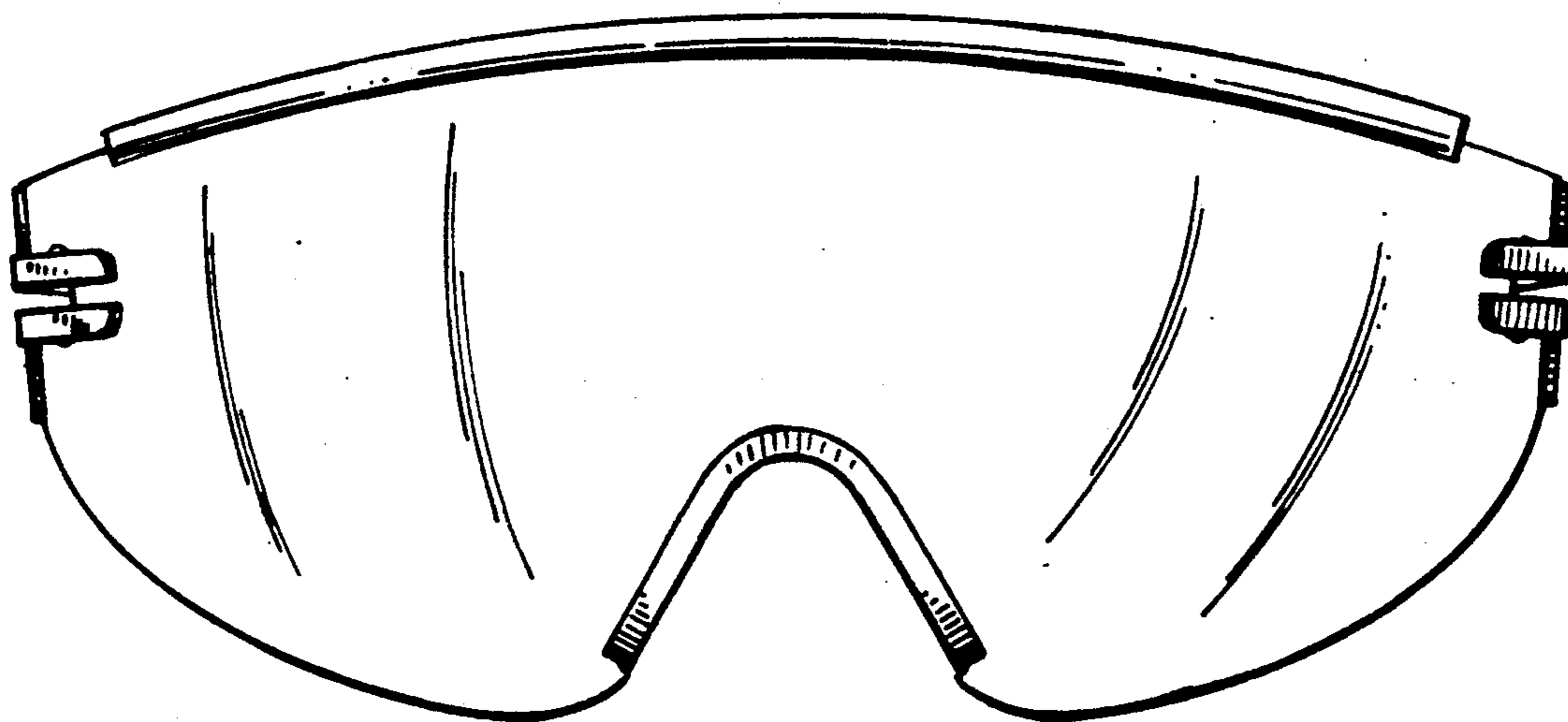
[57] CLAIM

The right side view is not shown as it is a mirror image of the illustrated left side.



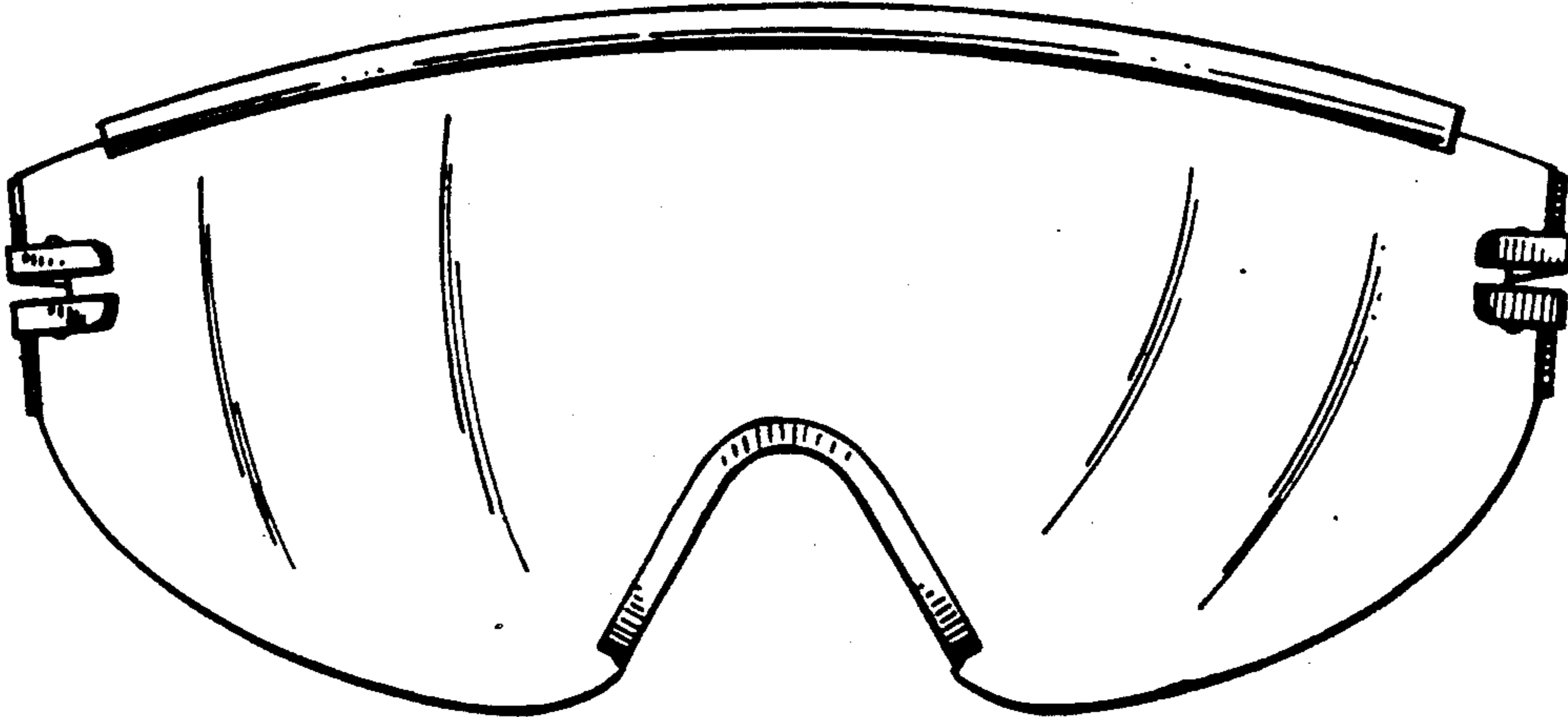

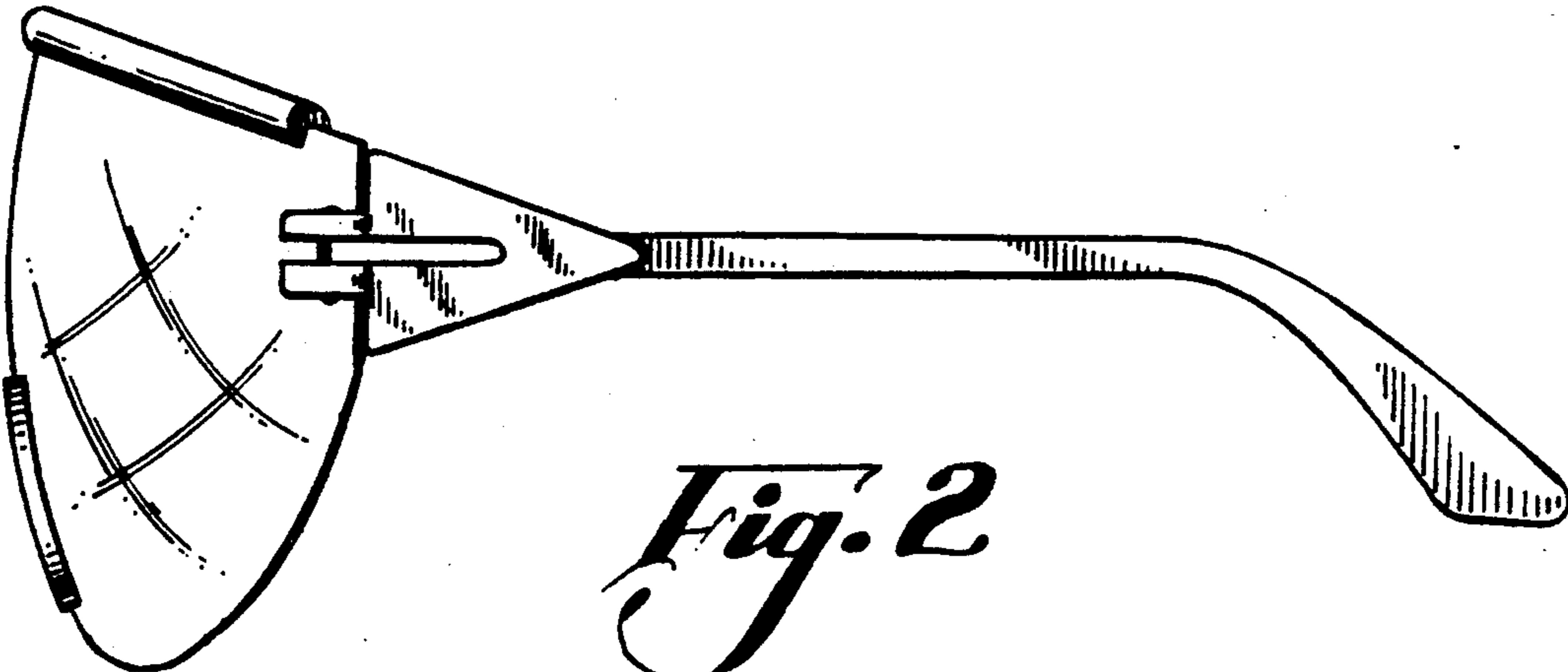

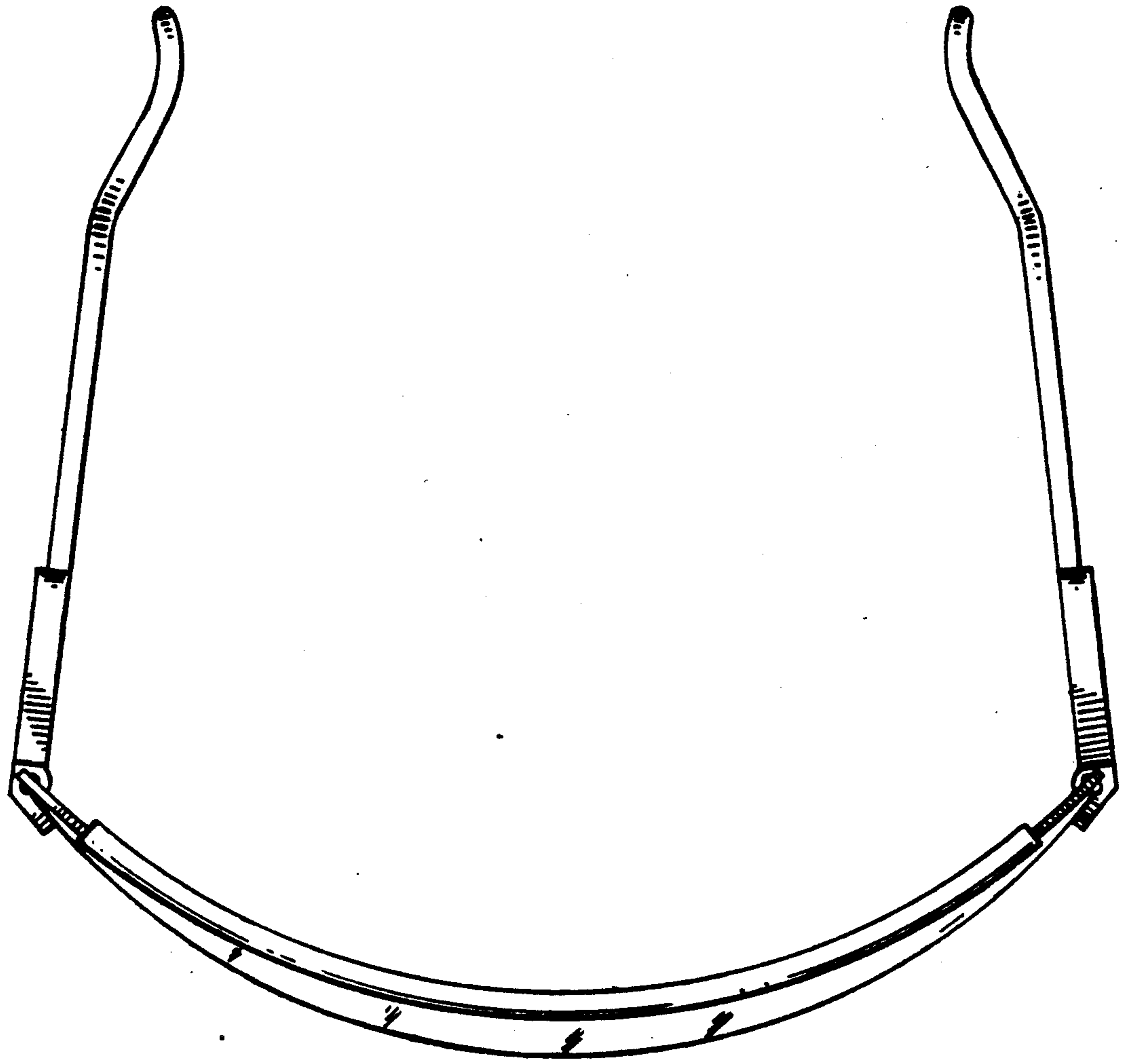

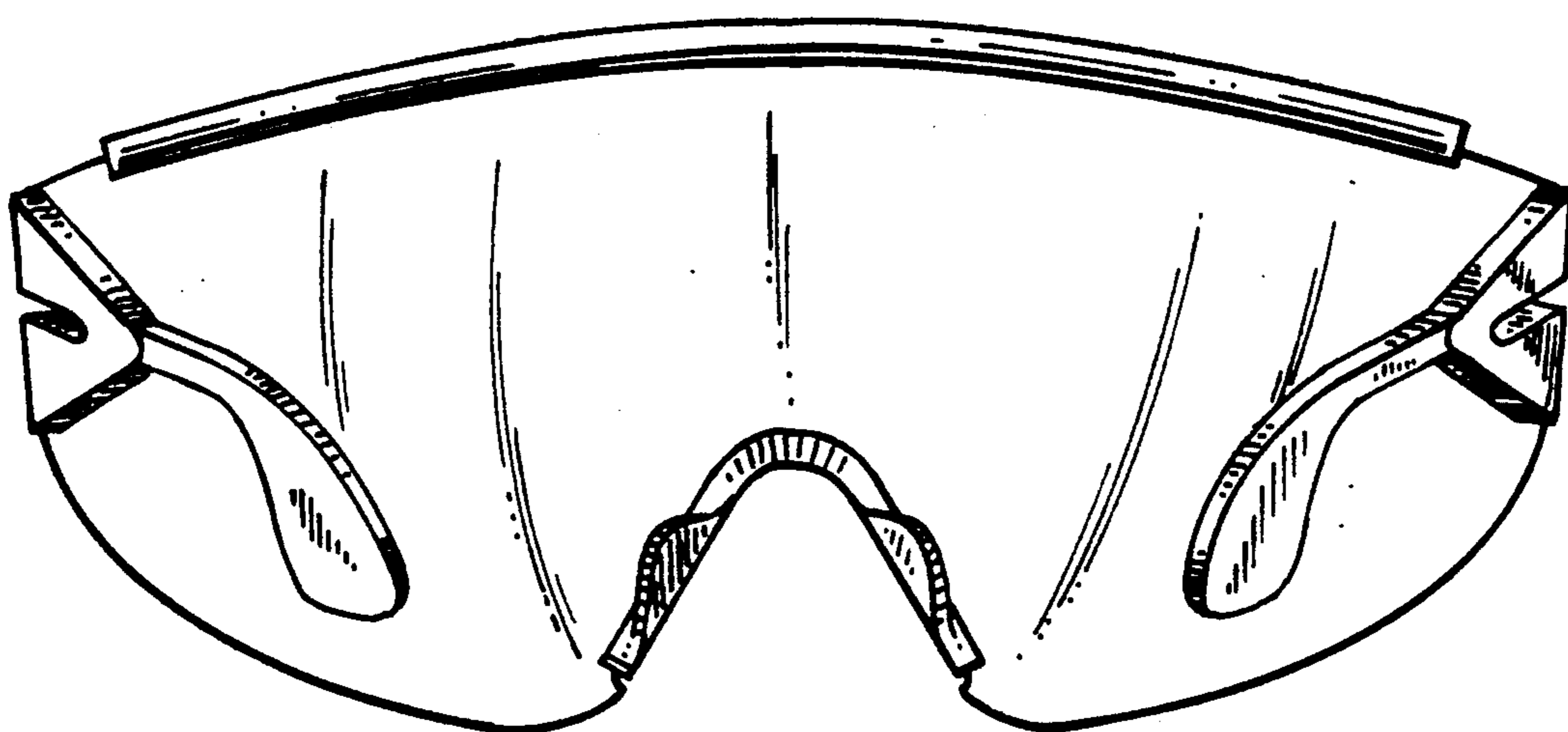
