The broken line showing of a cigarette is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

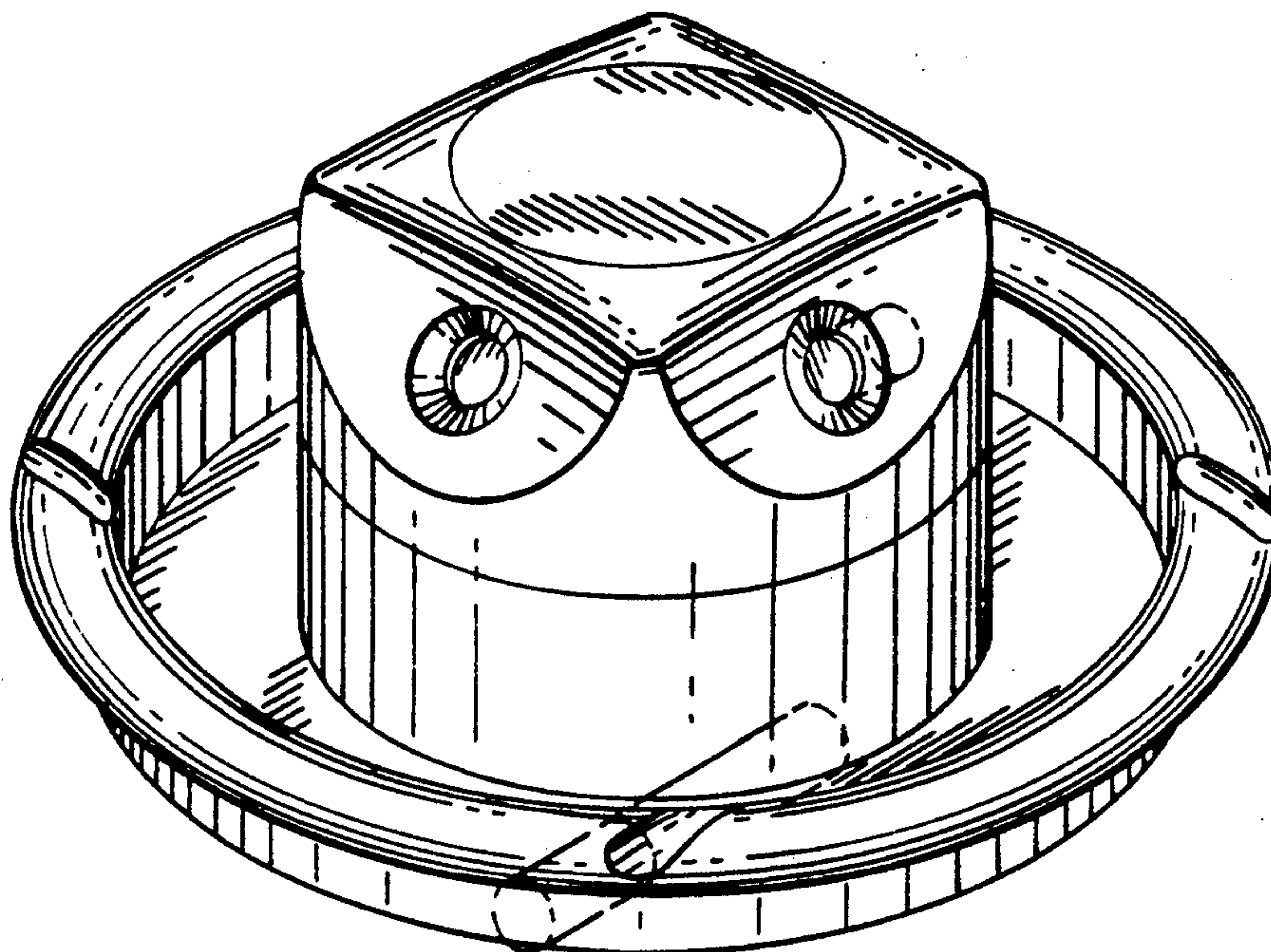

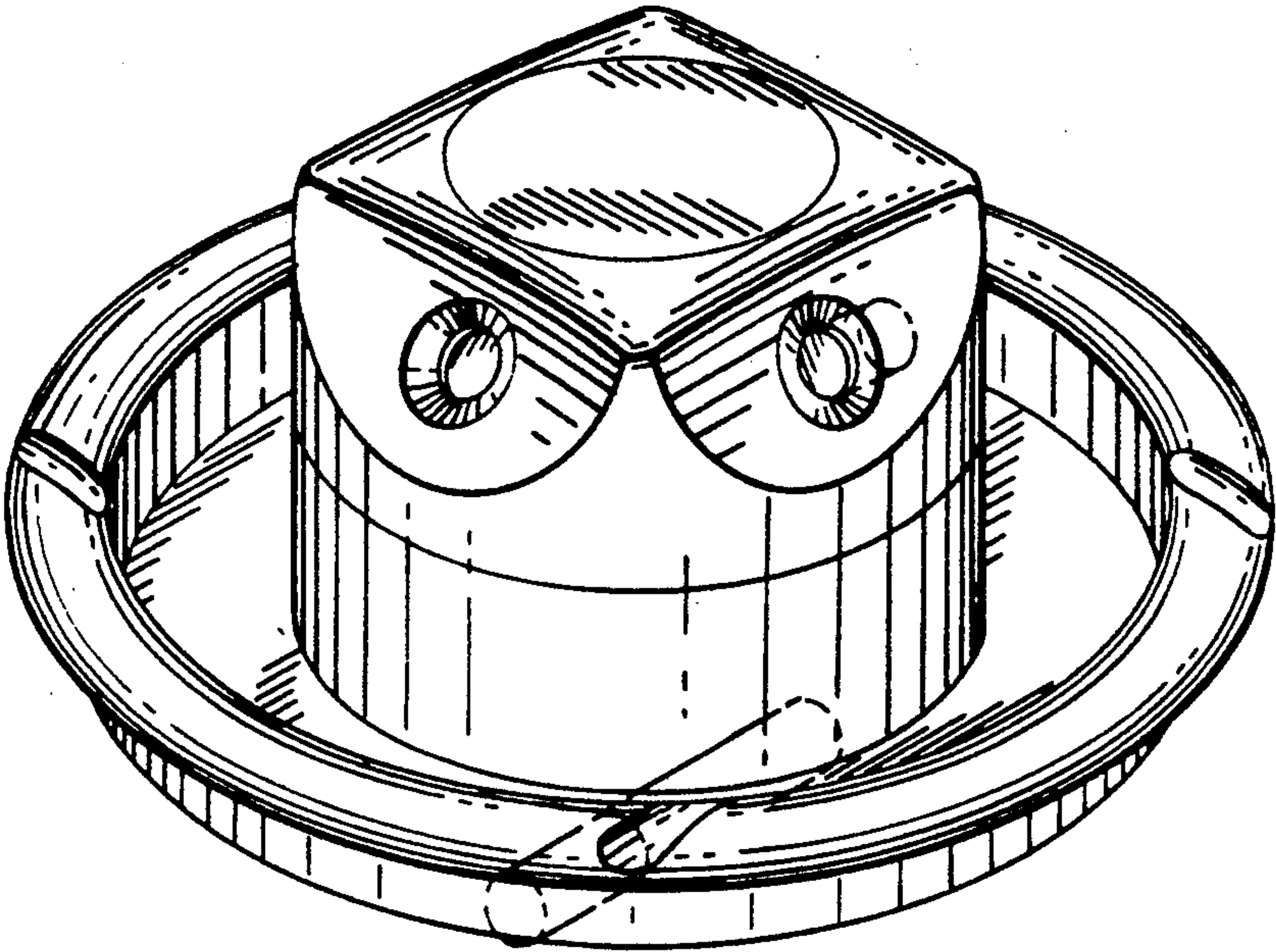

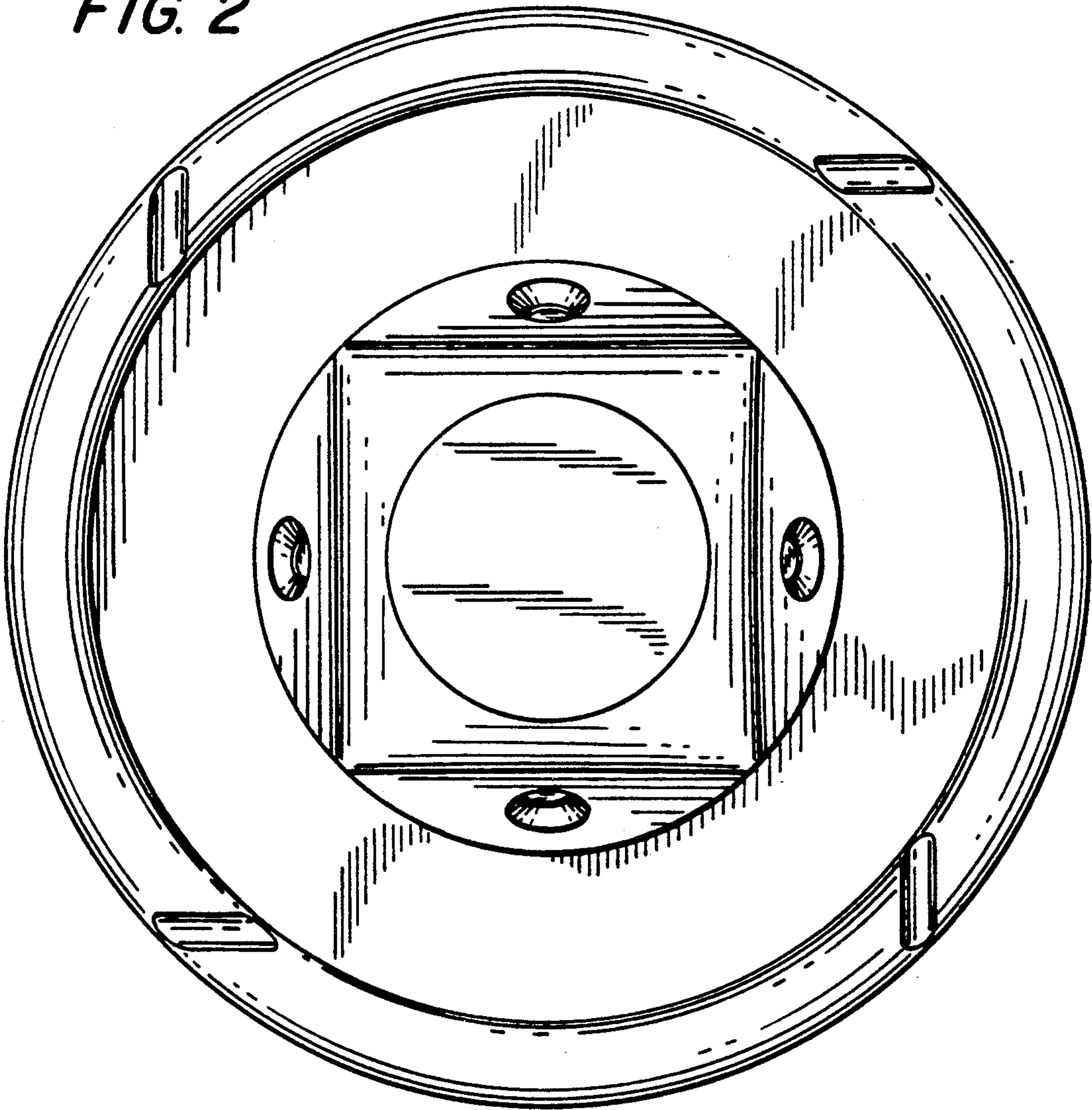

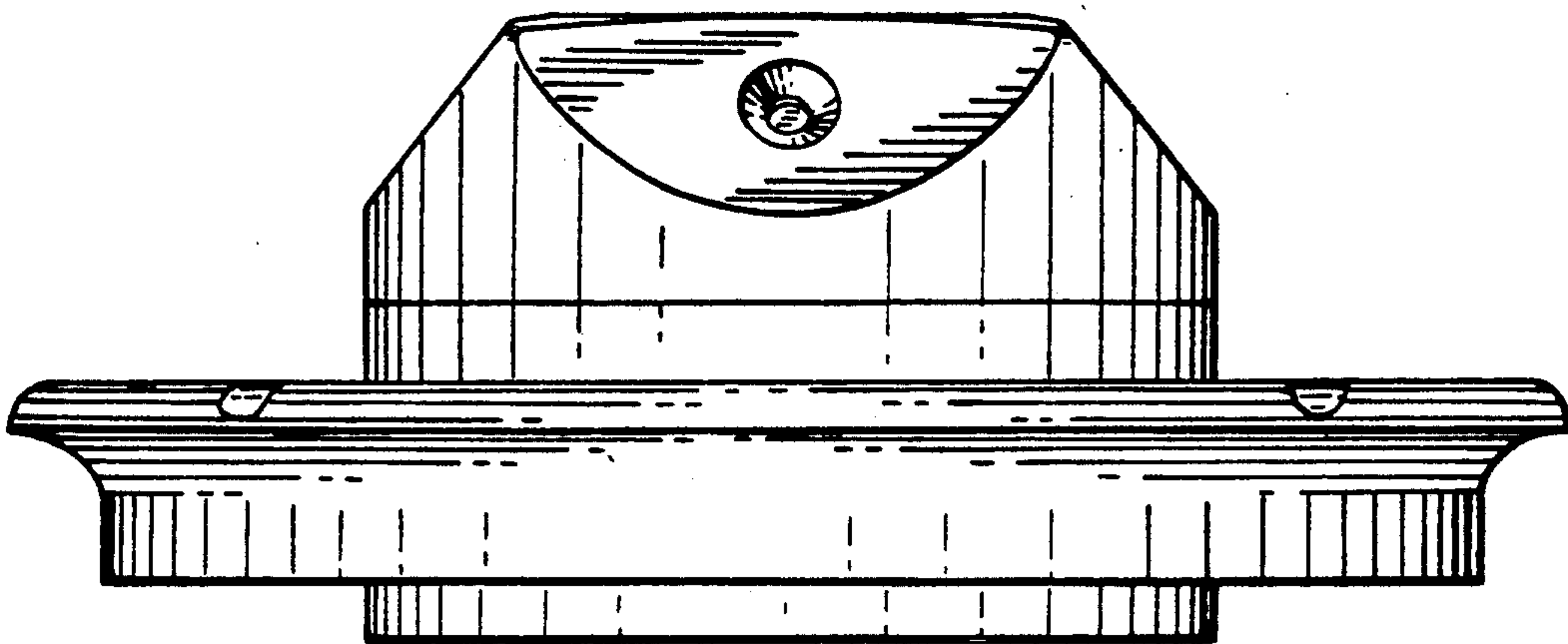
