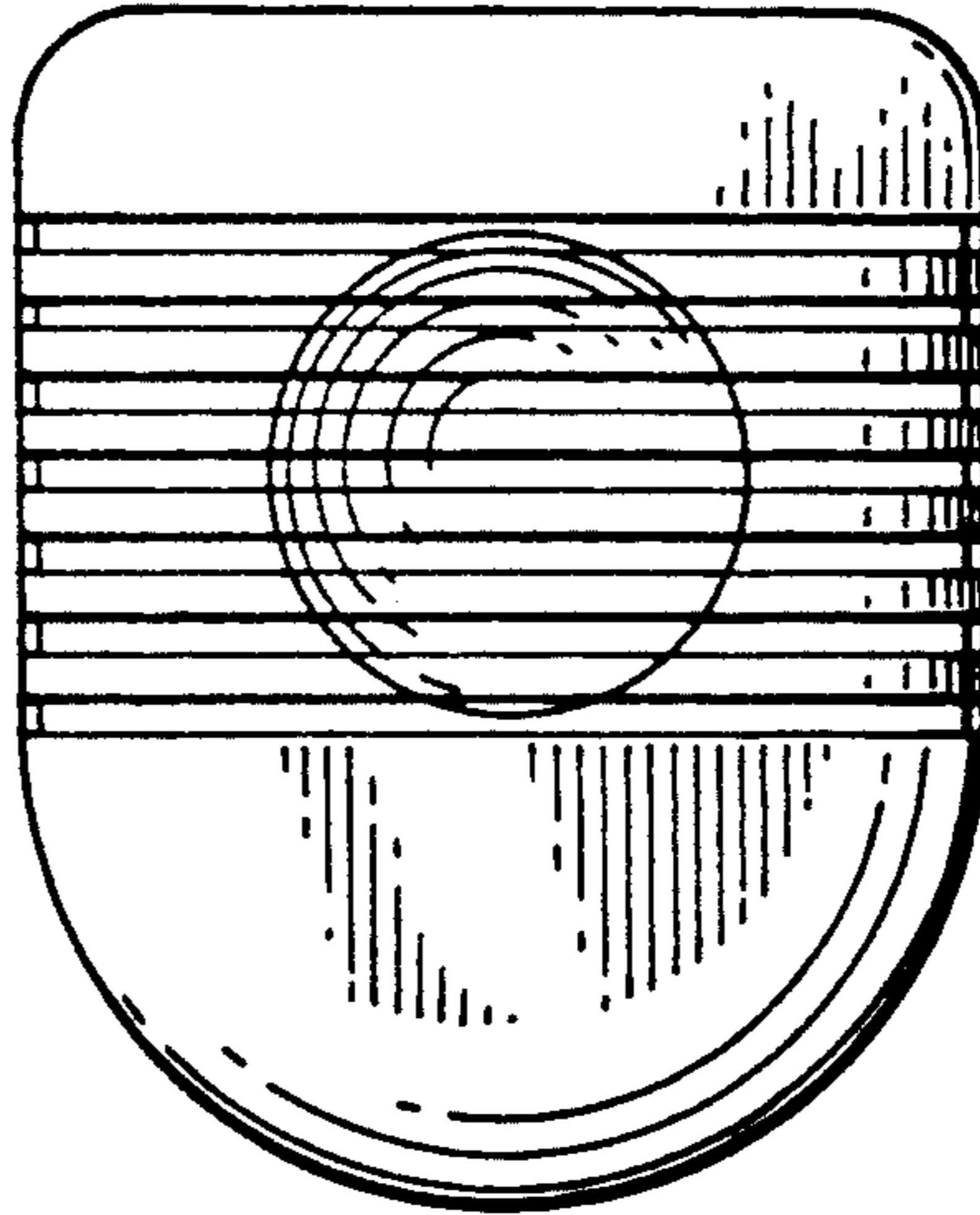

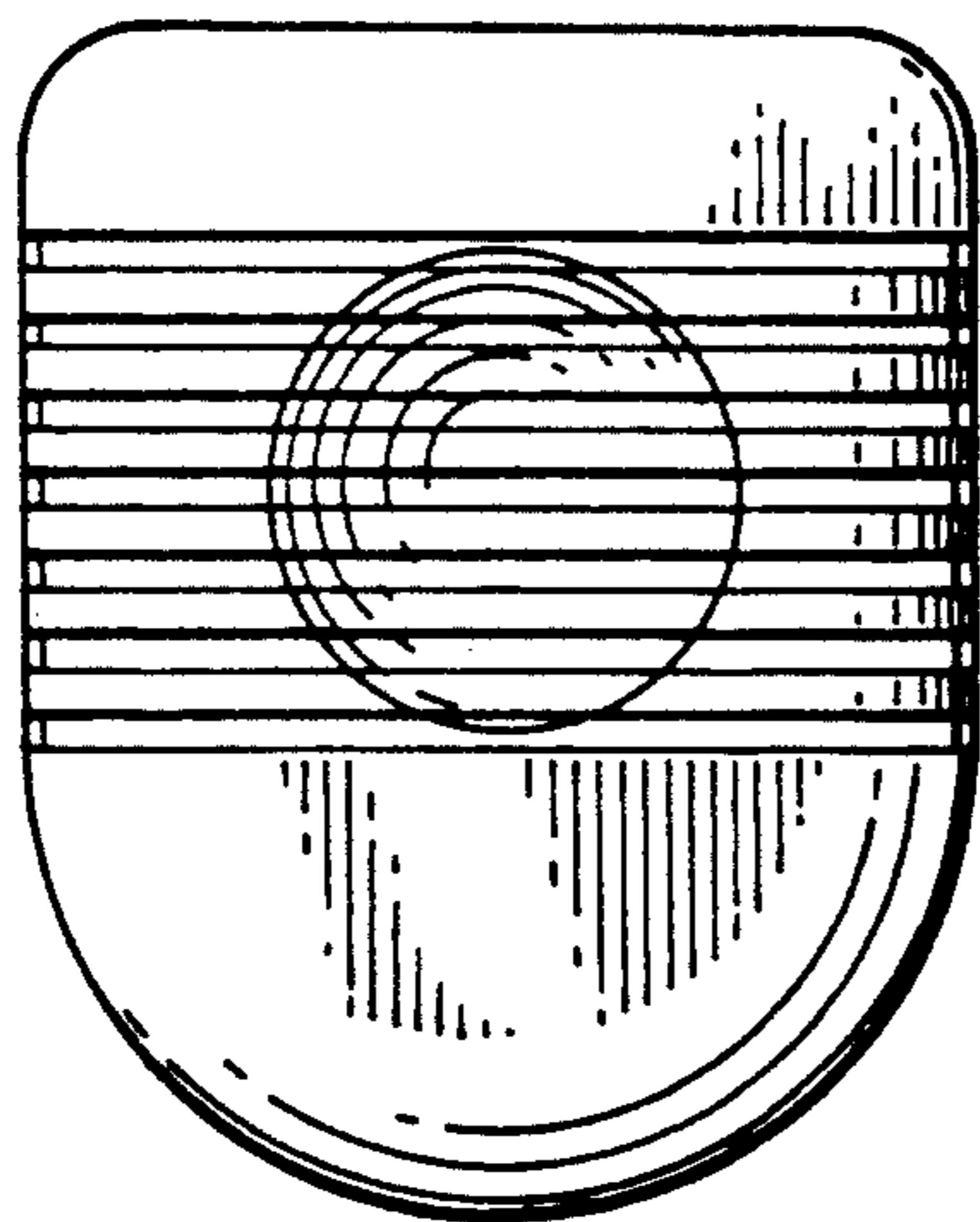
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a personal security alarm, as shown and described.

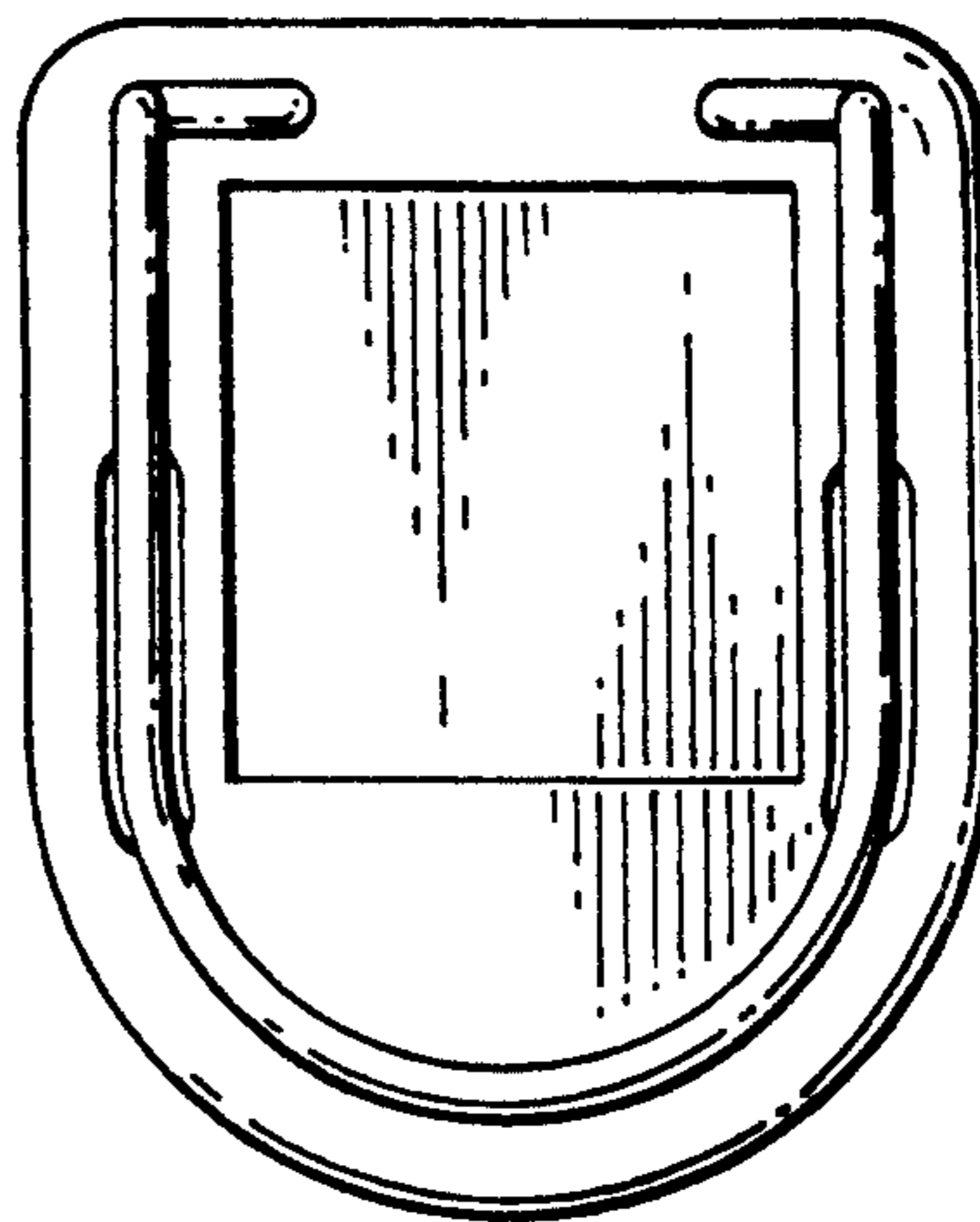
**DESCRIPTION**

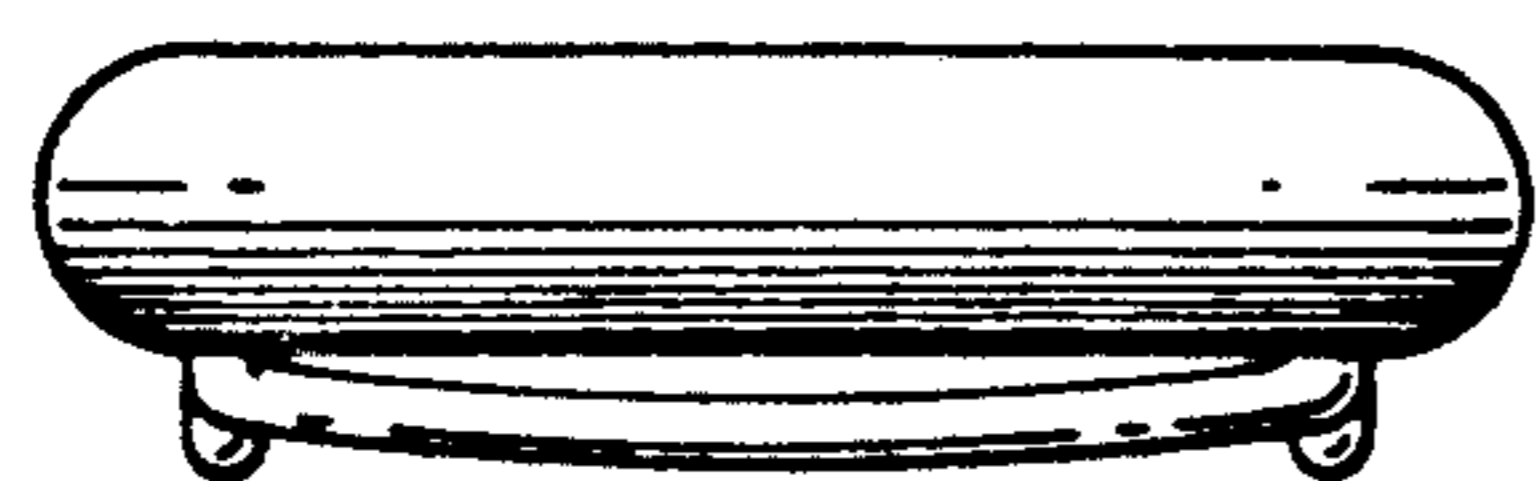

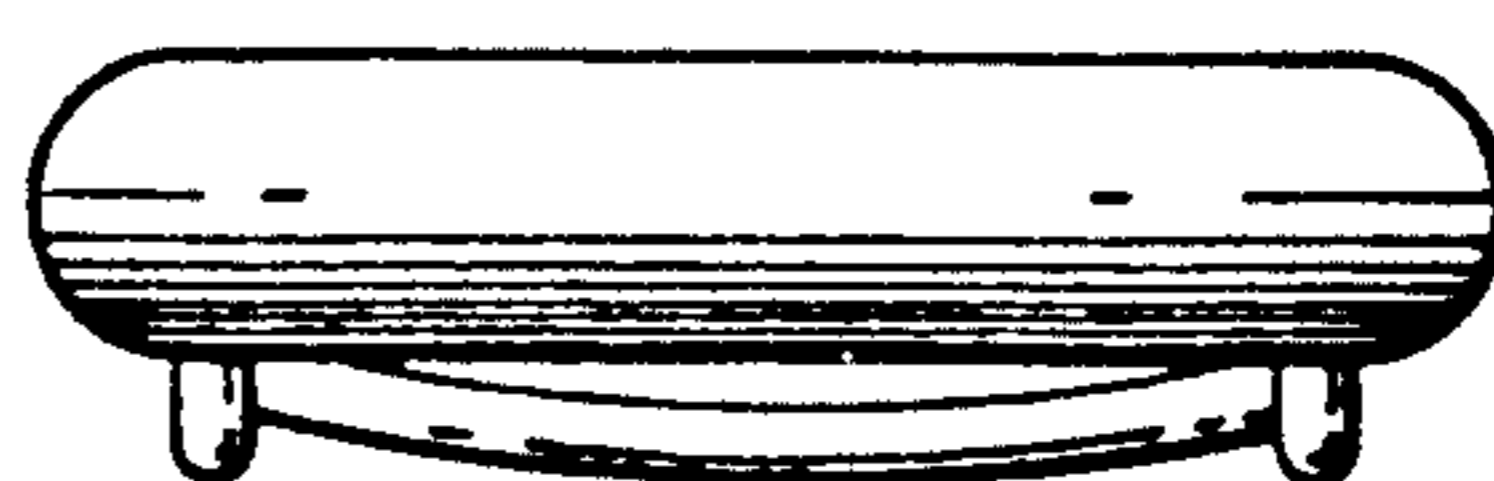
