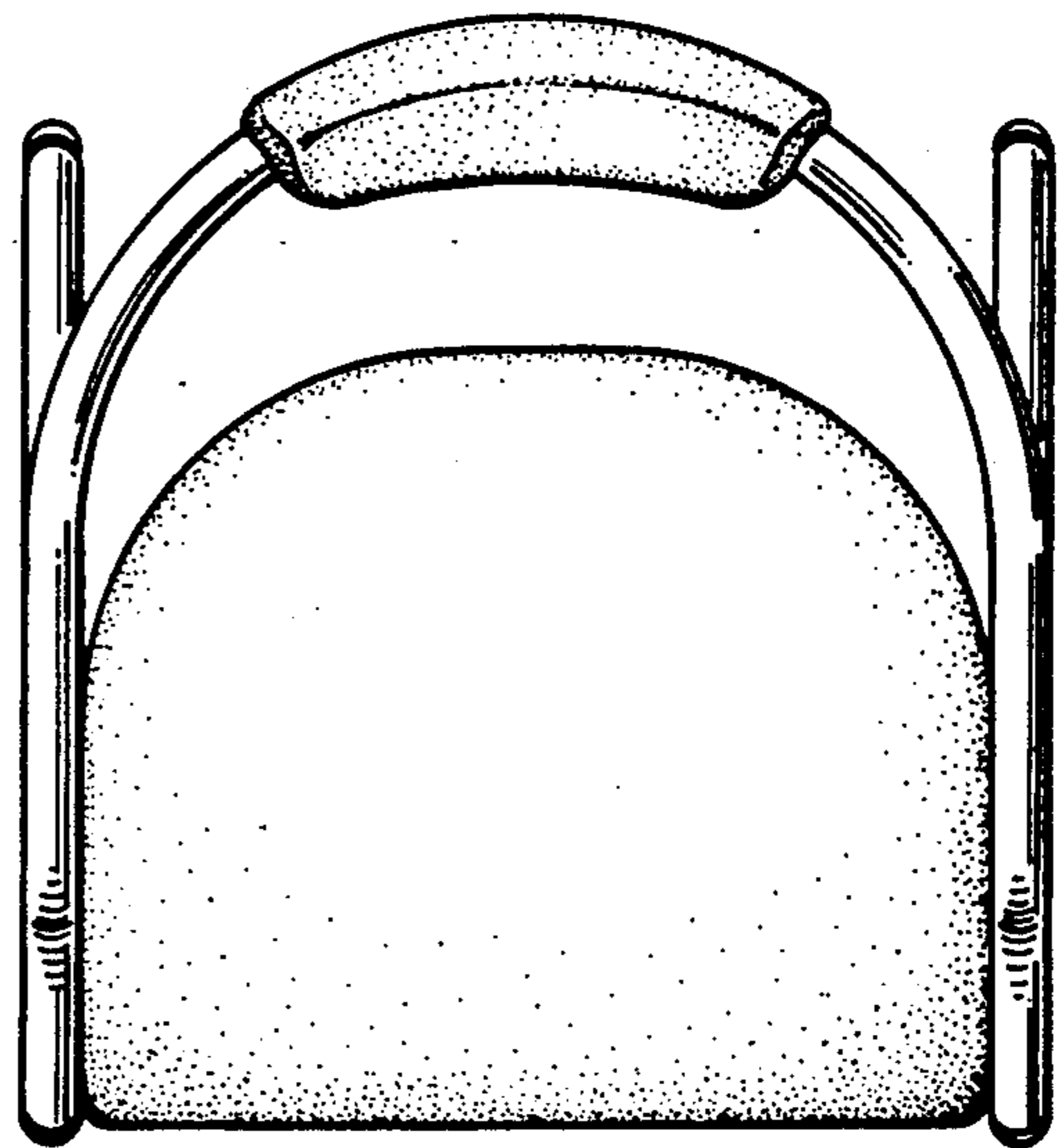

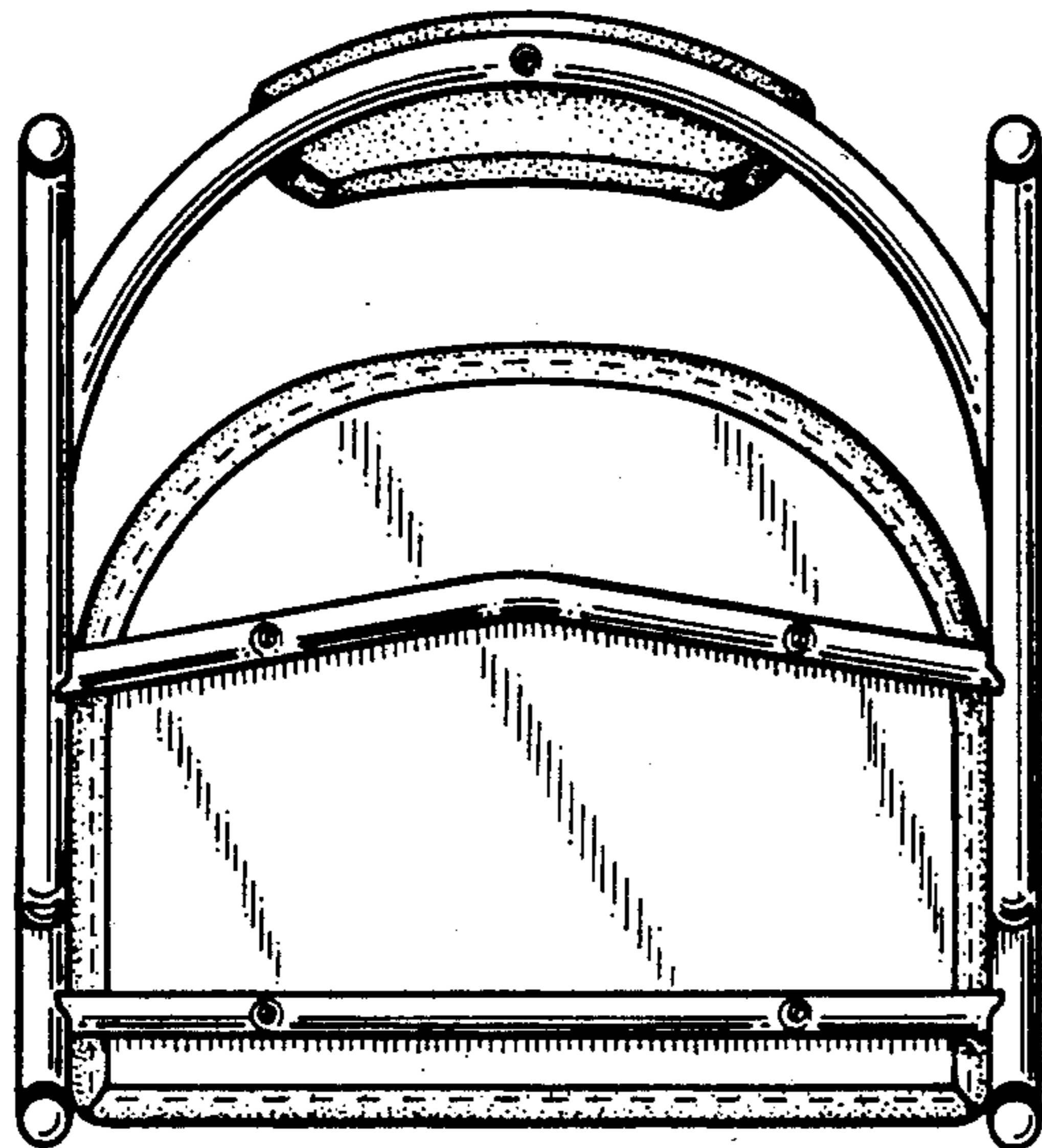

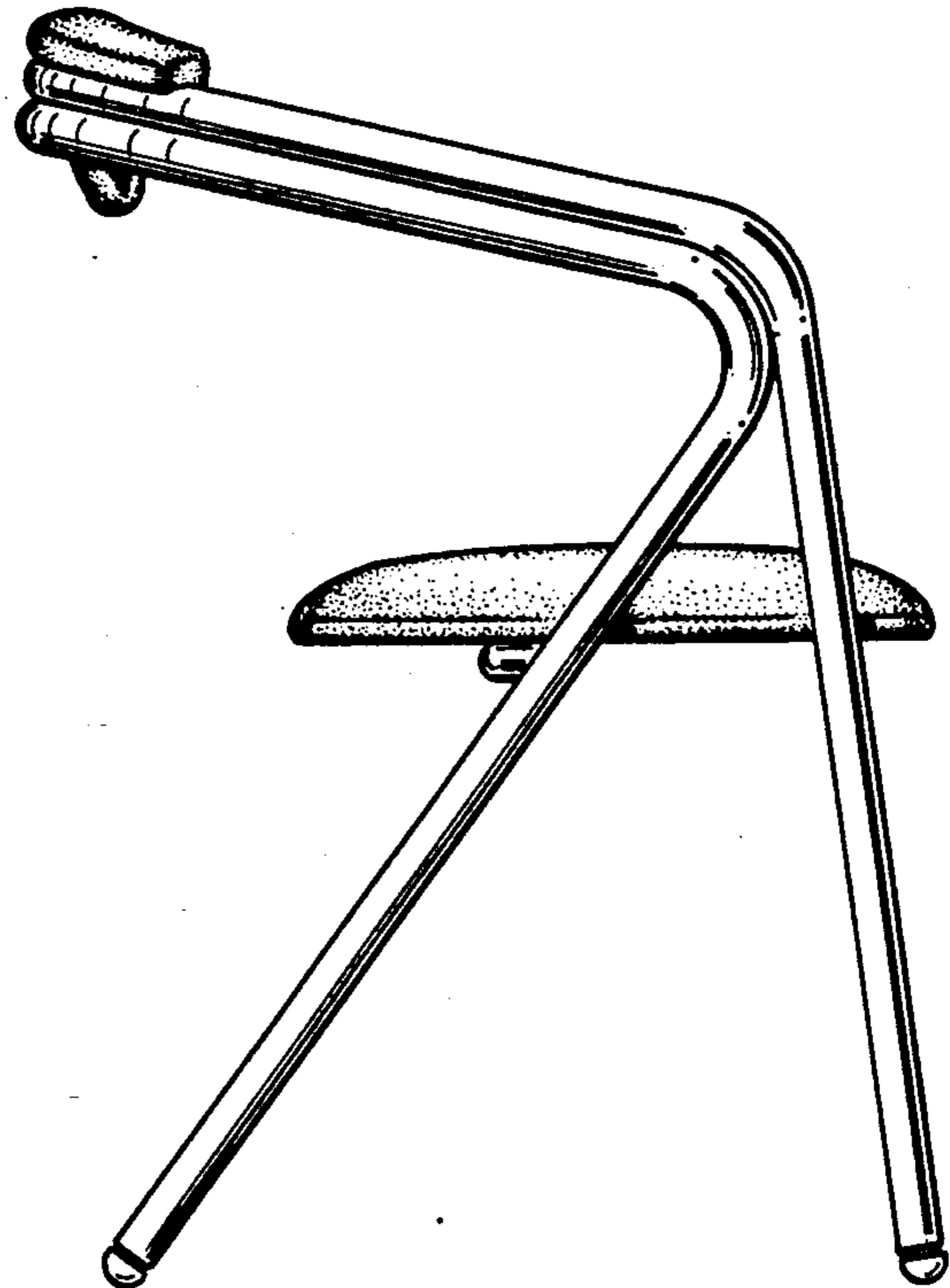
