[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an cabinet door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the cabinet door embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the cabinet of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side view of the cabinet of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the cabinet of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view, the bottom being a mirror image thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view, taken along line 6—6 in FIG. 2.

The broken lines shown in the drawings illustrate the environment upon which the article is mounted and are not a part of the design.

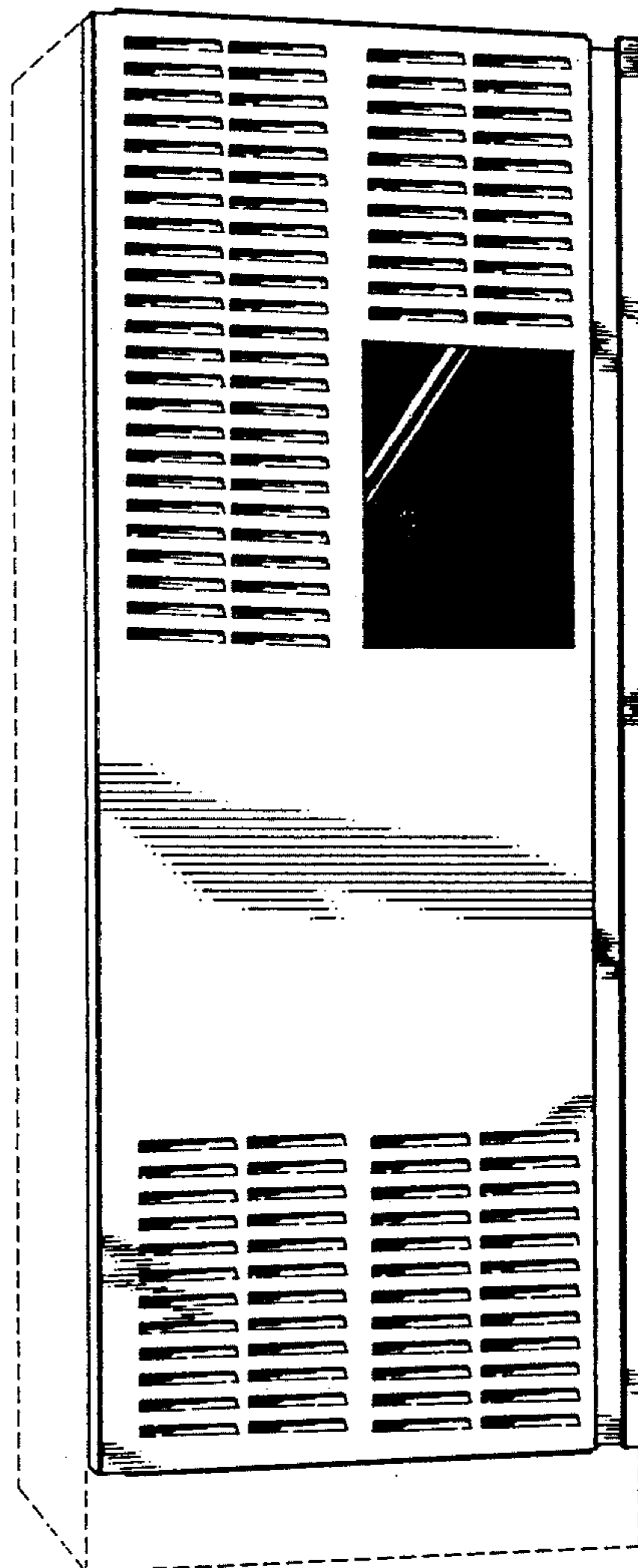
