CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toothbrush, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toothbrush showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a front end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1, the only difference residing in the number of openings in the handle;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1, the only difference residing in the number of openings in the handle;

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a fourth embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 14 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 15 is a front end elevational view thereof;


FIG. 16 is a rear elevational view thereof;




FIG. 20 is a bottom plan view thereof.




























