FIG. 4 is an enlarged partial perspective view.

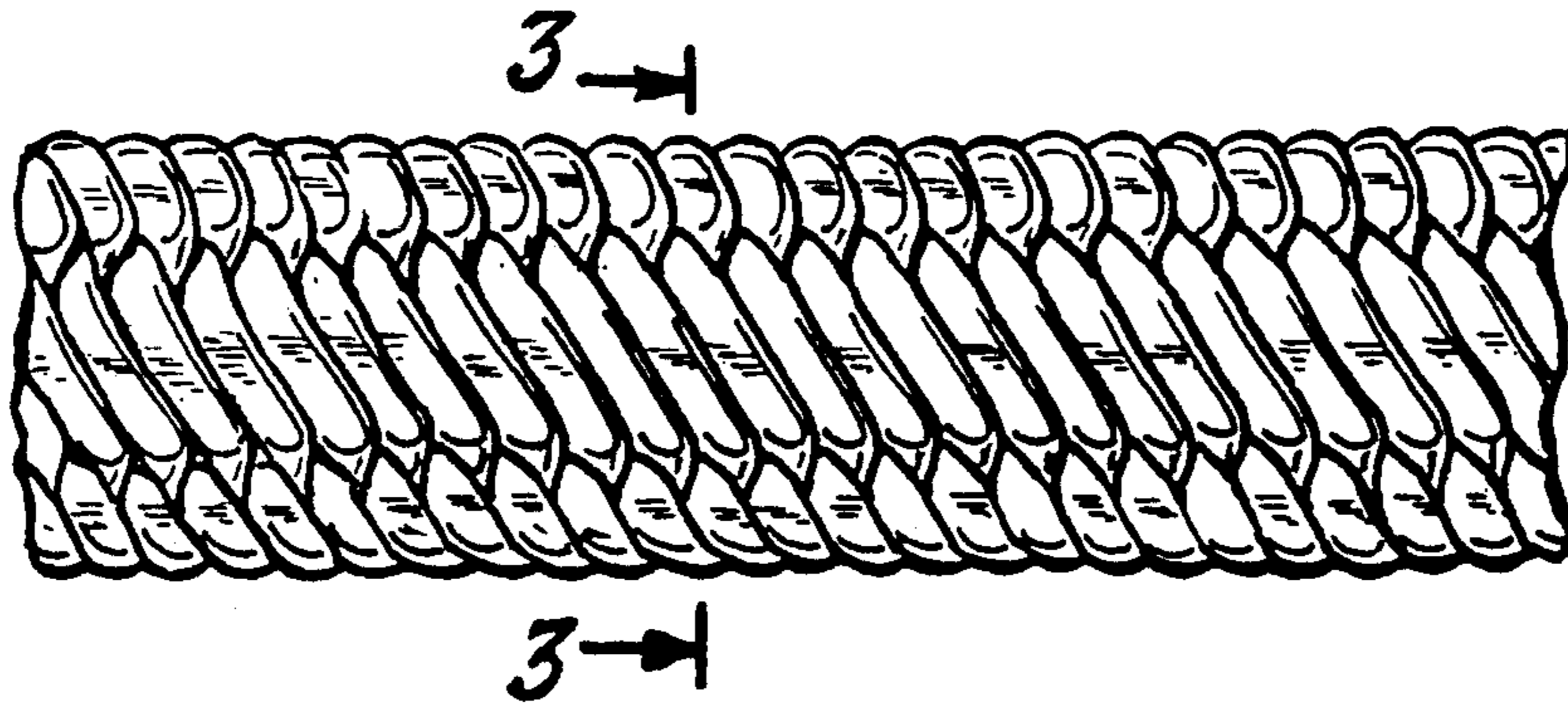

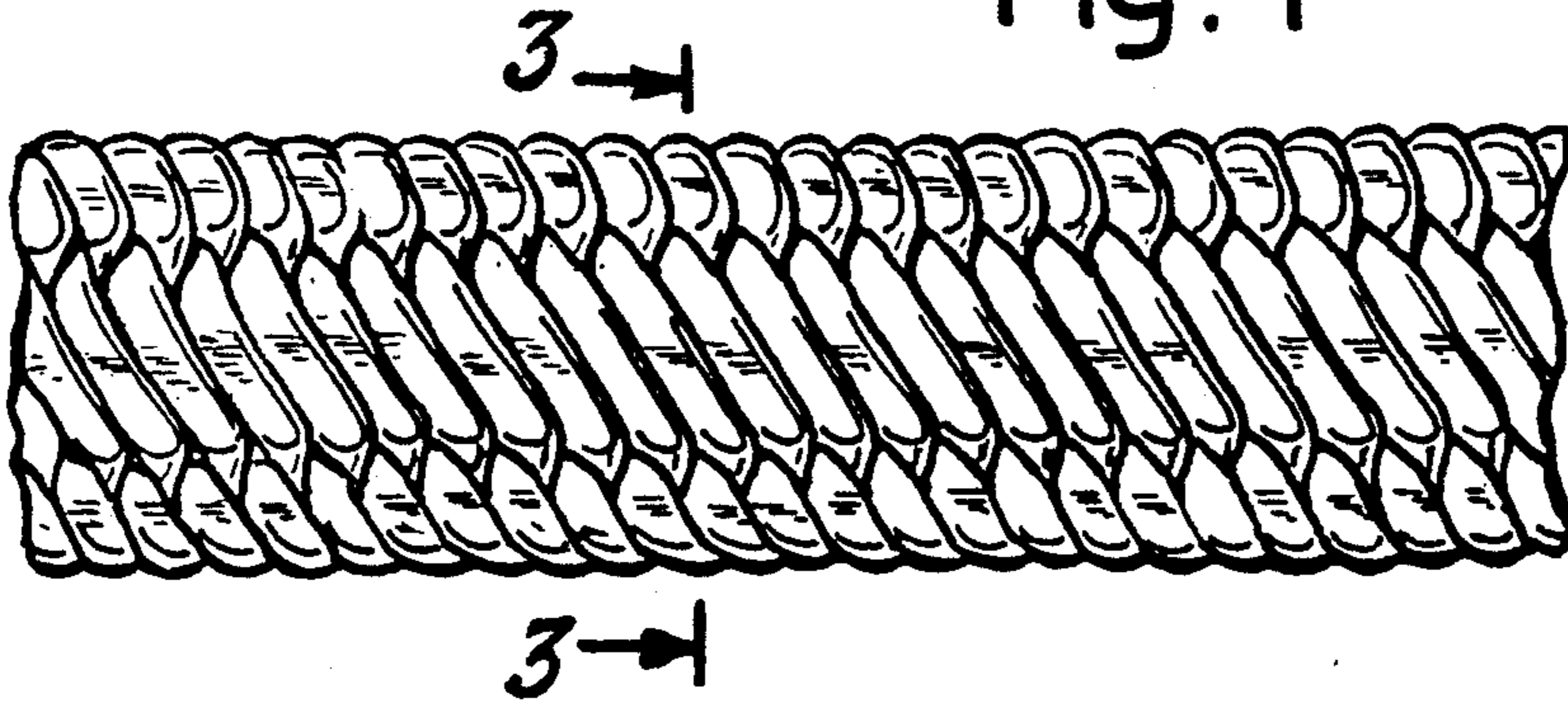
