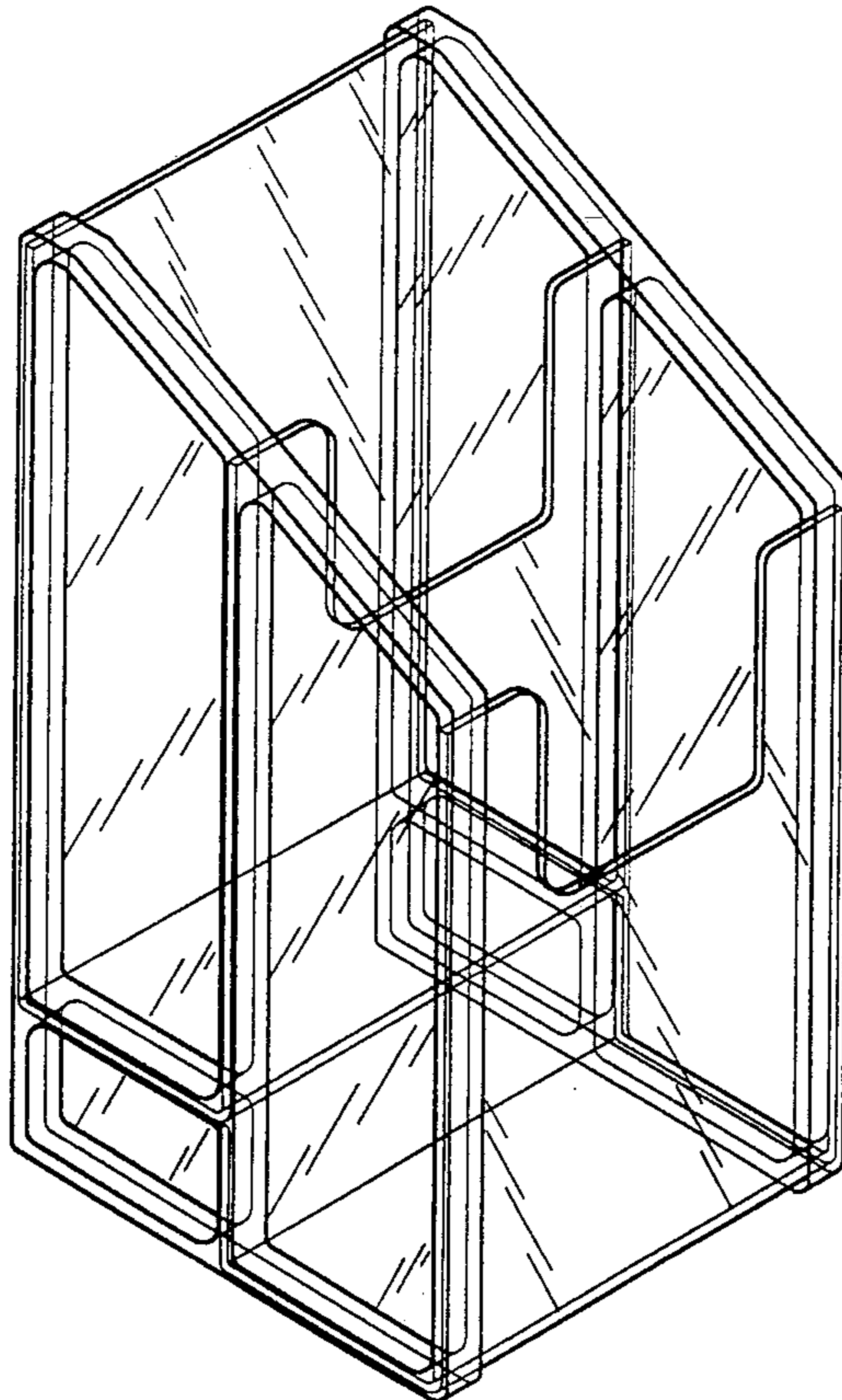
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIGS. 4-6 have been shown on a reduced scale with respect to FIG. 1.



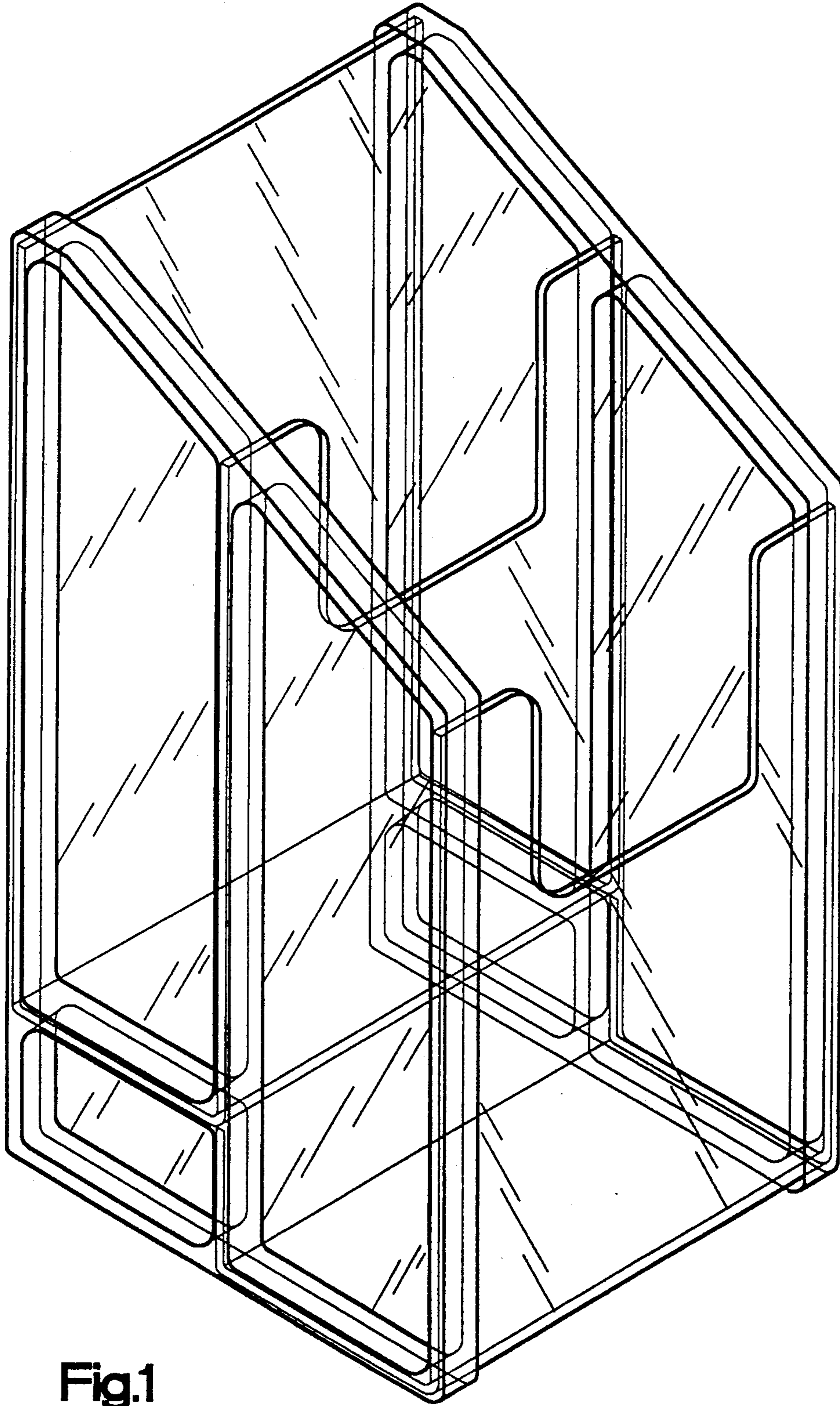

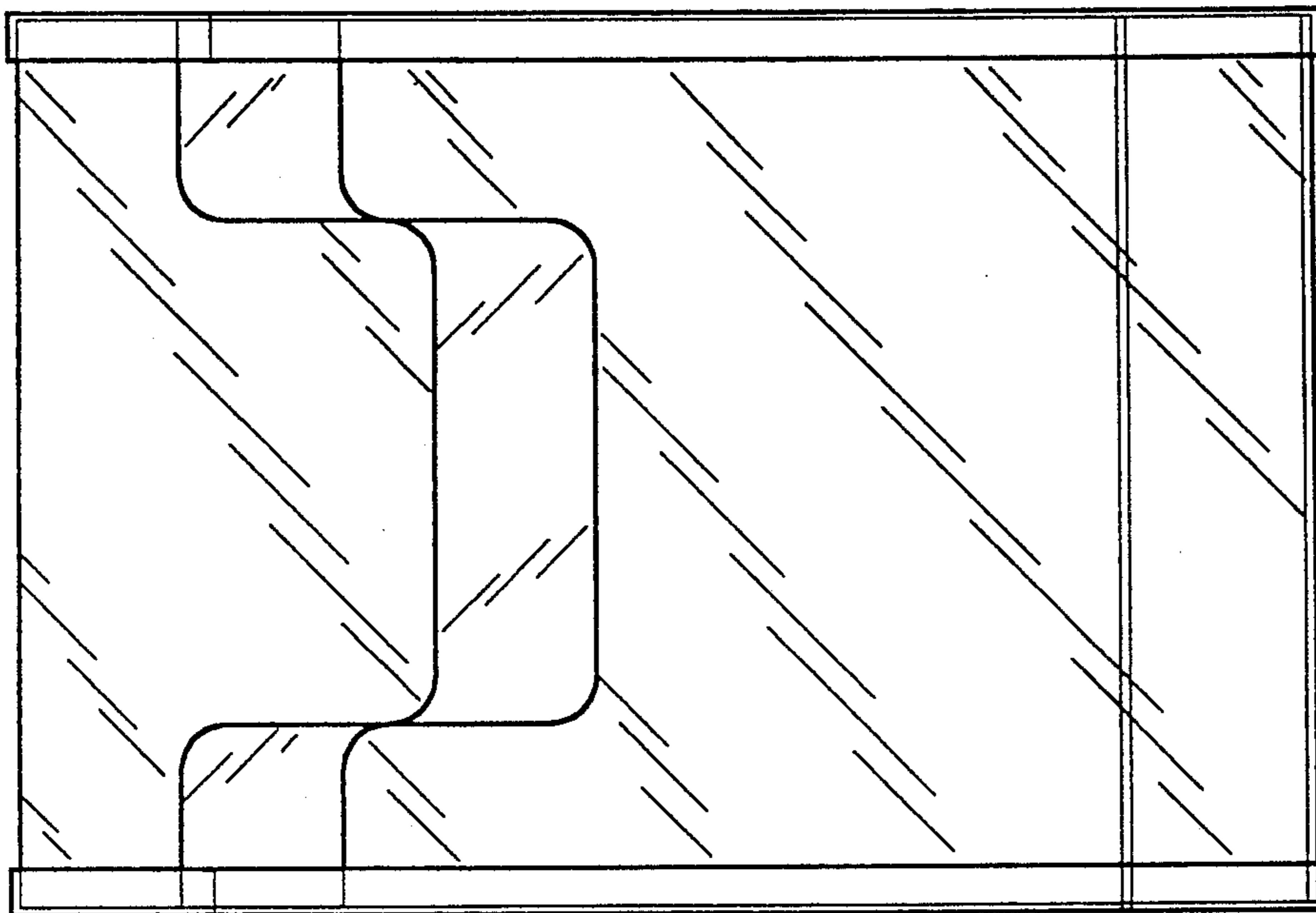

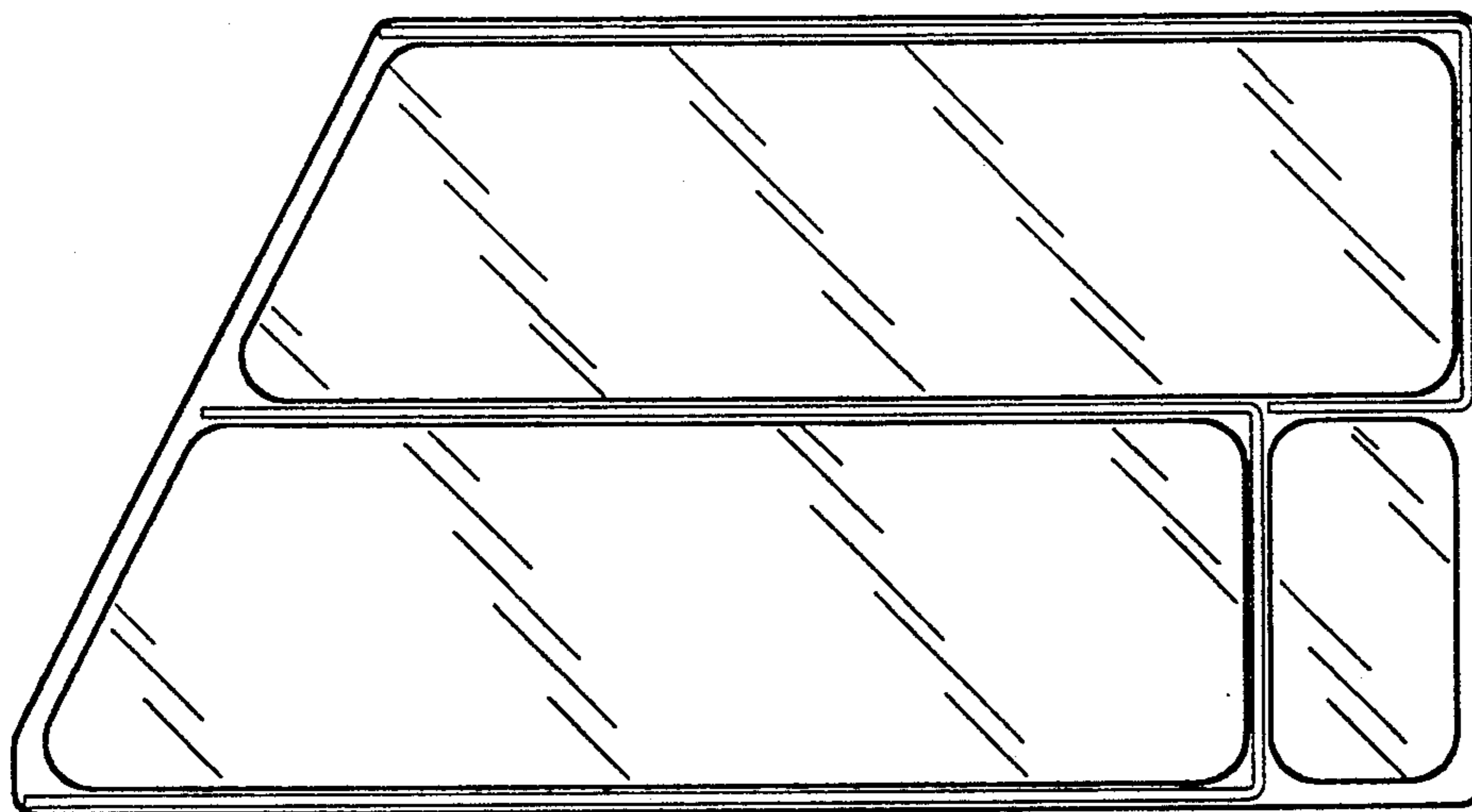

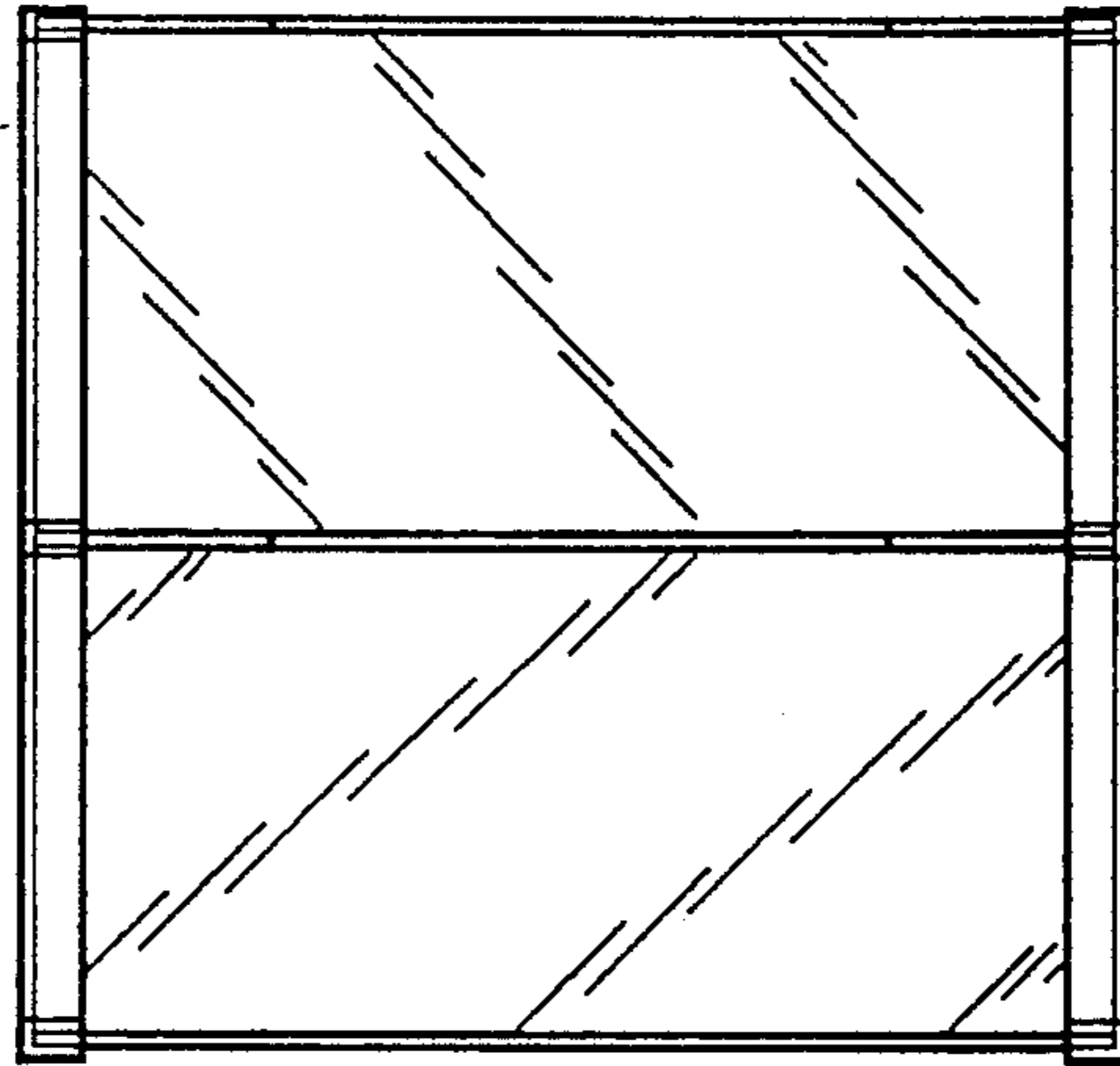

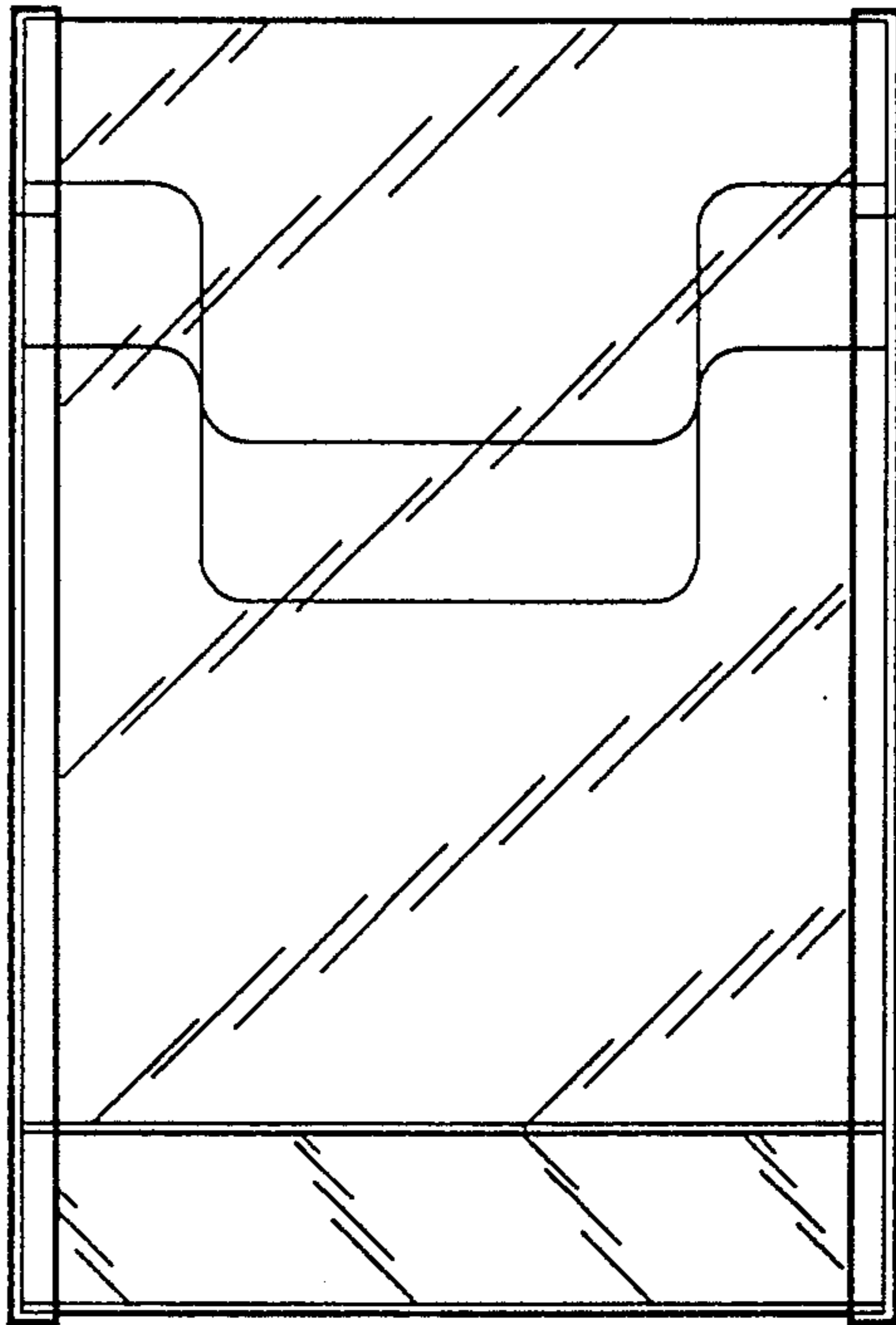
