[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a leader holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a leader holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a section on the line 5—5 of FIG. 1 and in the direction of the arrows;
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a leader holder showing my new design;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a section on the line 8—8 of FIG. 6 and in the direction of the arrows.
The rear elevational views of both forms of leader holder are identical.
The right end elevational view is a mirror image of the left end.
