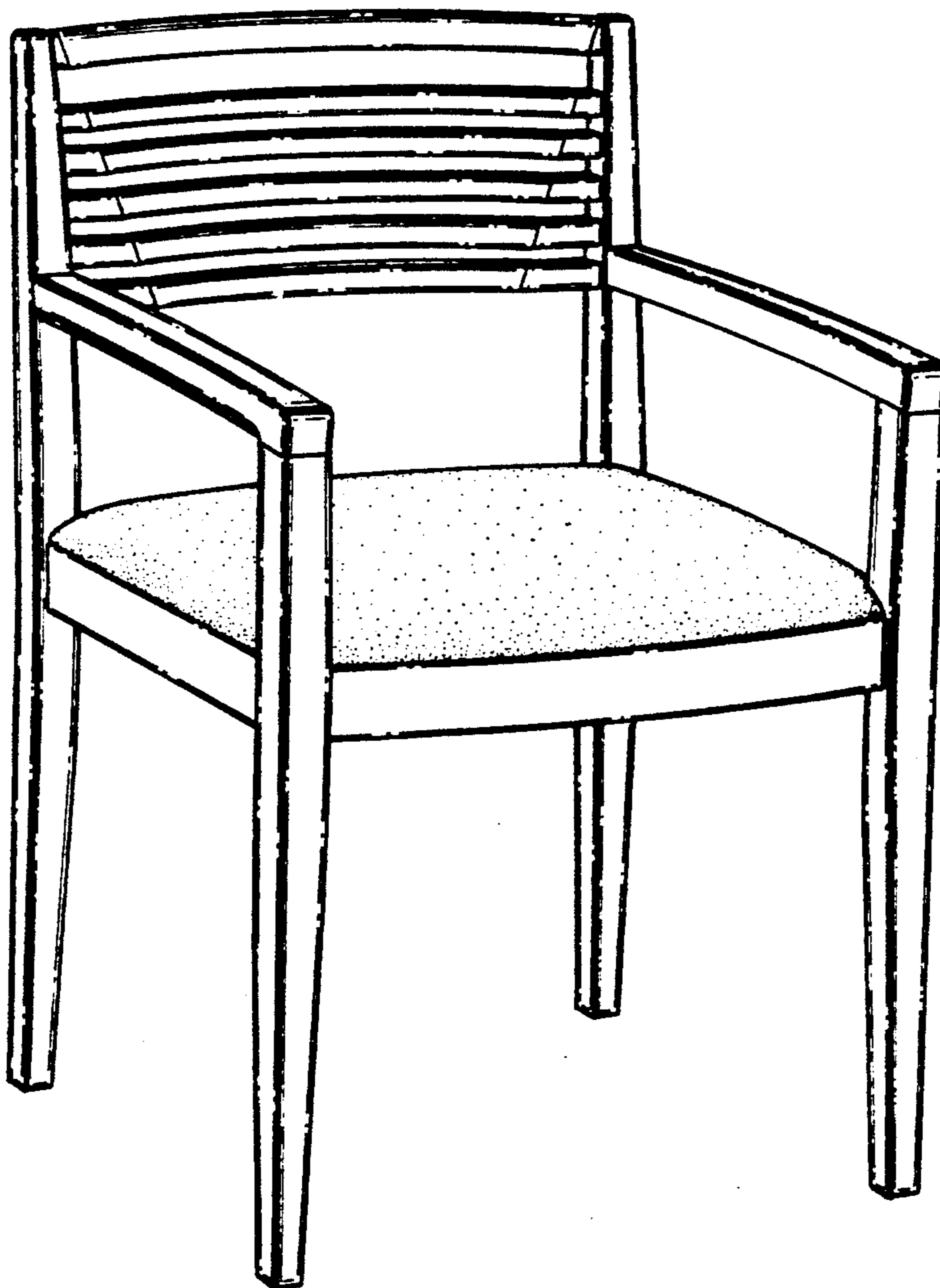

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-front perspective view of a chair showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



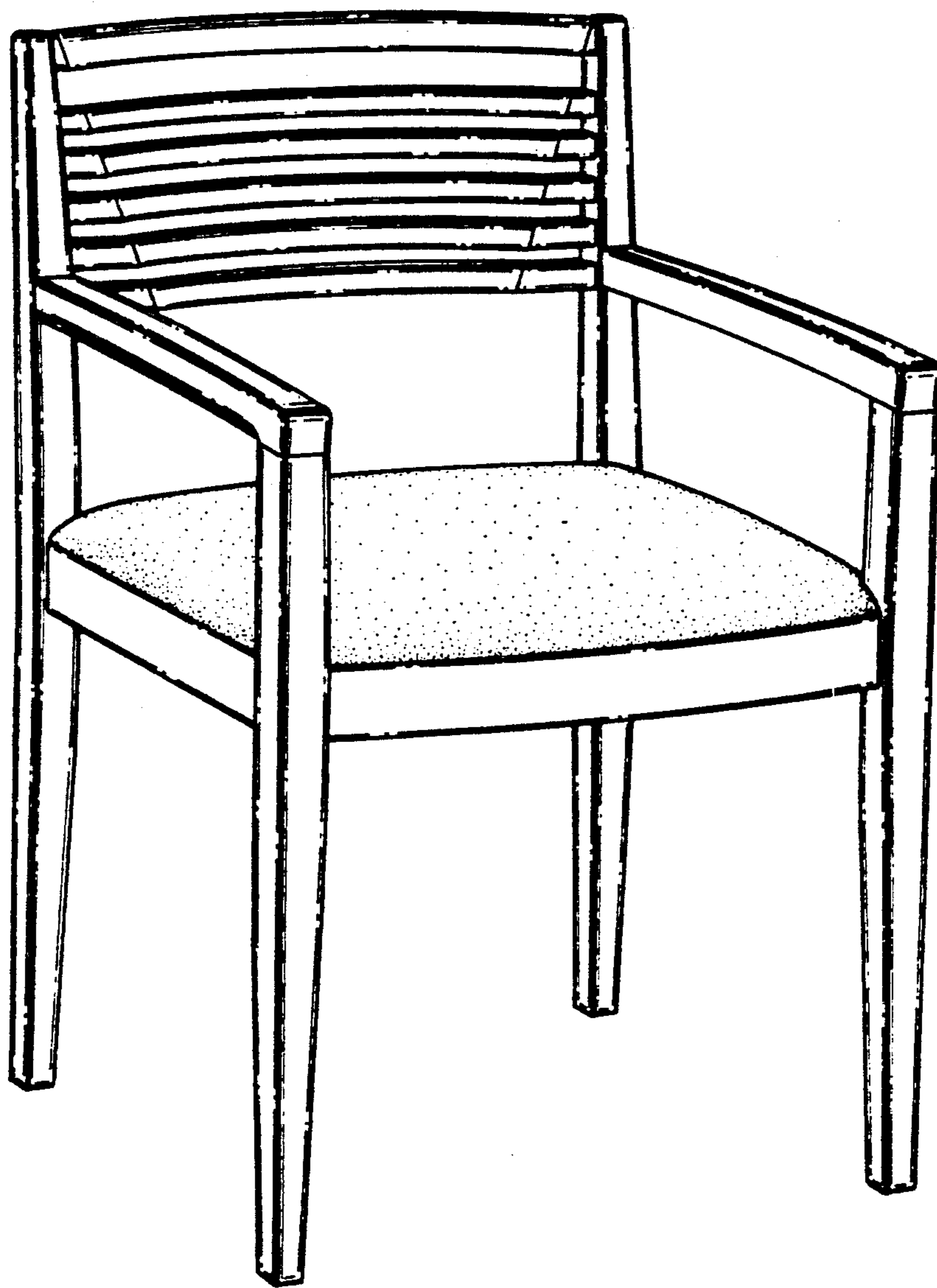

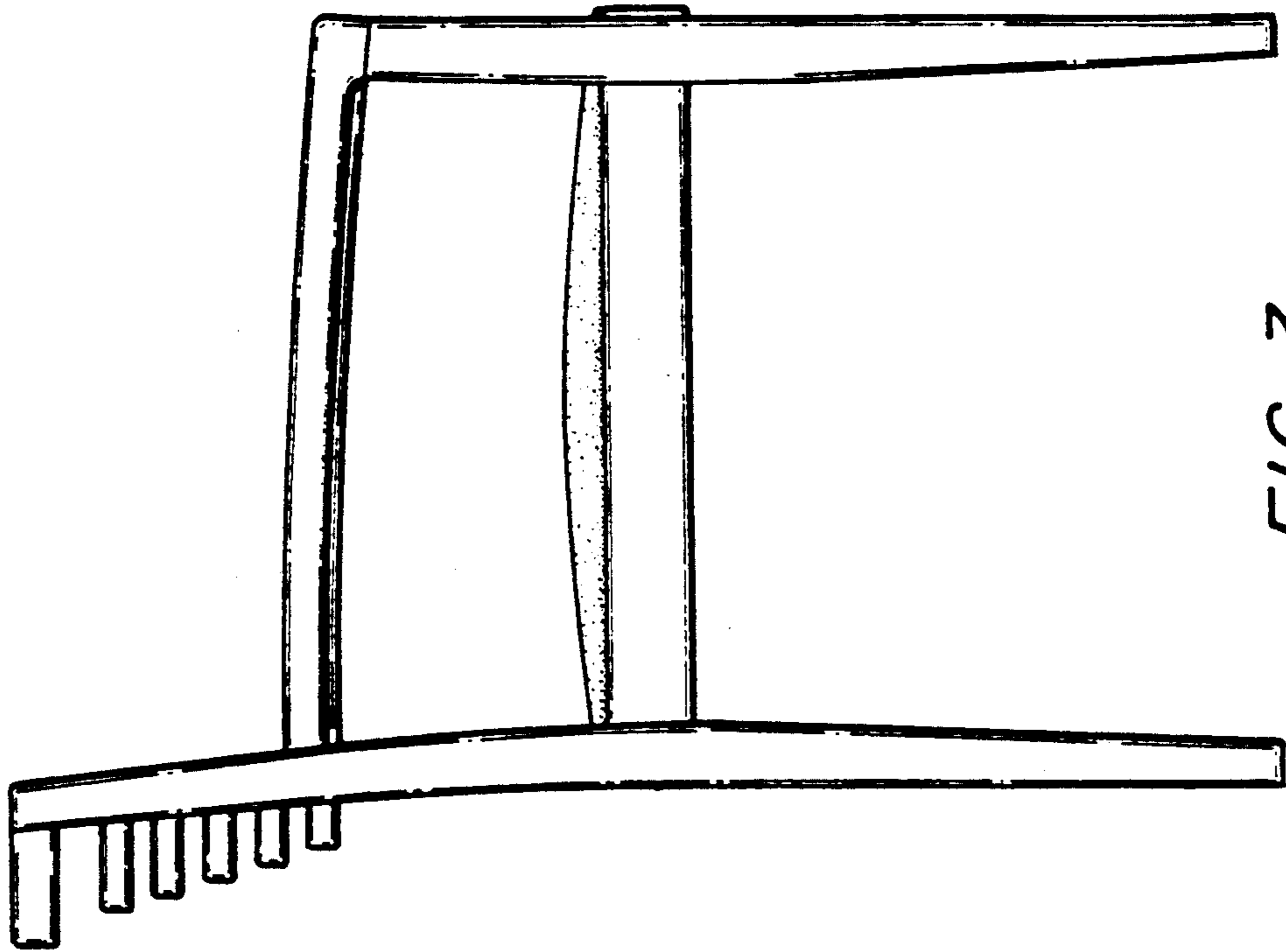

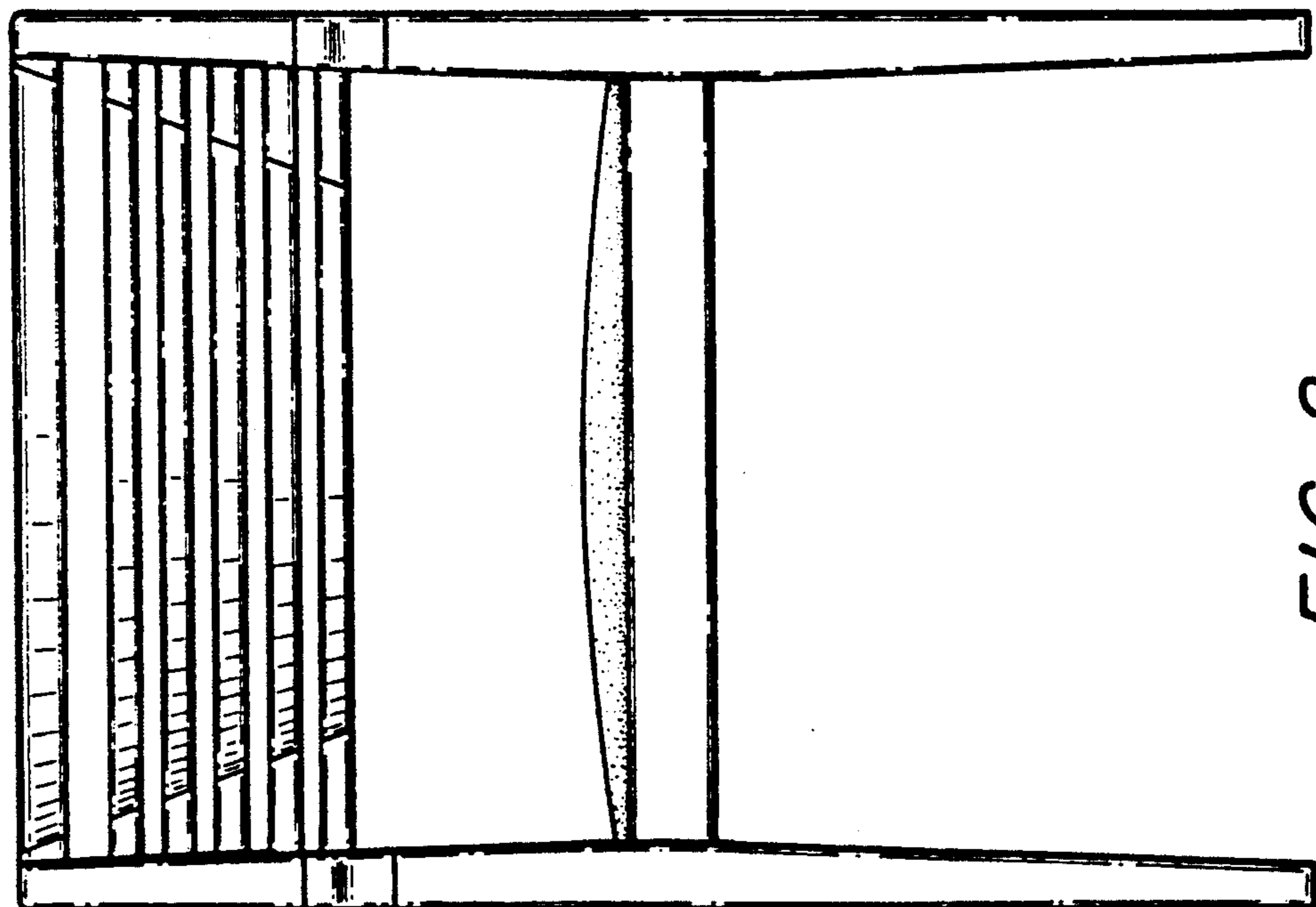

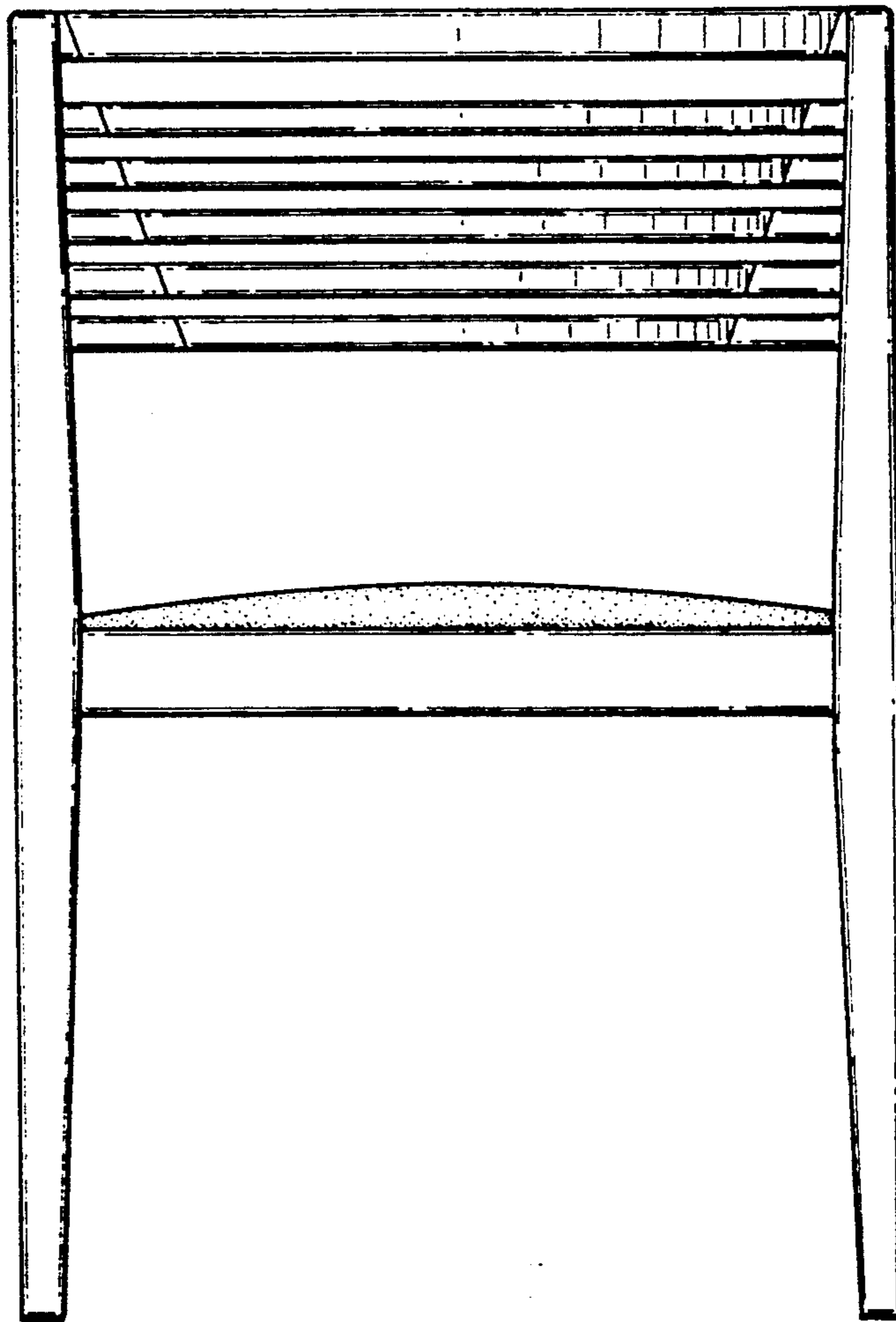

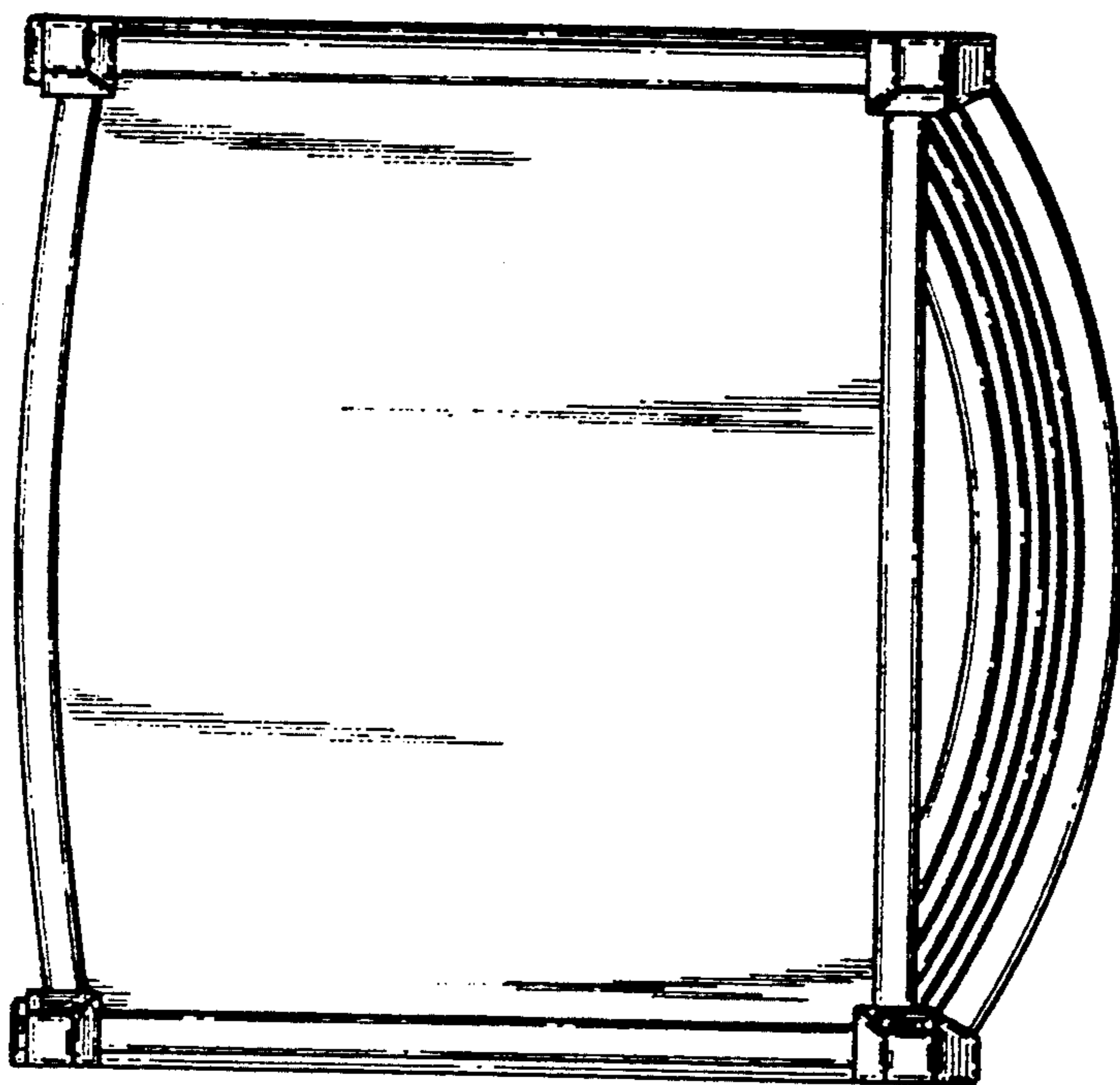

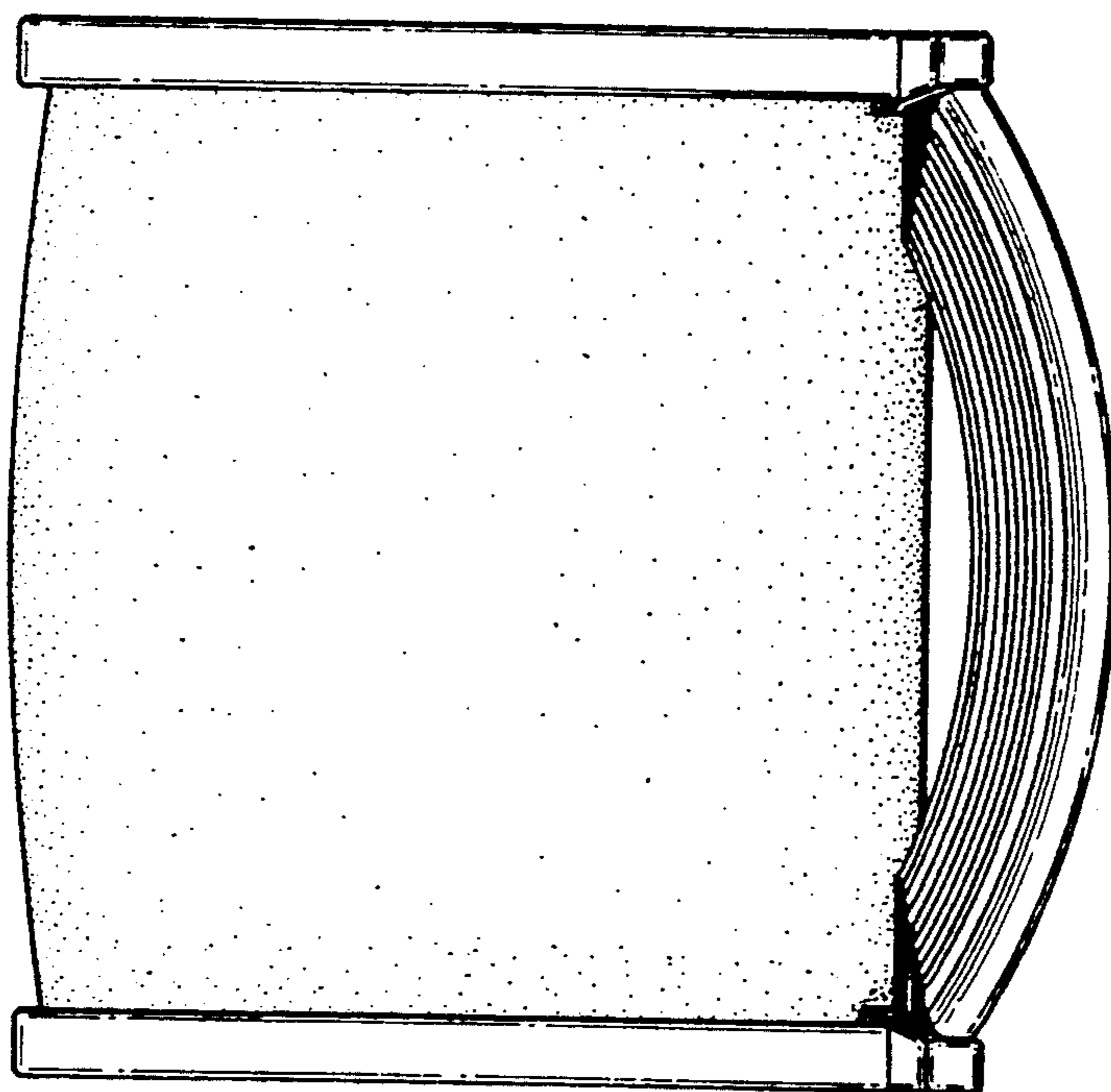
