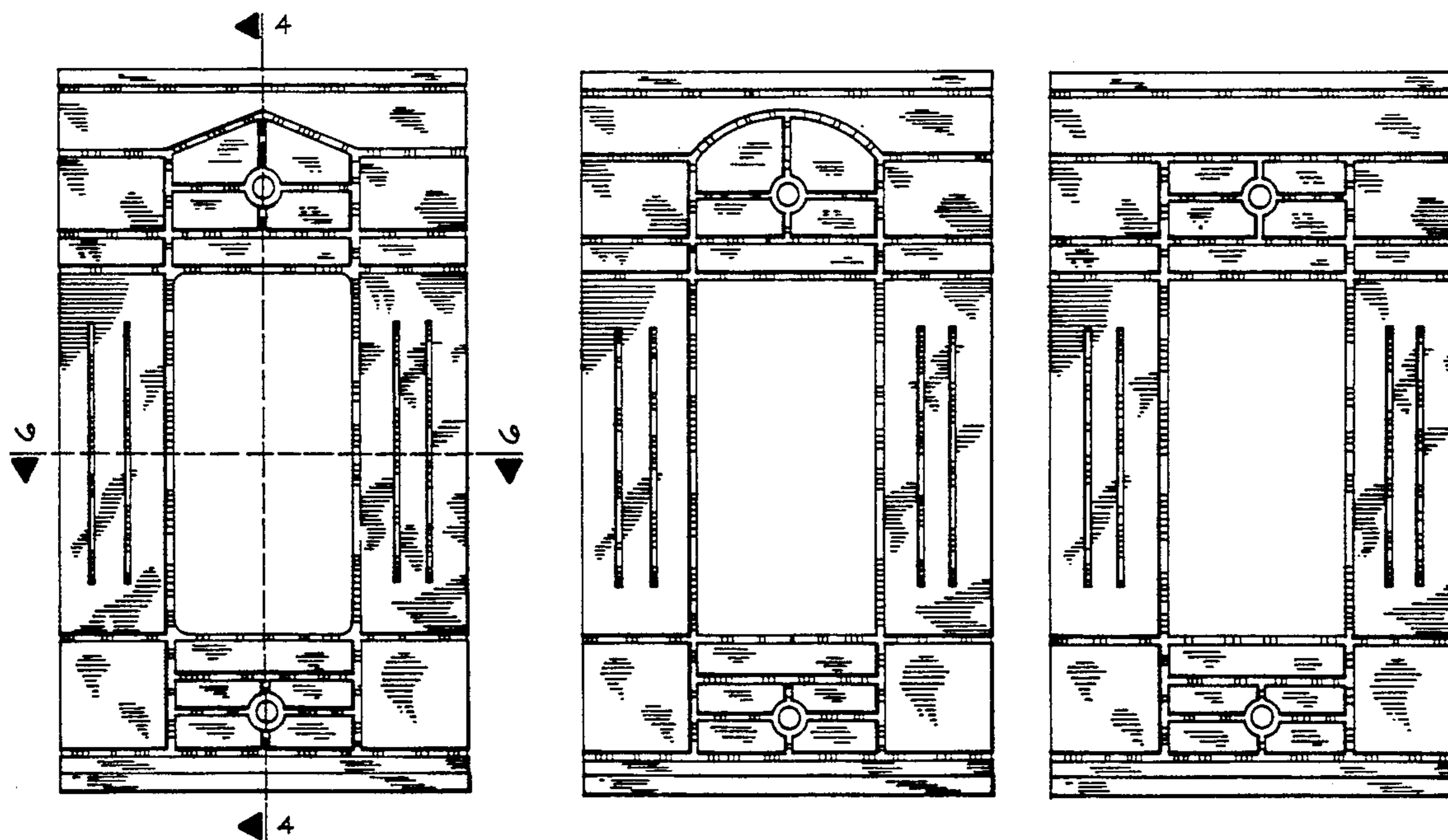
FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the second embodiment of the design of FIG. 1, the only difference being the curved groove over the upper mounting hole; and,

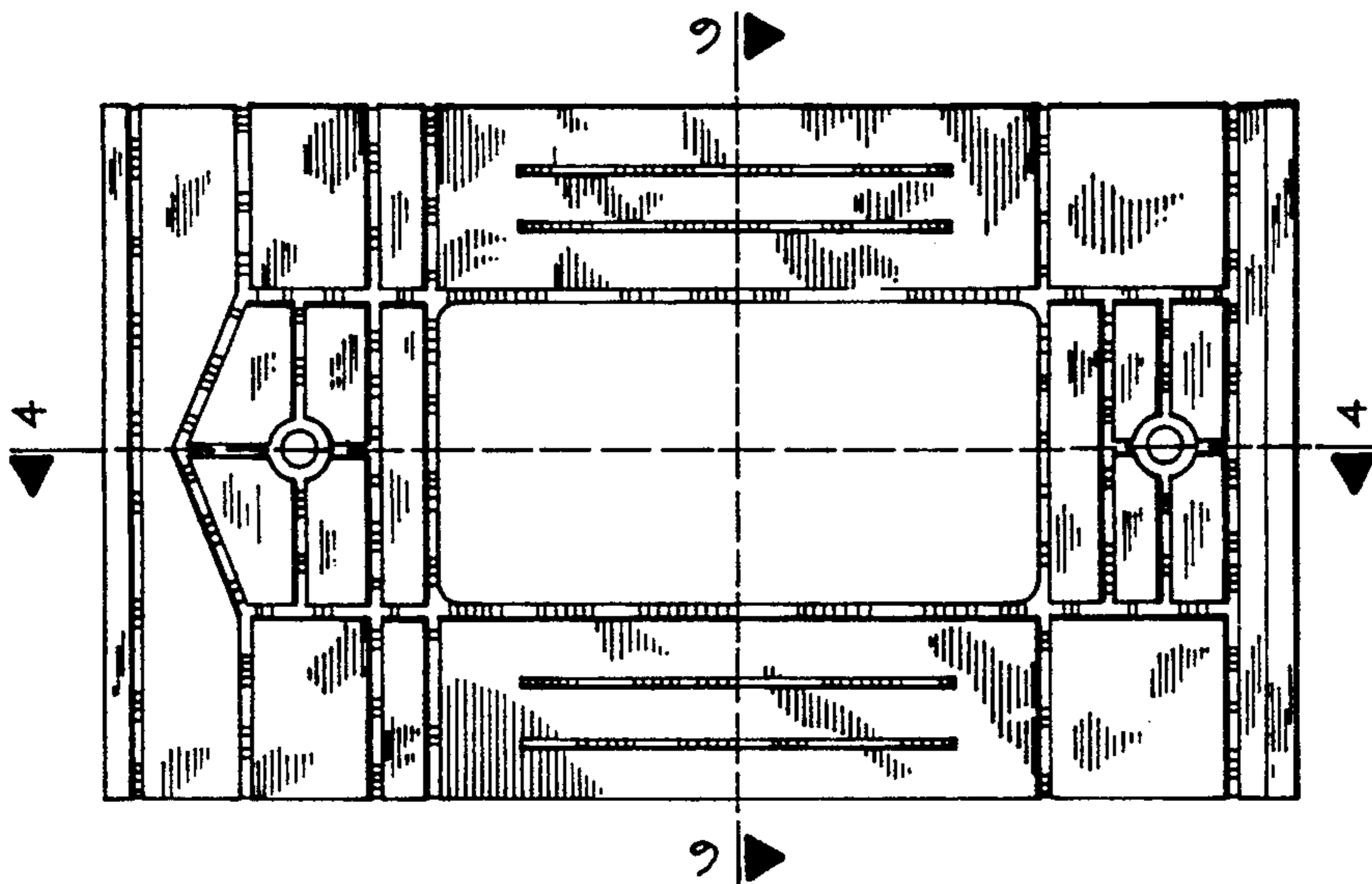

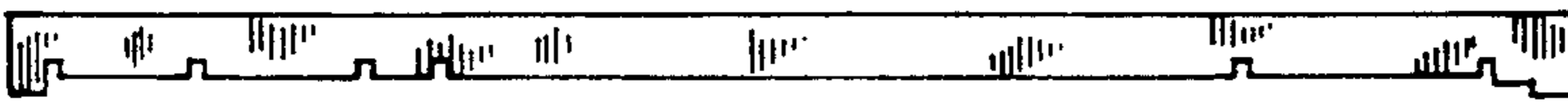

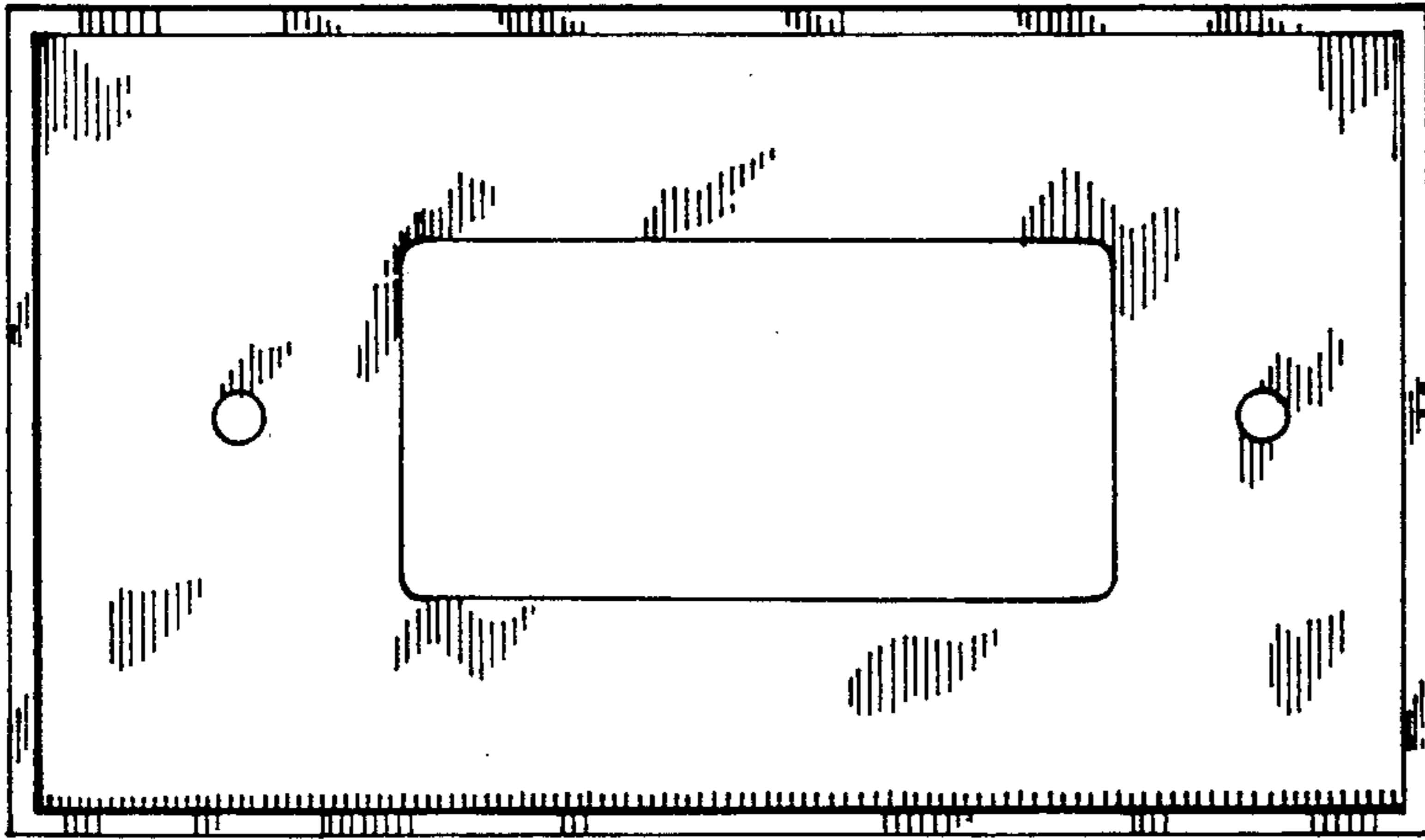

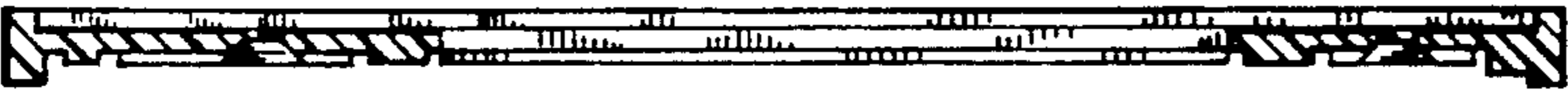

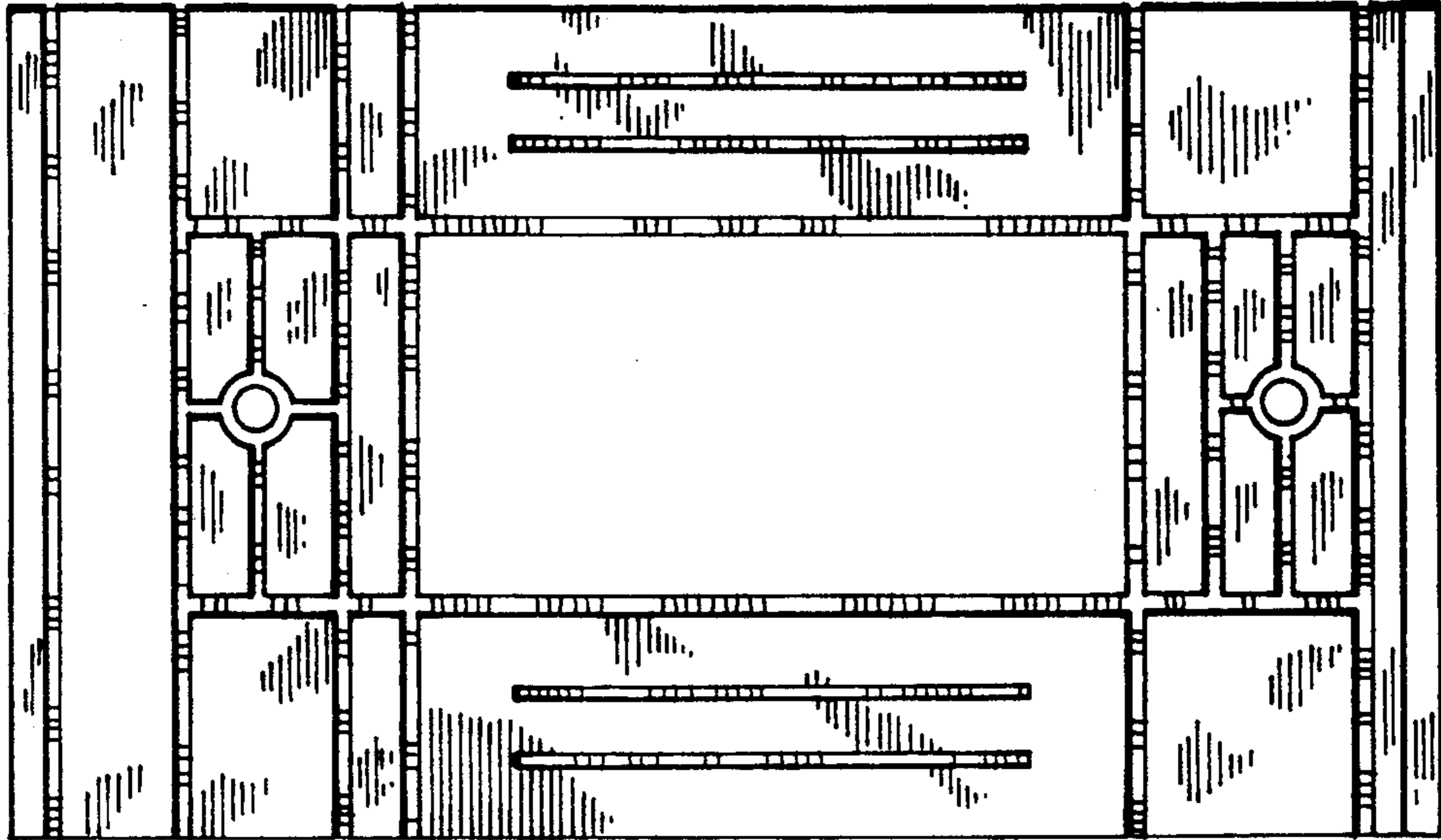

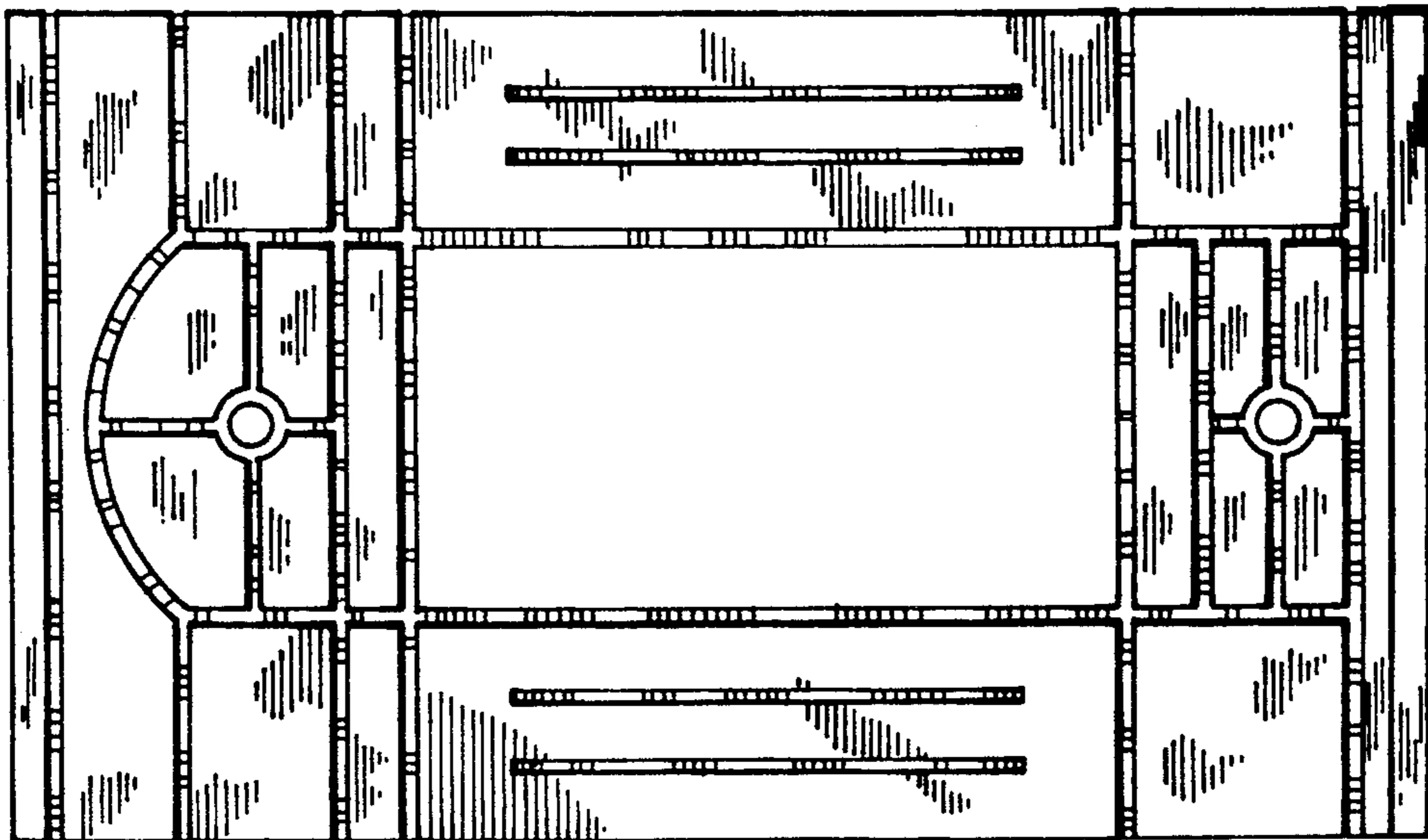
