FIG. 6 is an enlarged side view taken from below of the headlight lens of FIG. 4;

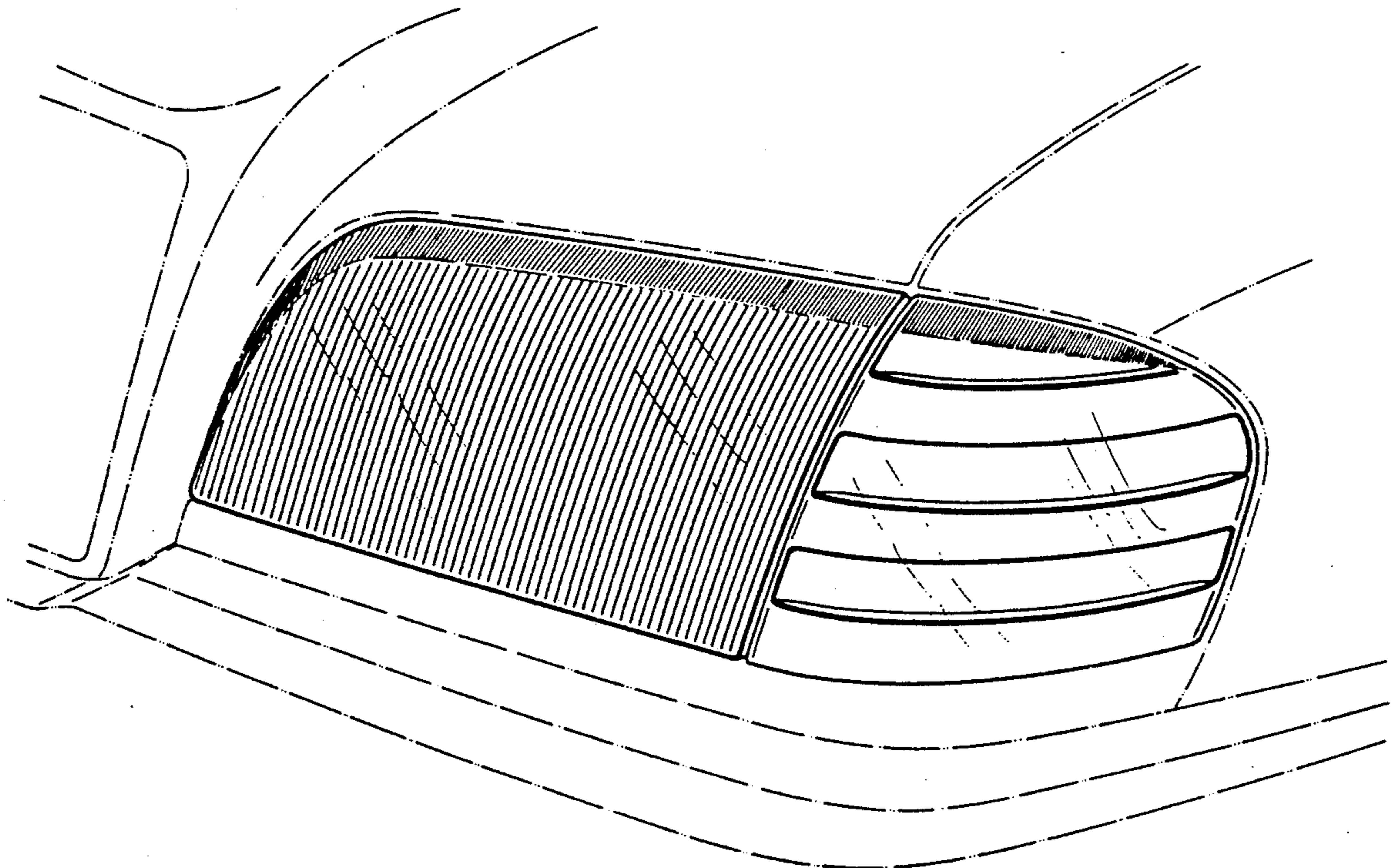

The motor vehicle is fragmentarily shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



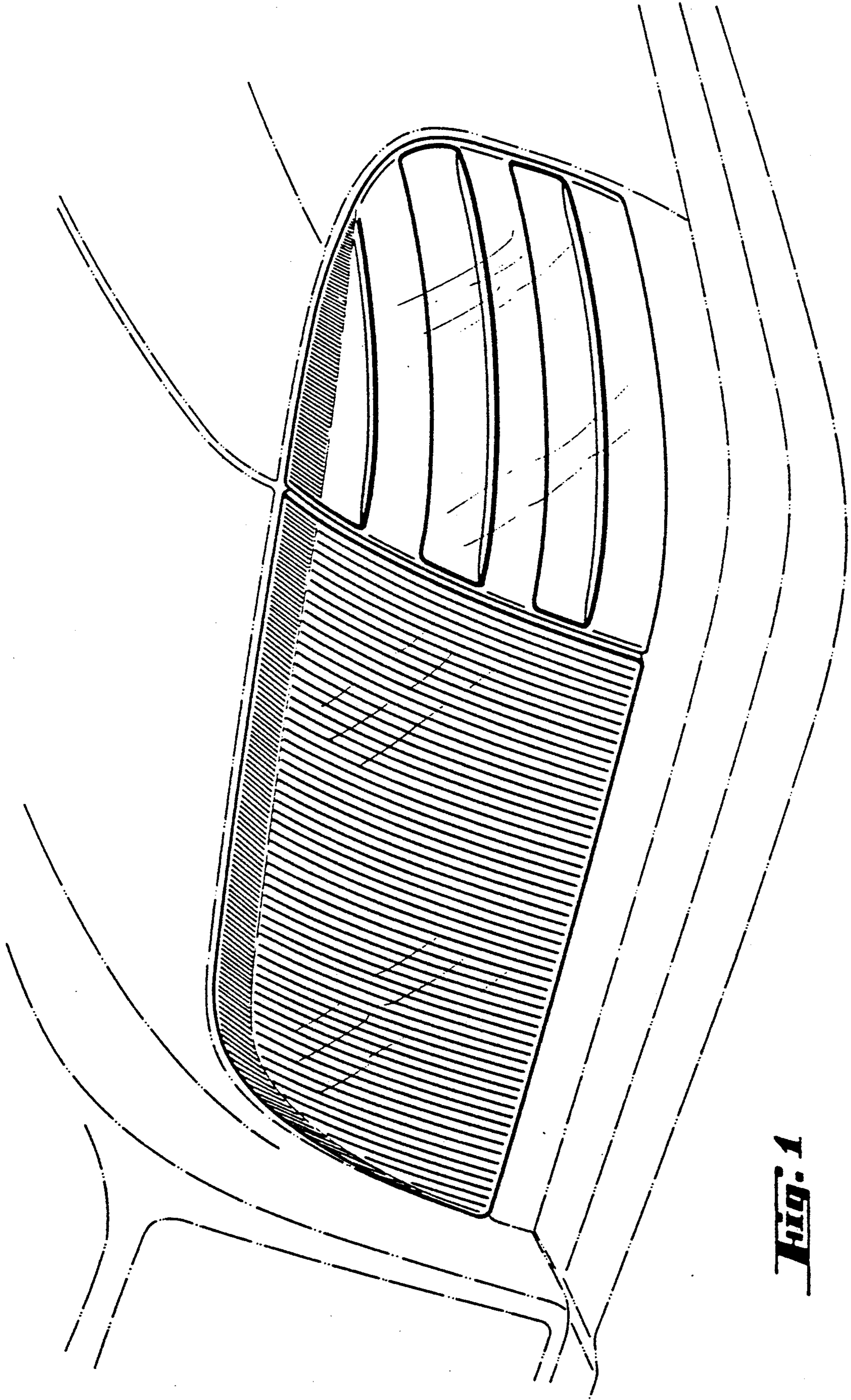

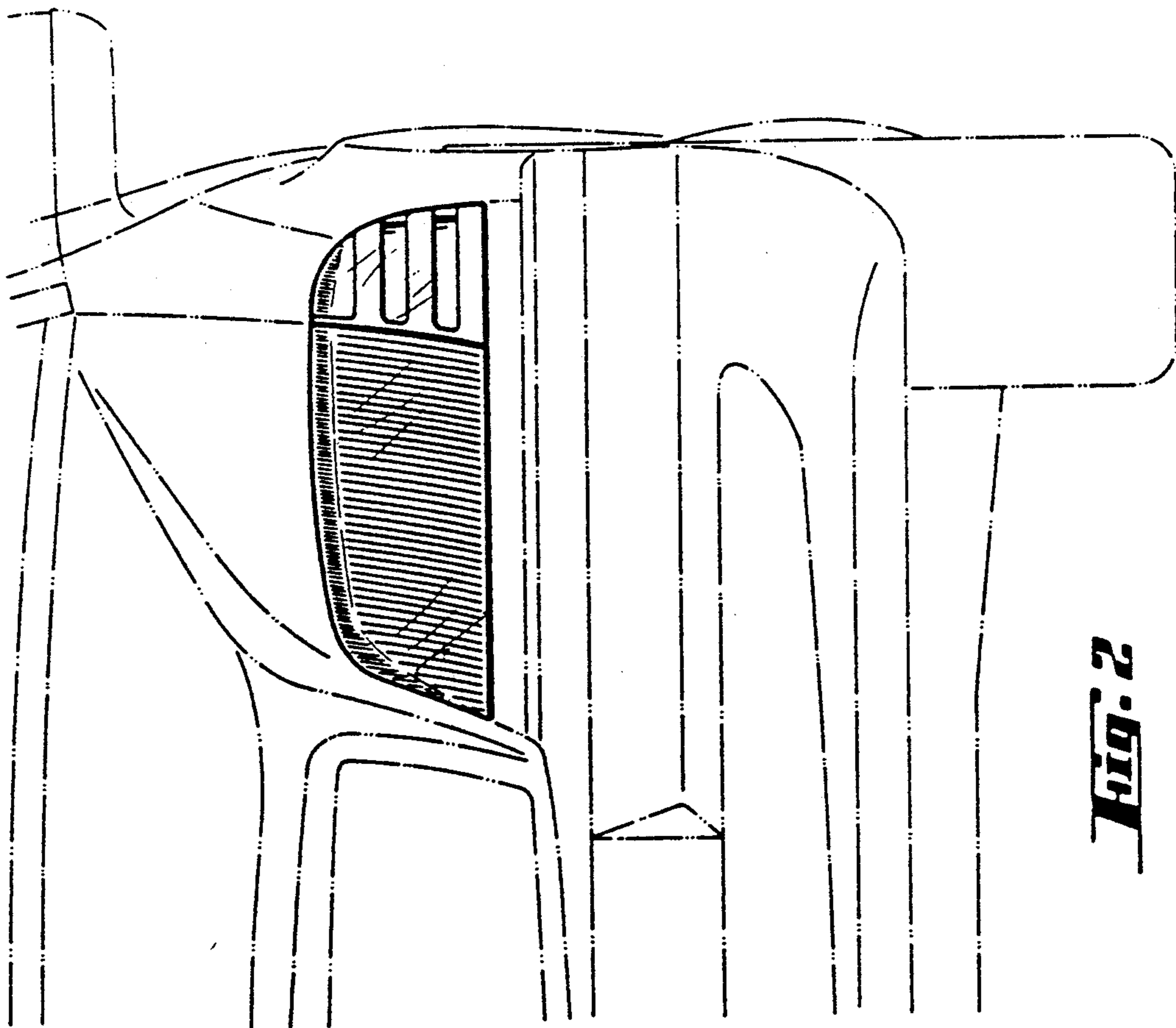

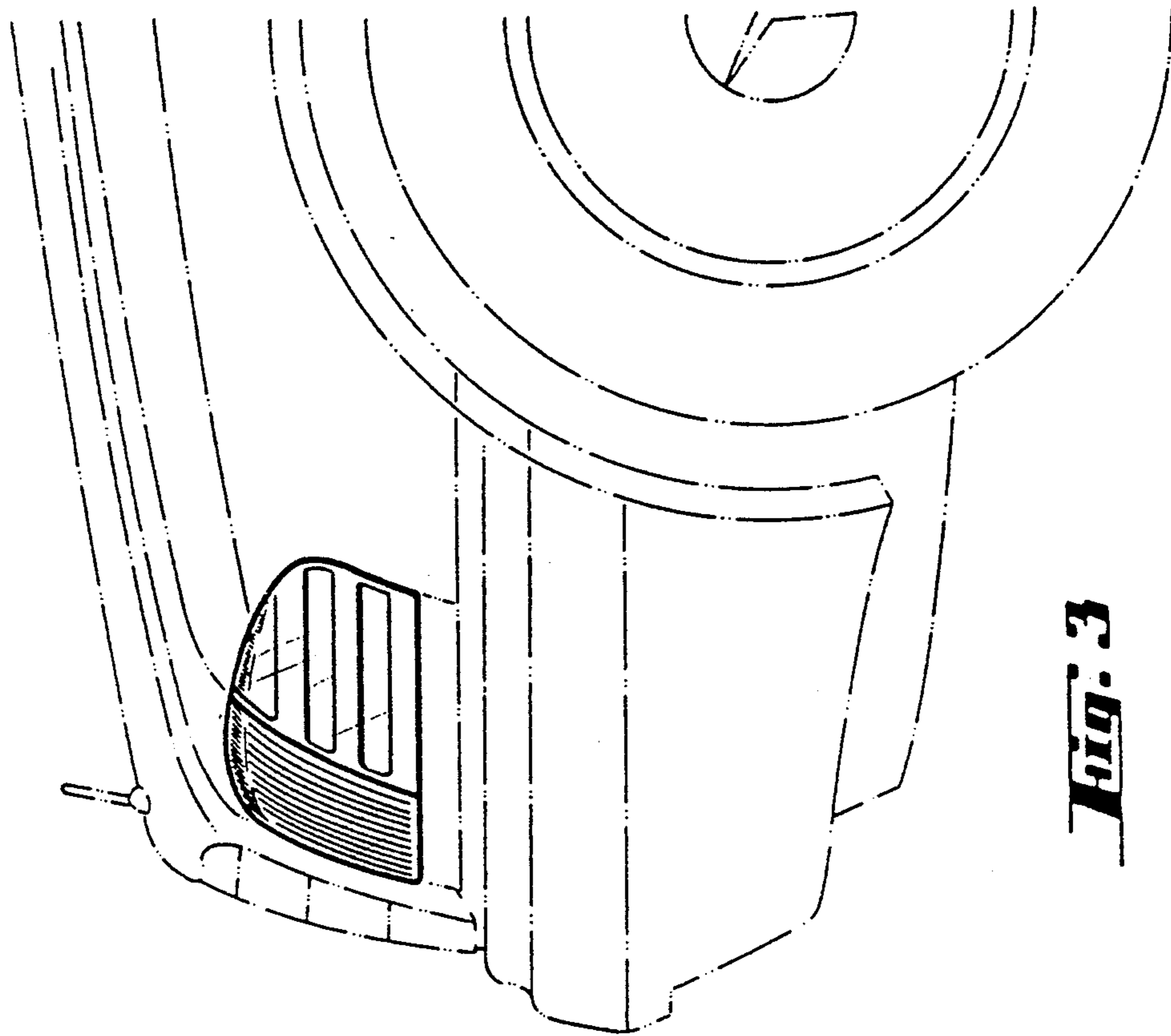

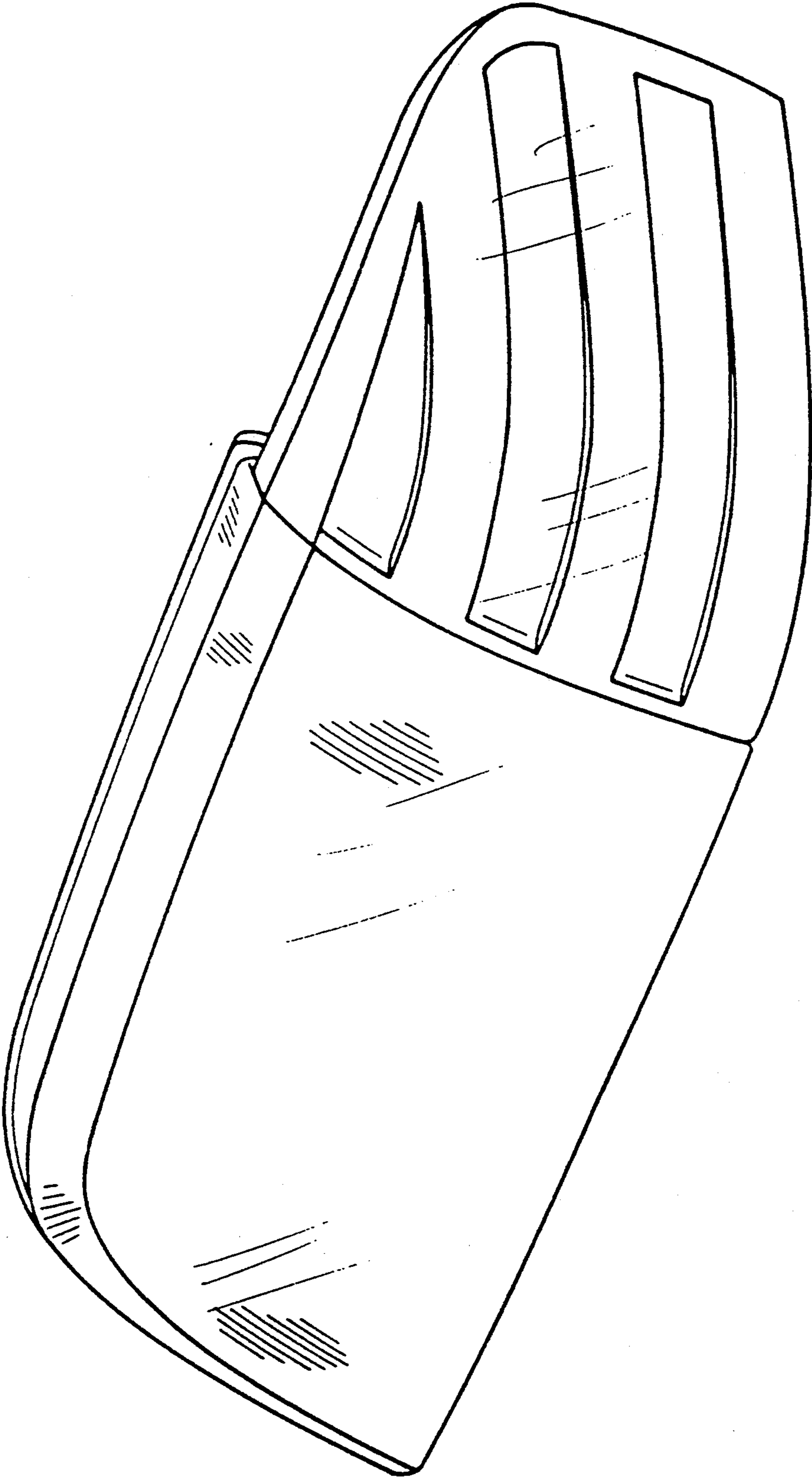

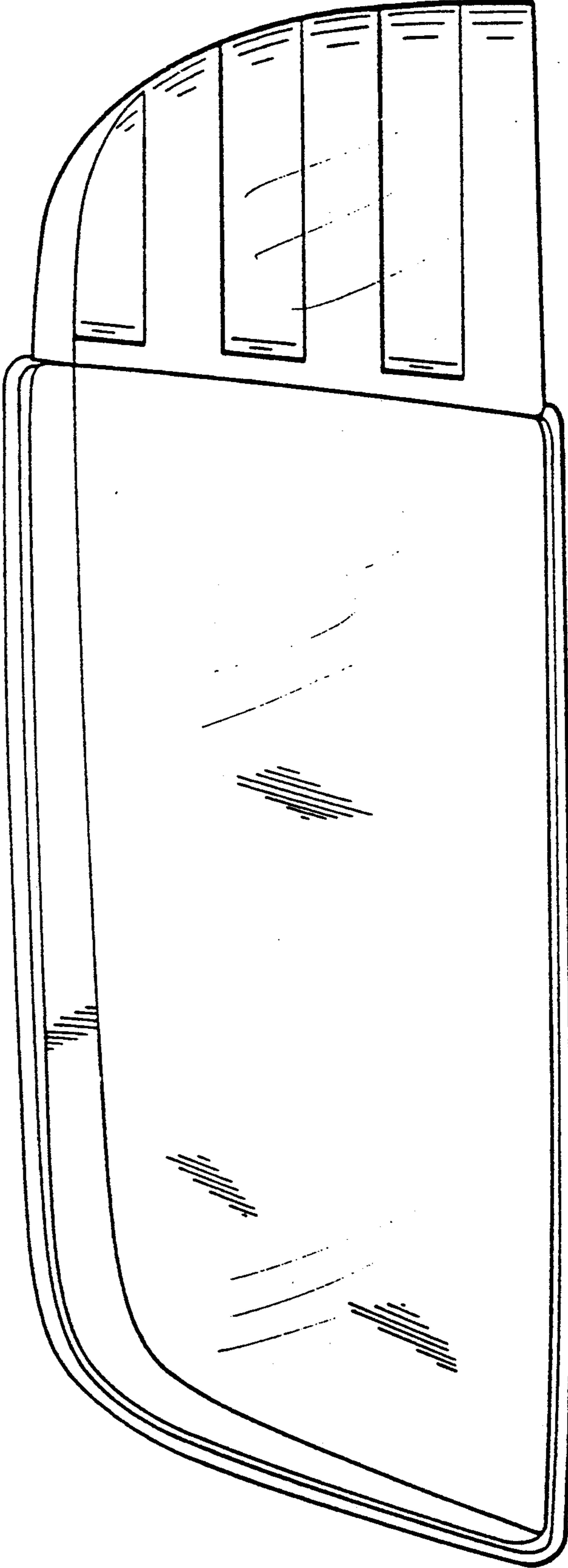

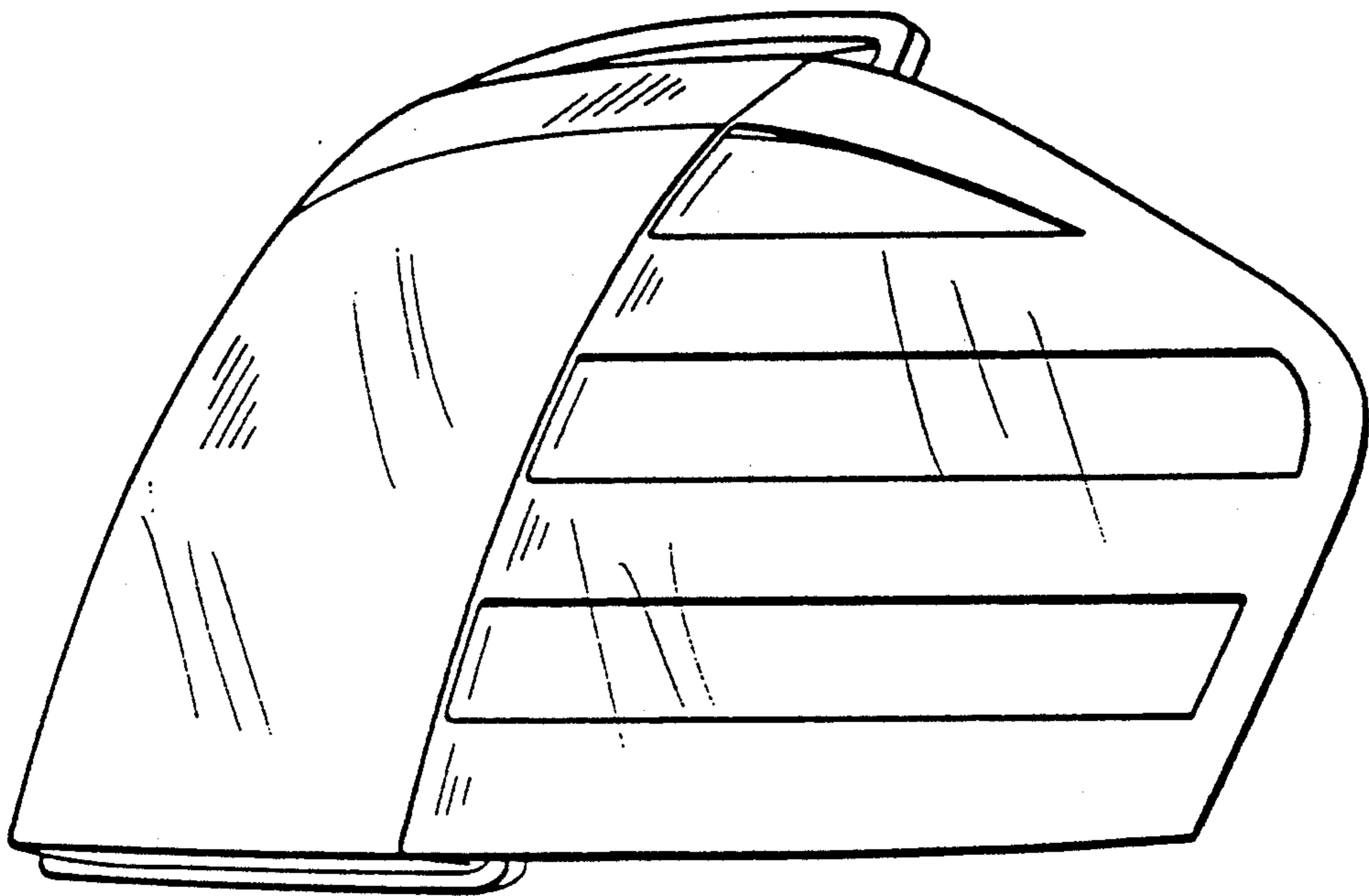

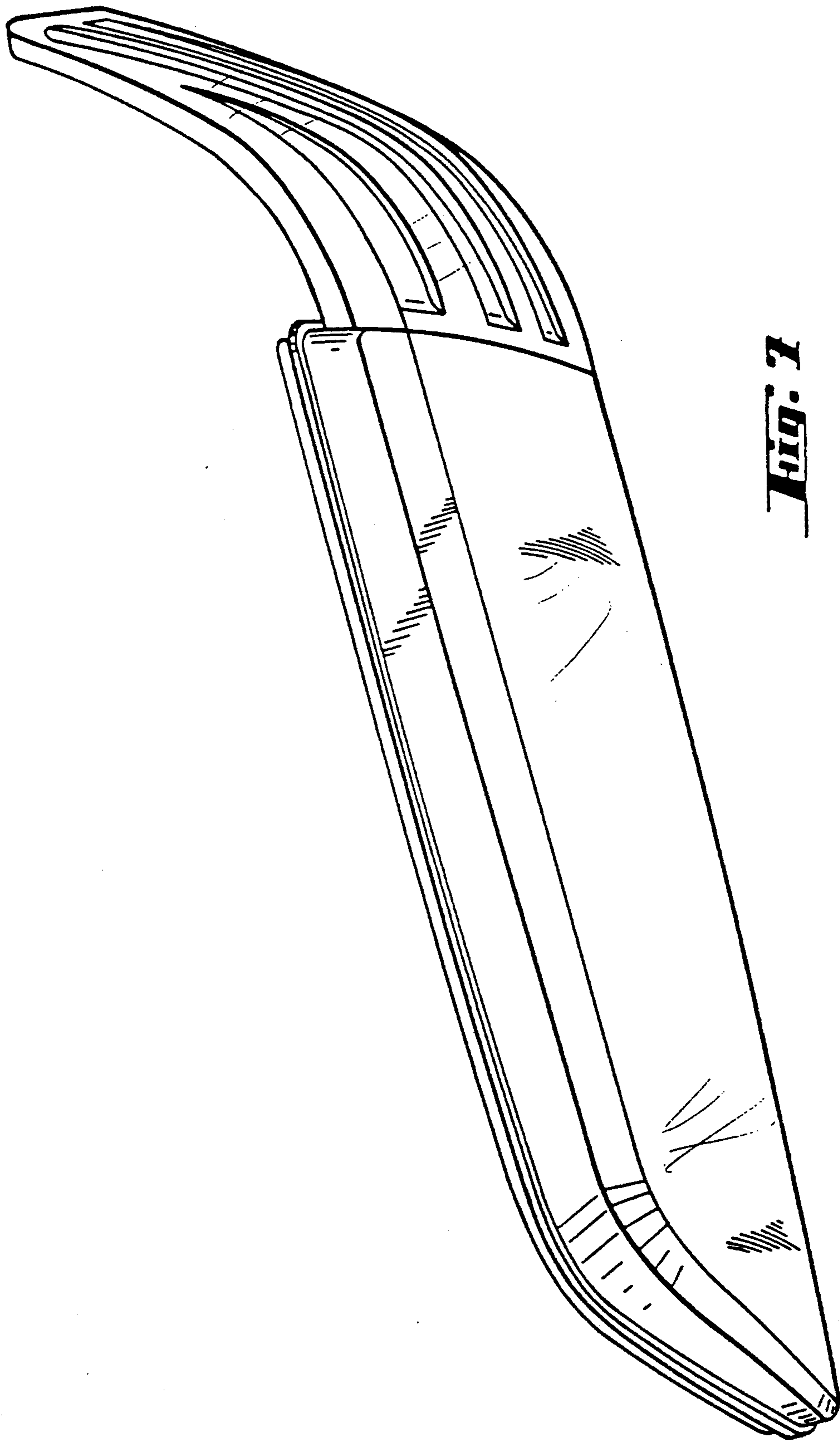
