FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the lower part.

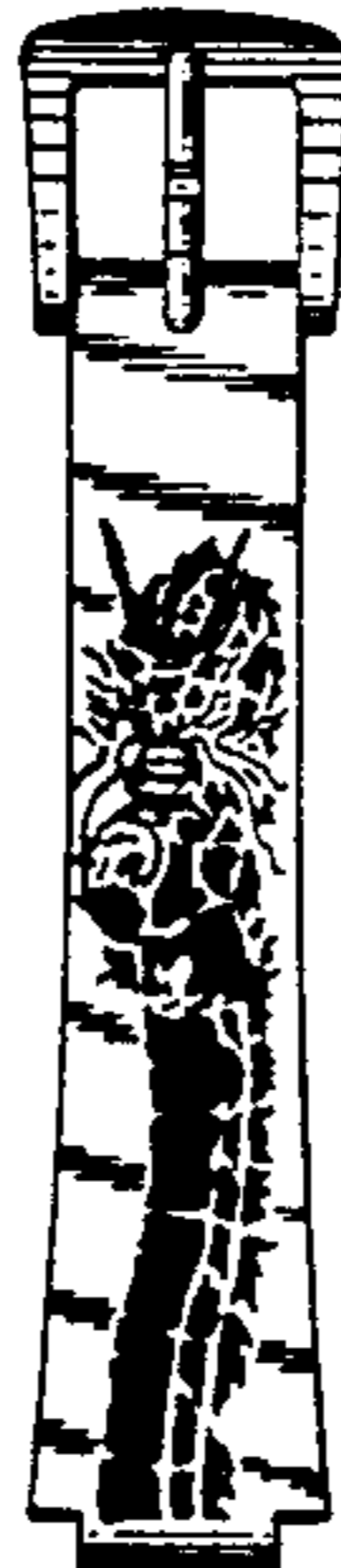

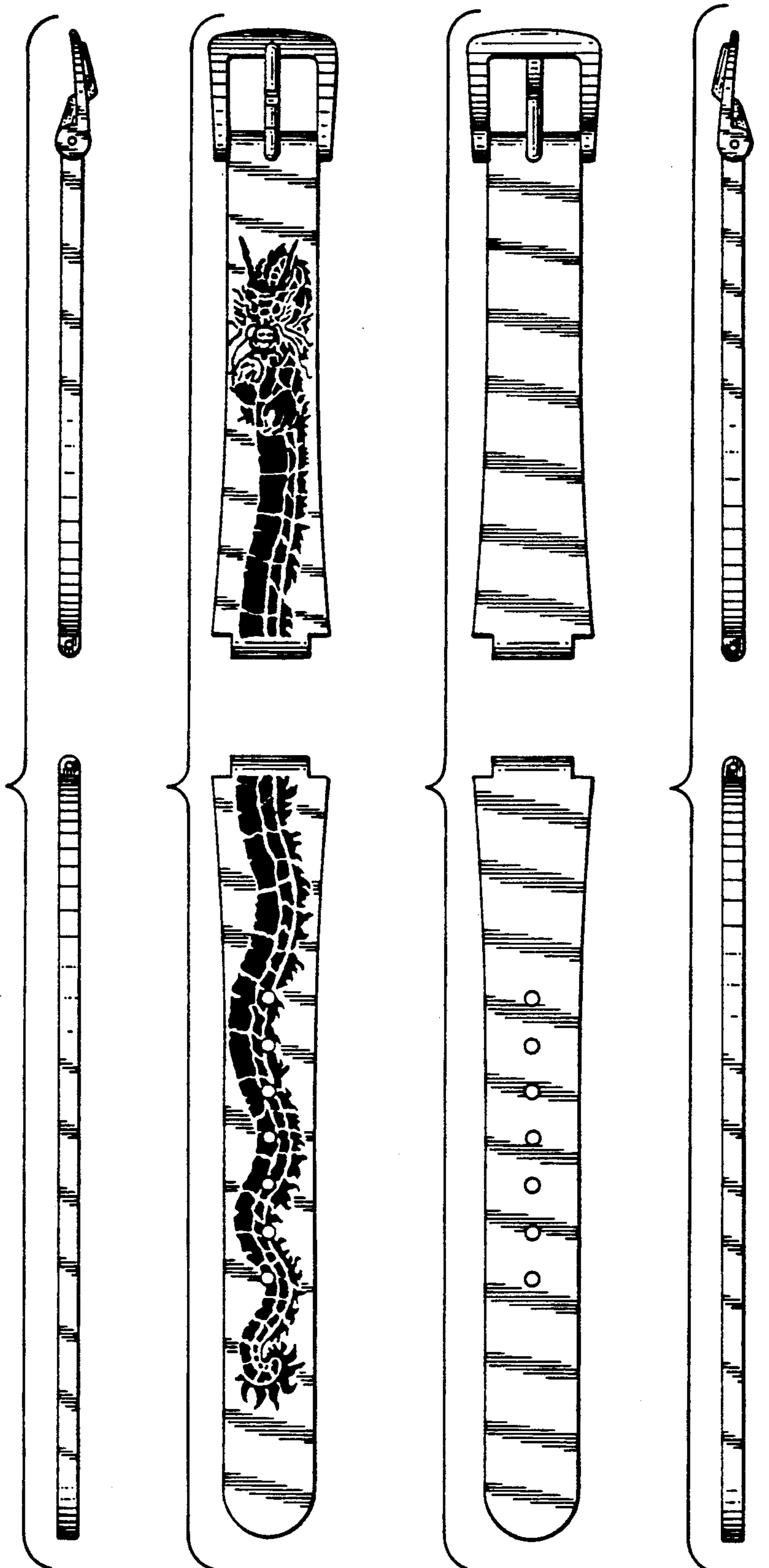
