[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined bathtub and spout, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a combined bathtub and spout showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4—4 of FIG. 2 with the spout shown in full for clarity;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2 with the spout shown in full for clarity;

FIG. 6 is a detailed top frontal and right side perspective view of the spout shroud portions of the design;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view thereof being the mirror image thereof.

The fragmentary broken line representation of a deck in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only and forms no part of the claimed design.

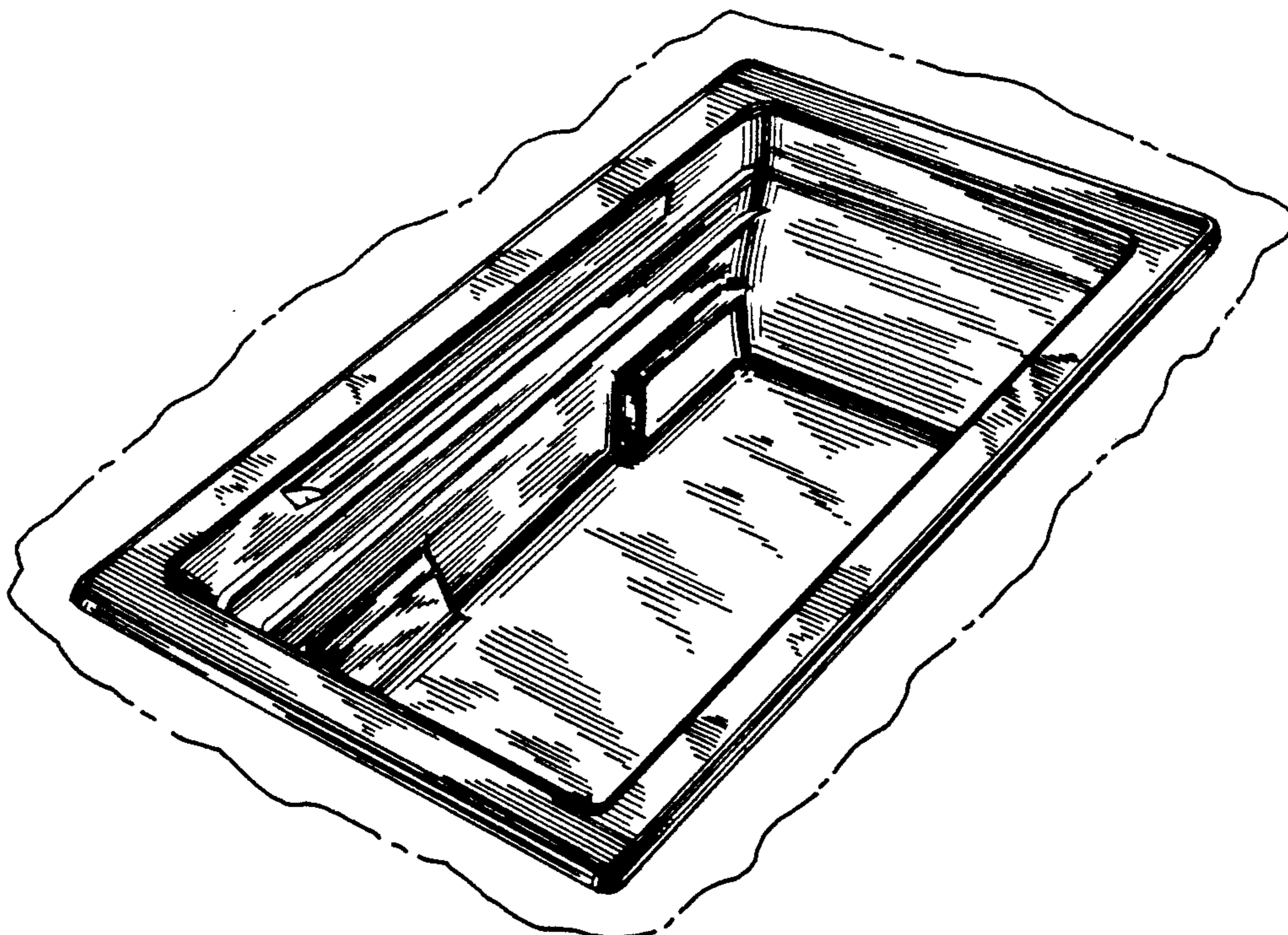

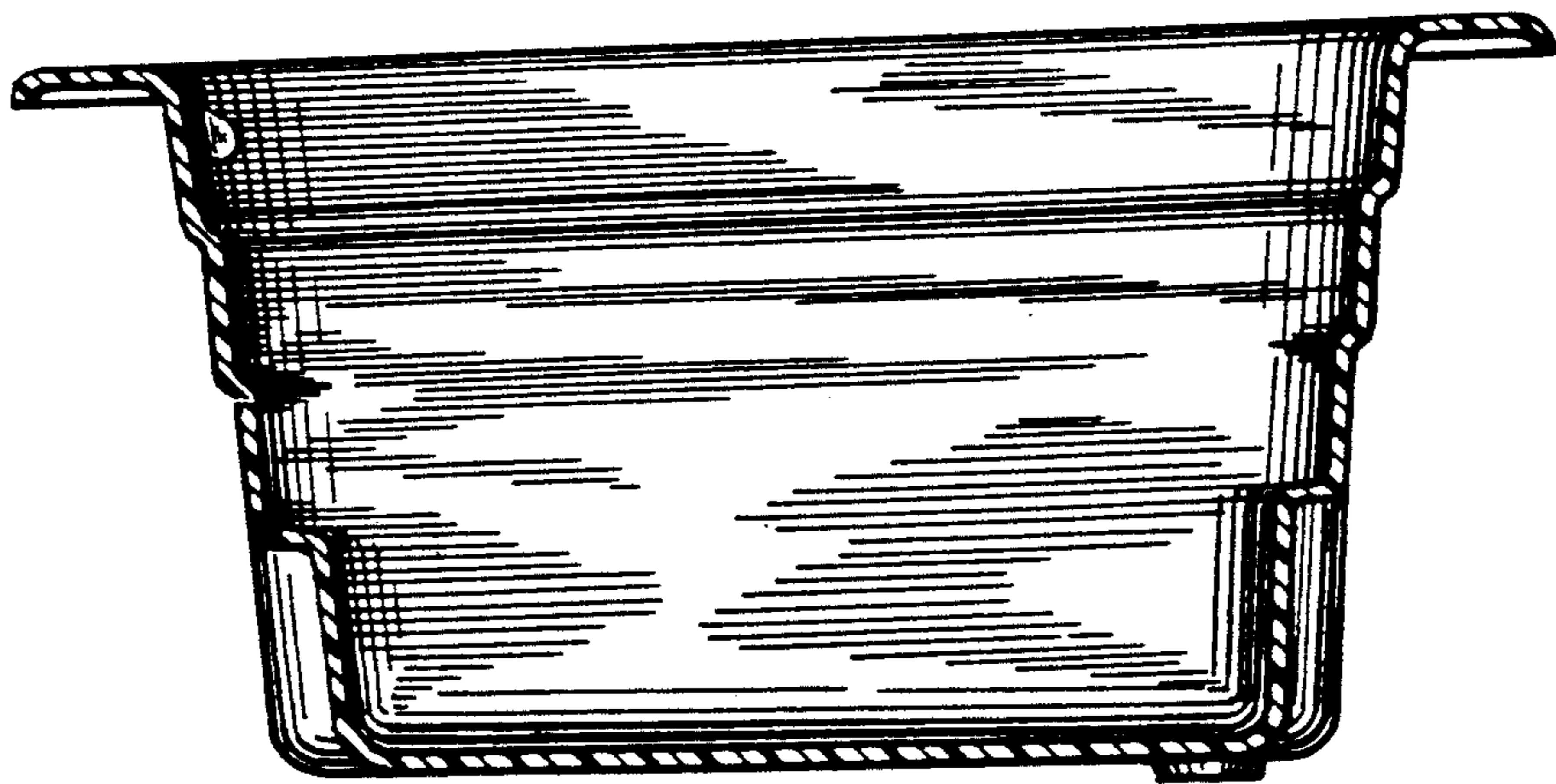
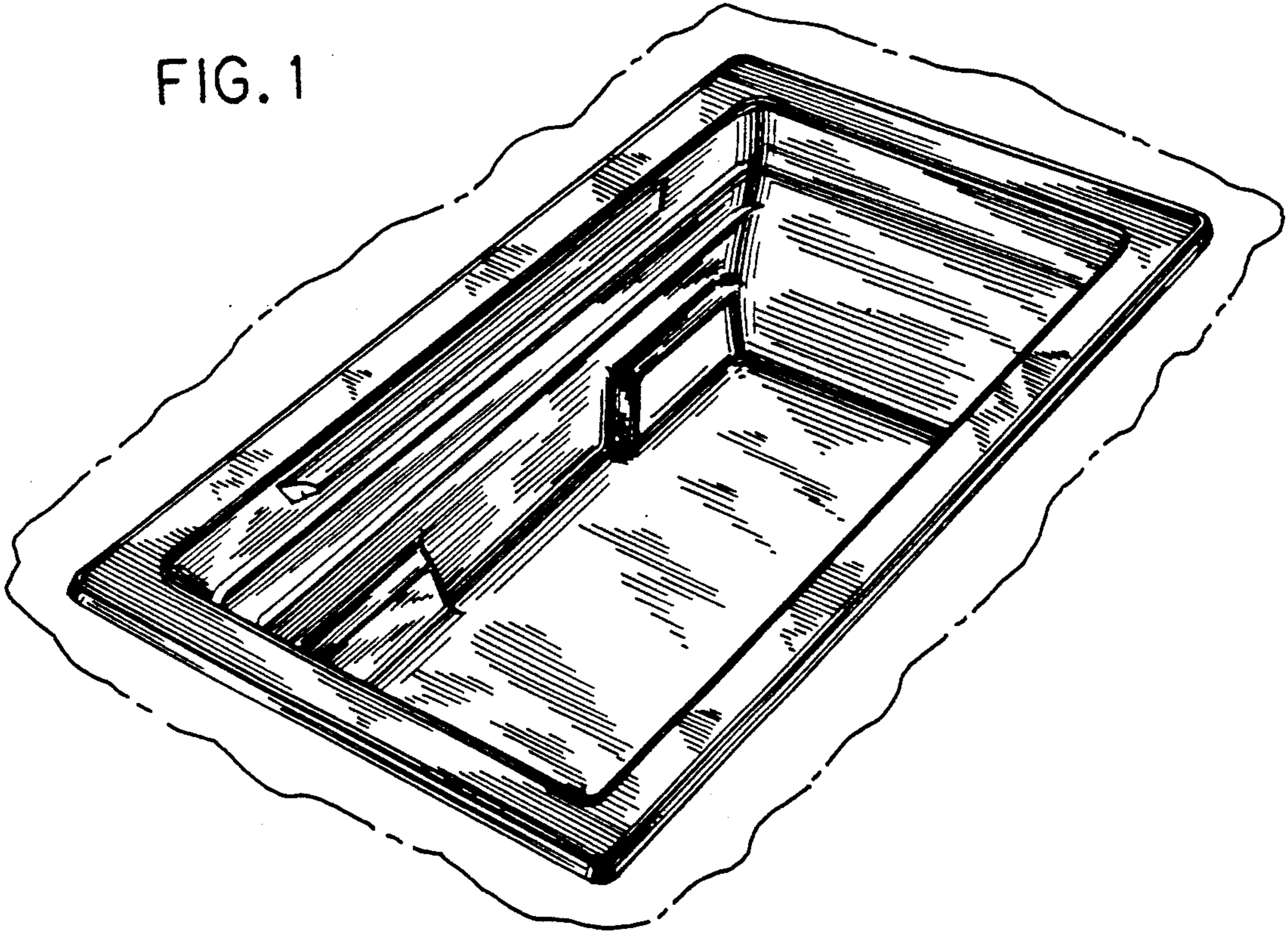

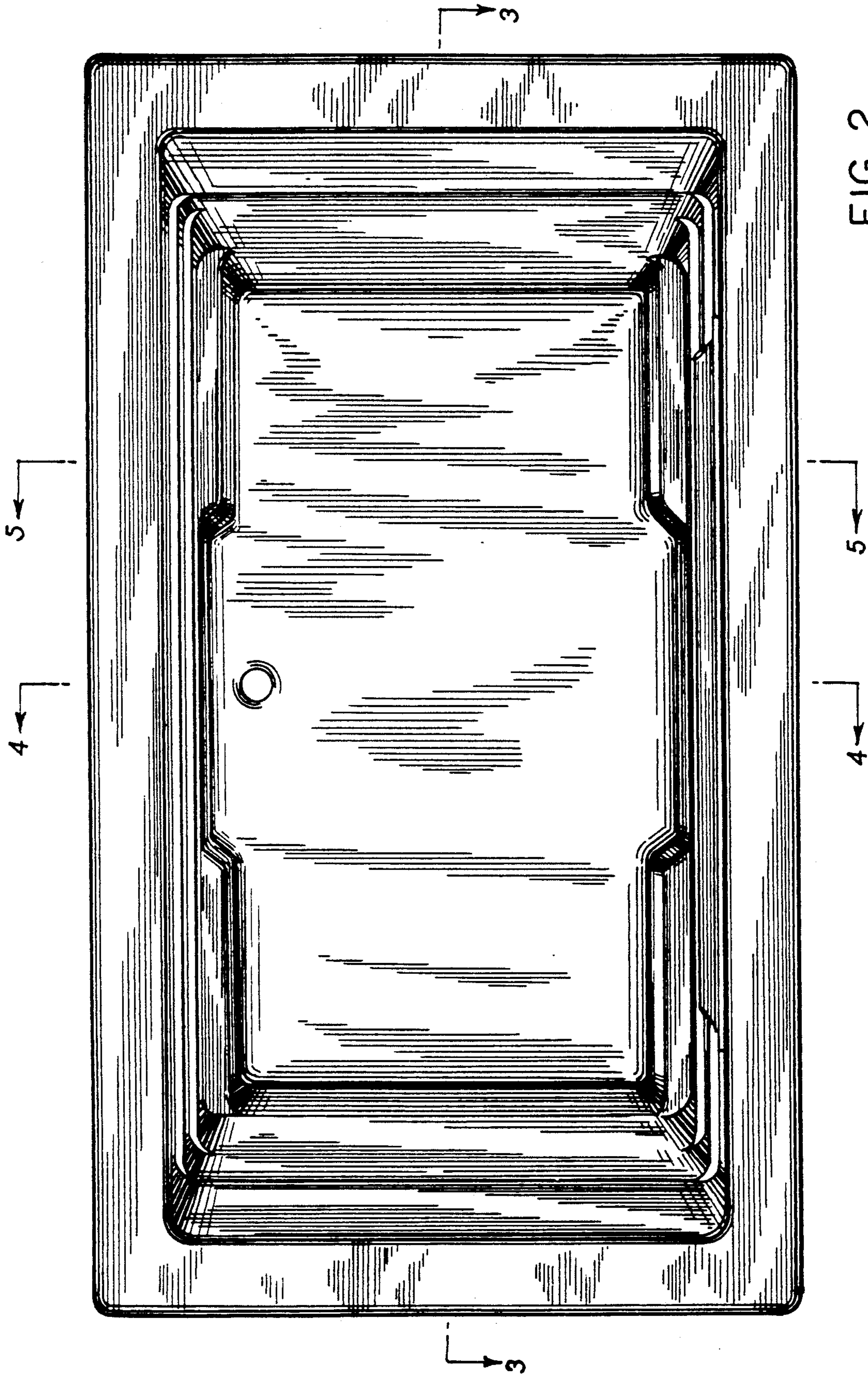

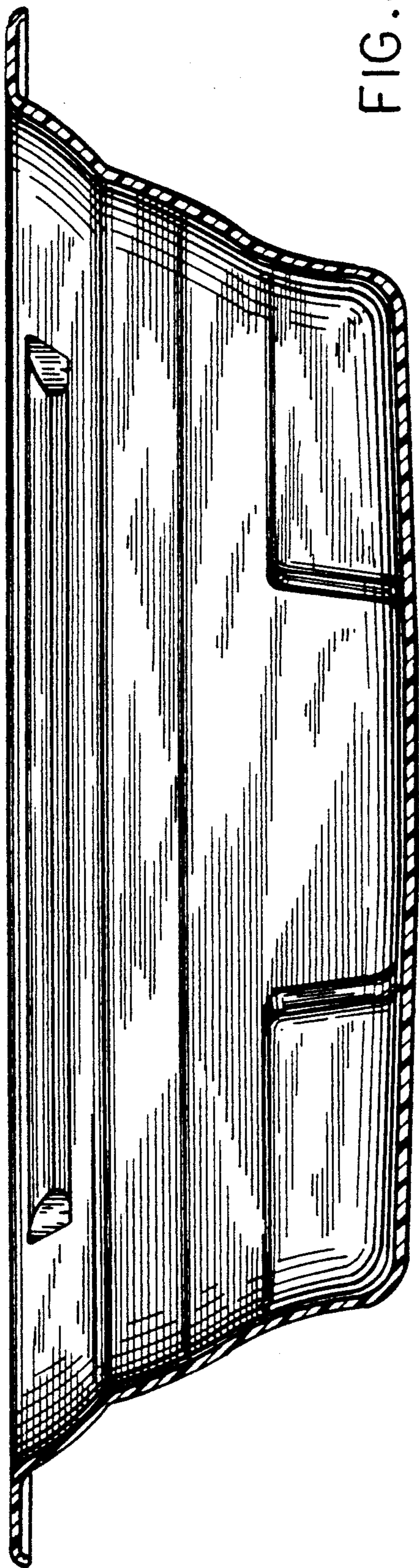

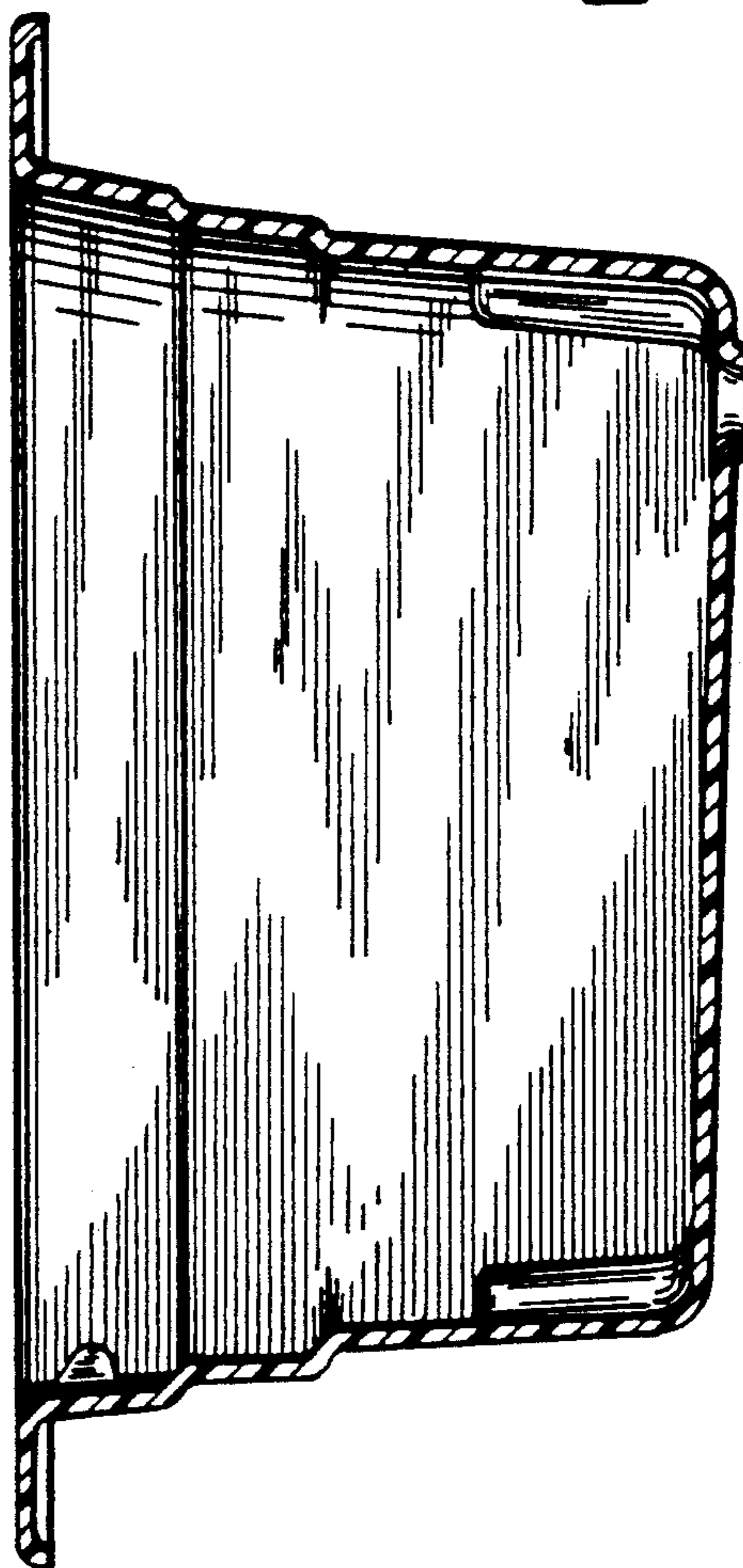

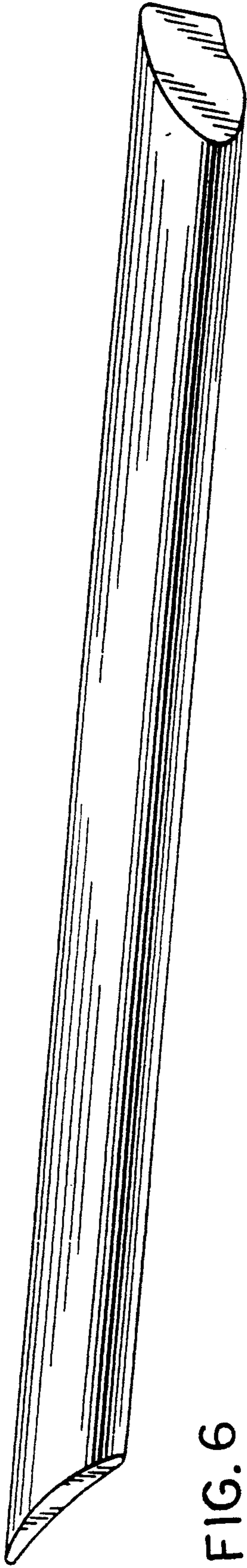
