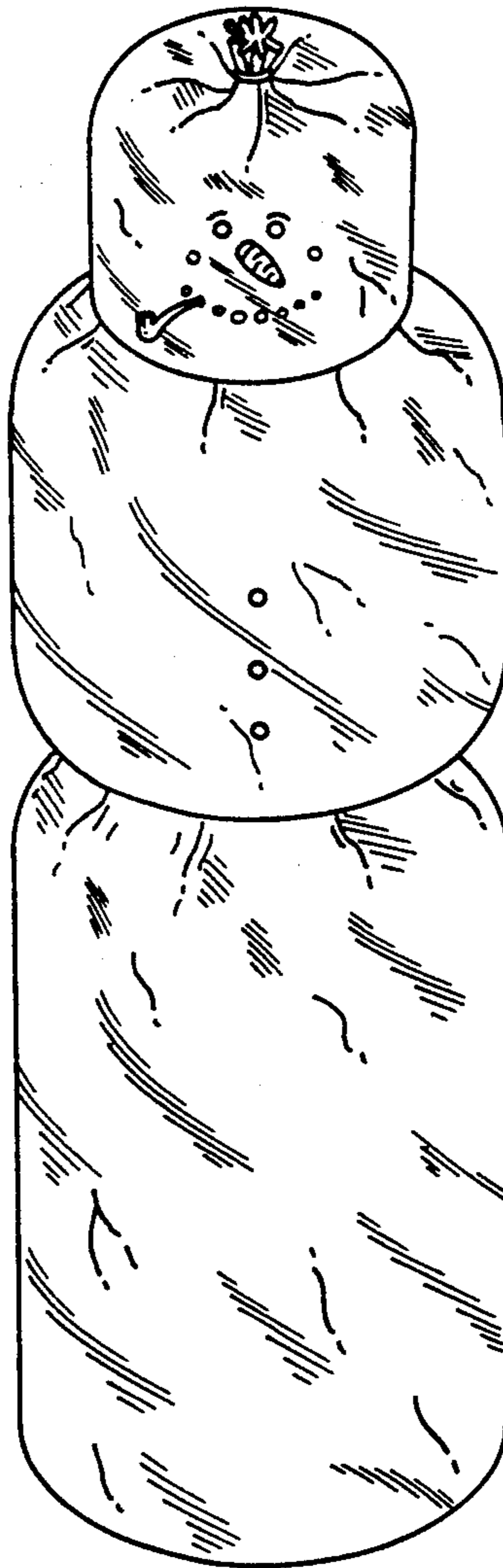
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the flexible bag showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being substantially a mirror image.



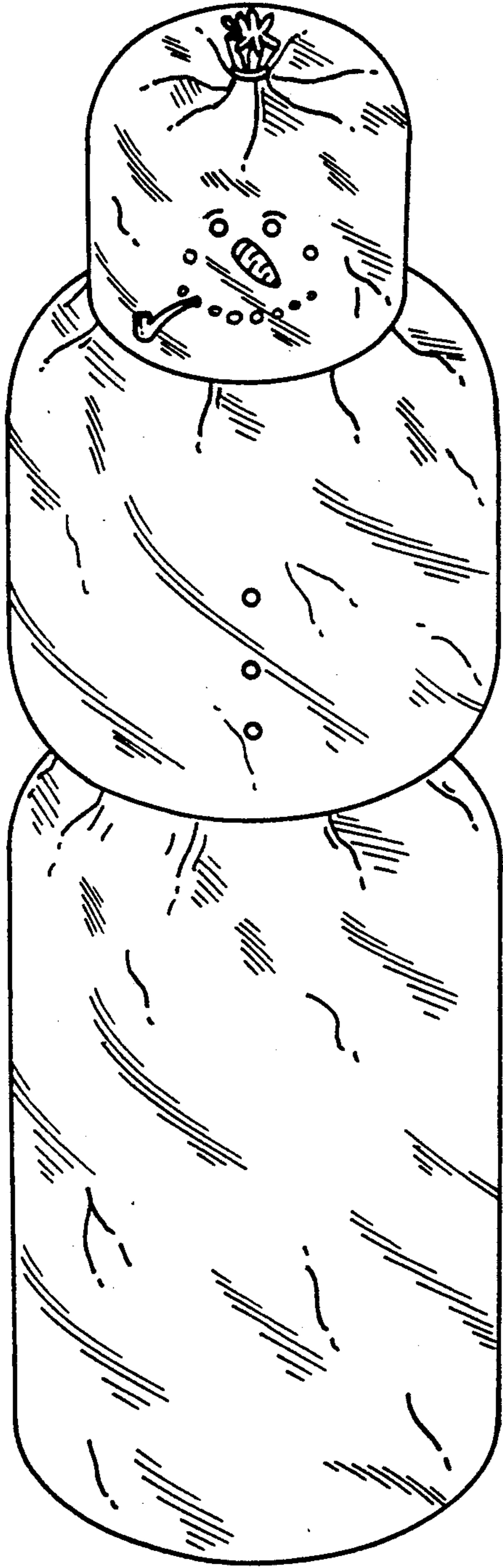

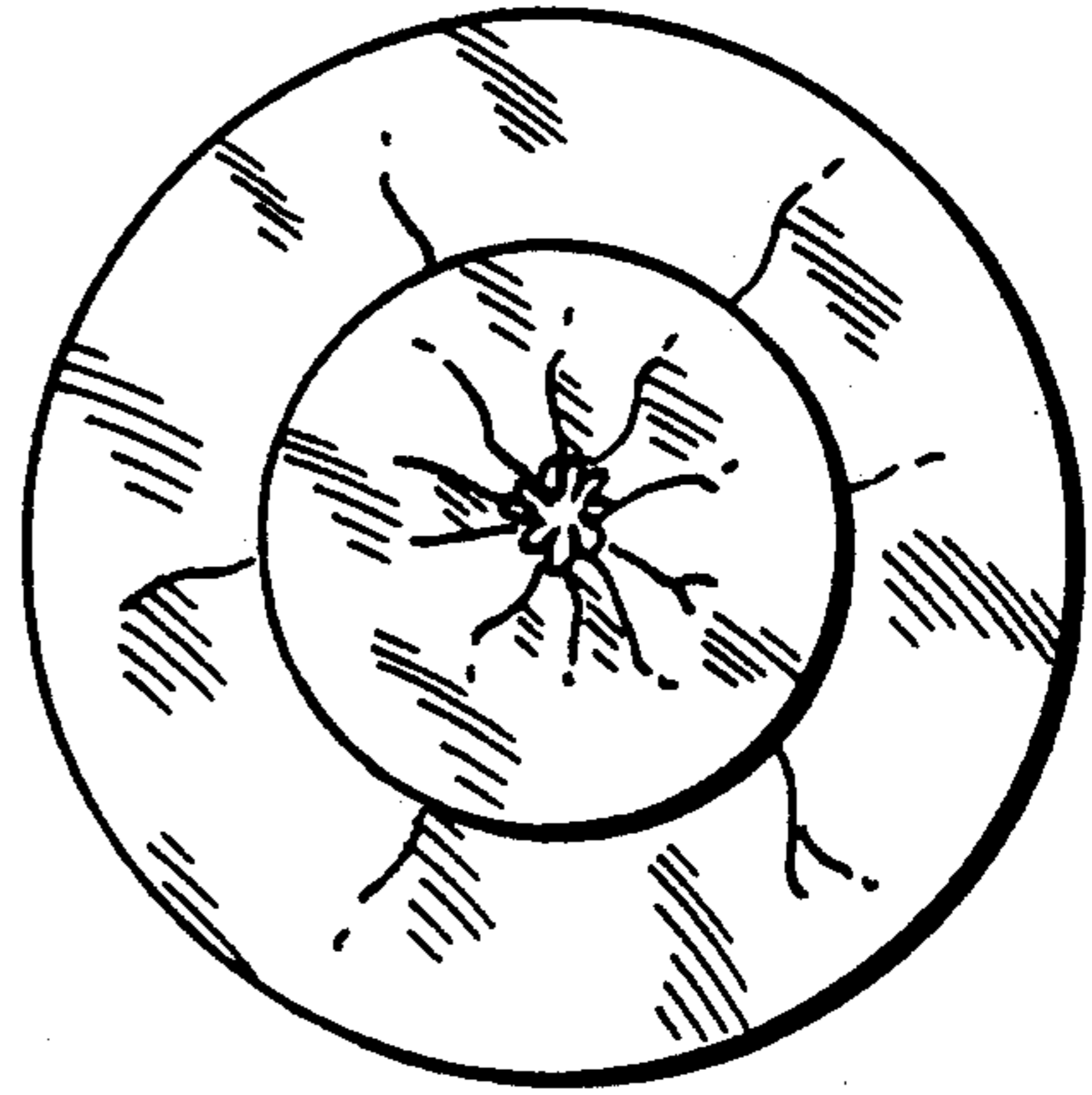

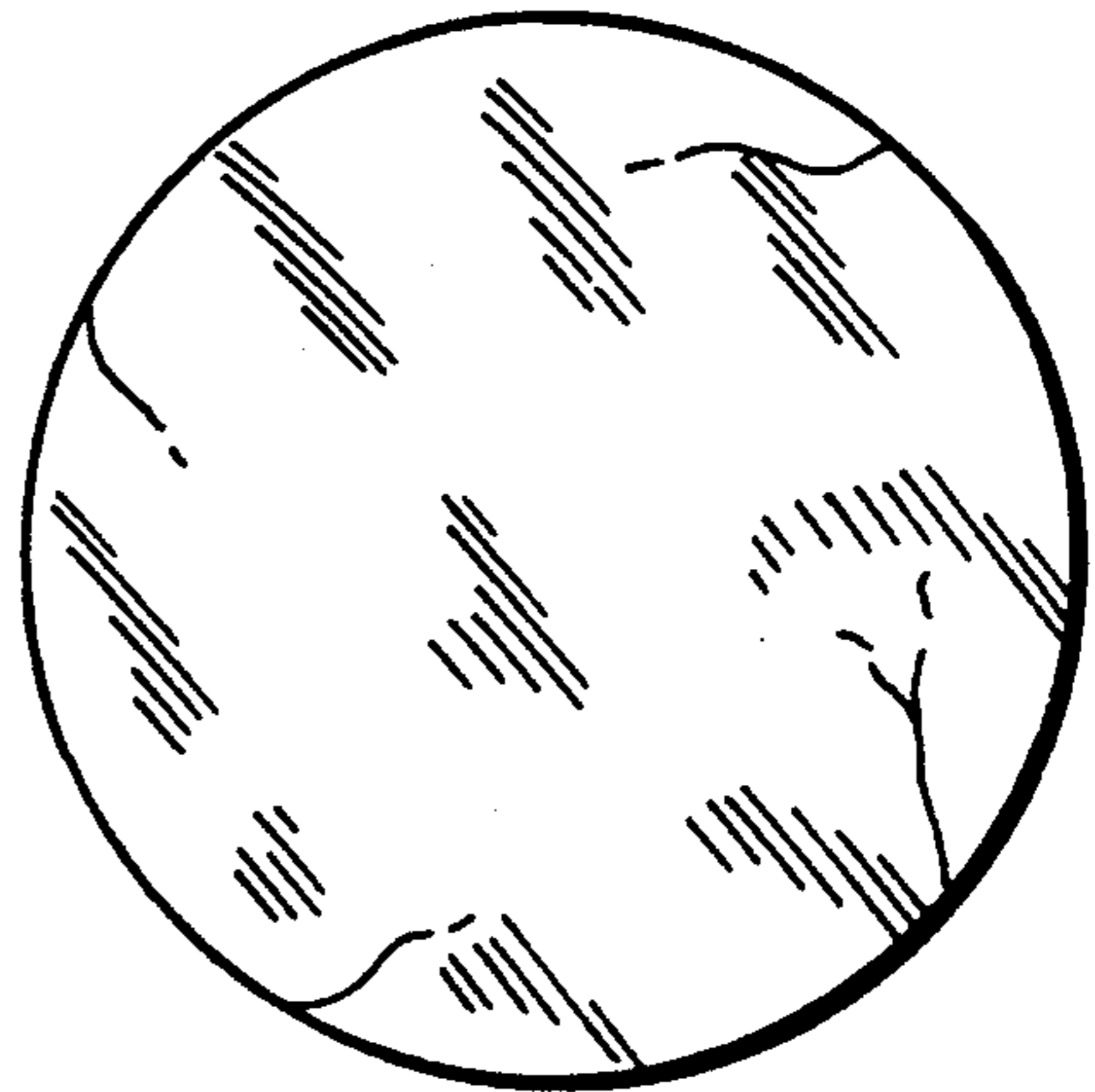

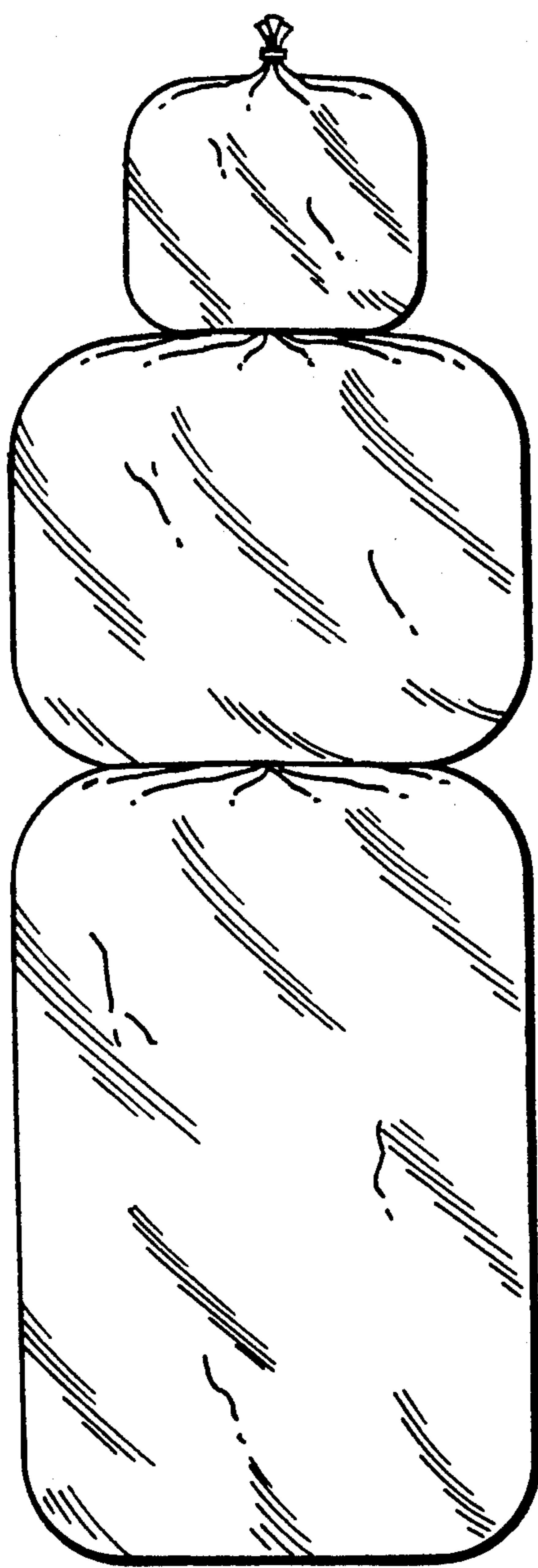

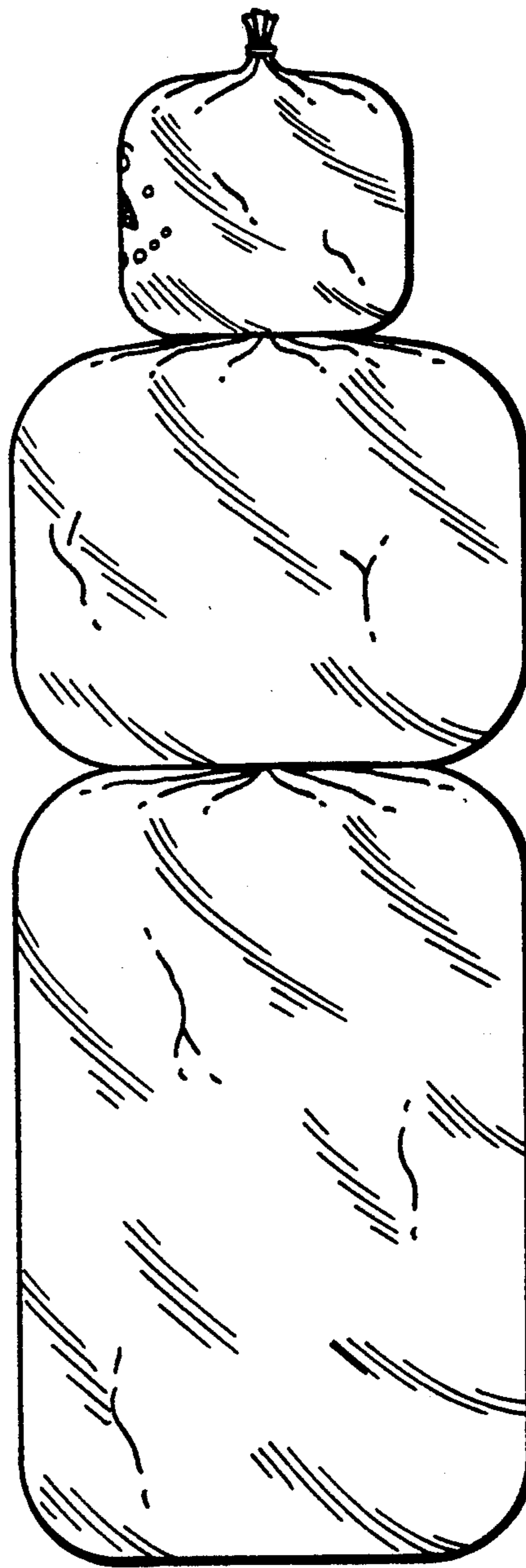
