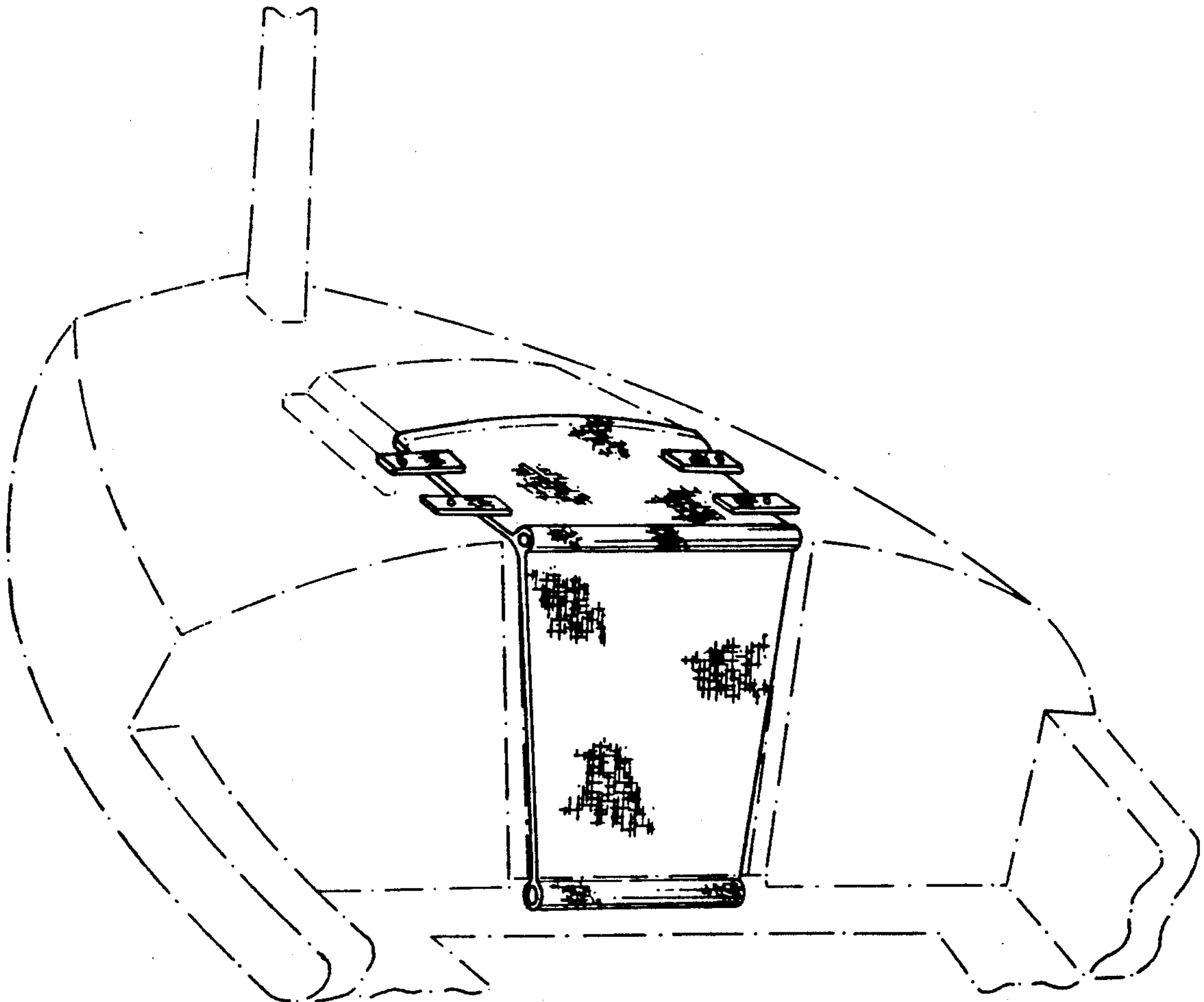

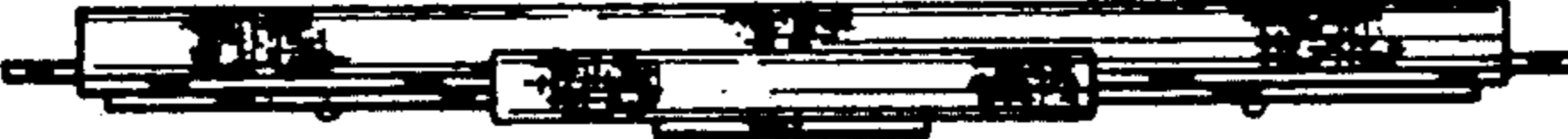
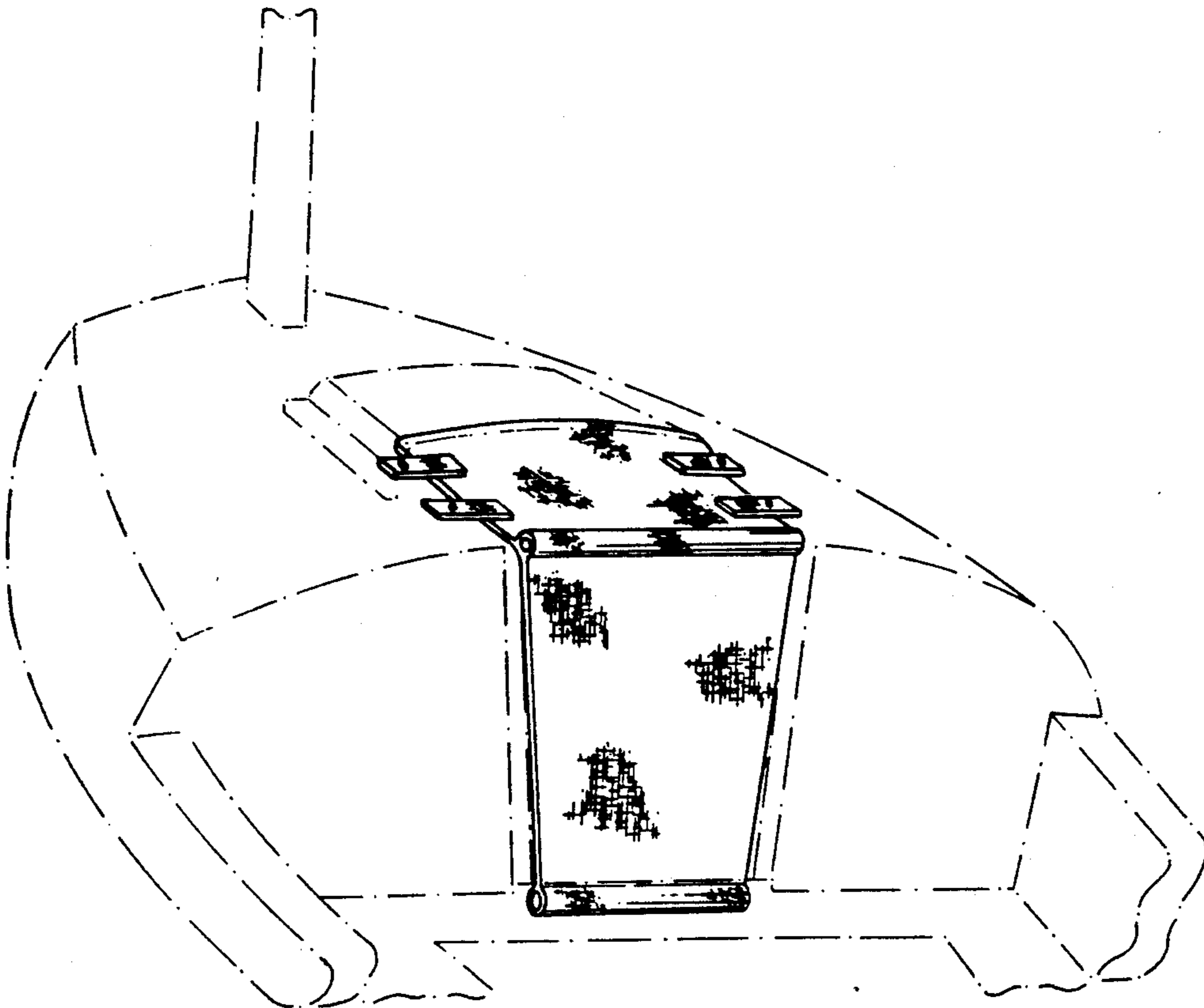
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.





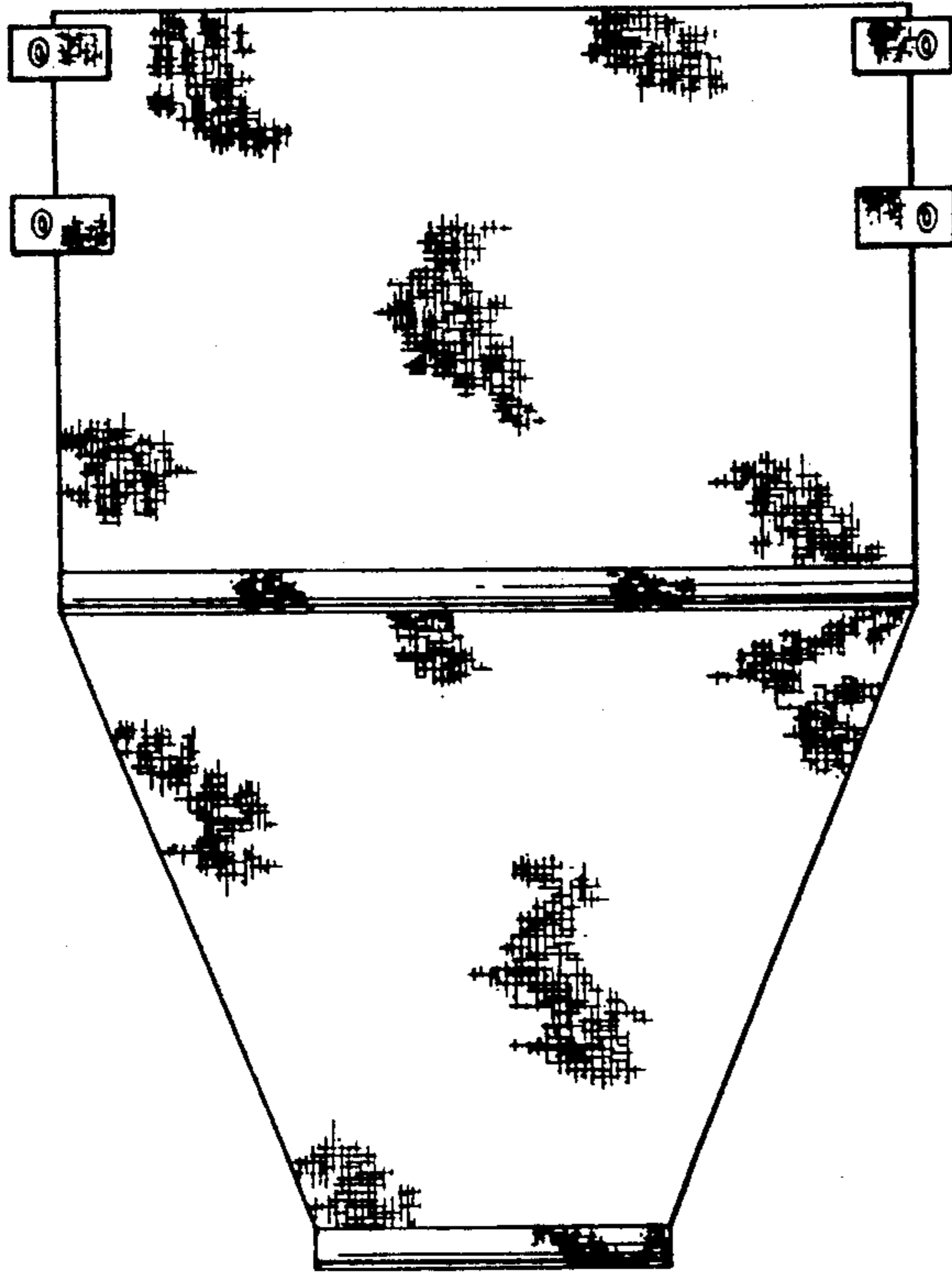
