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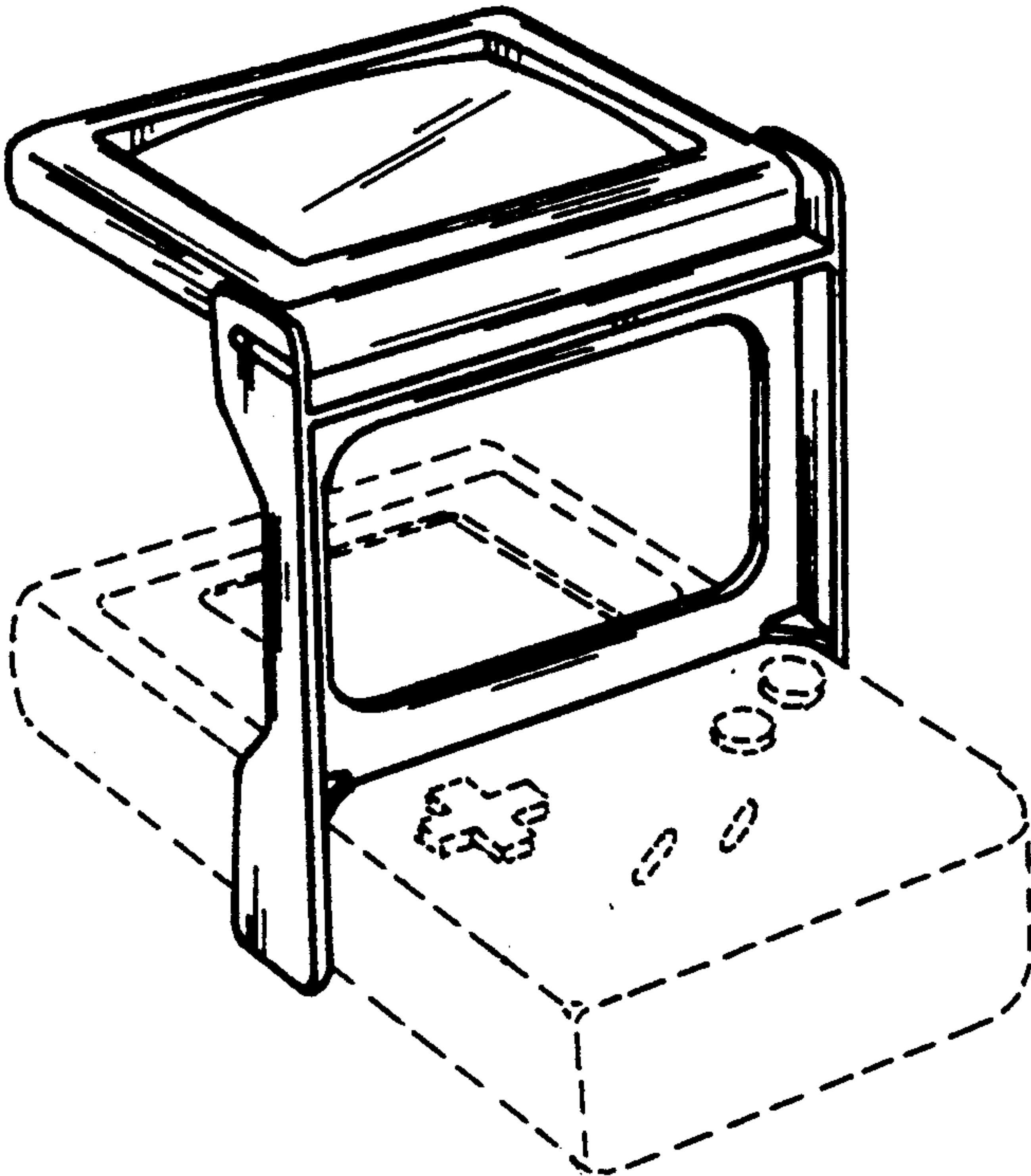

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a portable magnifier for video screen of hand held computer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable magnifier for video screen of hand held computer in the open position, showing our new design, the broken line showing of a computer is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view, the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof in a closed position;
FIG. 8 is a side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof.



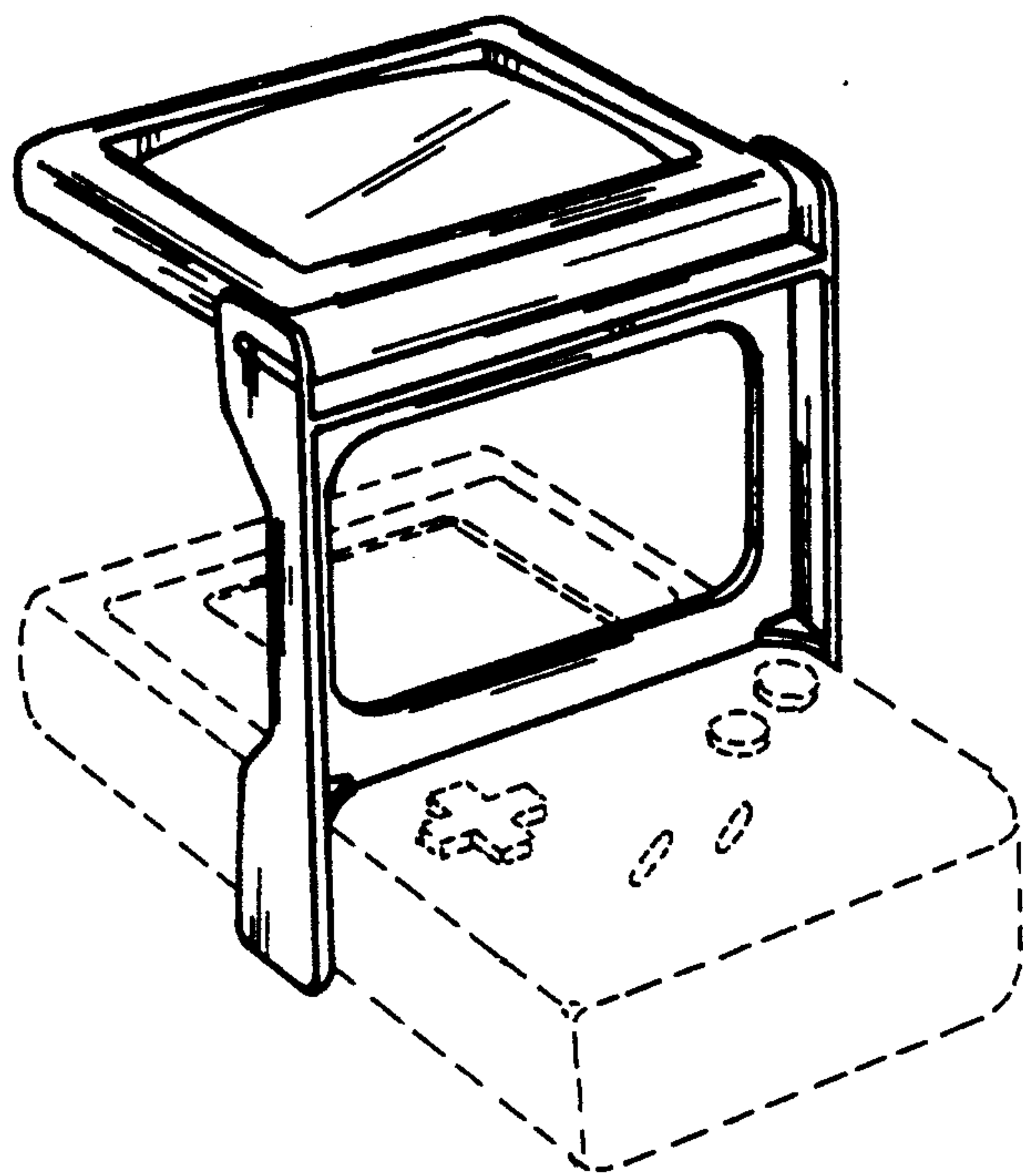

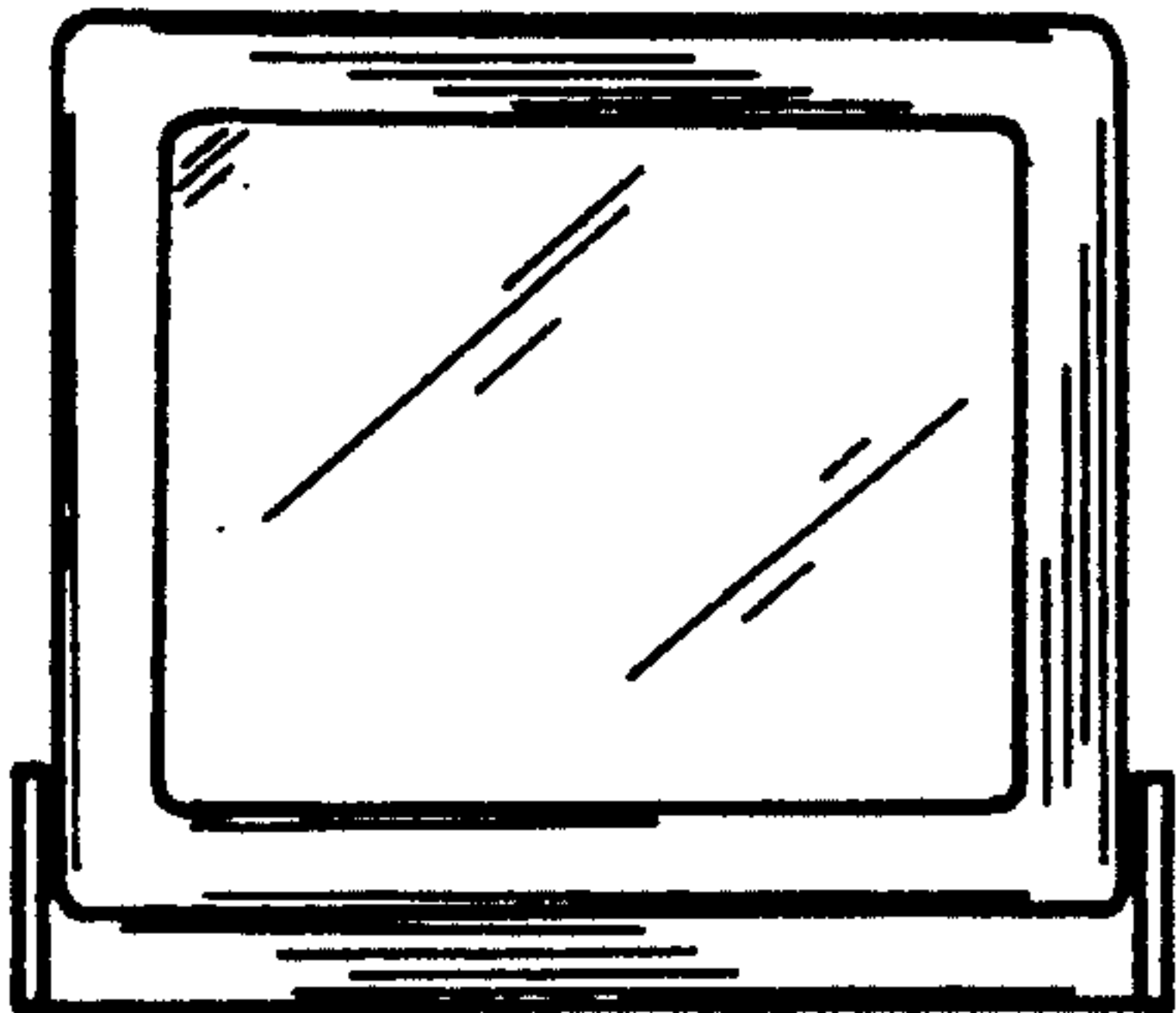

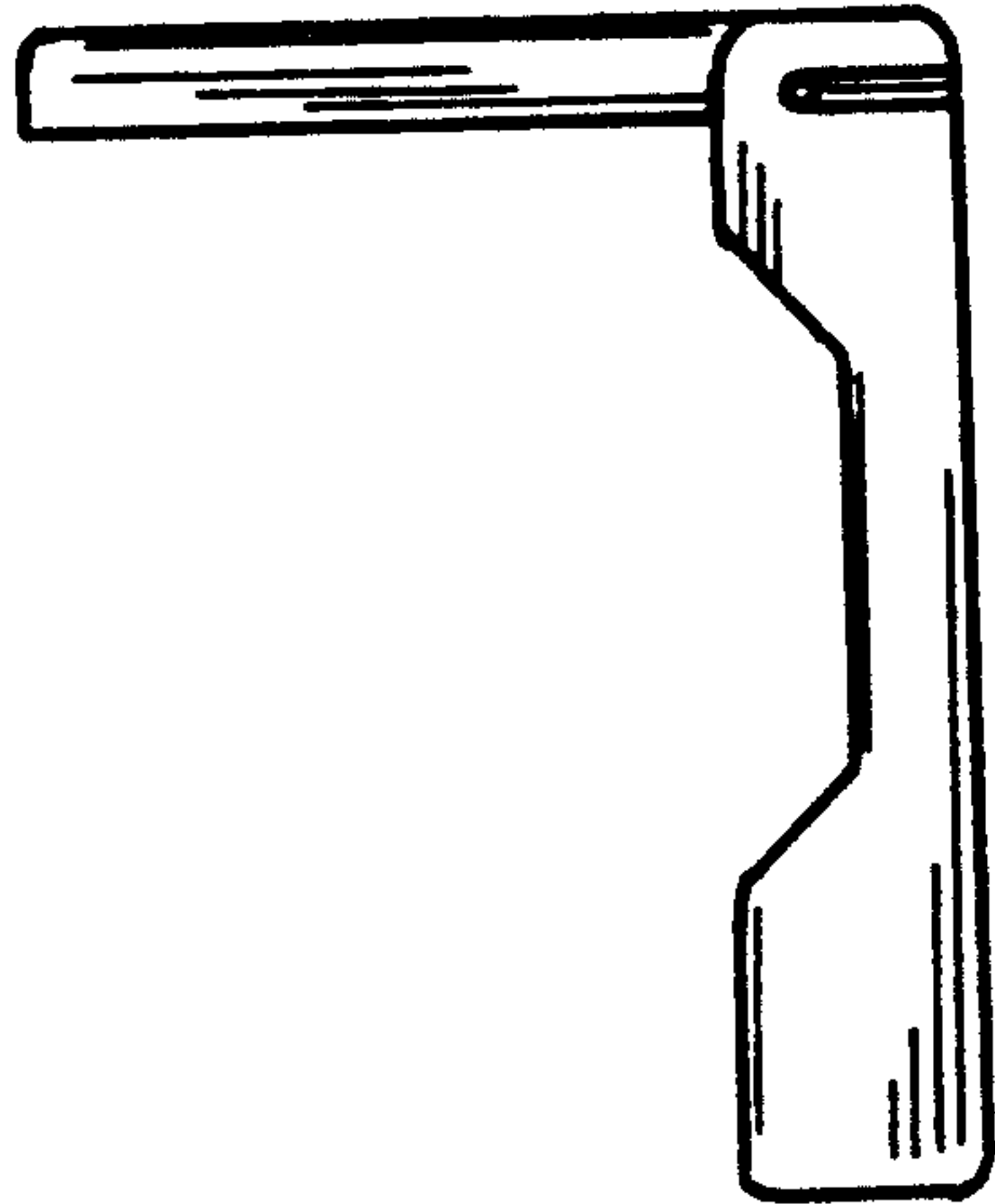

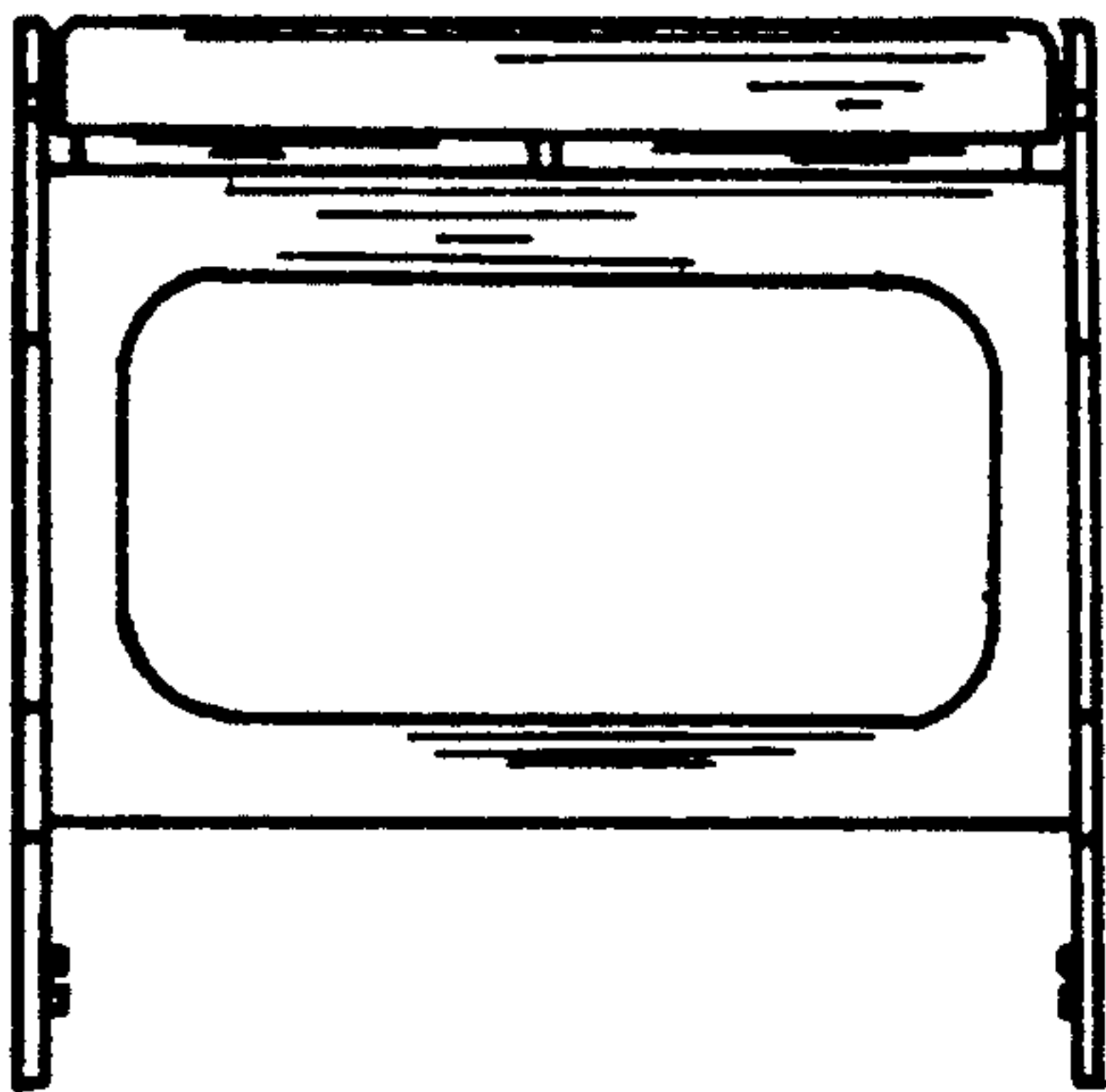

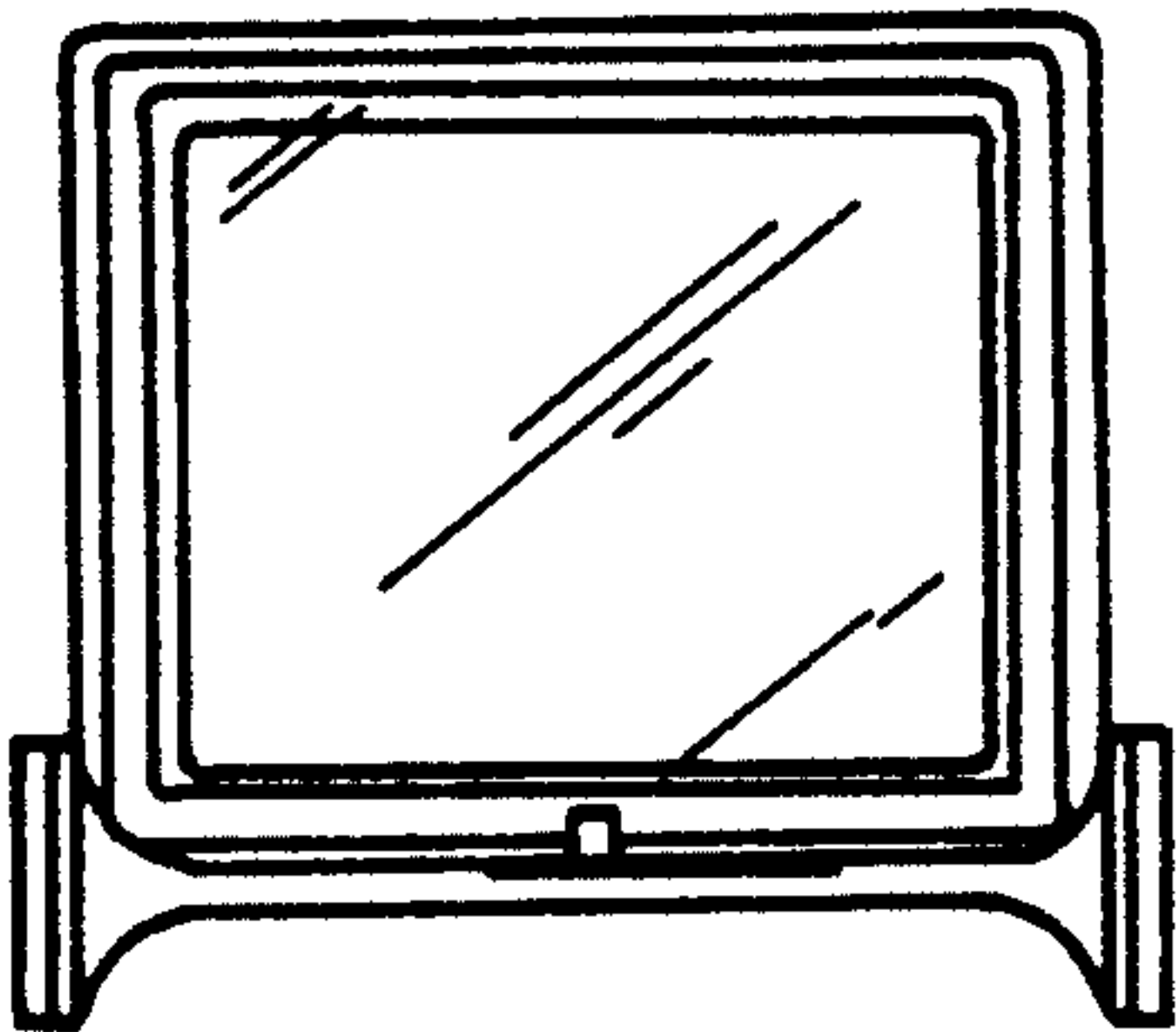

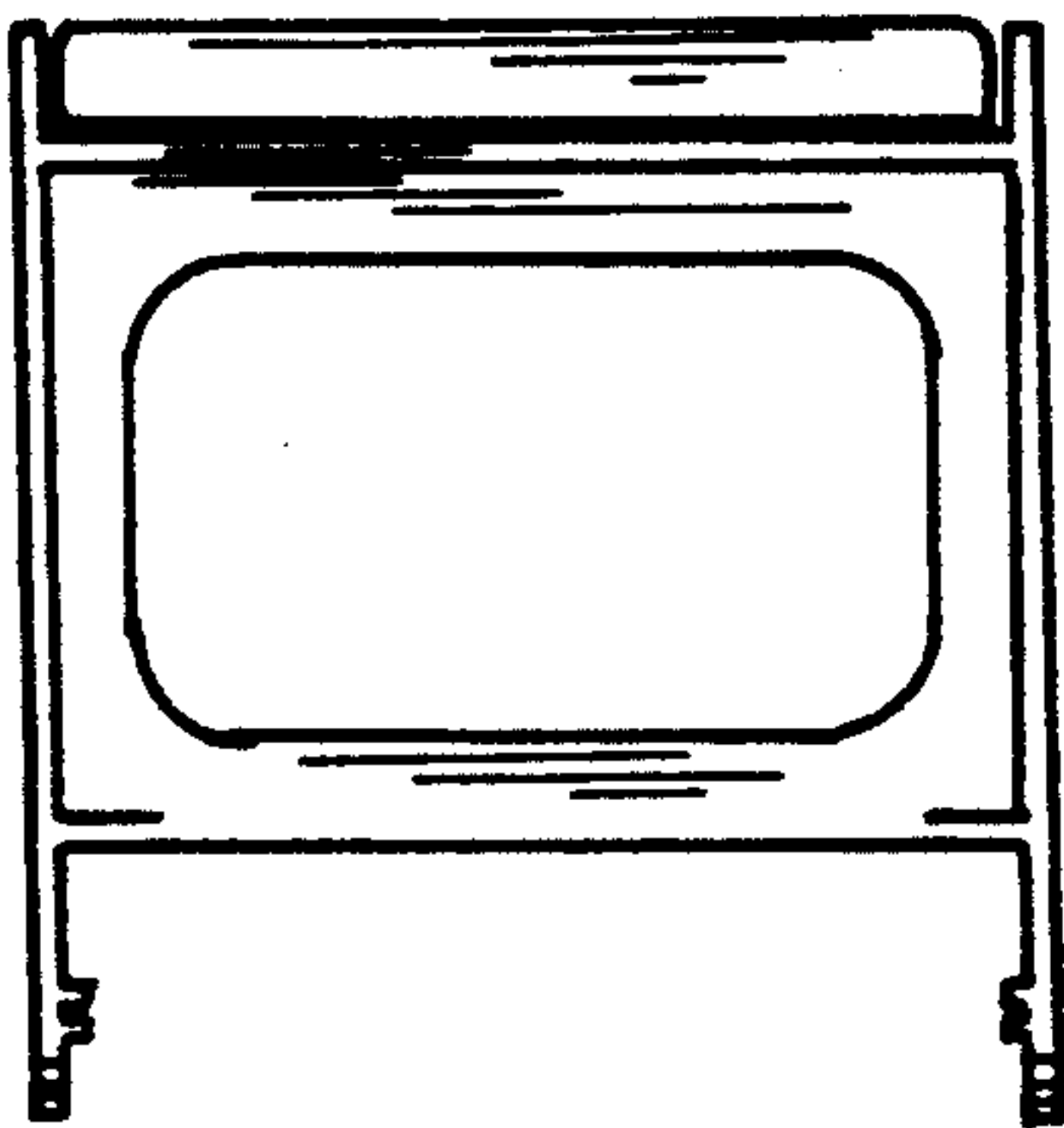

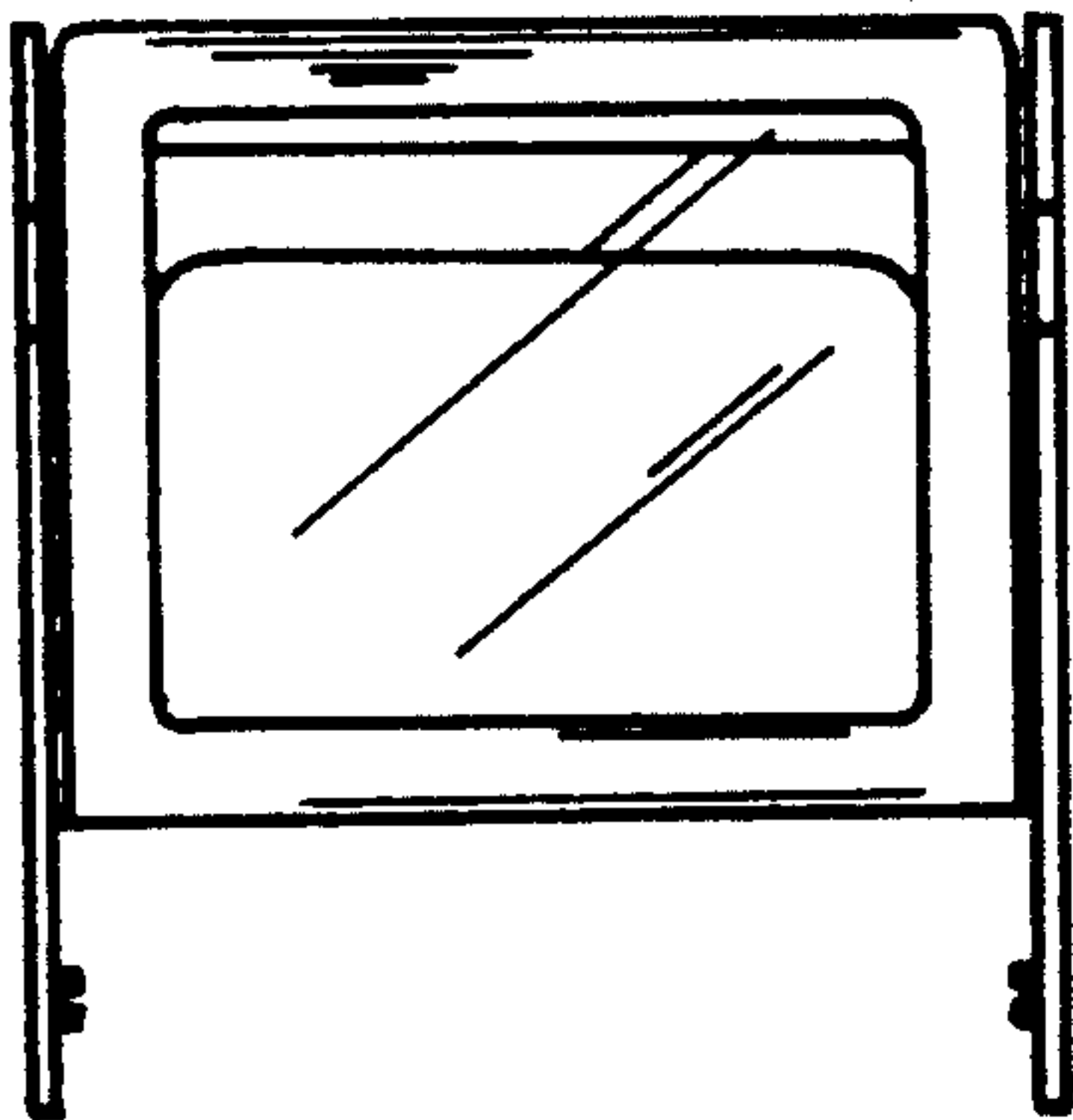

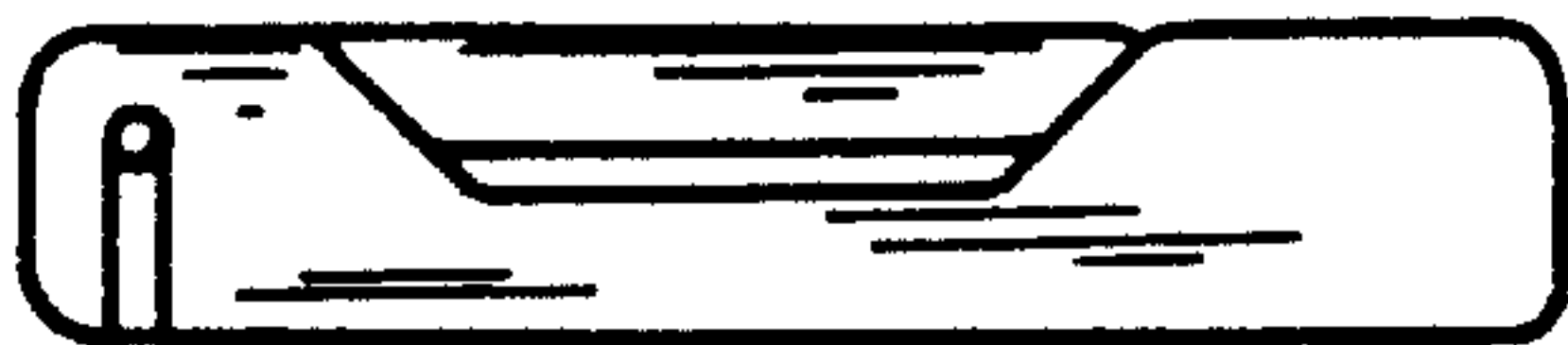

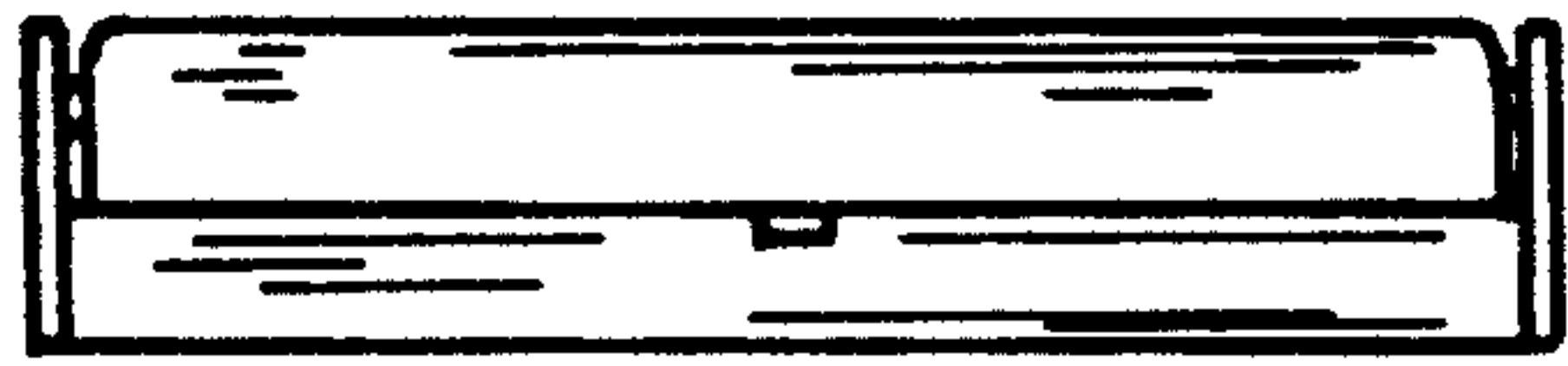

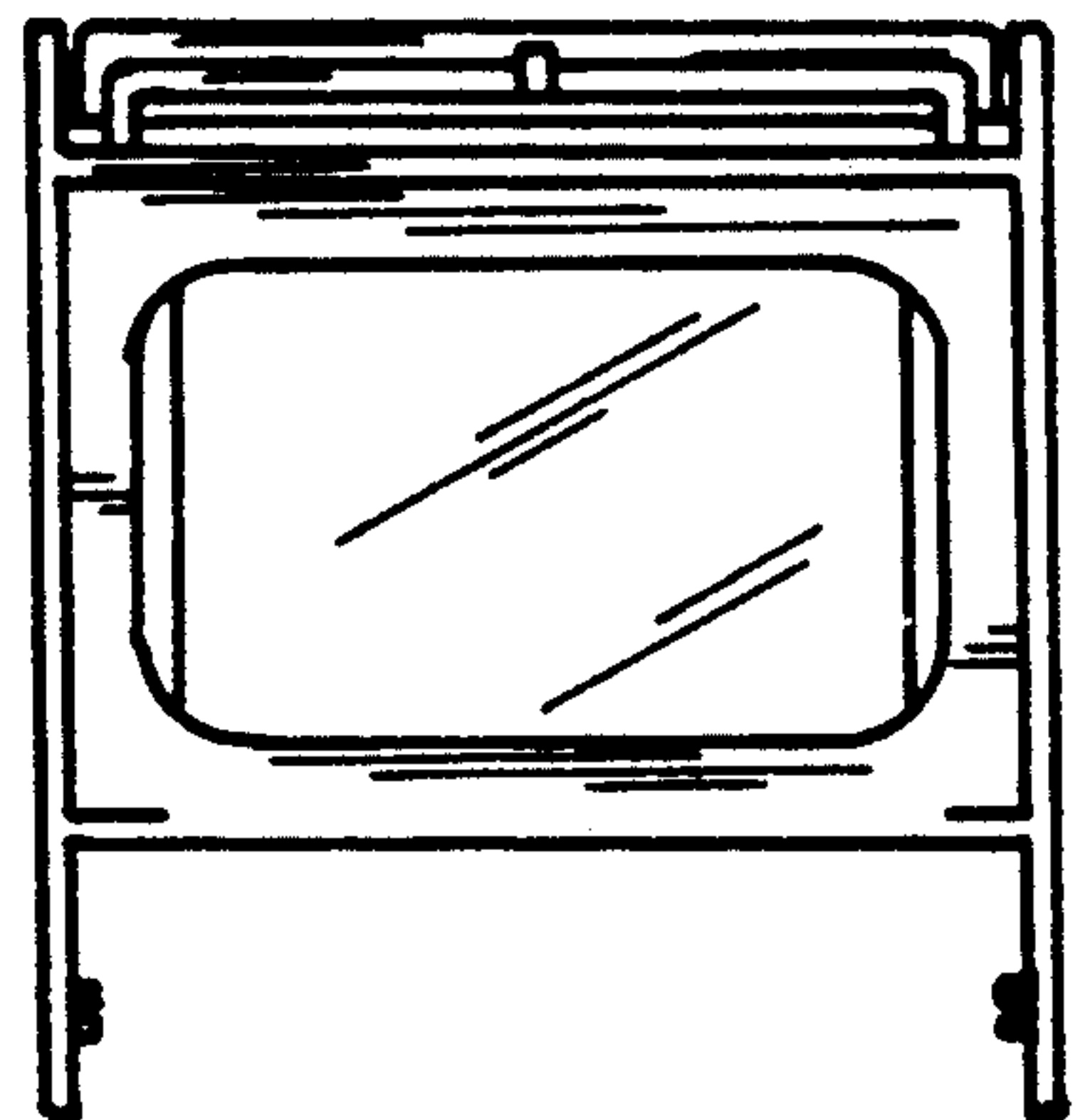

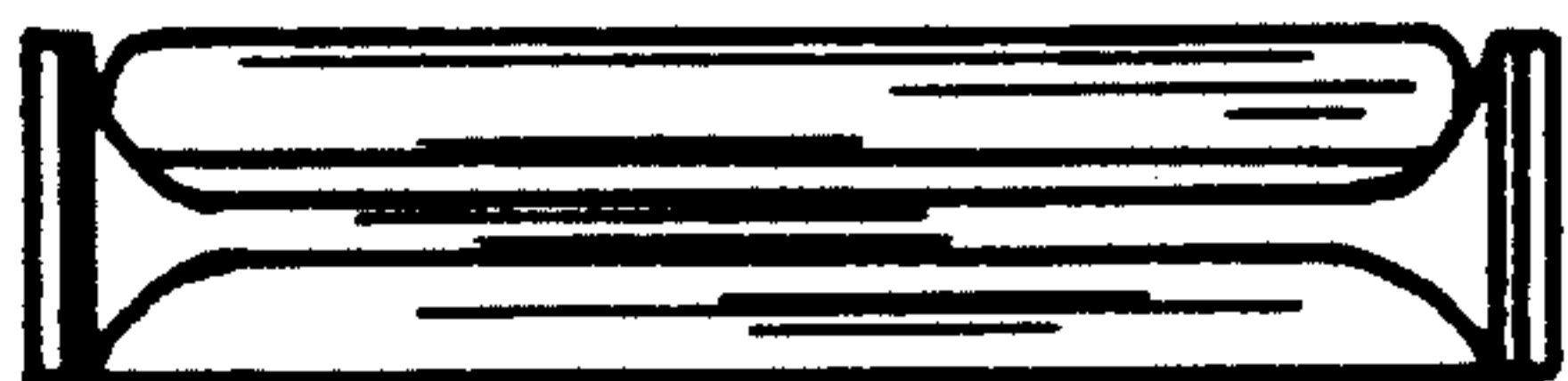
