DESCRIPTION

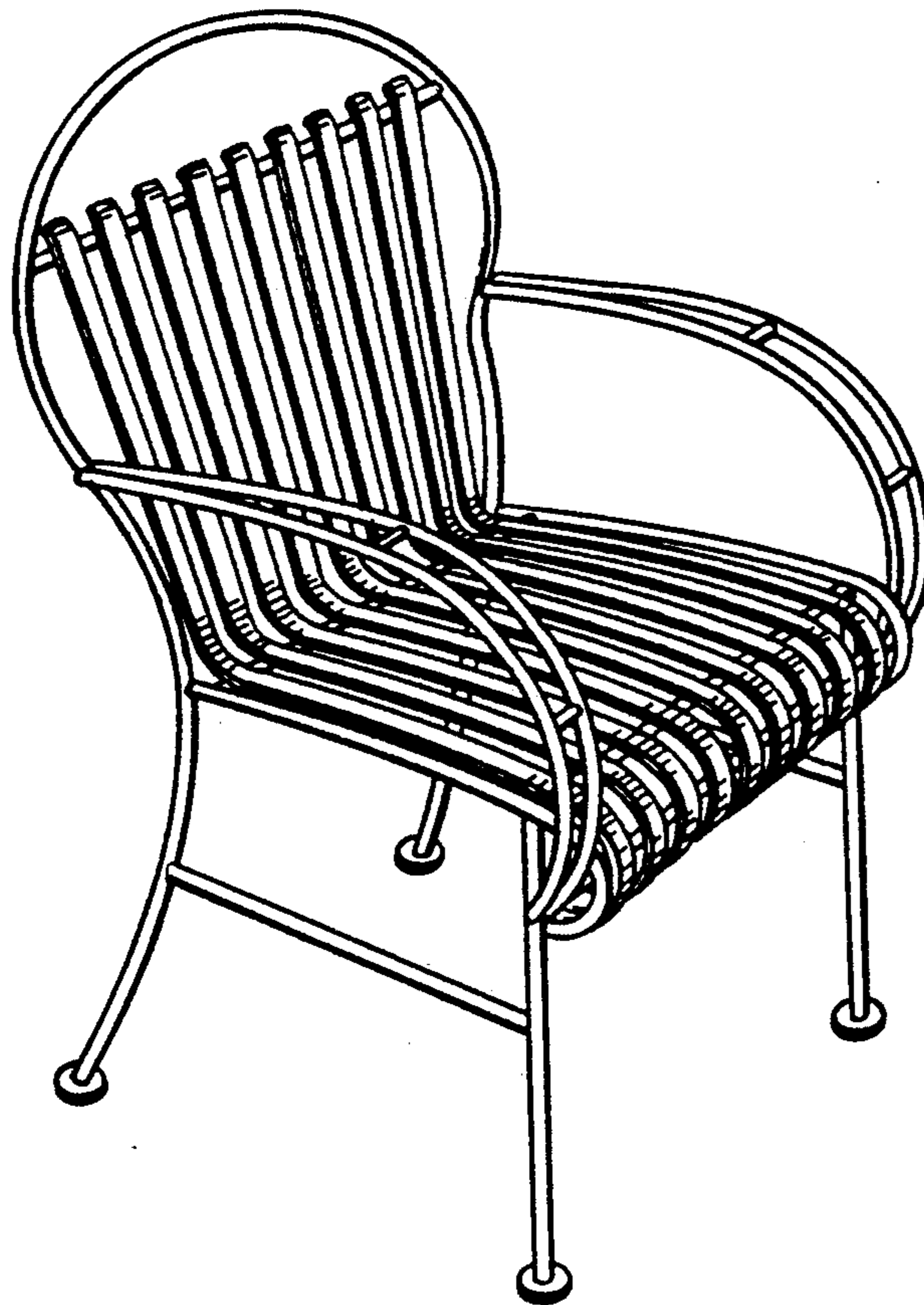
FIG. 1 is a left-front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



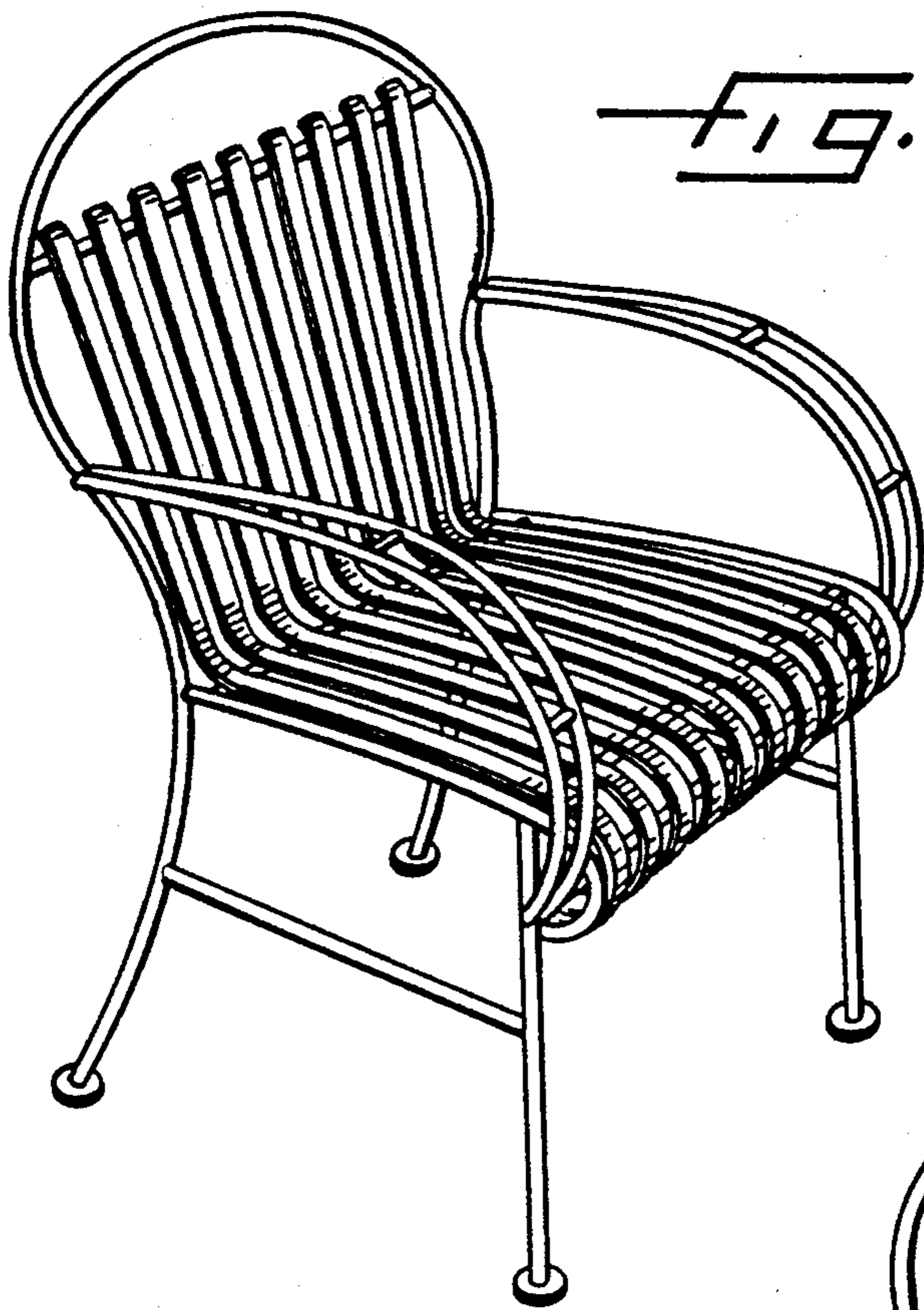

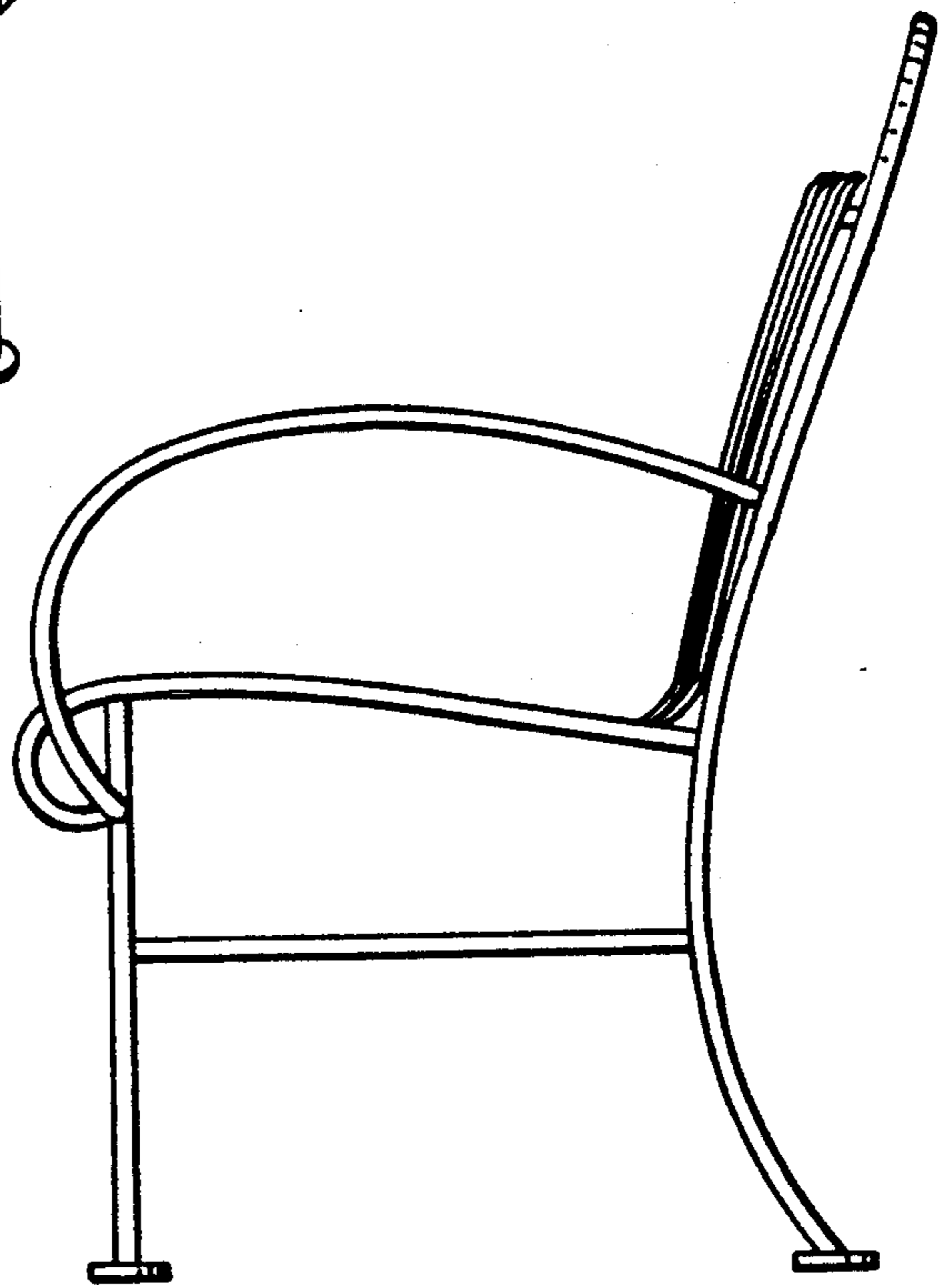

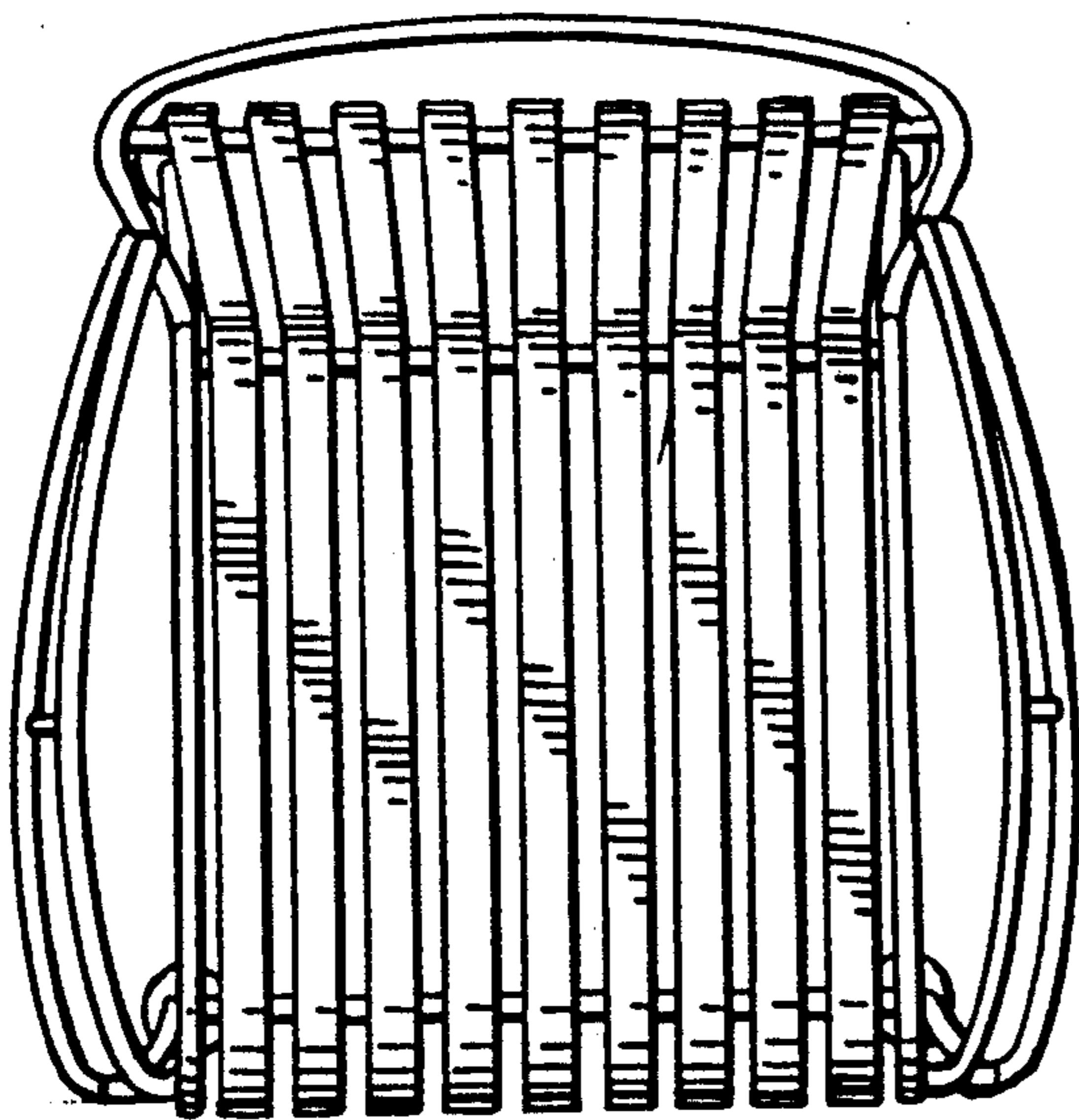

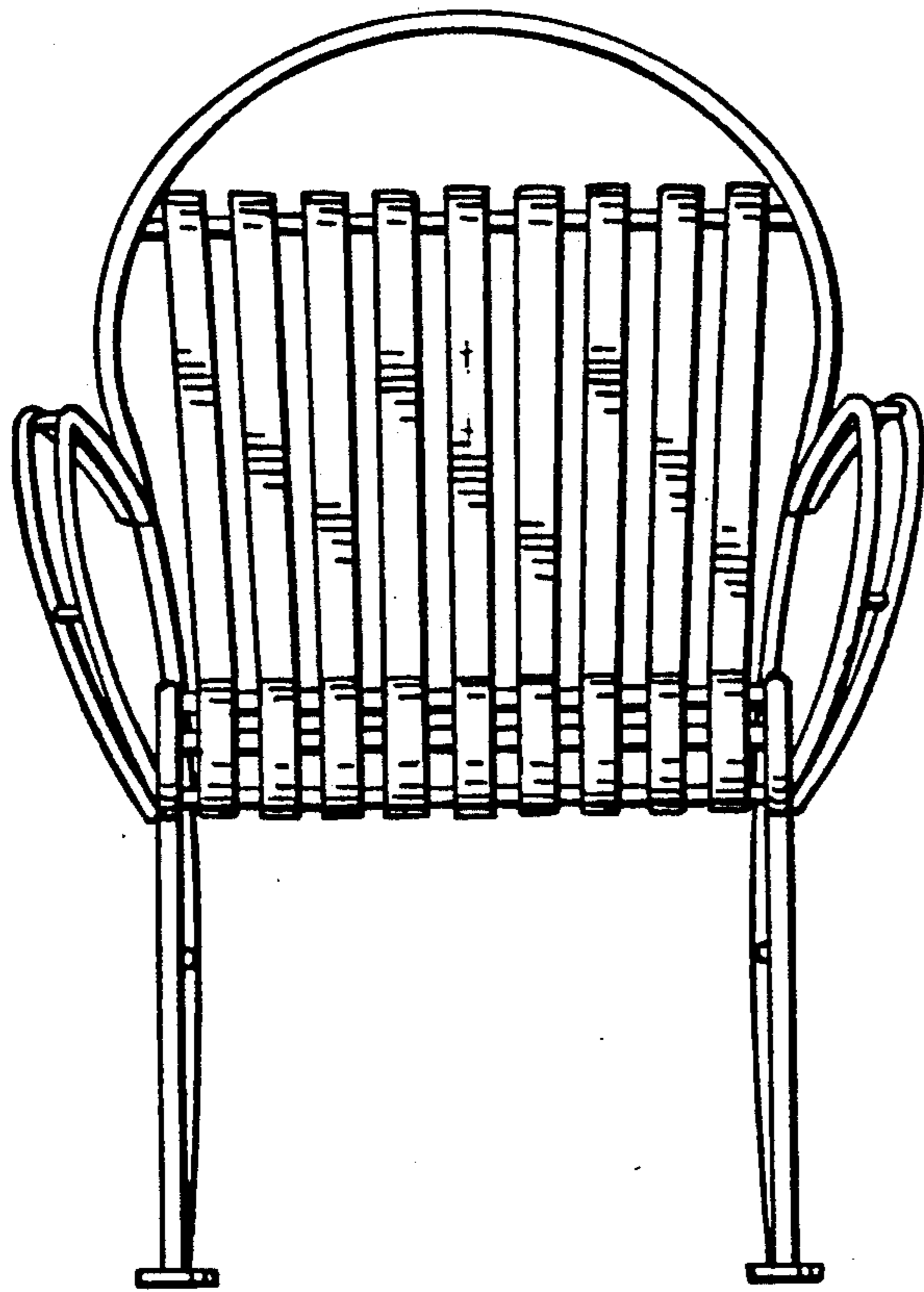

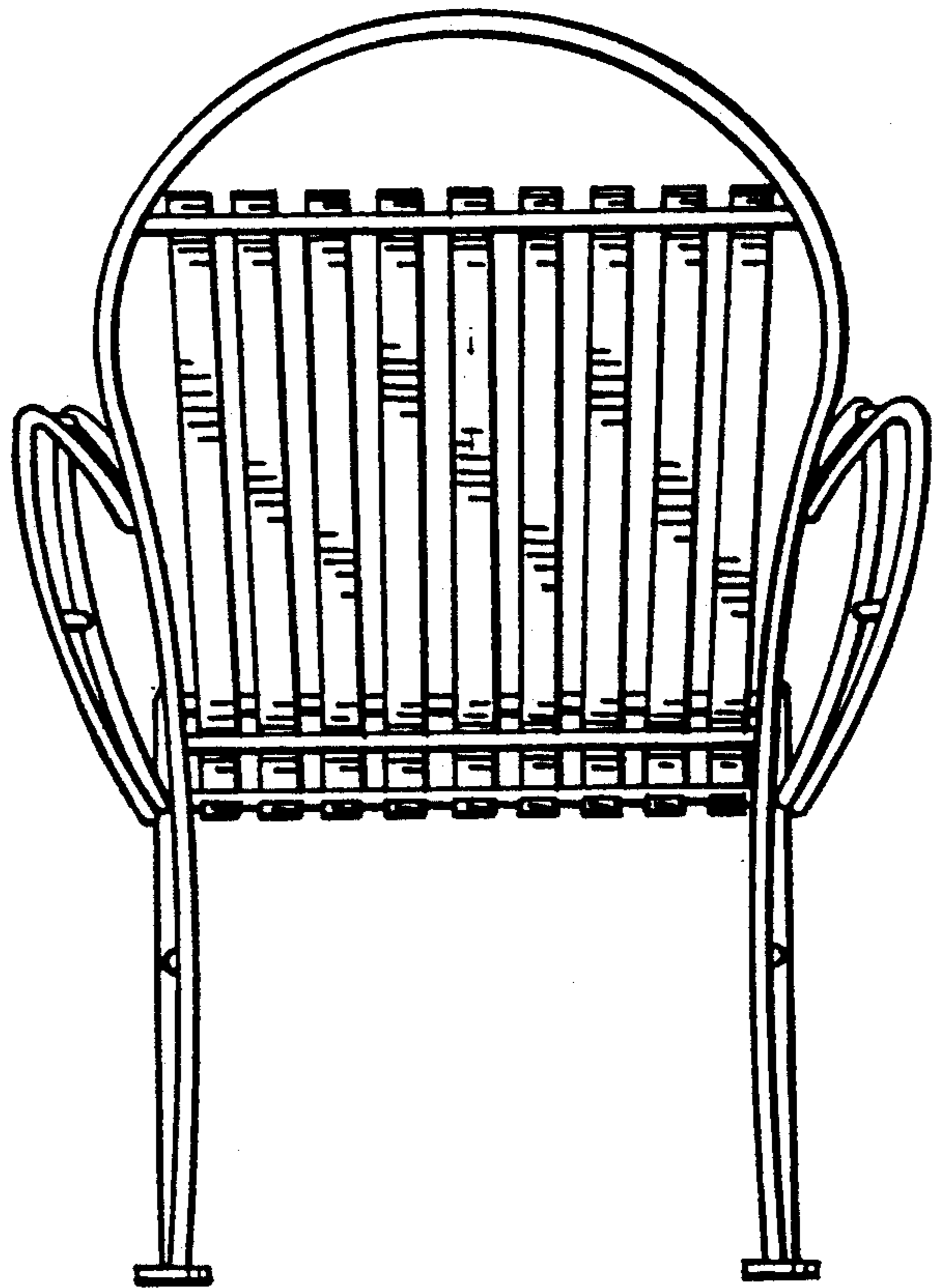
