The bottom of the bottle for oil is plain.

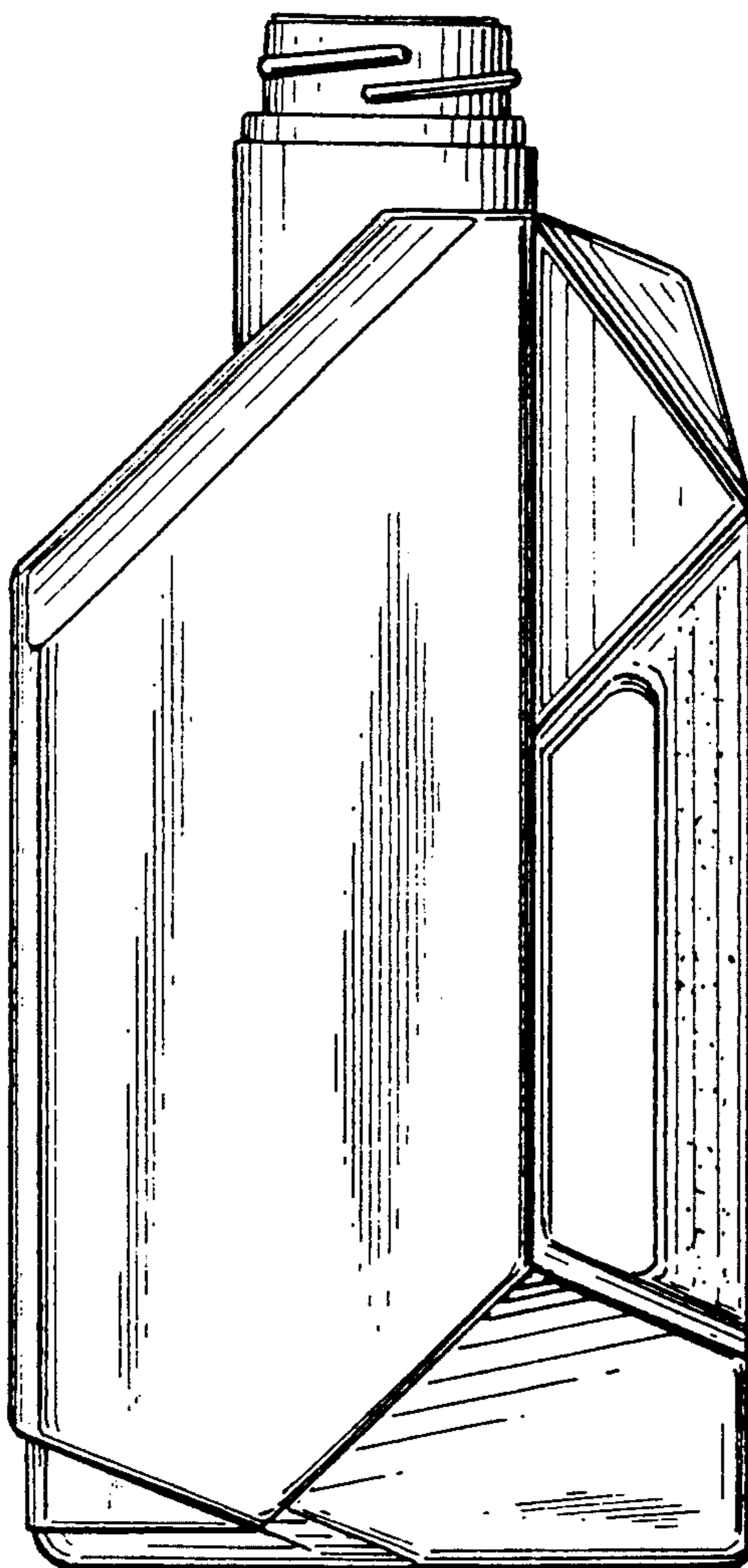

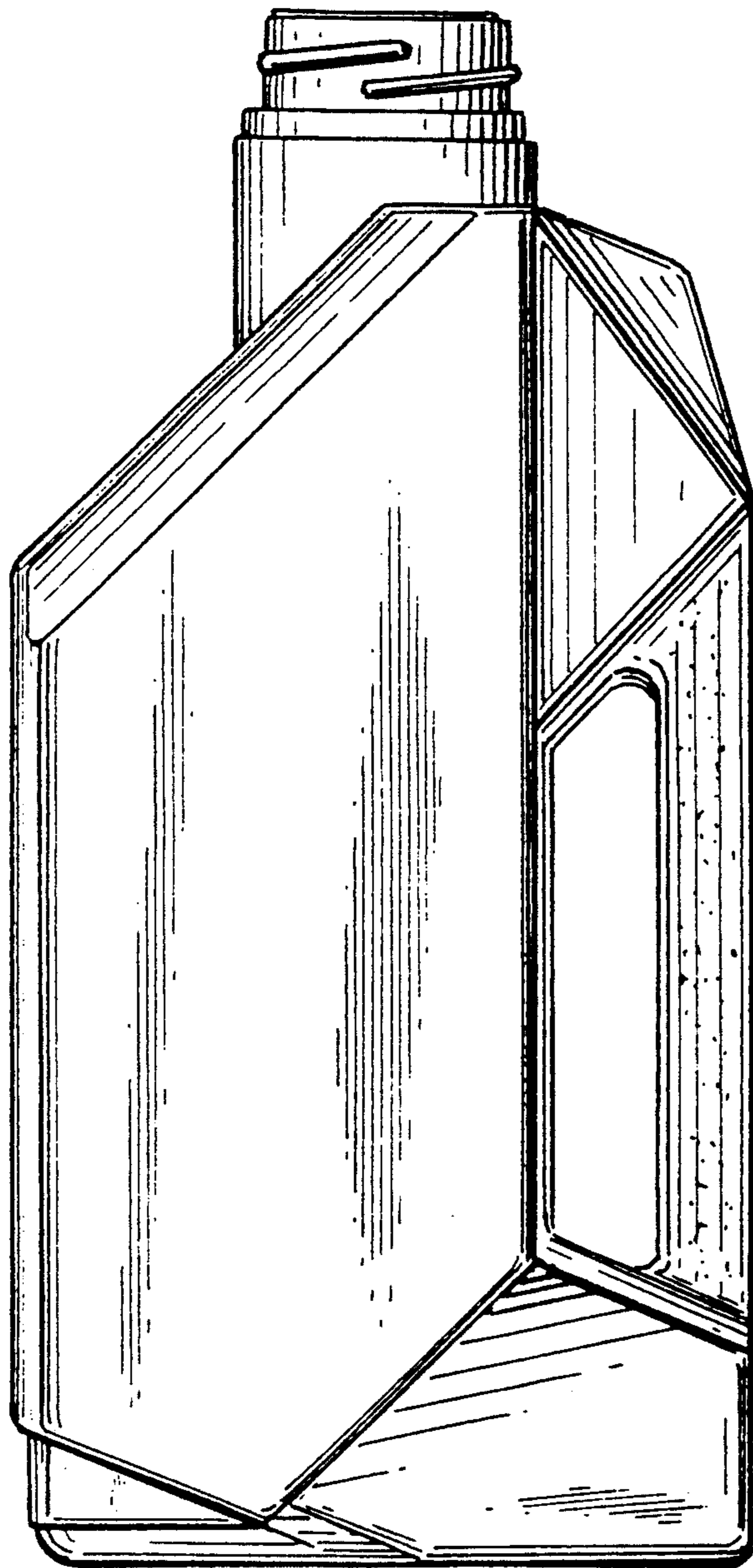

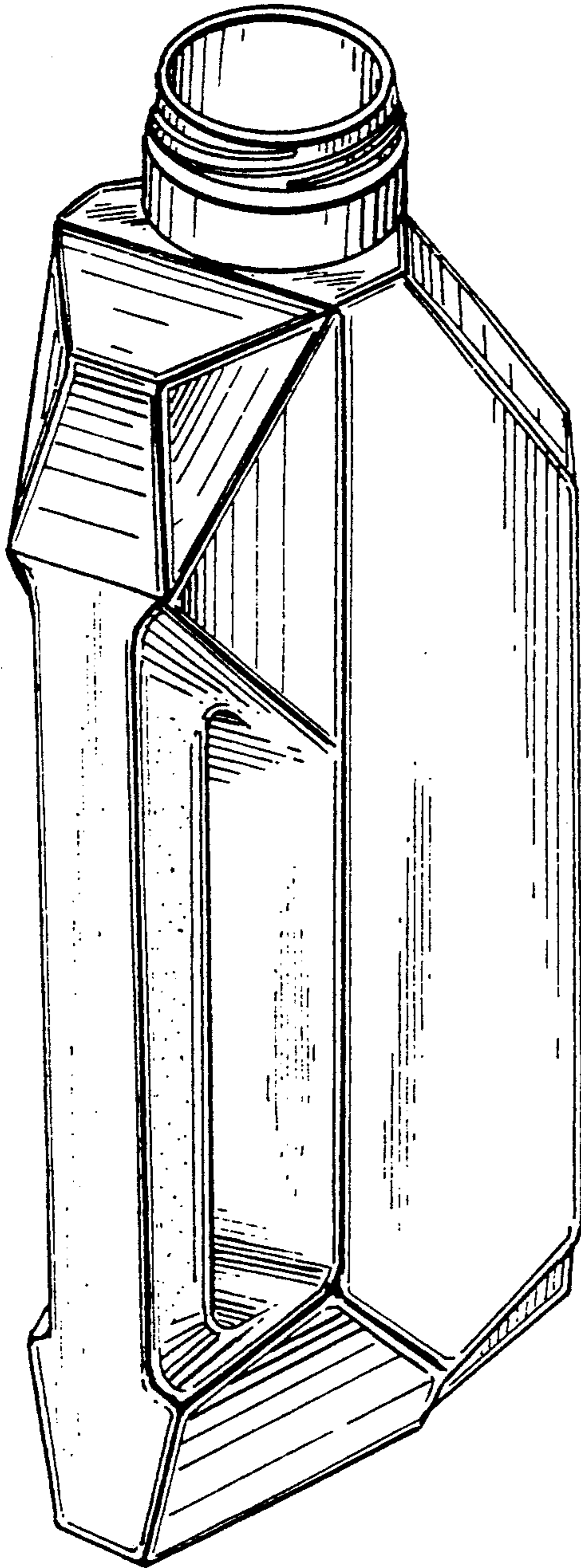

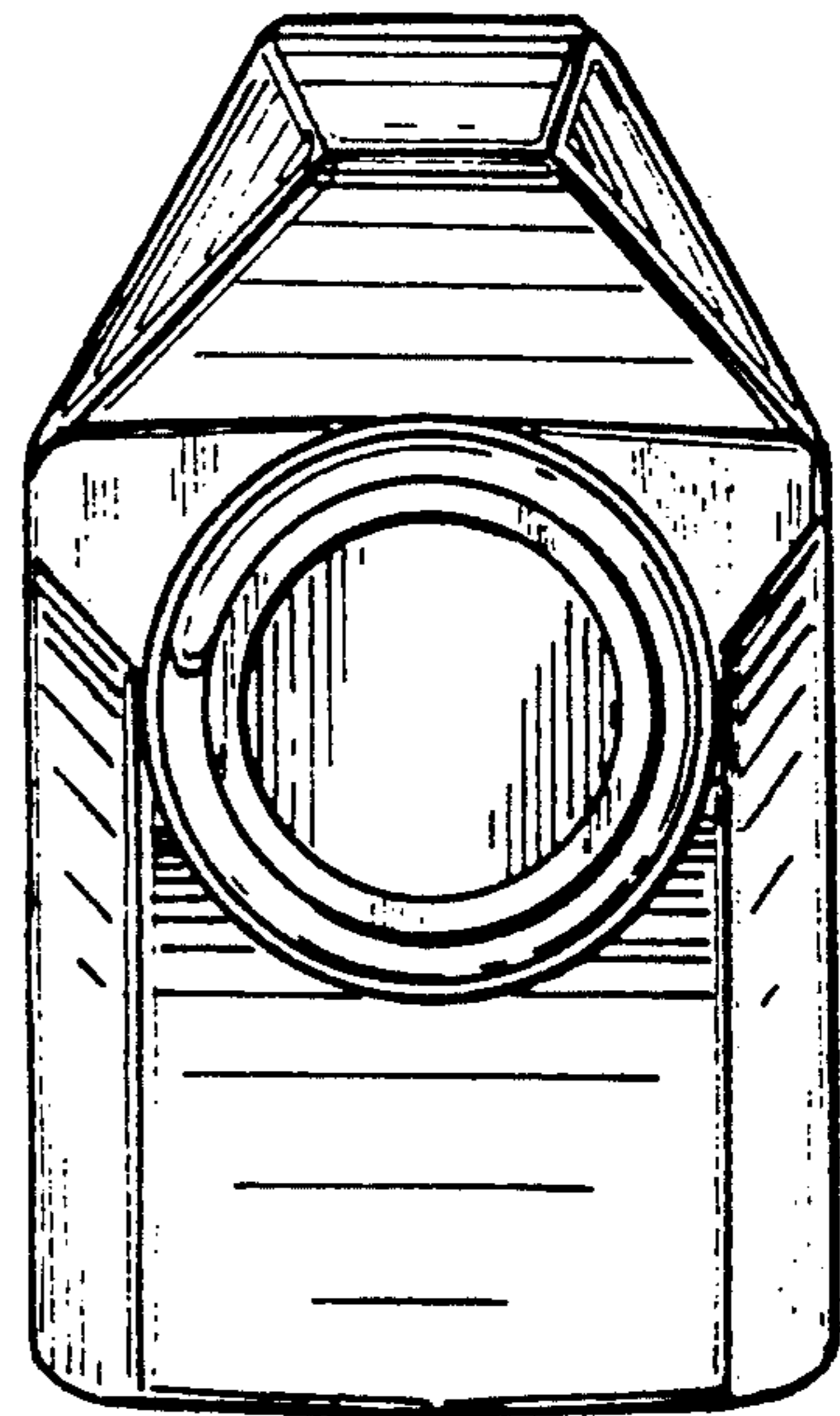

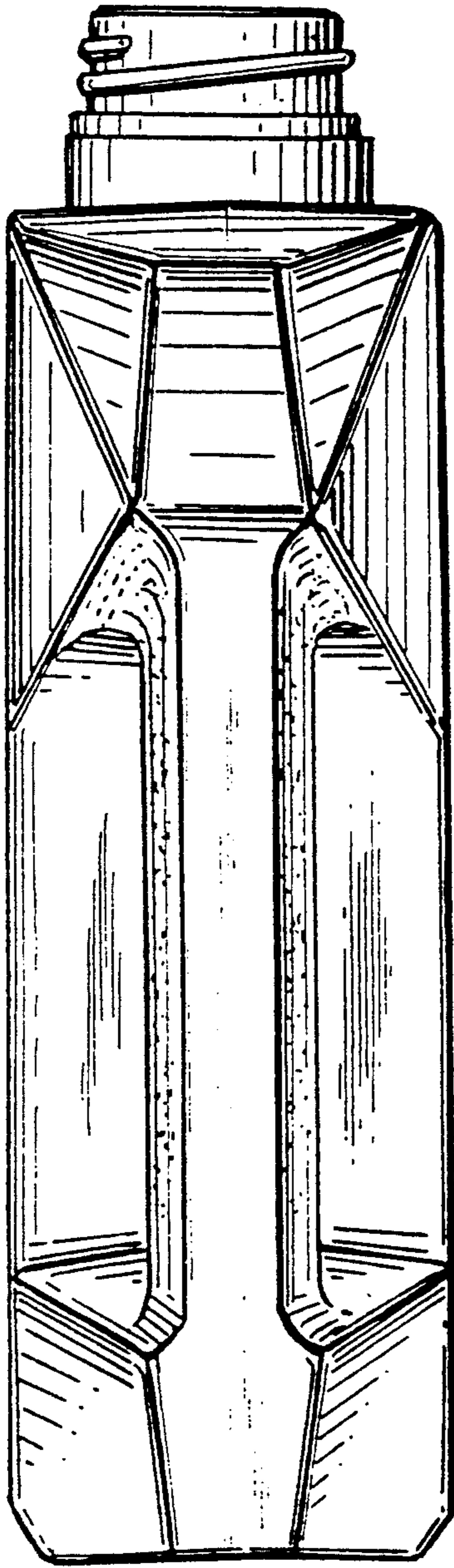
