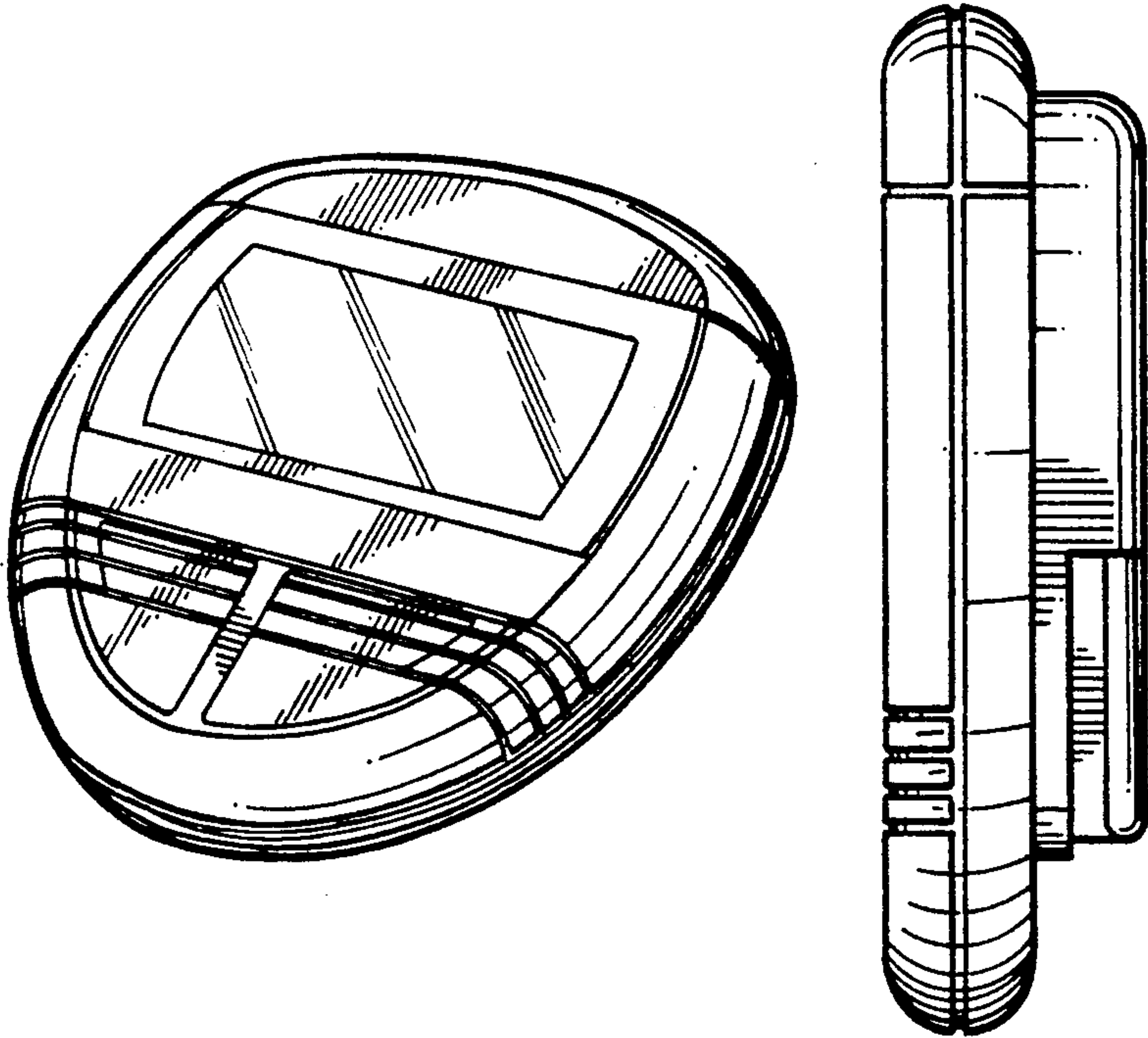
The ornamental design for a bicycle computer, as shown and described.

FIGS. 2-5 are drawn on an enlarged scale.



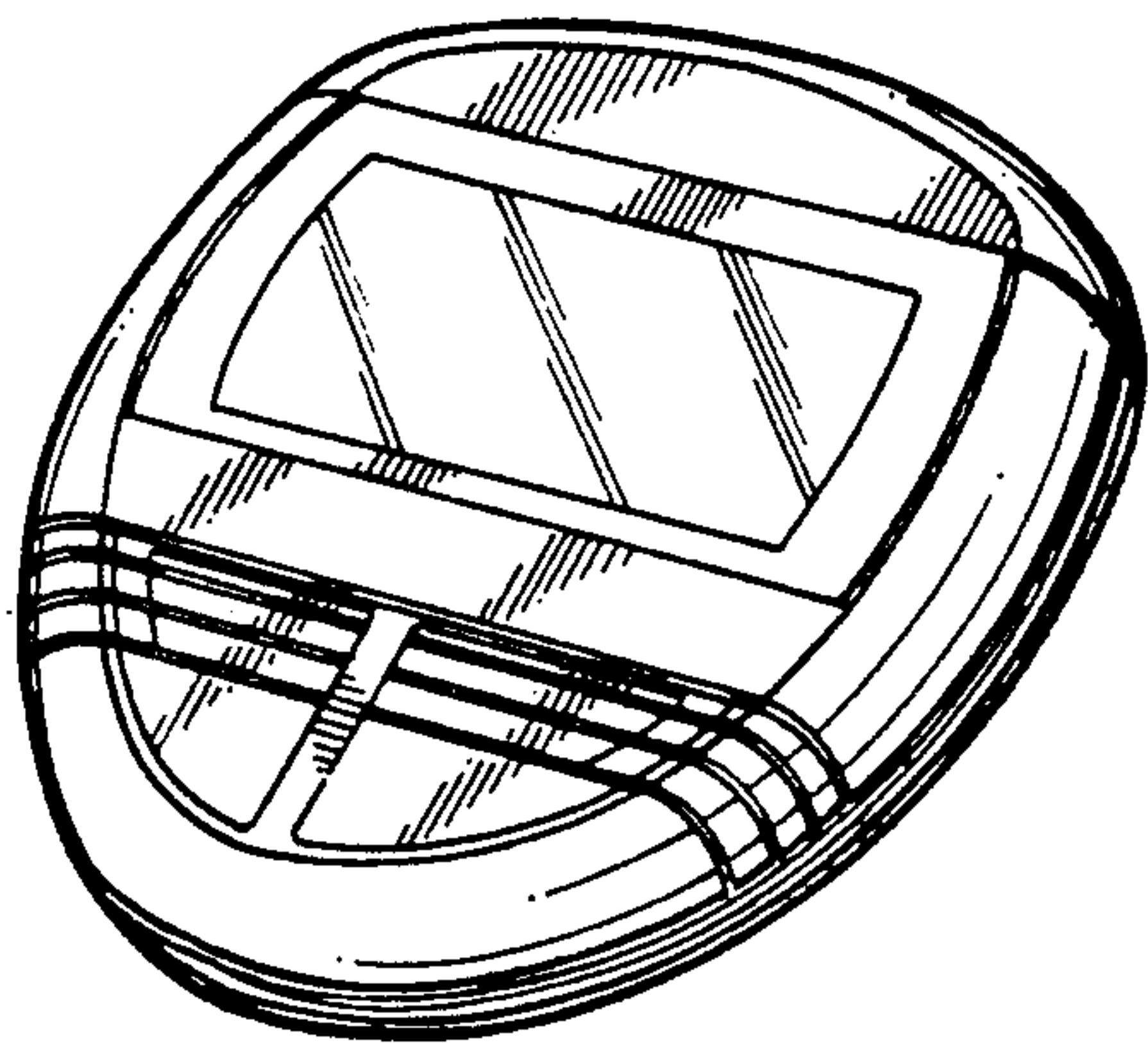

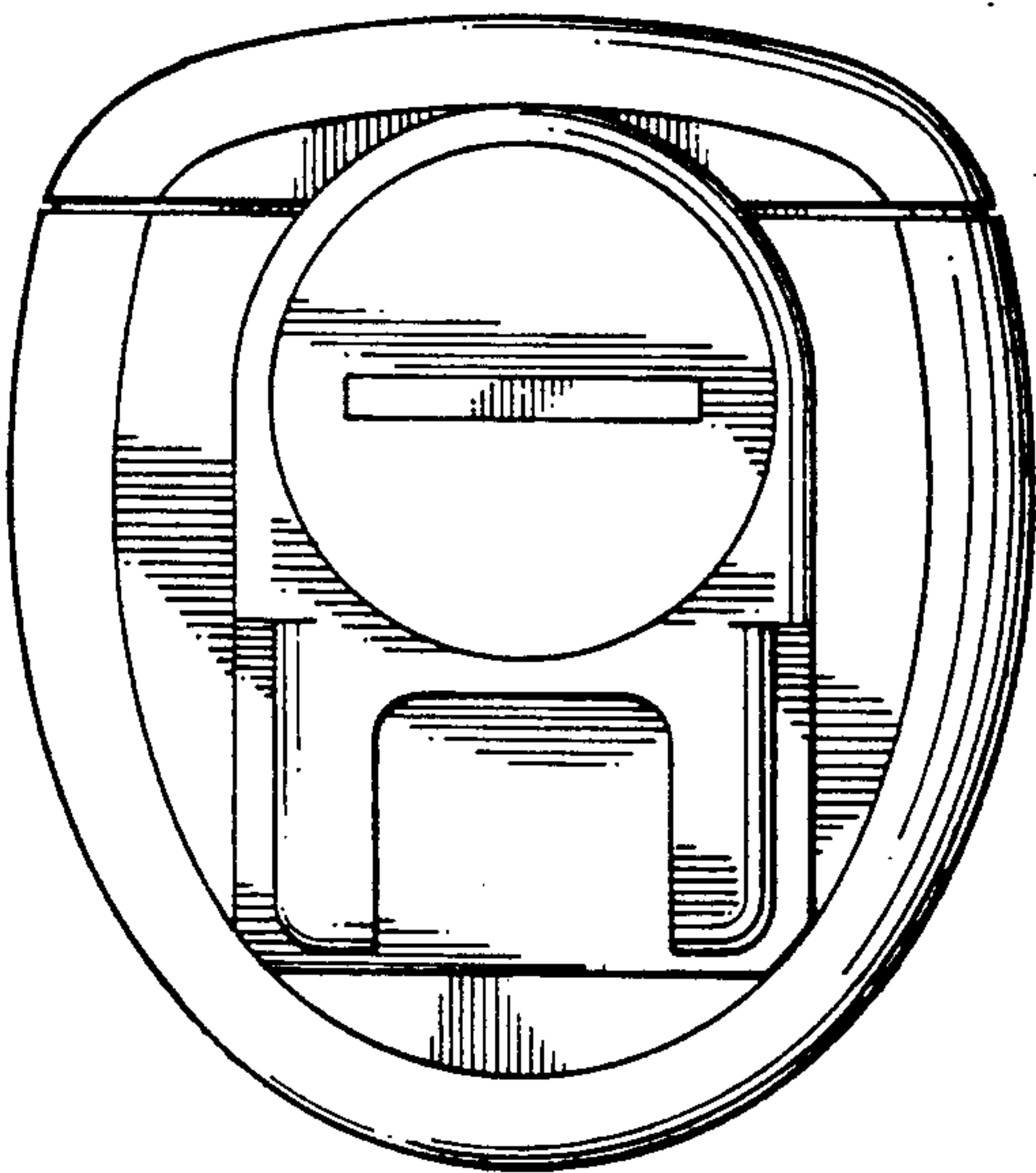

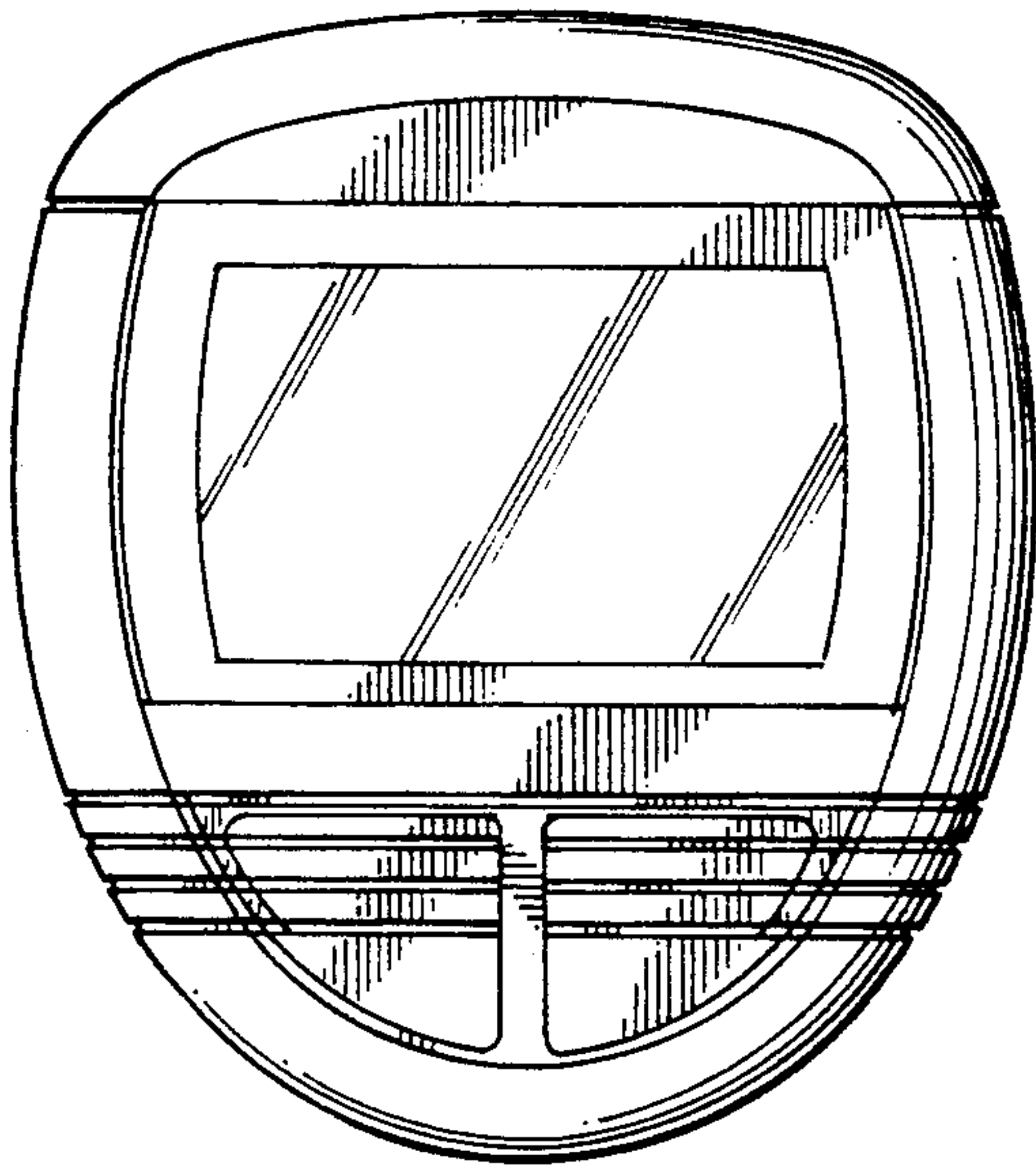

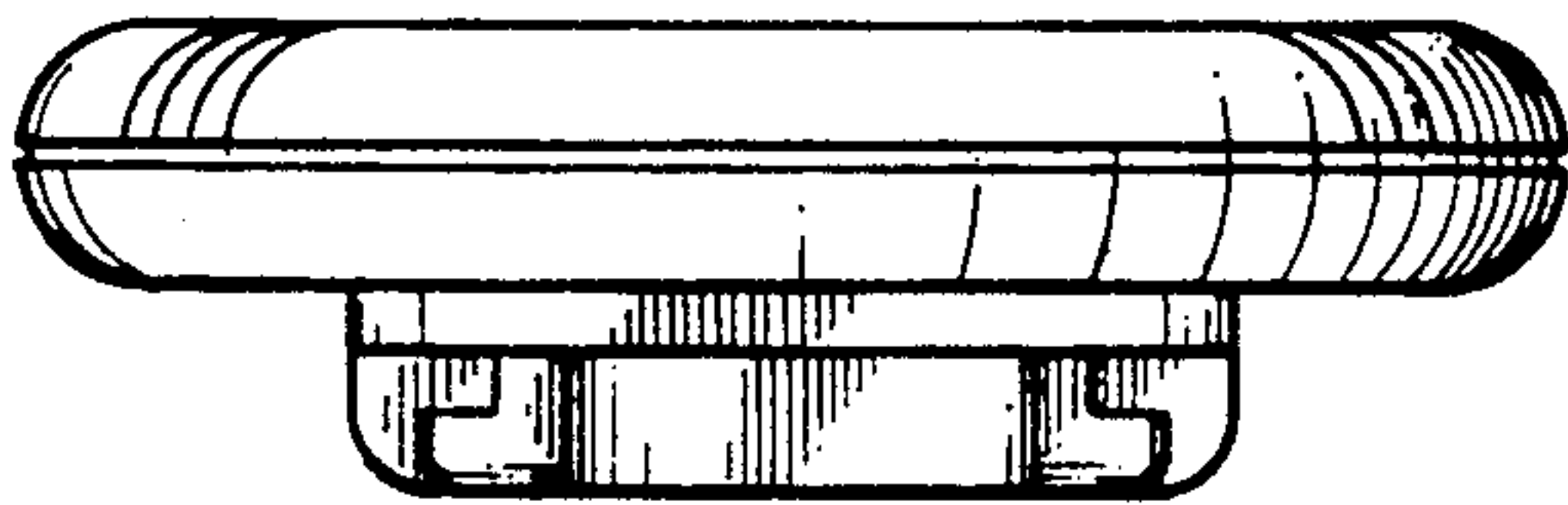

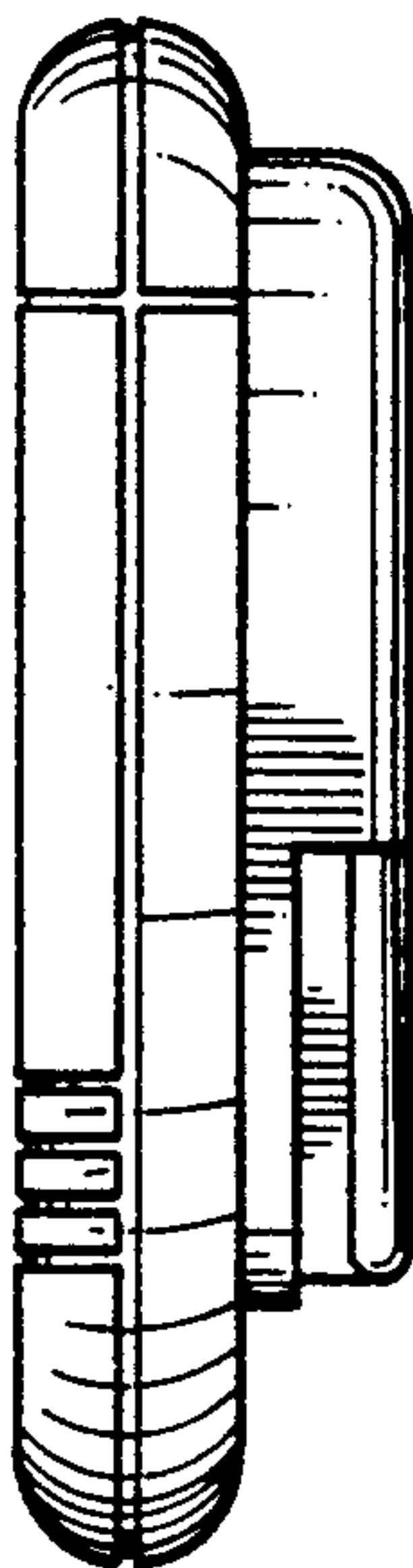
