### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shoe outsole, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe outsole embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of one side of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the other side of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a cross-section of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1, taken on section line 4—4;

FIG. 5 is a cross-section of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1, taken on section line 5—5;

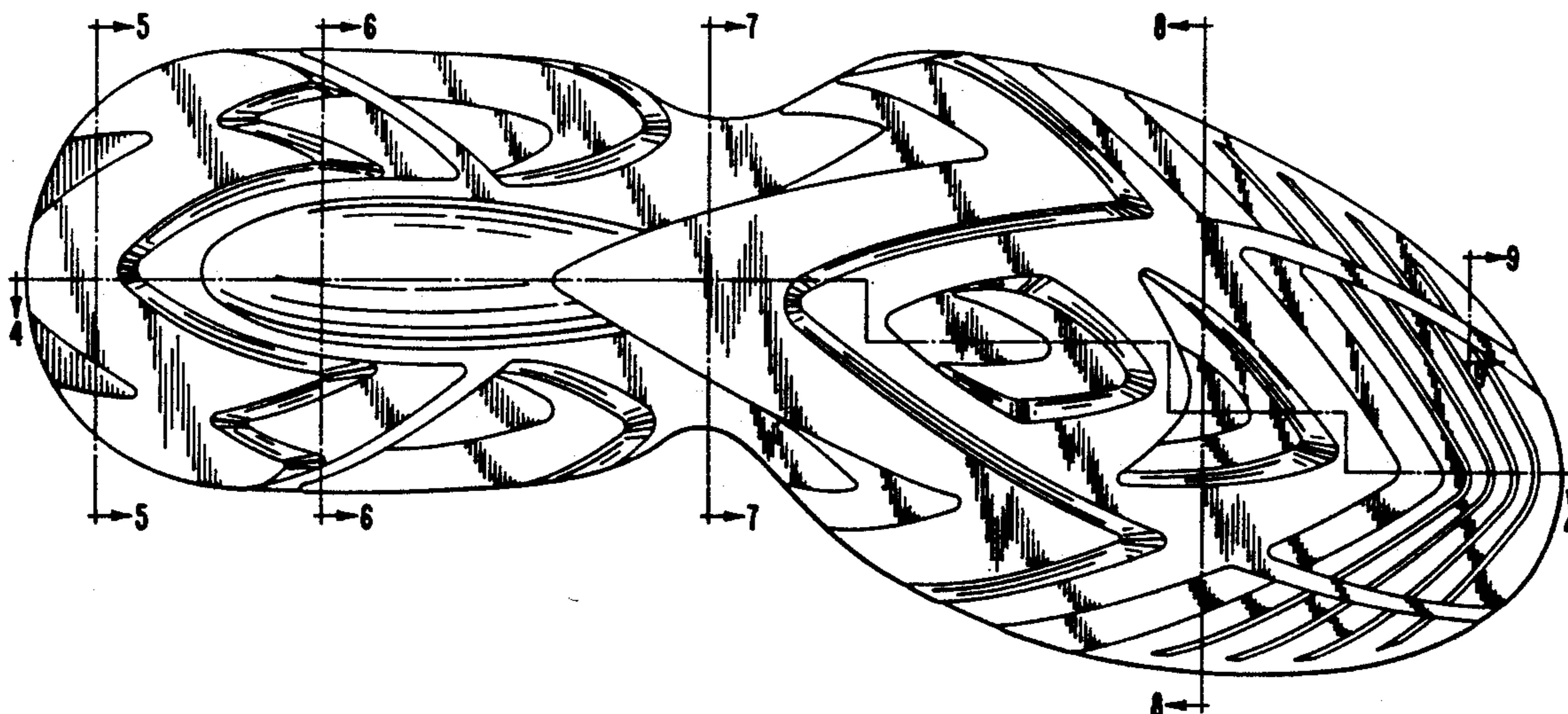
FIG. 6 is a cross-section of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1, taken on section line 6—6;

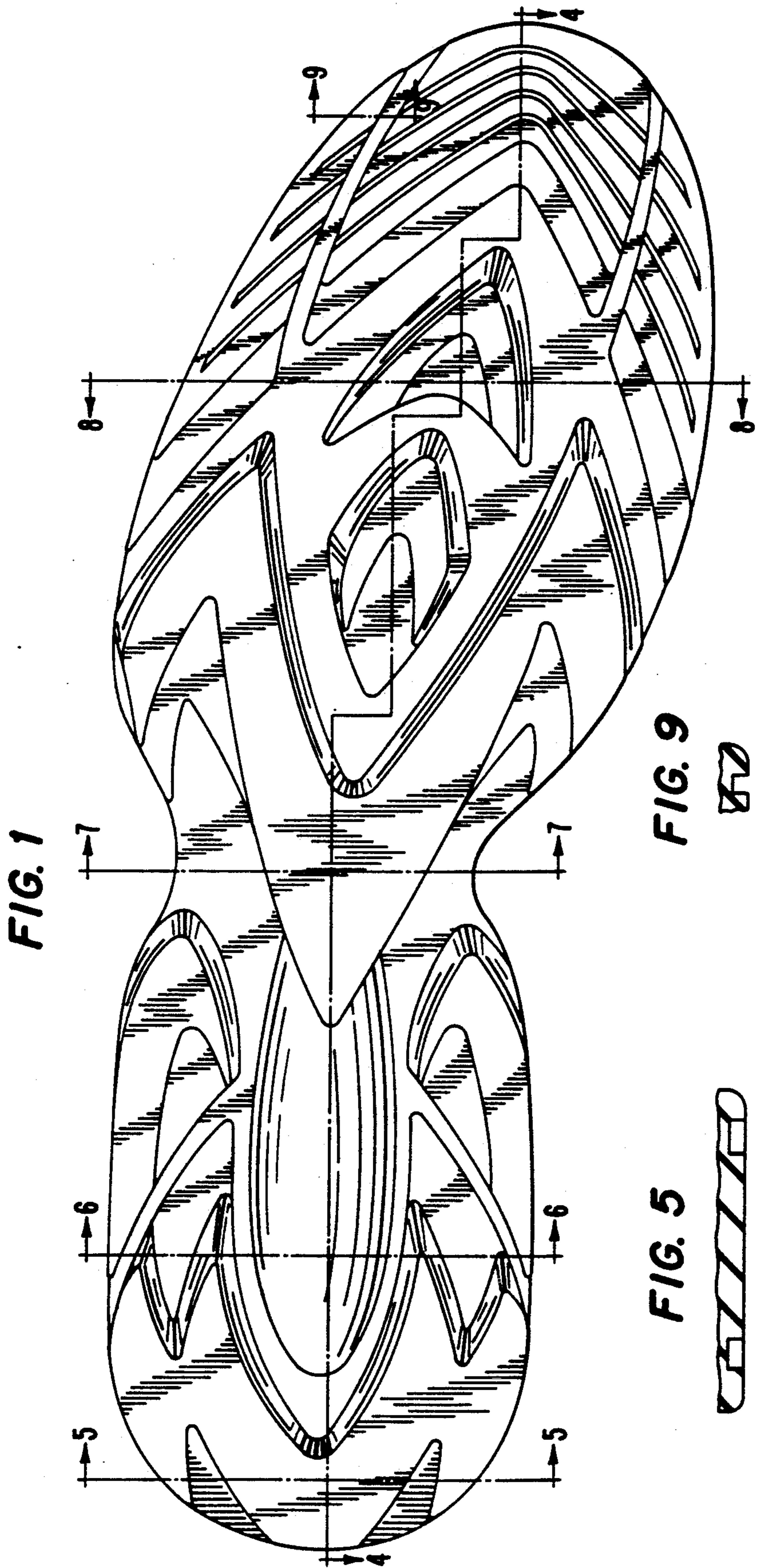
FIG. 7 is a cross-section of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1, taken on section line 7—7;

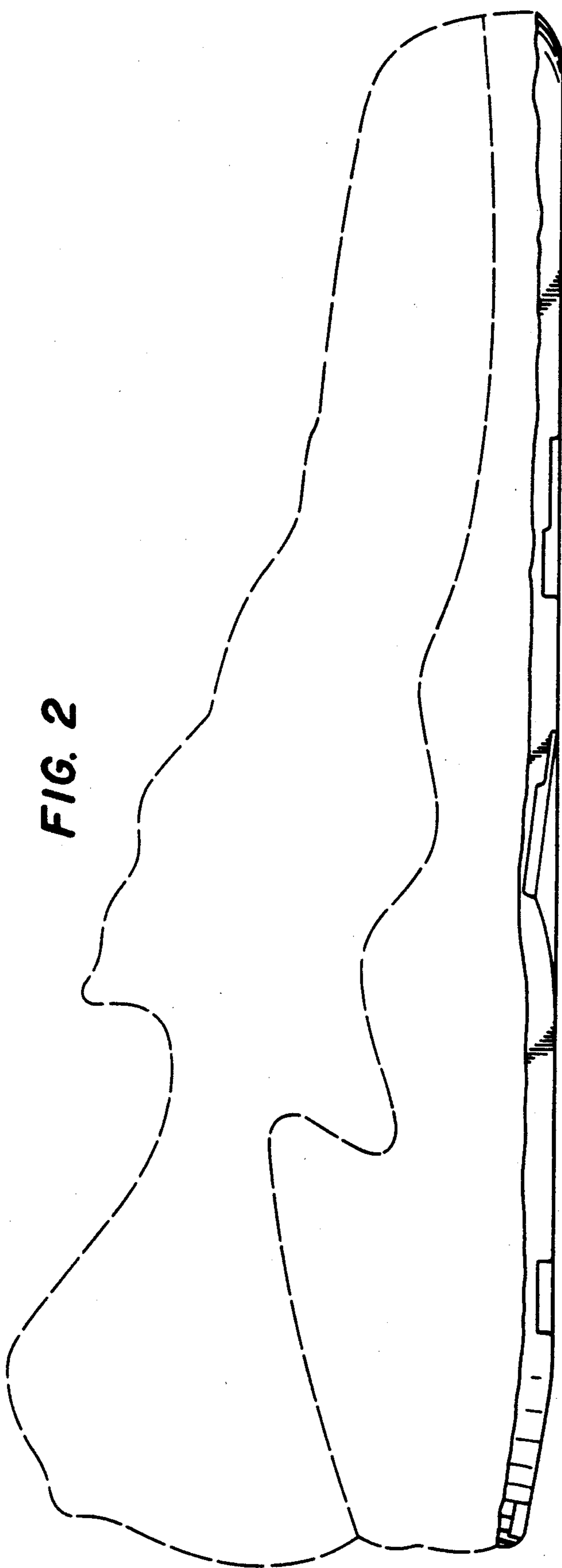
FIG. 8 is a cross-section of the shoe outsole shown in FIG. 1, taken on section line 8—8; and,

The broken line showing of a shoe upper and midsole is for illustrative purposes and forms no part of the claimed design.









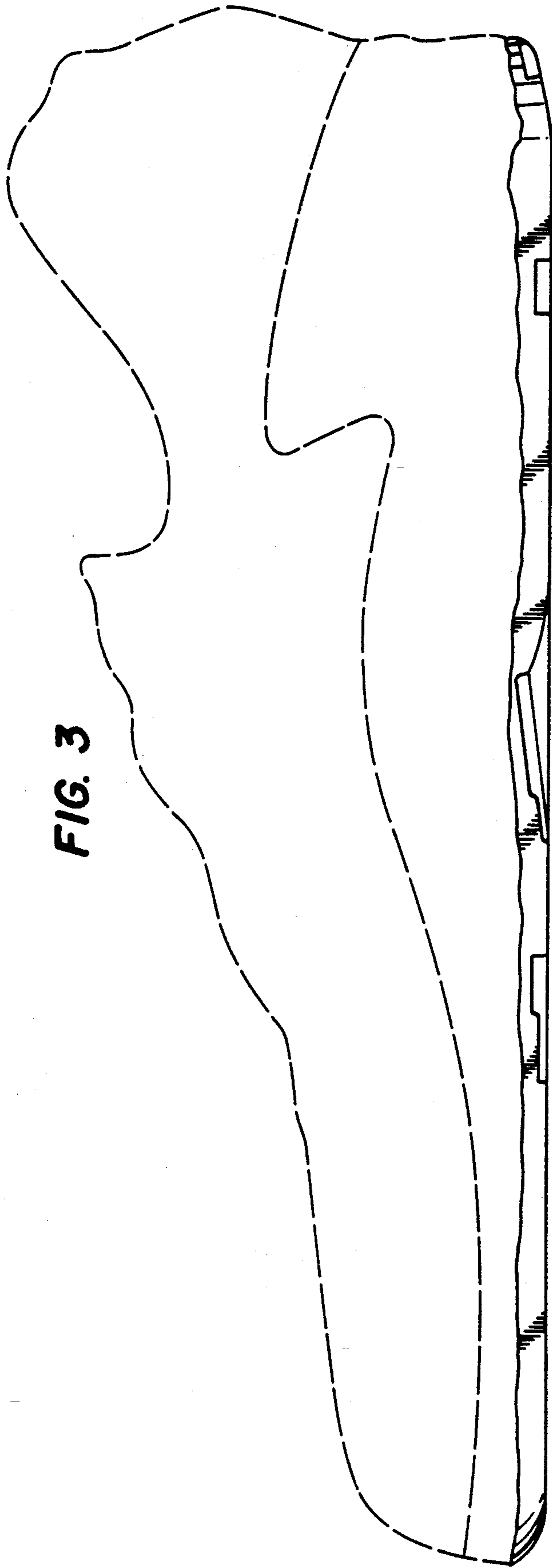
