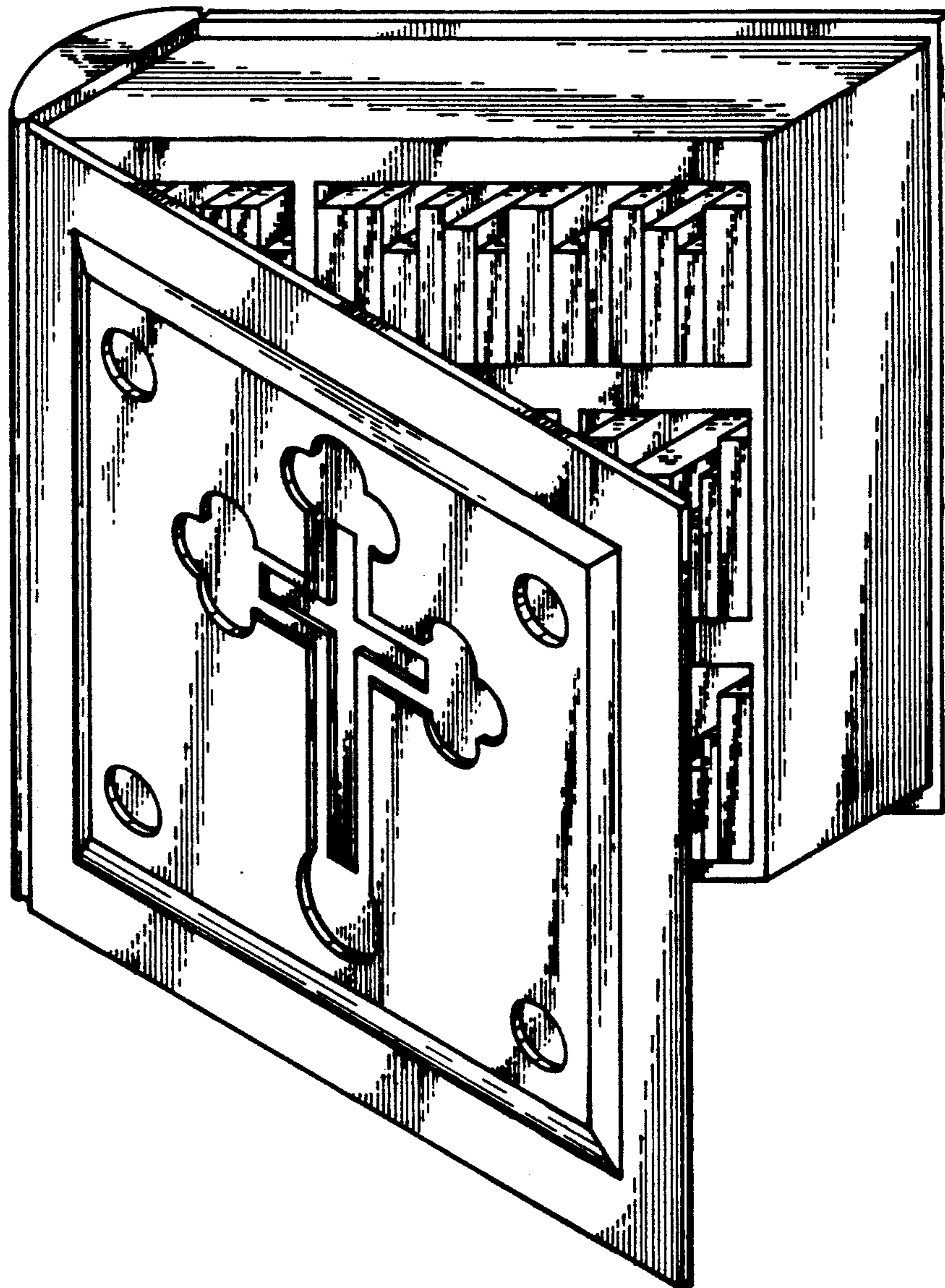

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a puzzle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a puzzle showing my new design in the partially open configuration; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and, FIG. 7 is a front elevational view in the fully open condition.



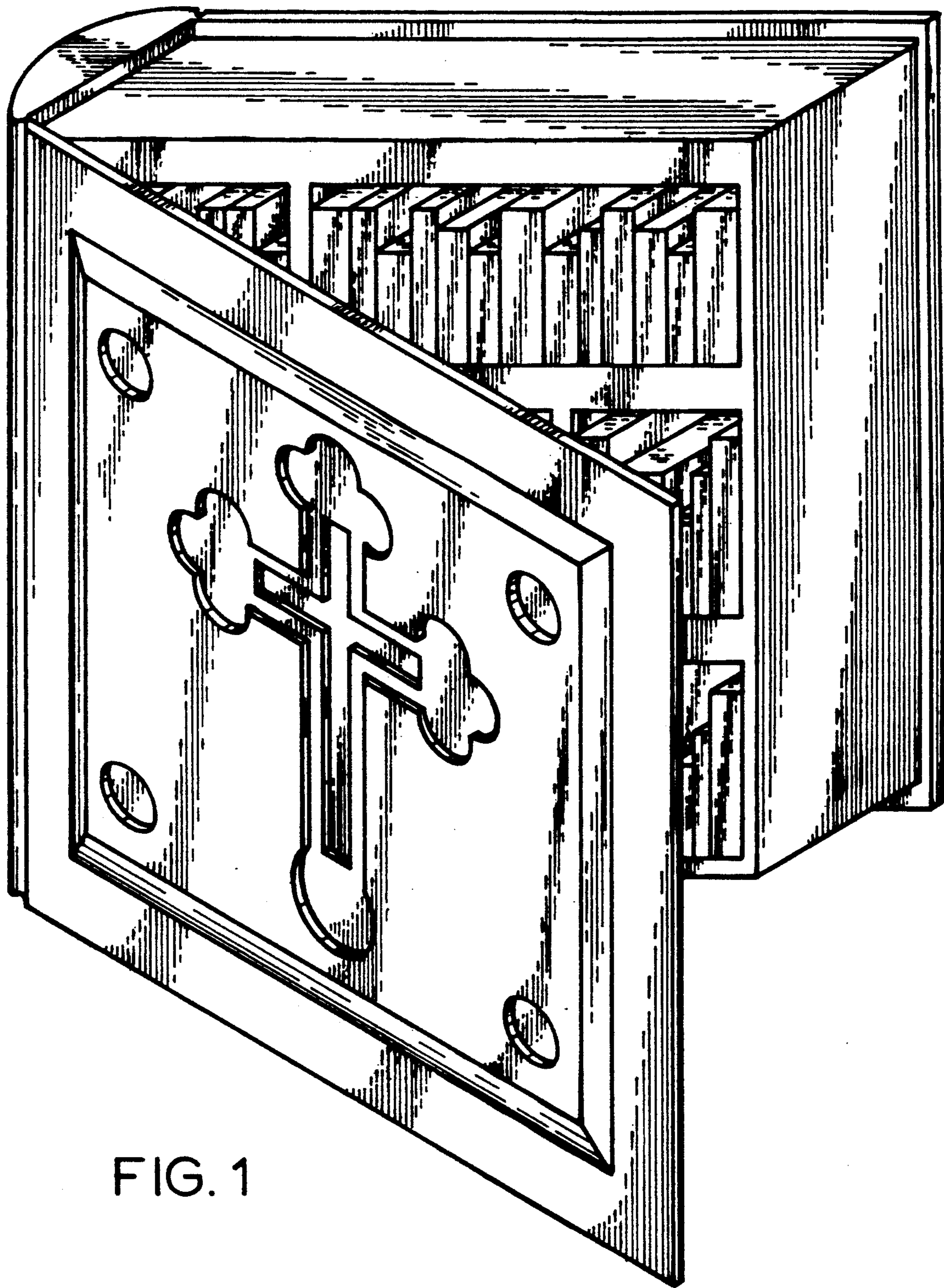

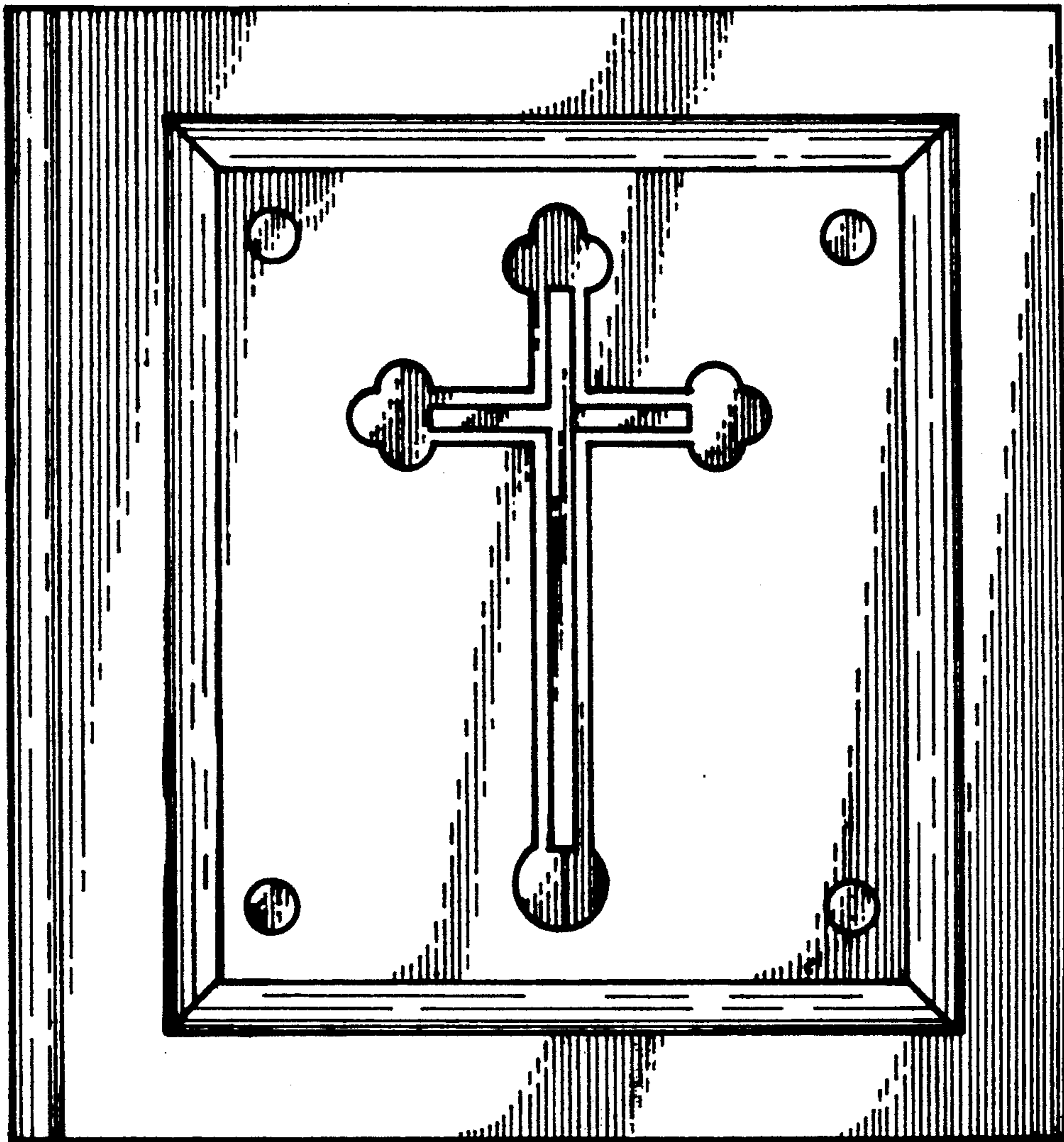

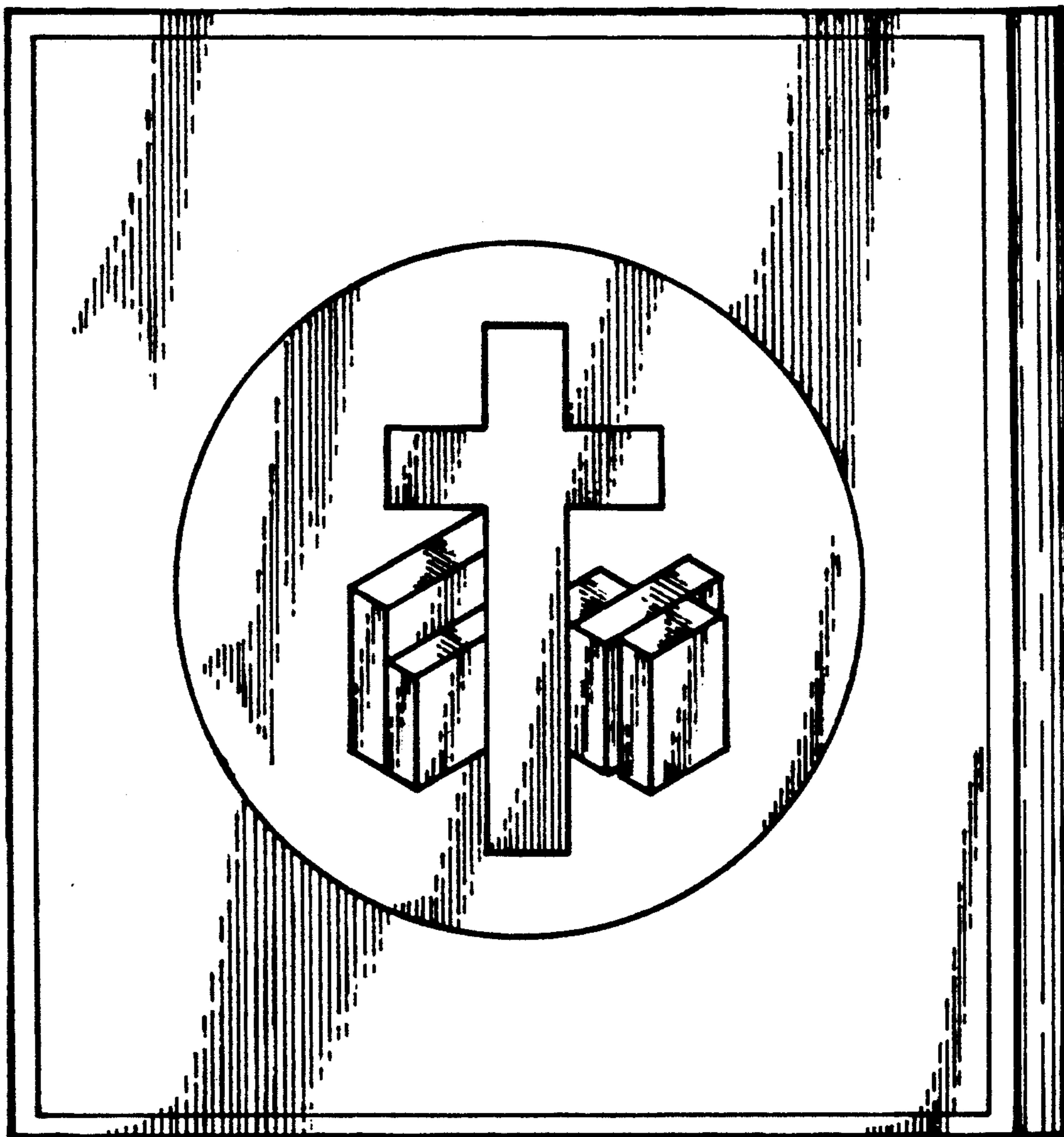

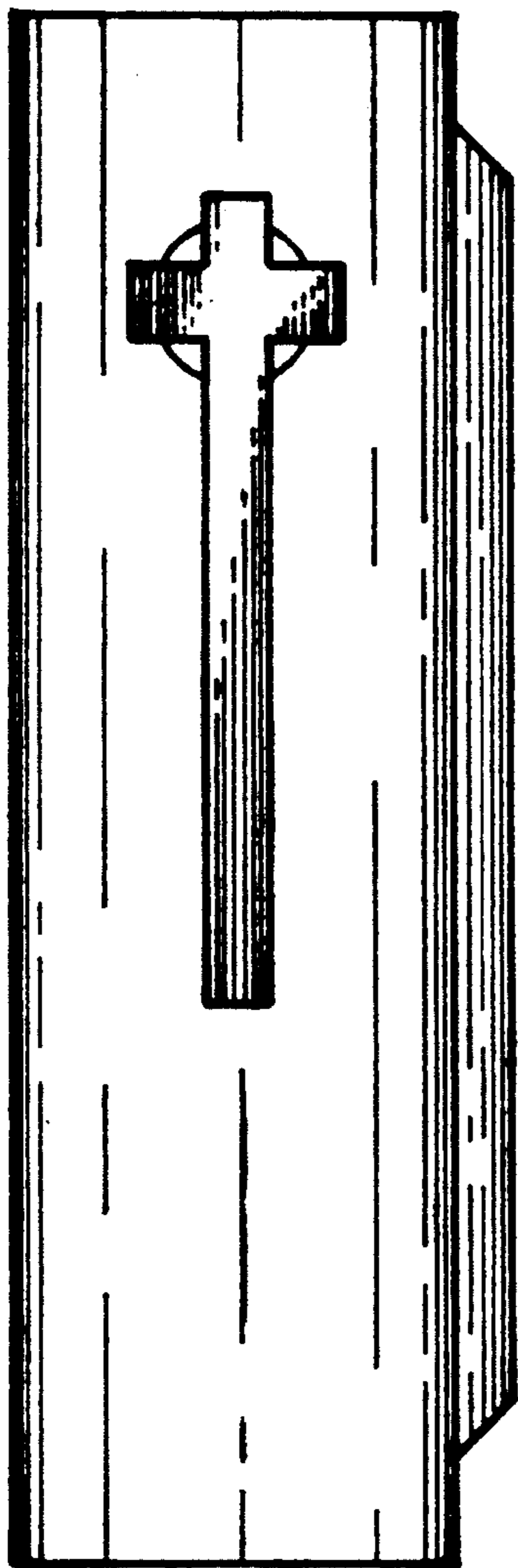

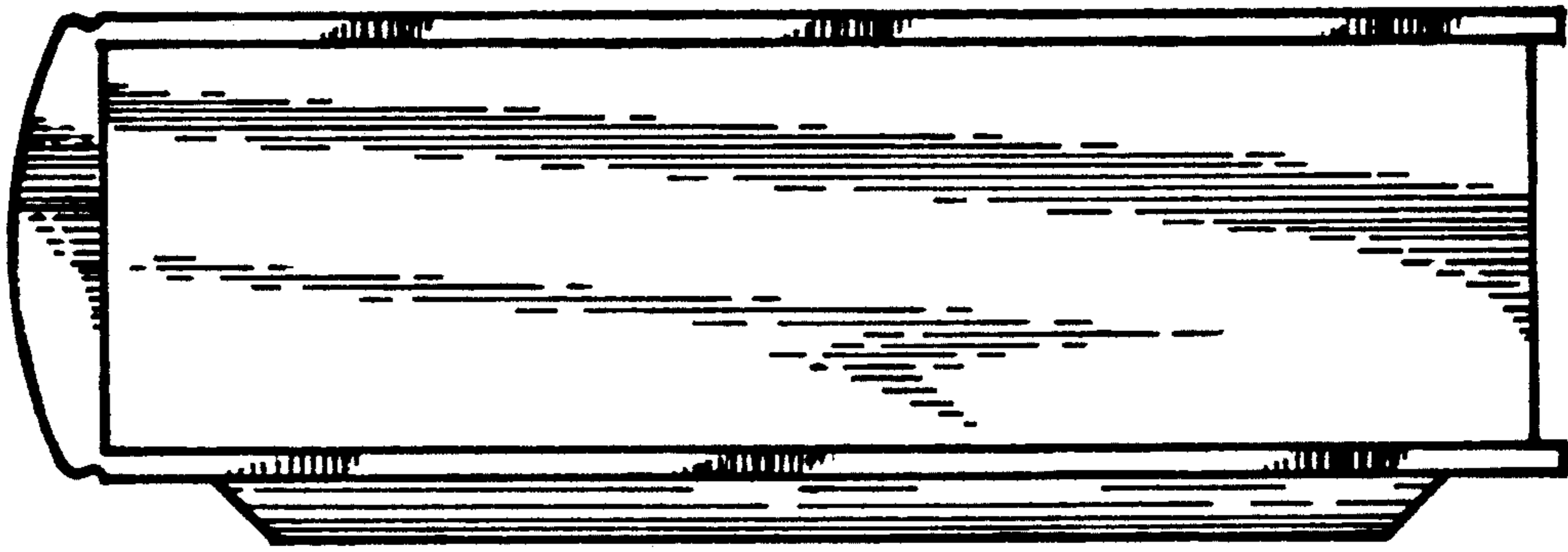

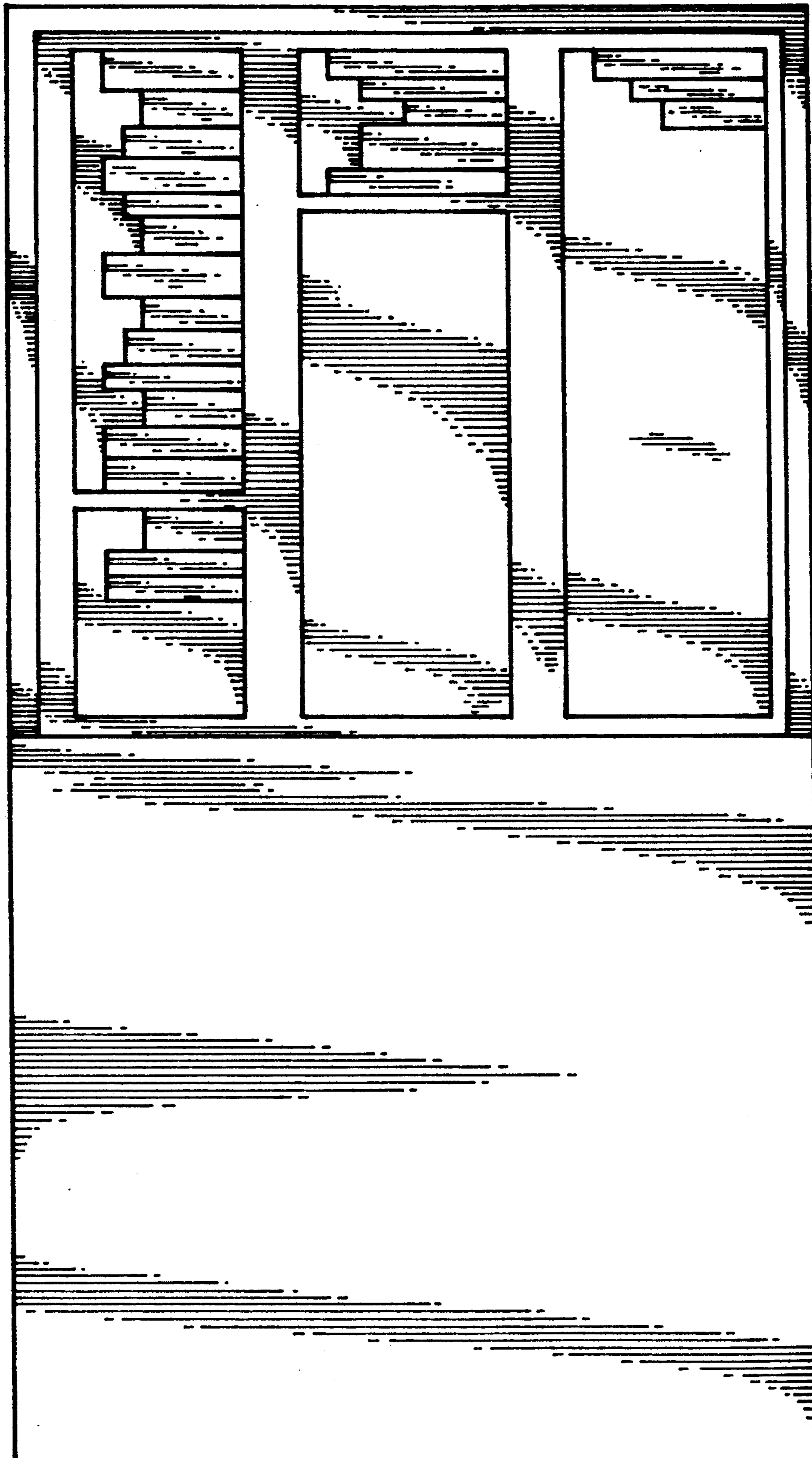
