FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a control panel for a combined vehicular radio receiver, cassette player and digital clock showing our new design;


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and,


FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.


