FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, with the bottom being a mirror image.

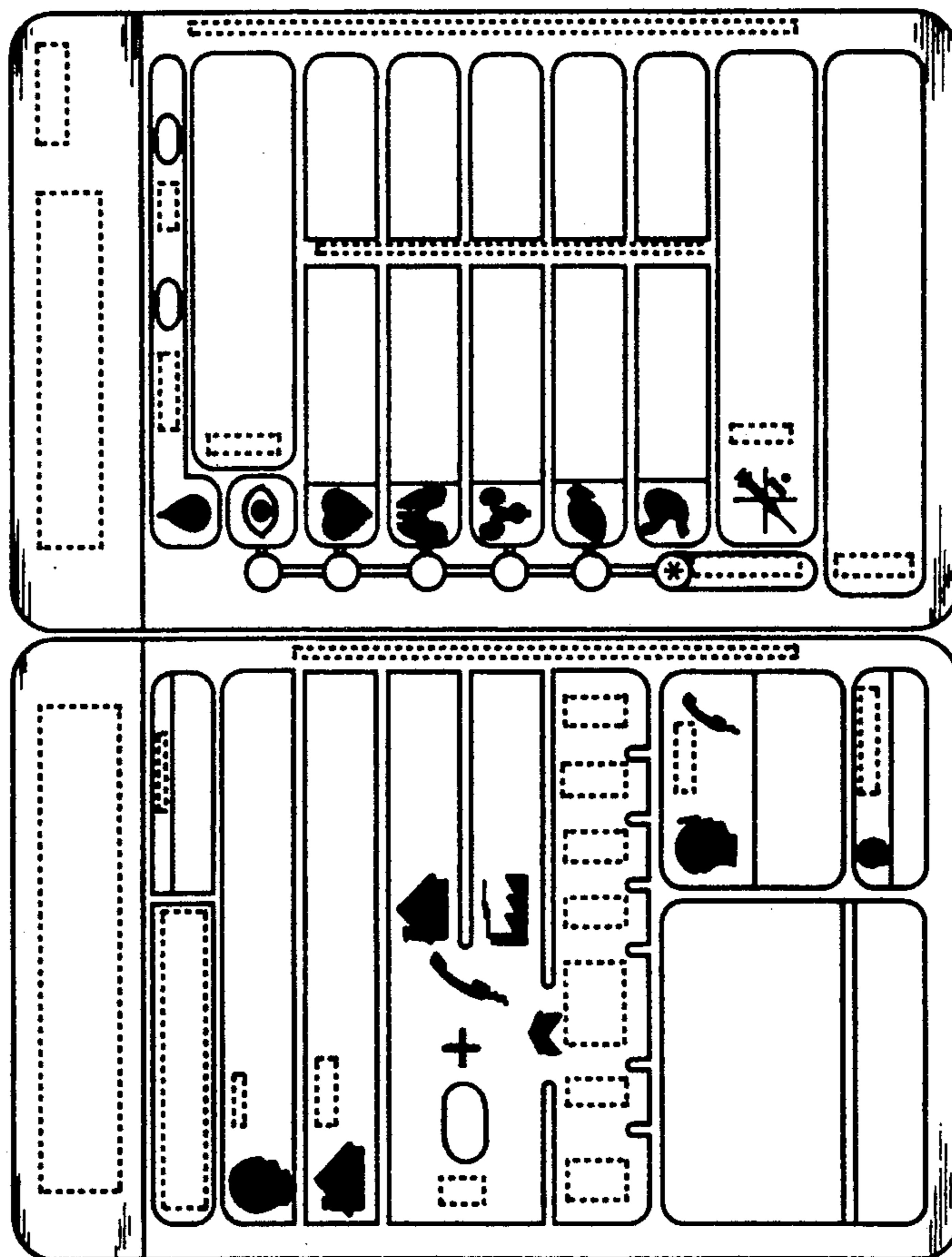

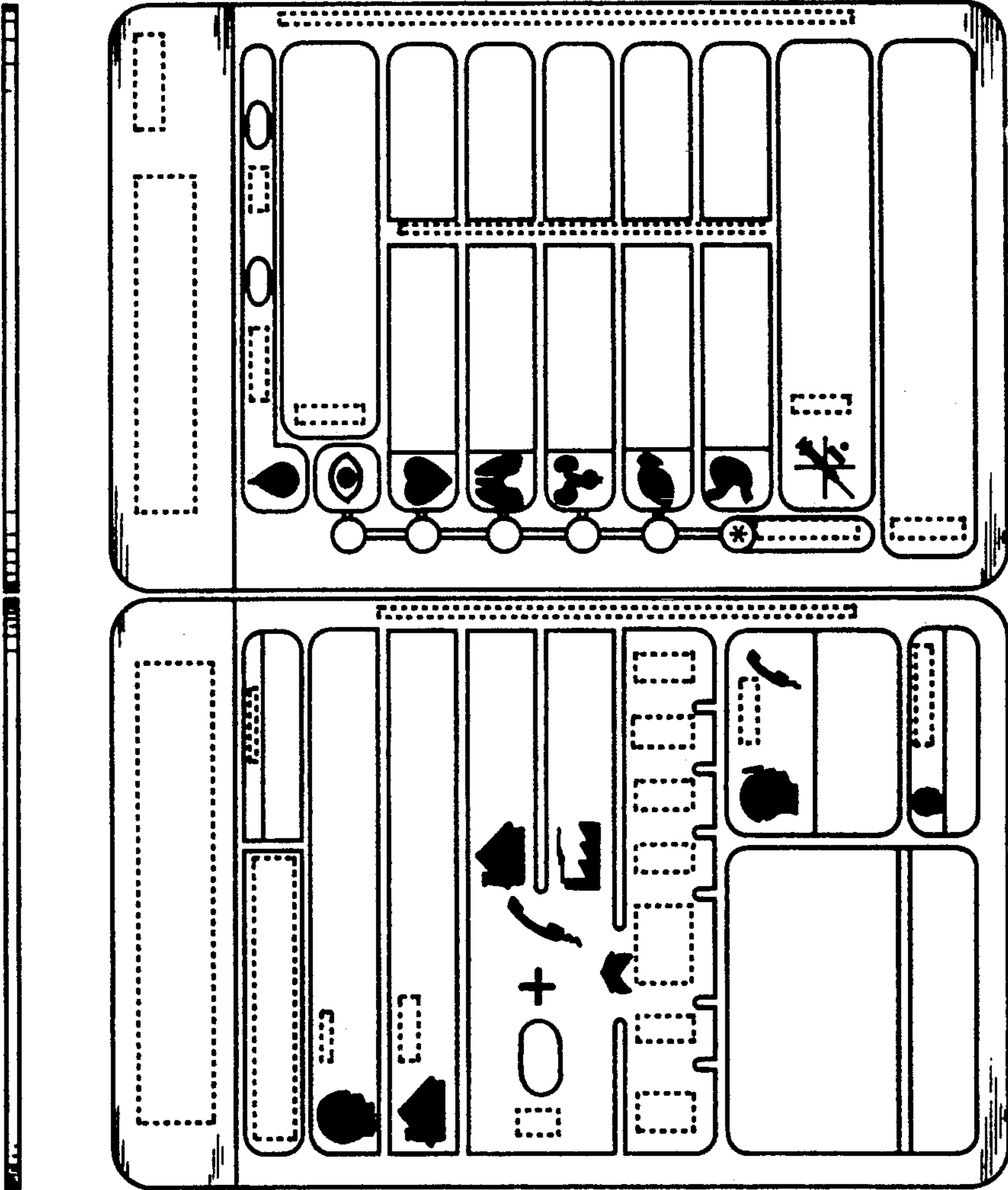
