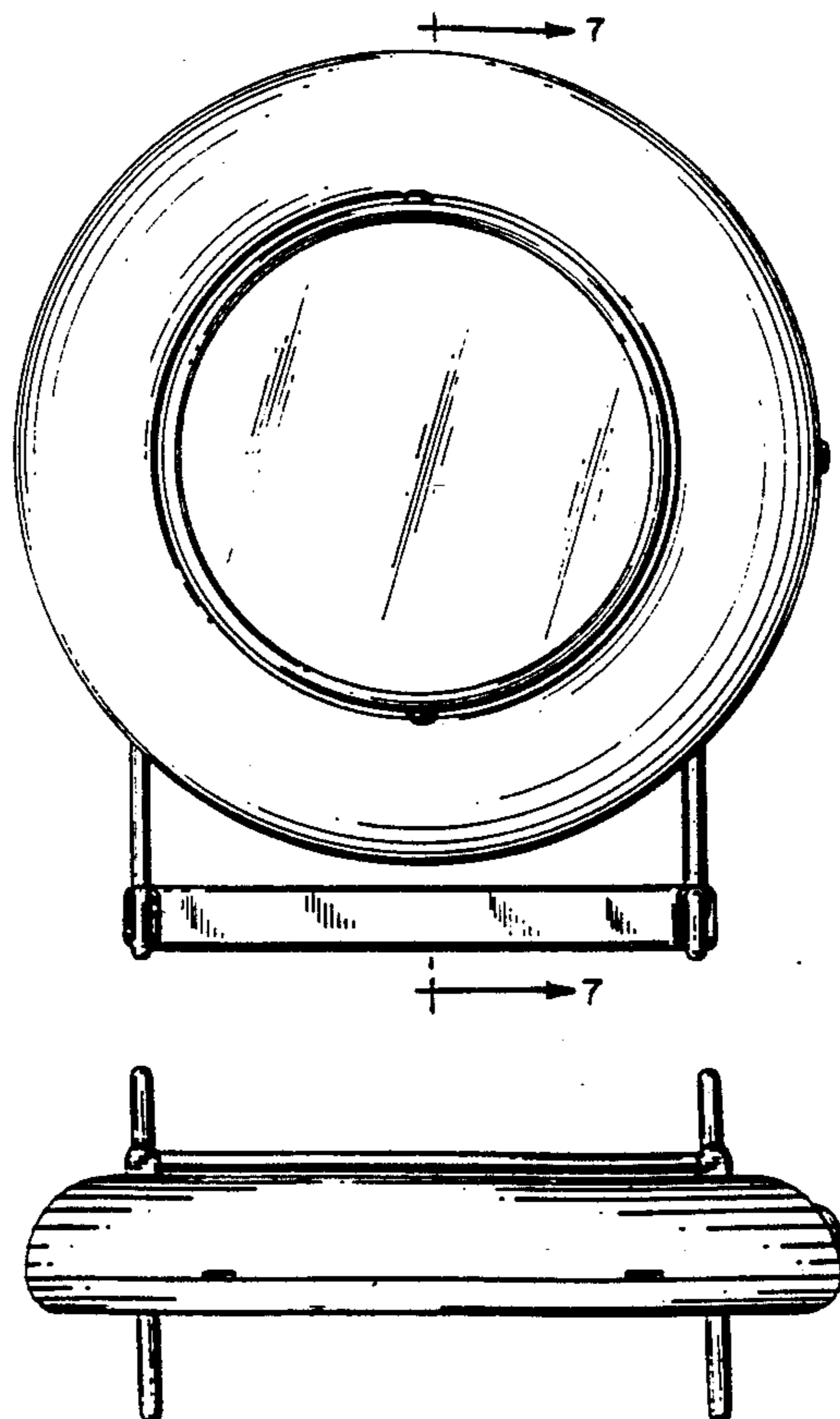

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a make-up mirror showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing the cord in FIG. 5 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



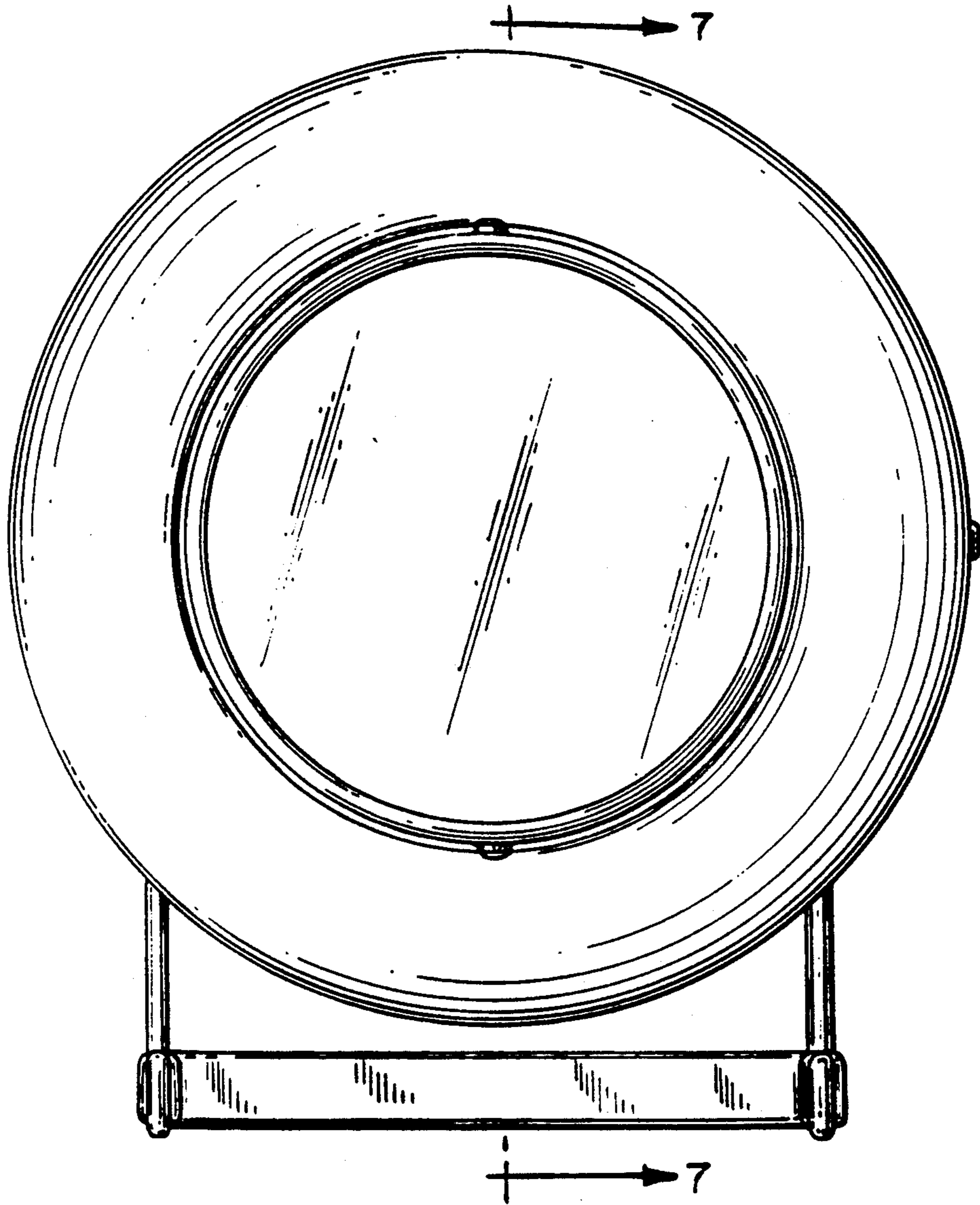

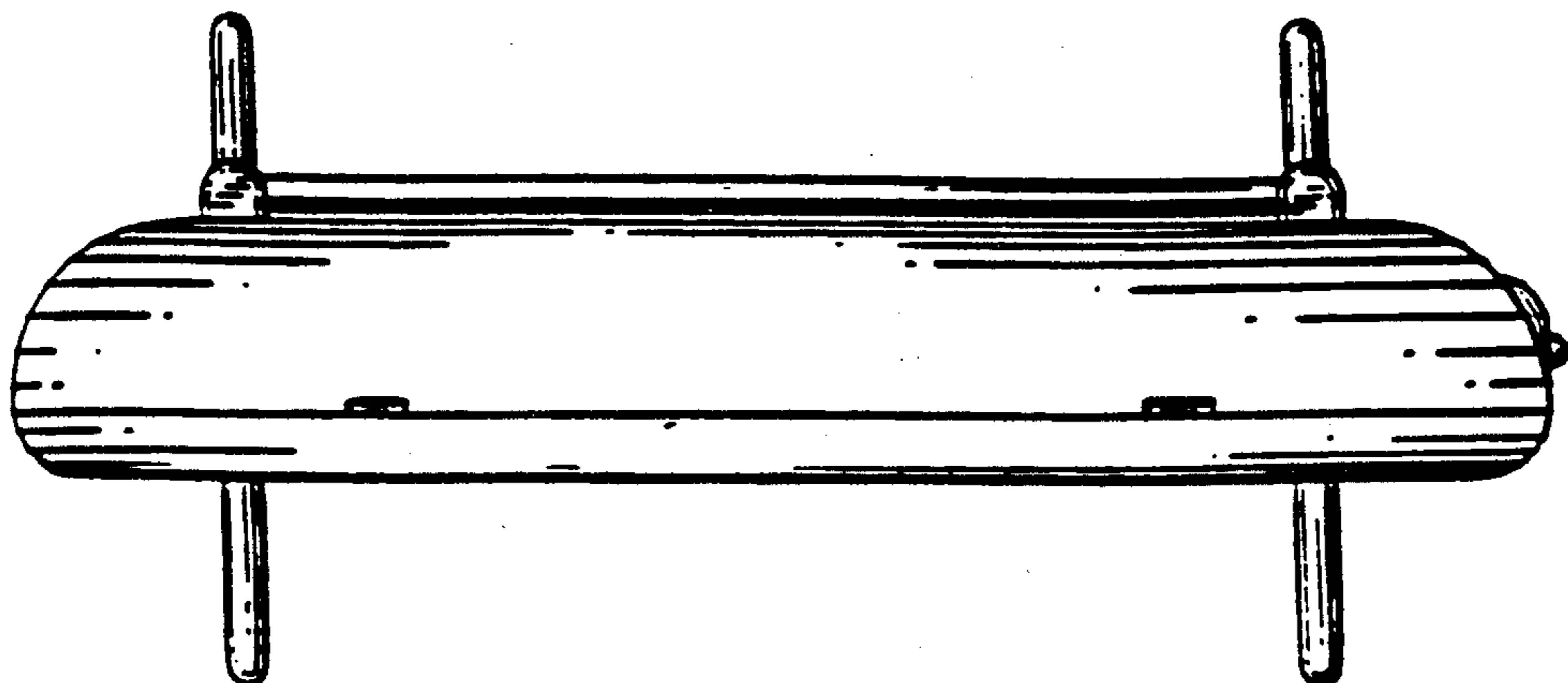

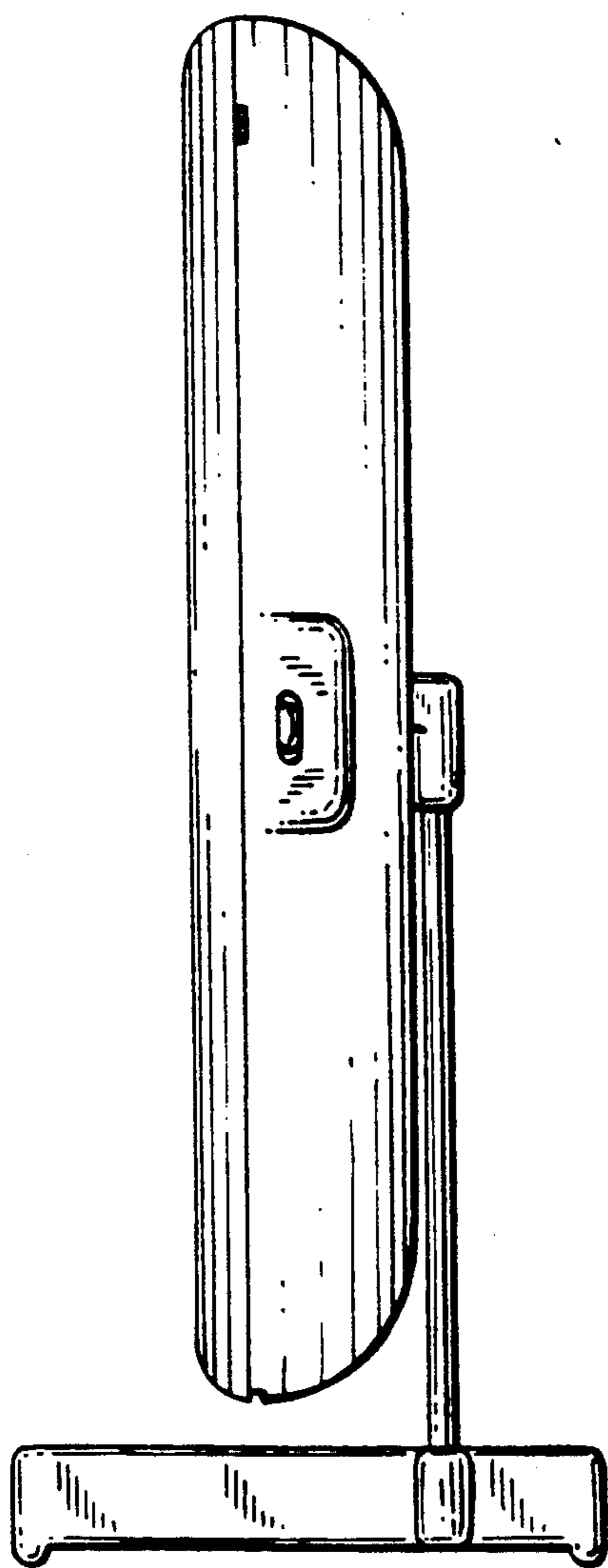

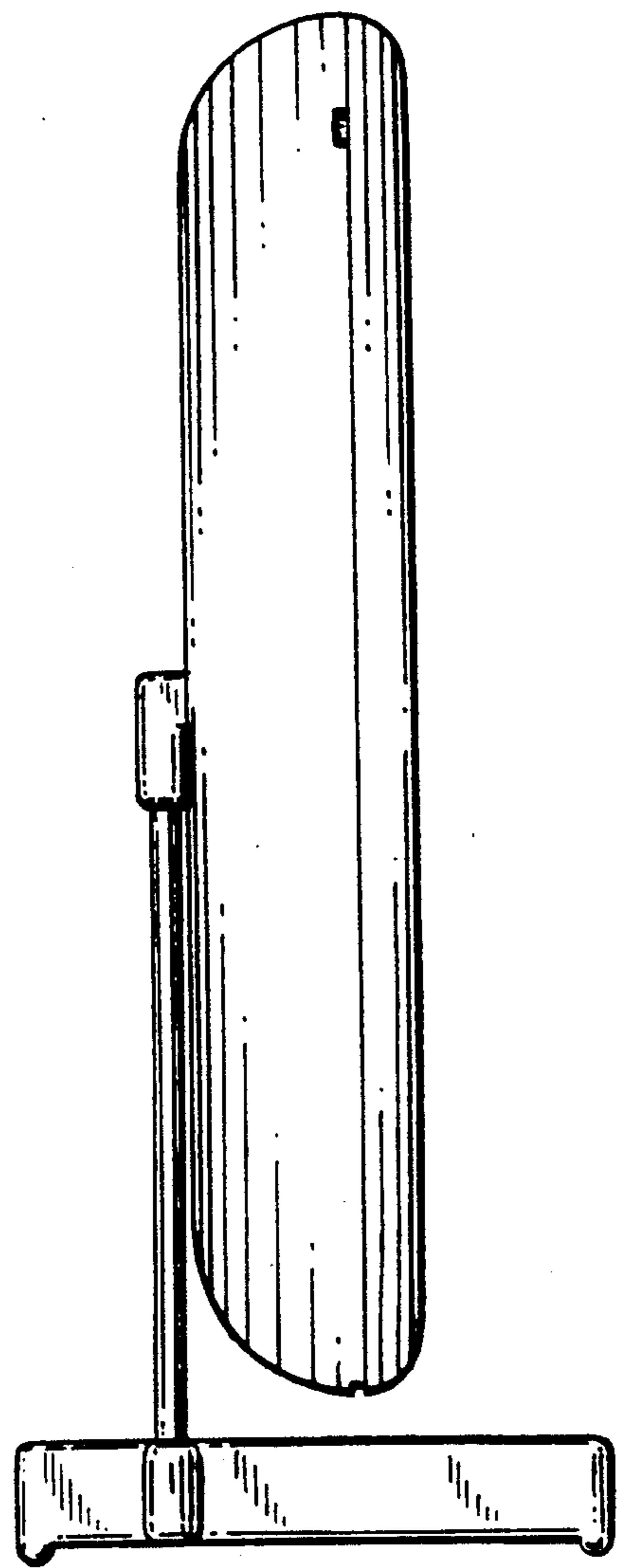

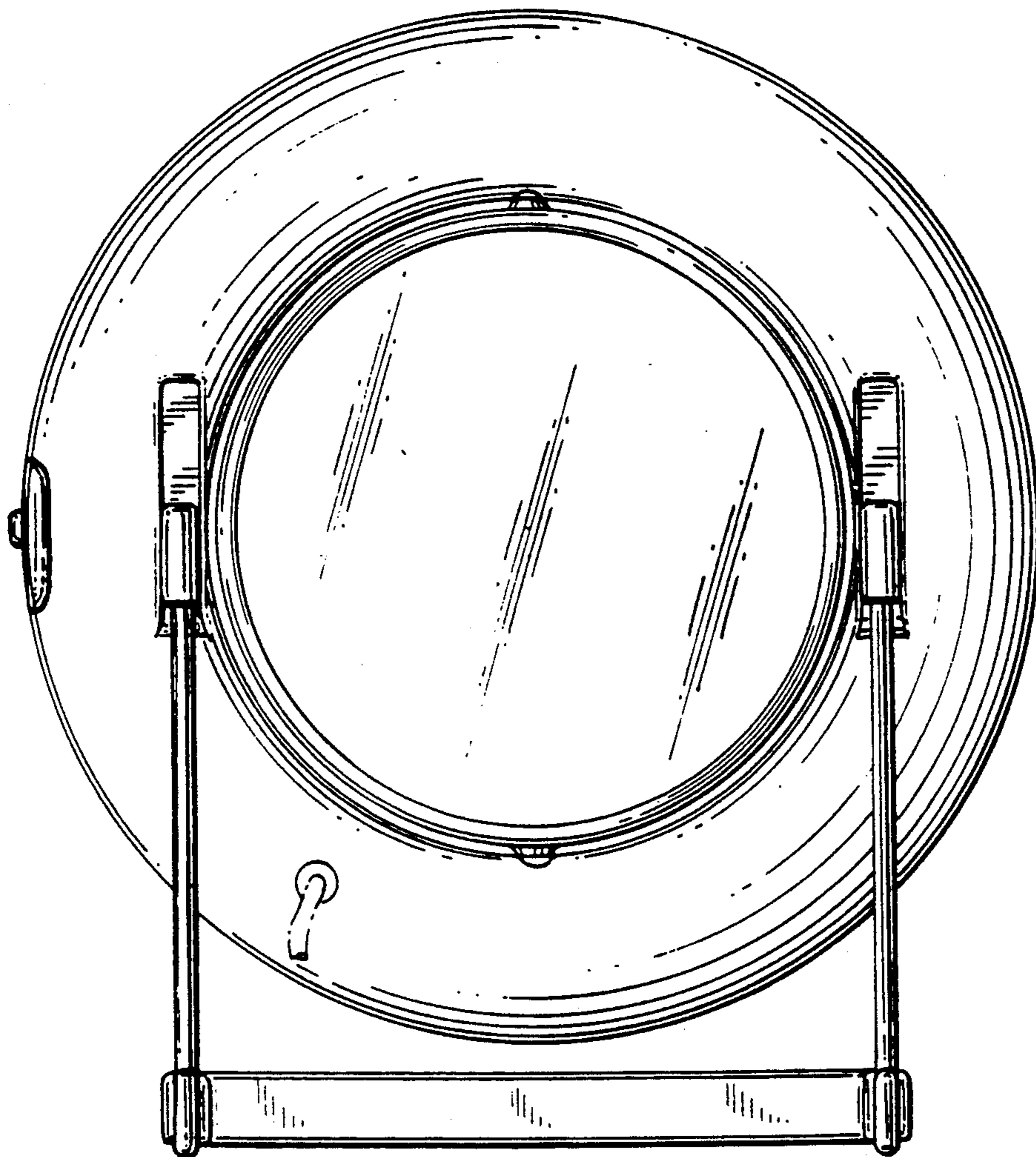

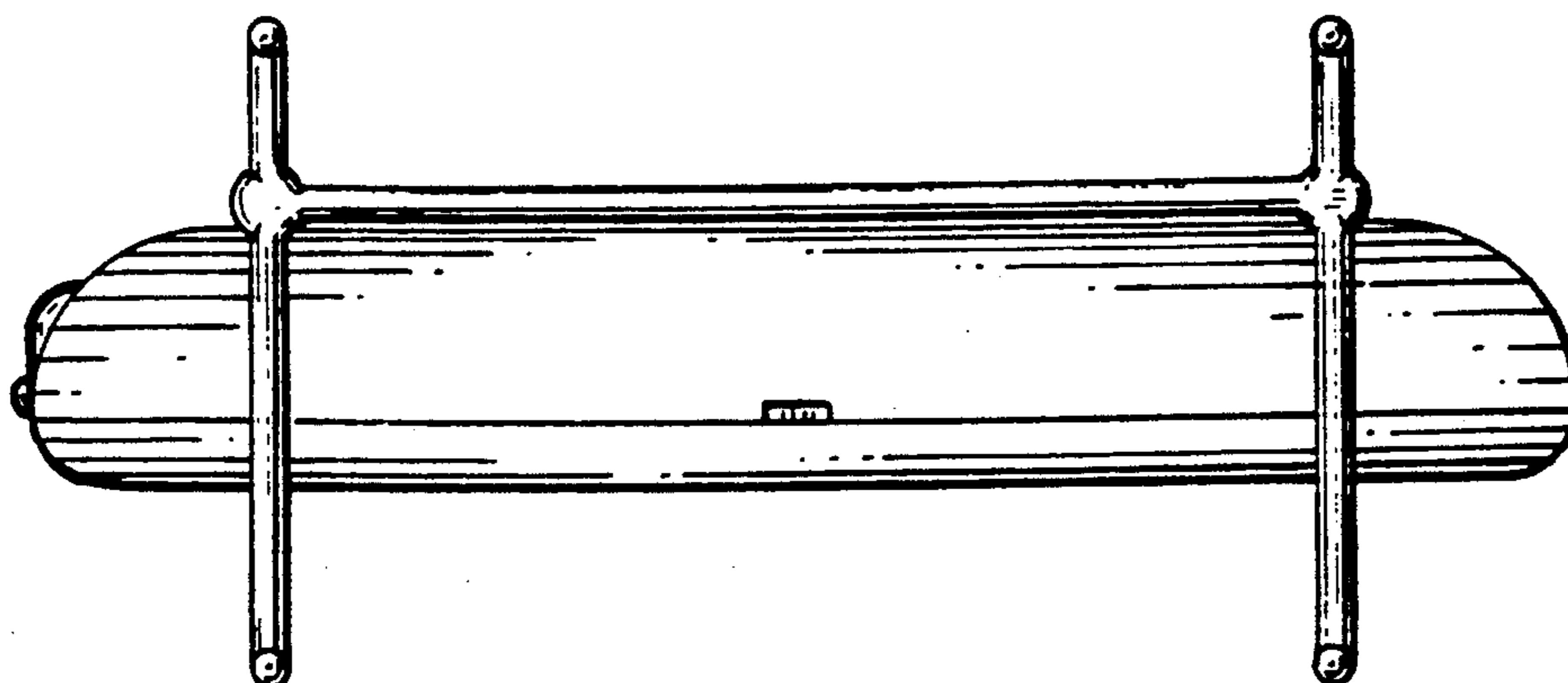

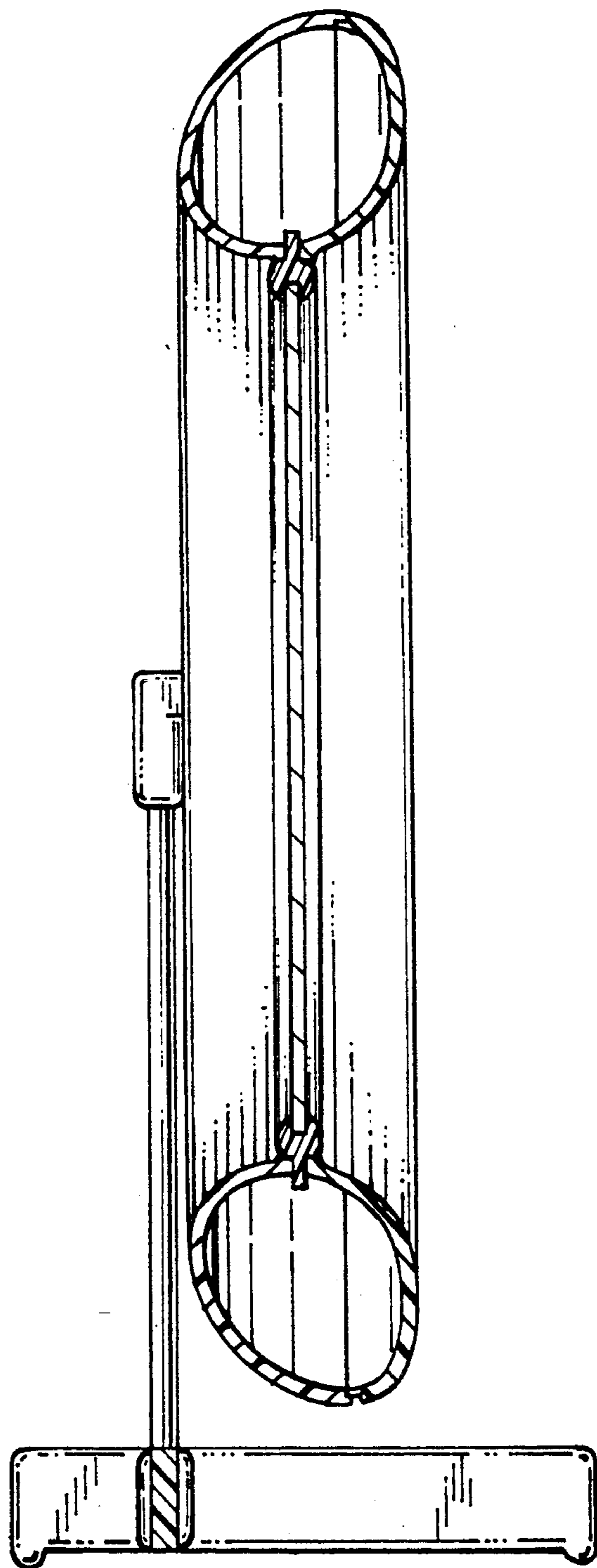
