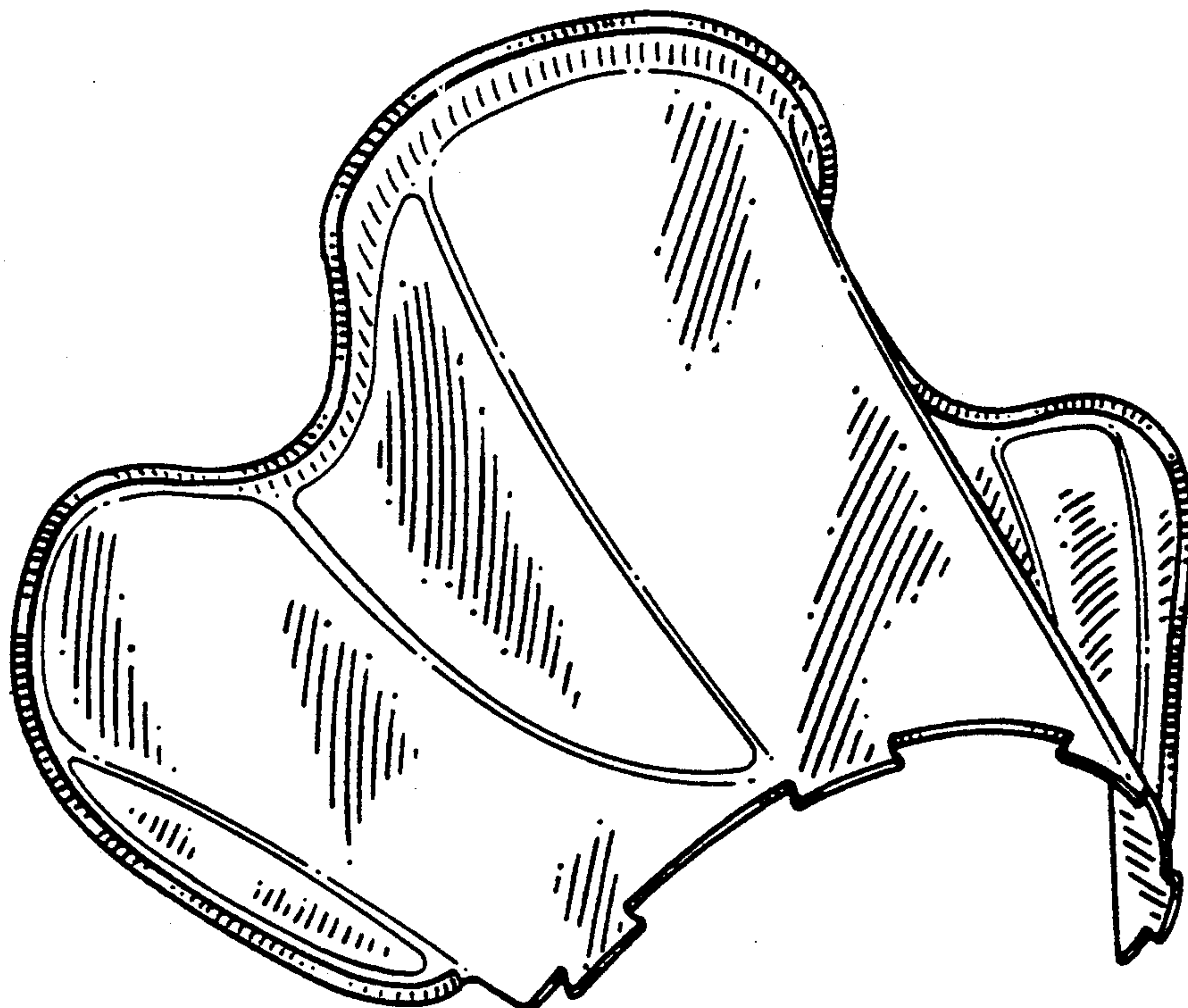

FIG. 4 is a rear and side perspective view thereof.



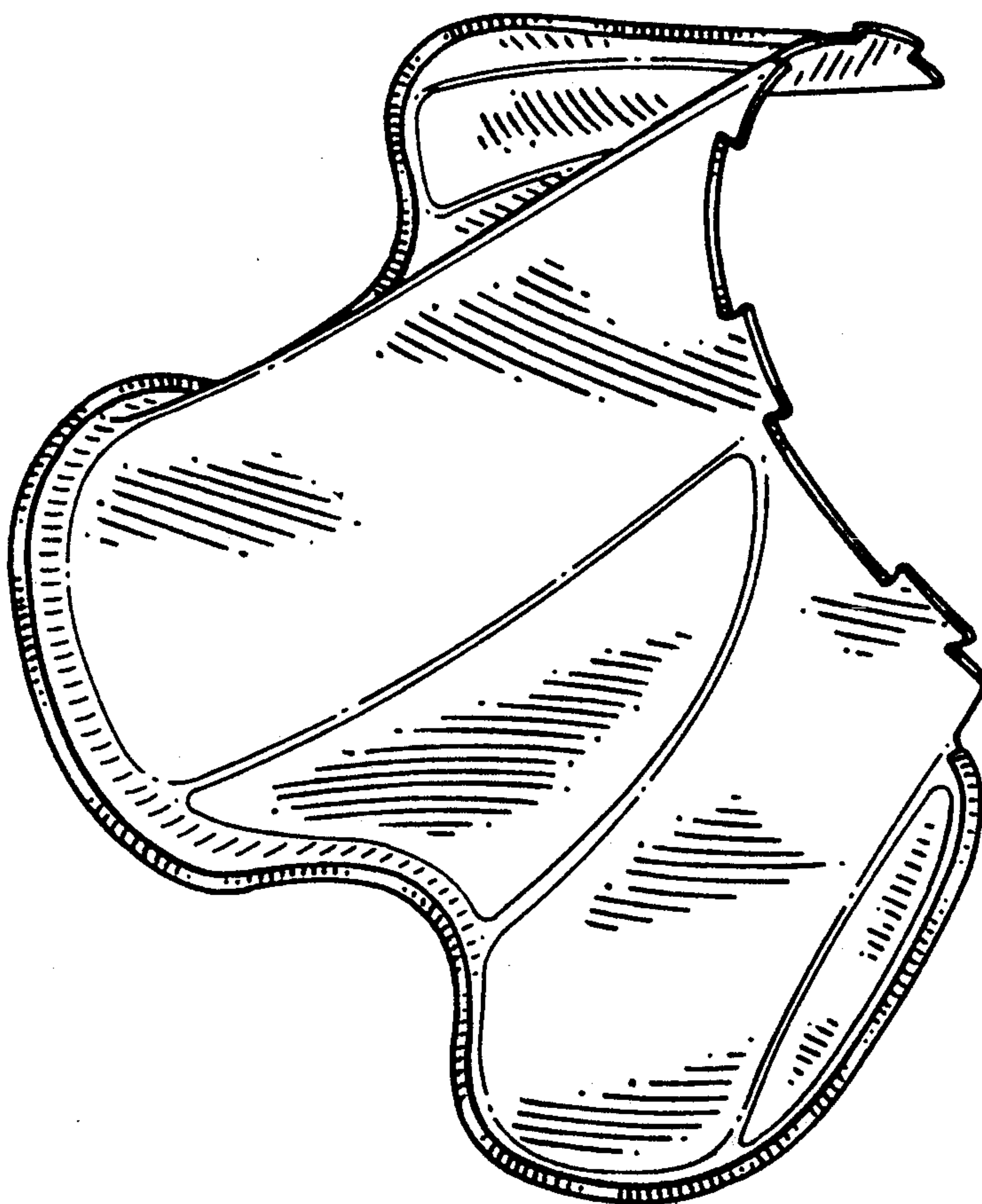

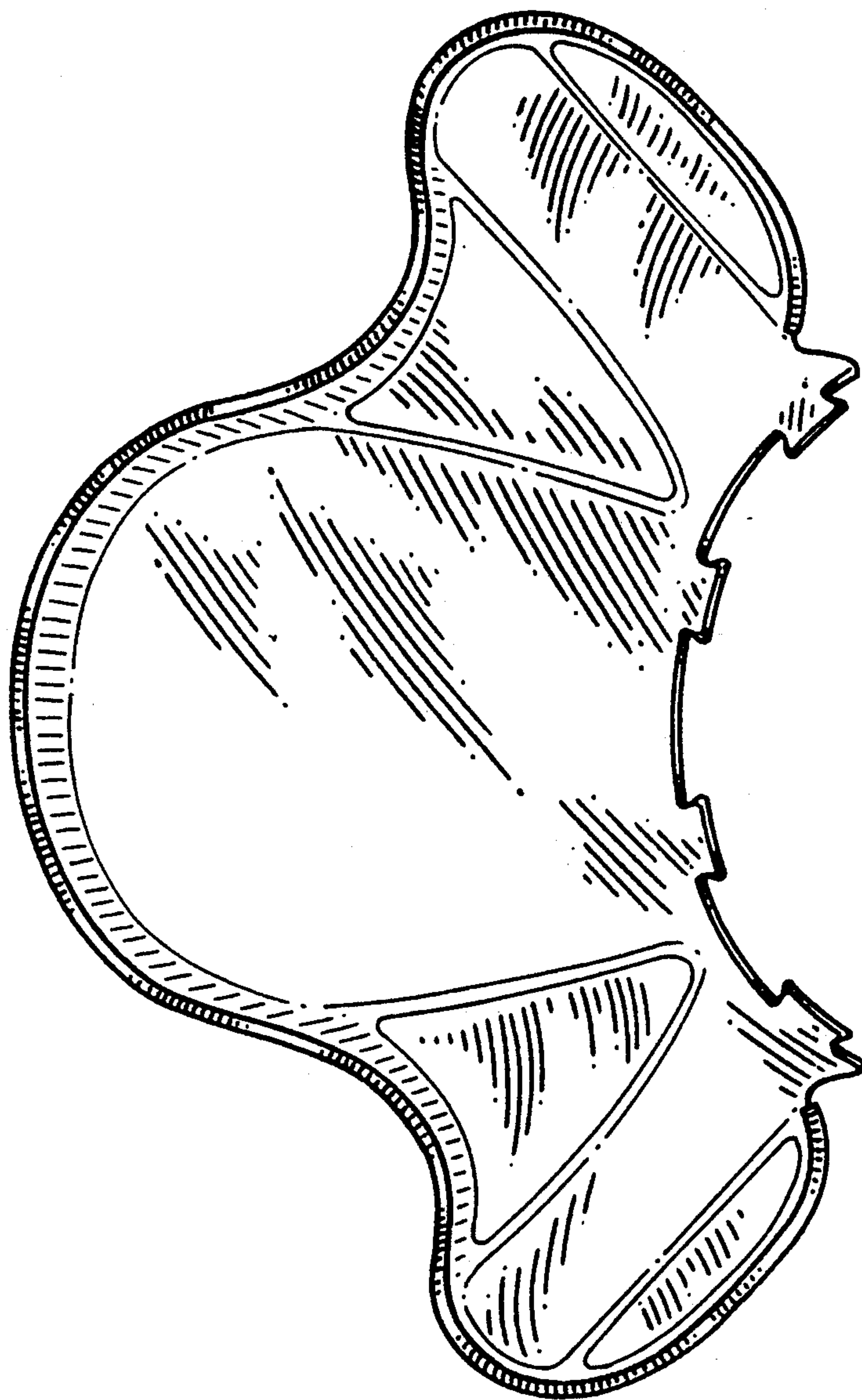

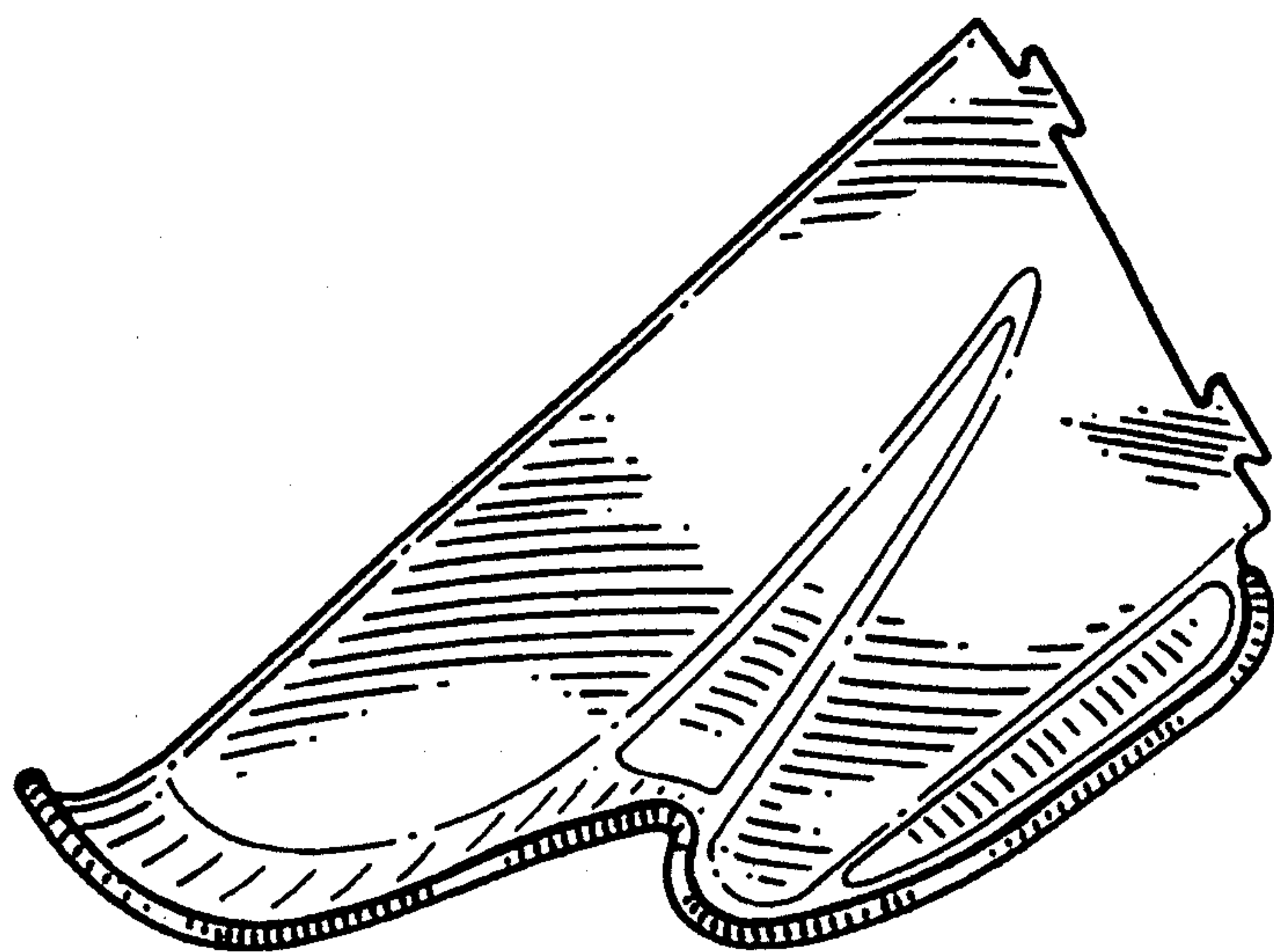

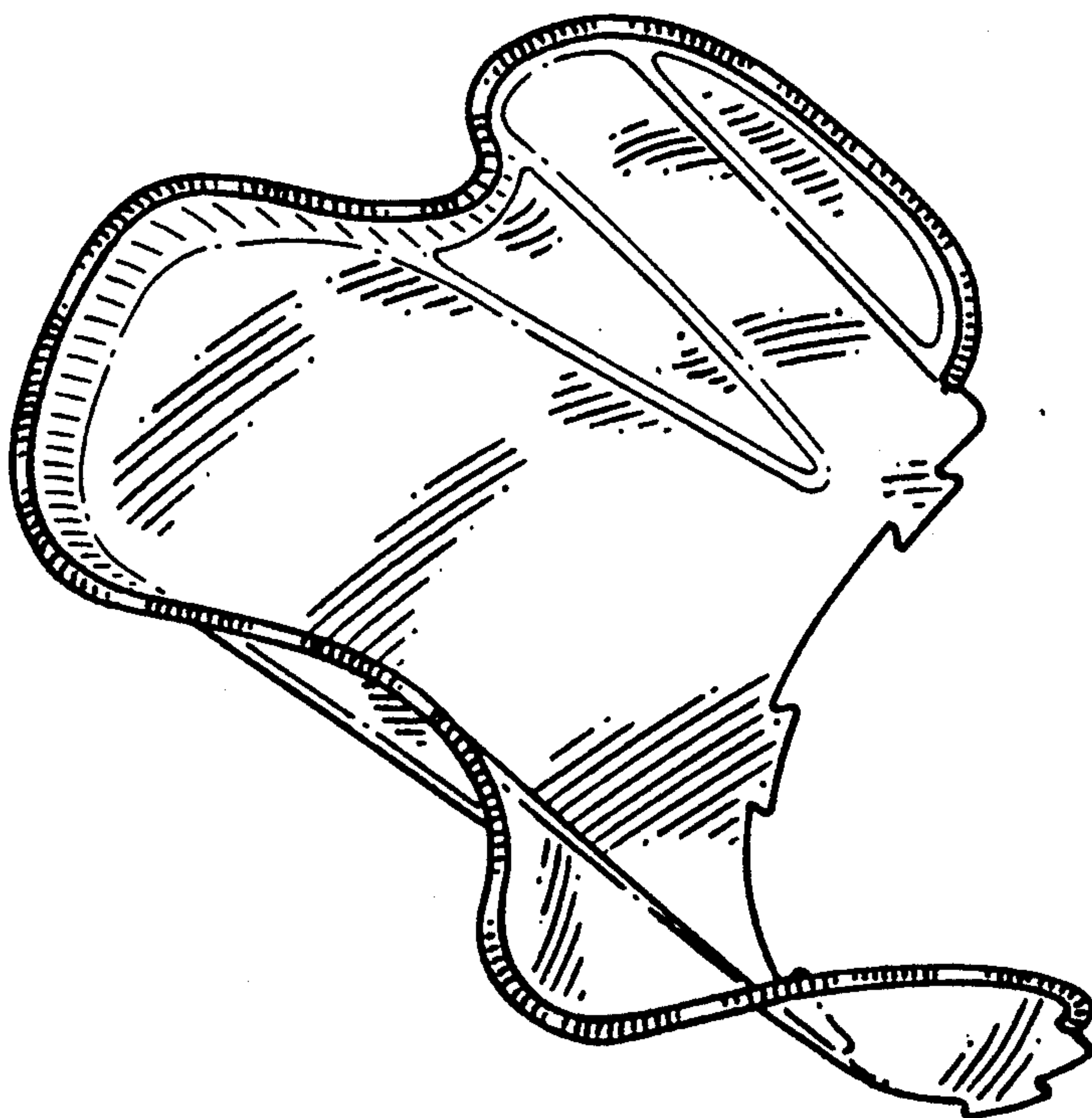
