FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view;

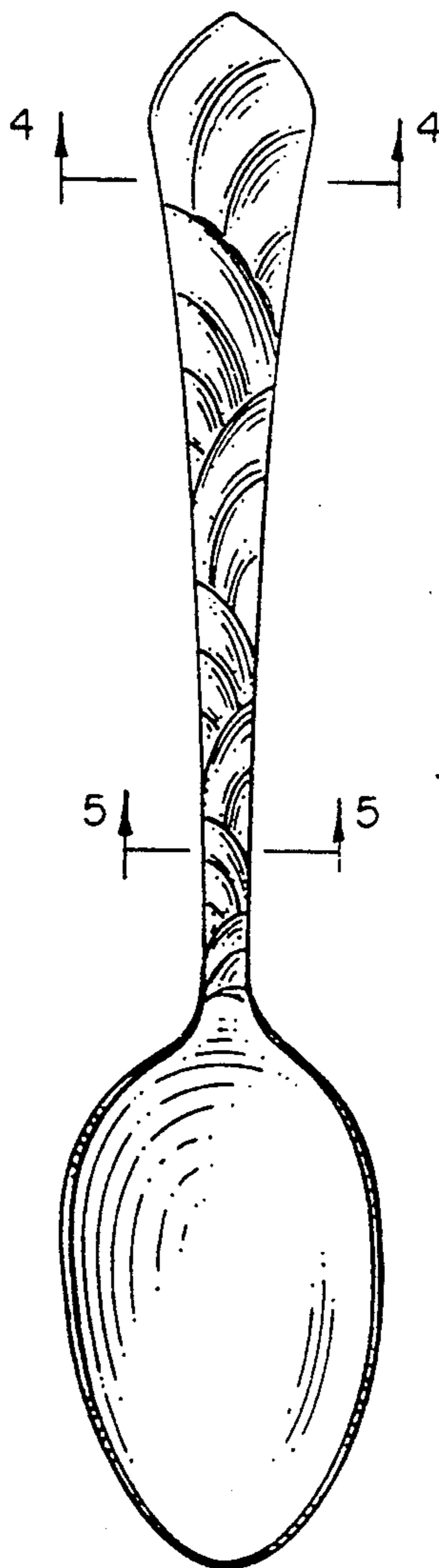
FIG. 4 is a cross section taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and,

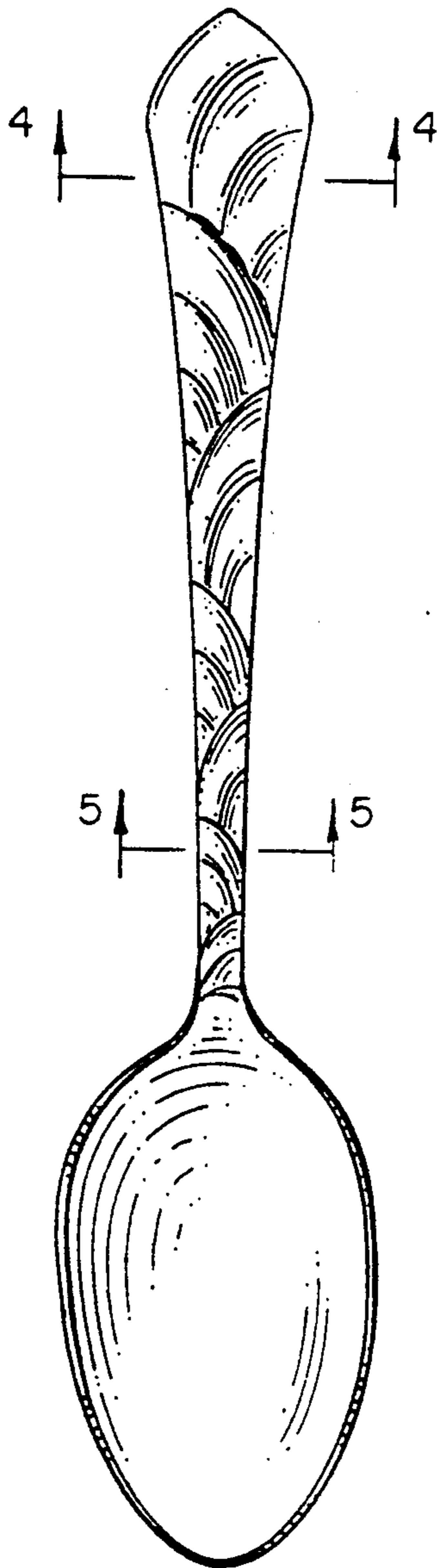

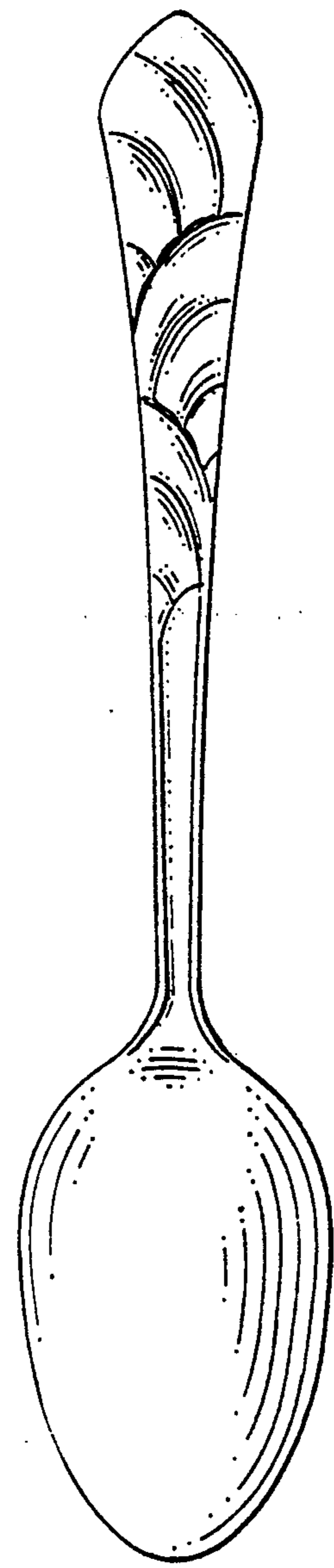
