The cross-hatch shading shown in all views is understood to repeat throughout the indicated areas.

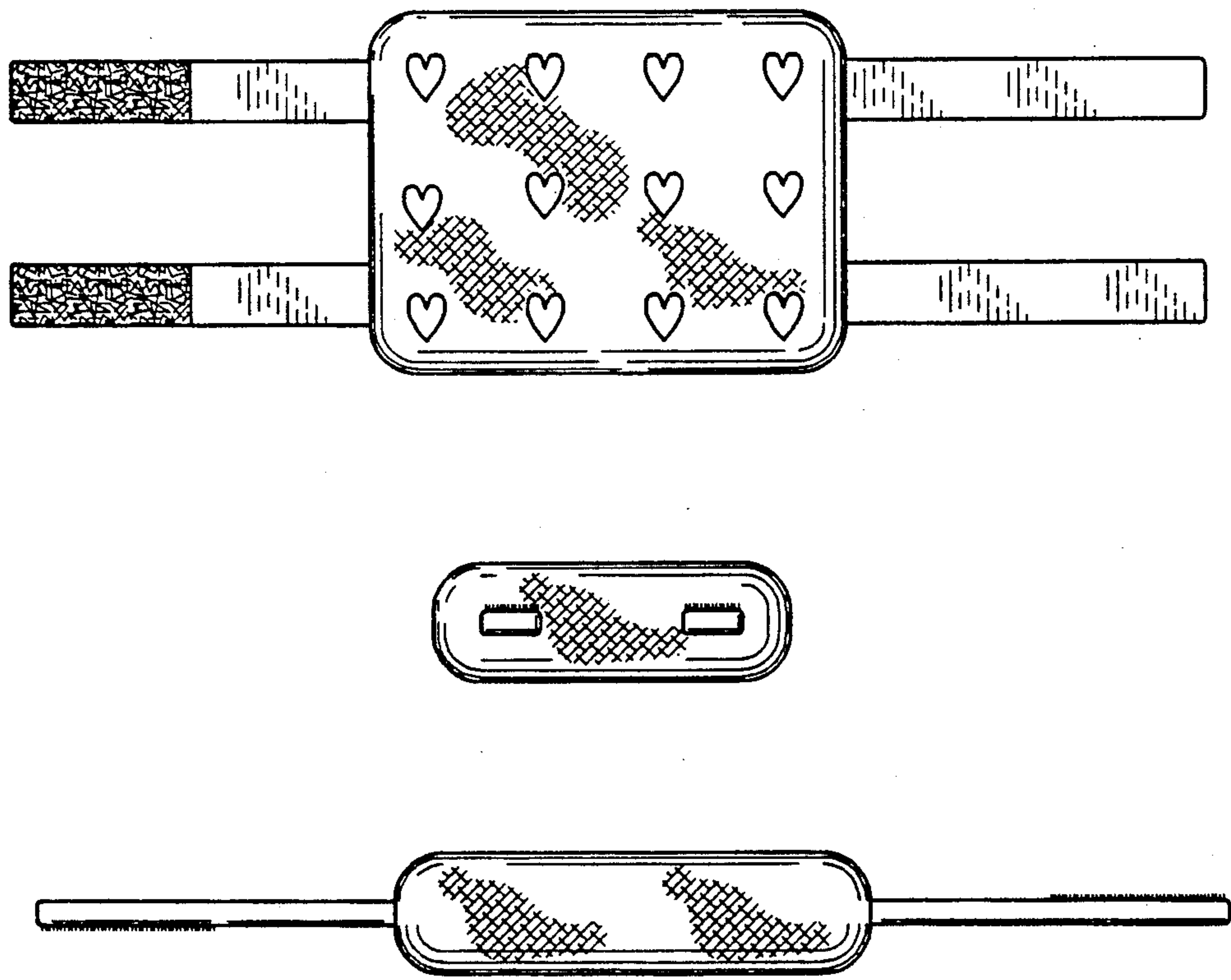

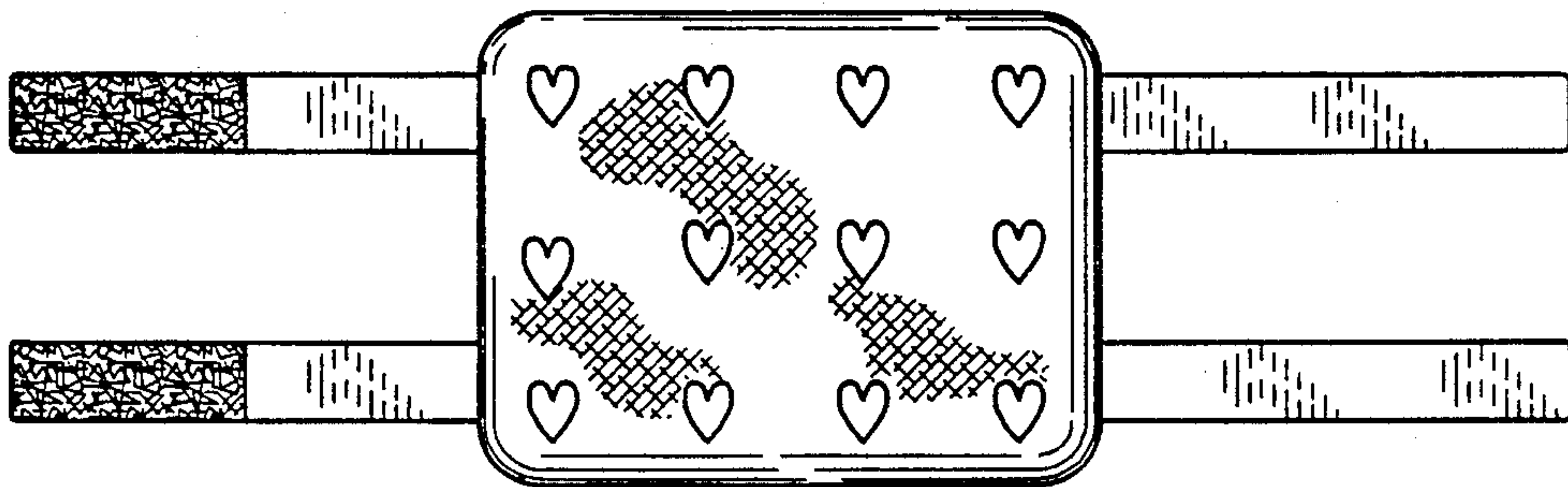
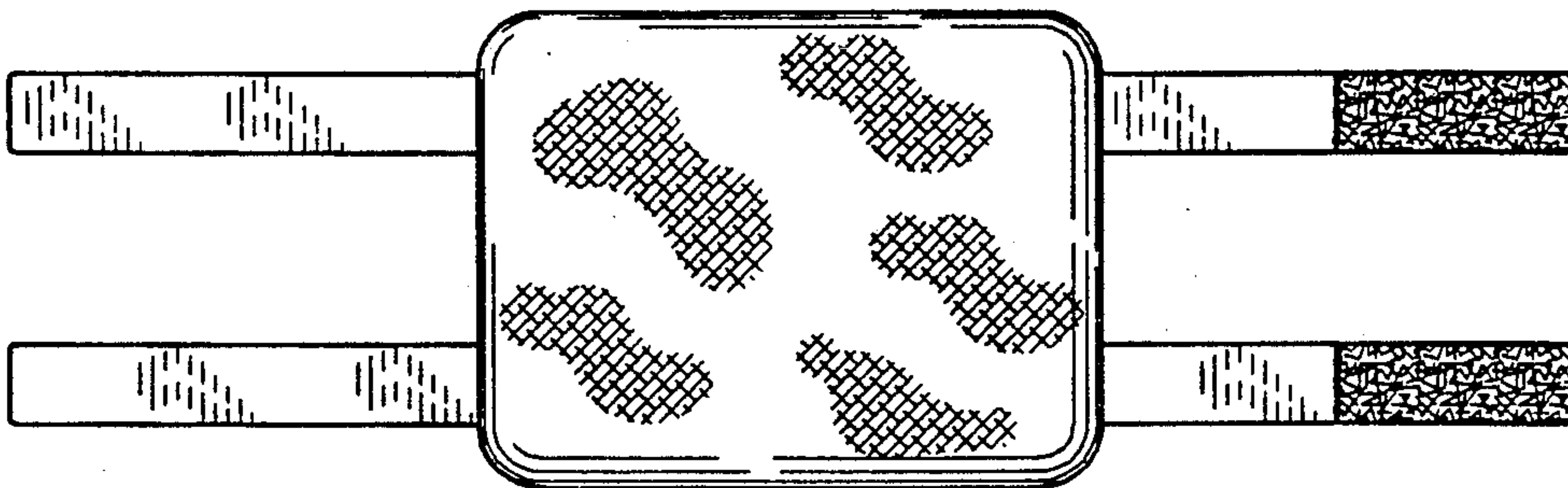
