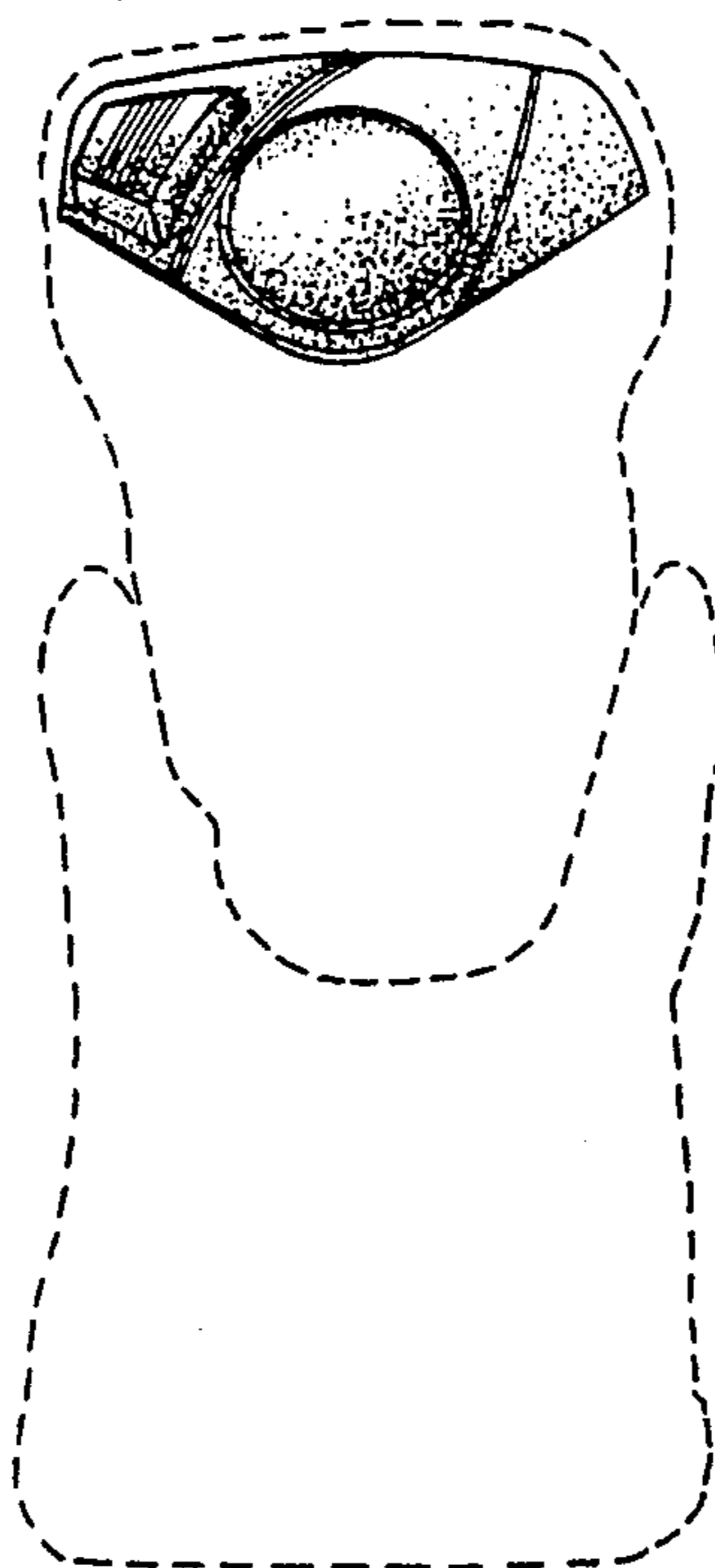
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

The broken line showing a shoe in the figures is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



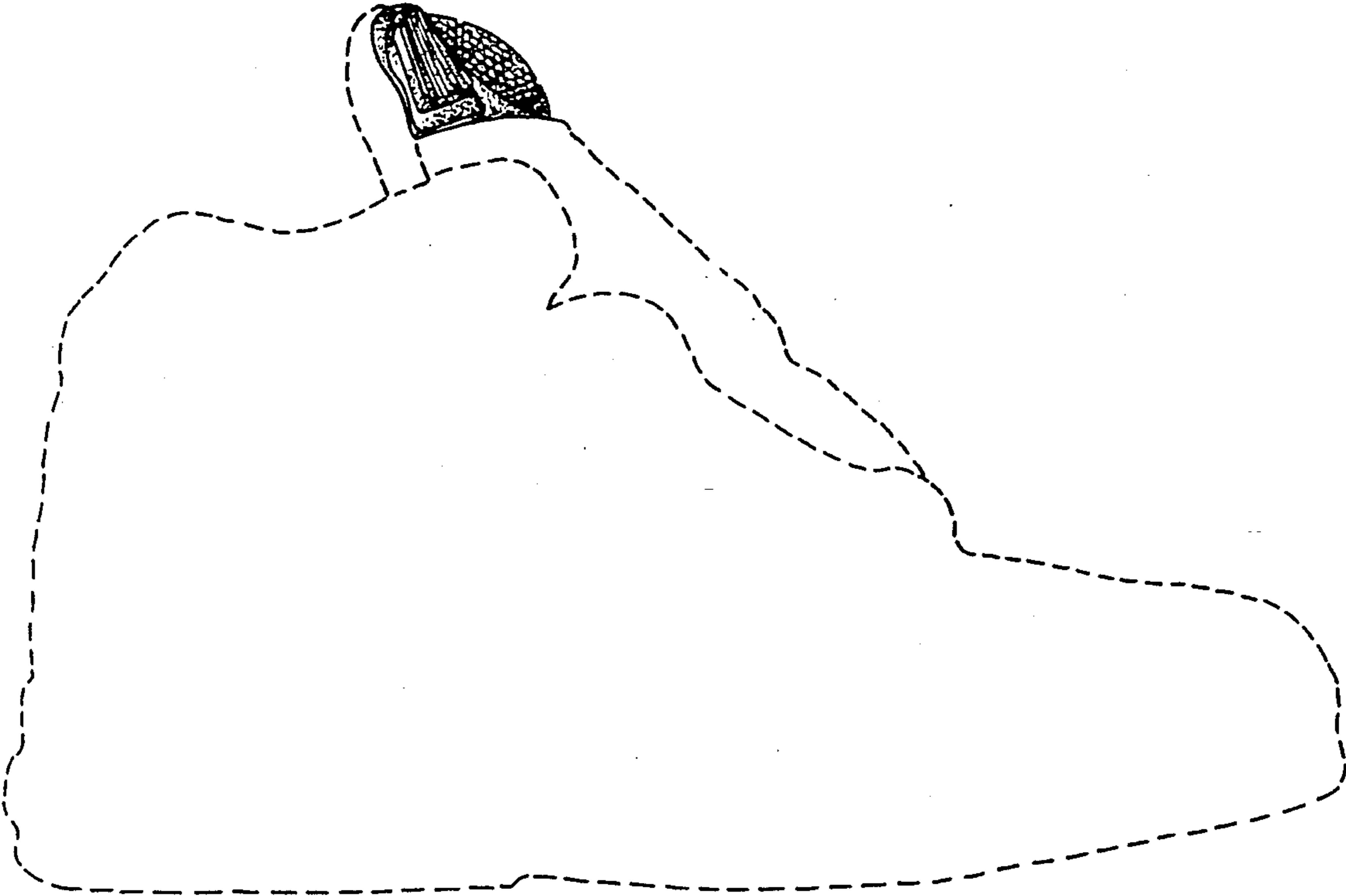

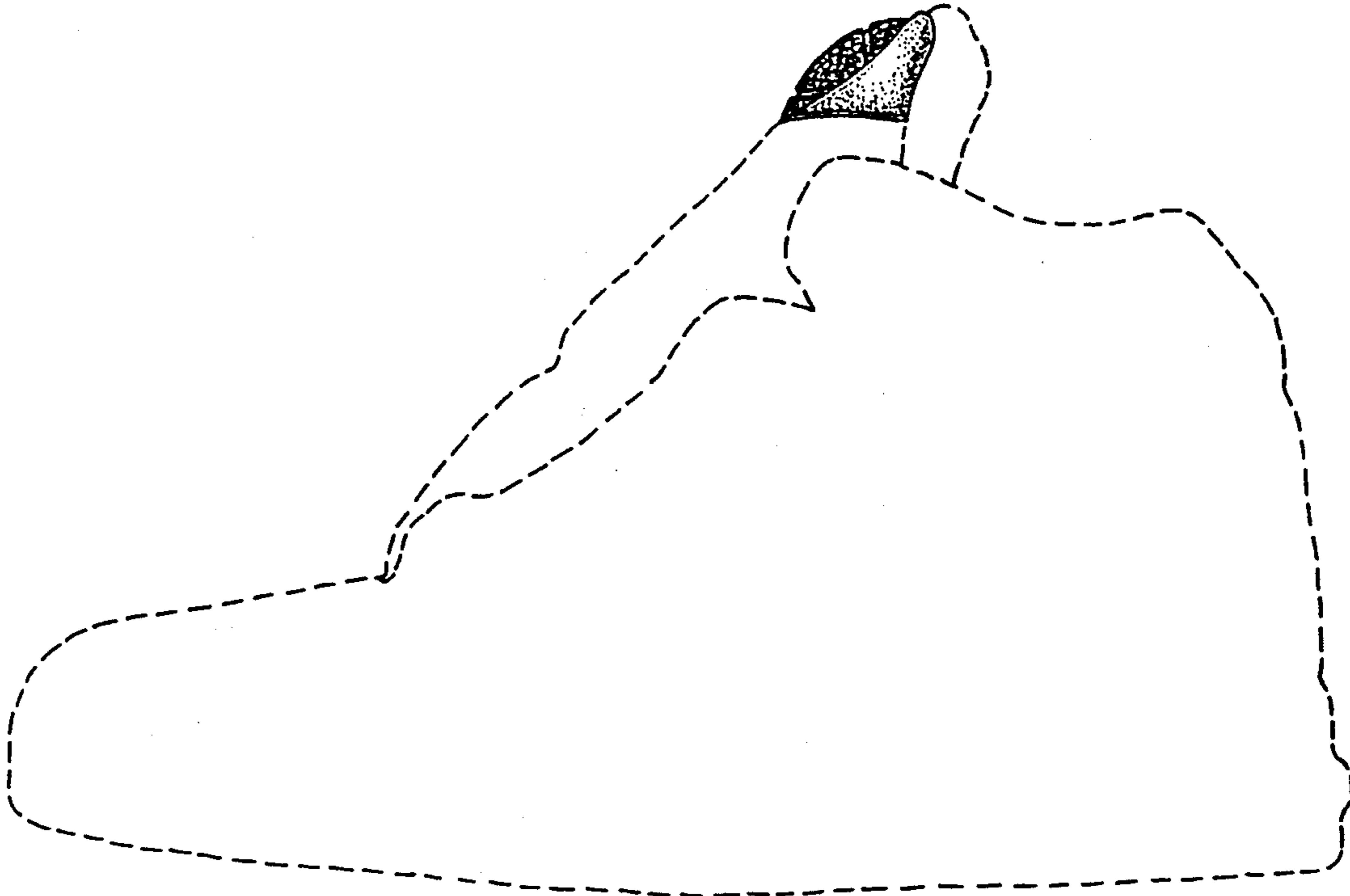

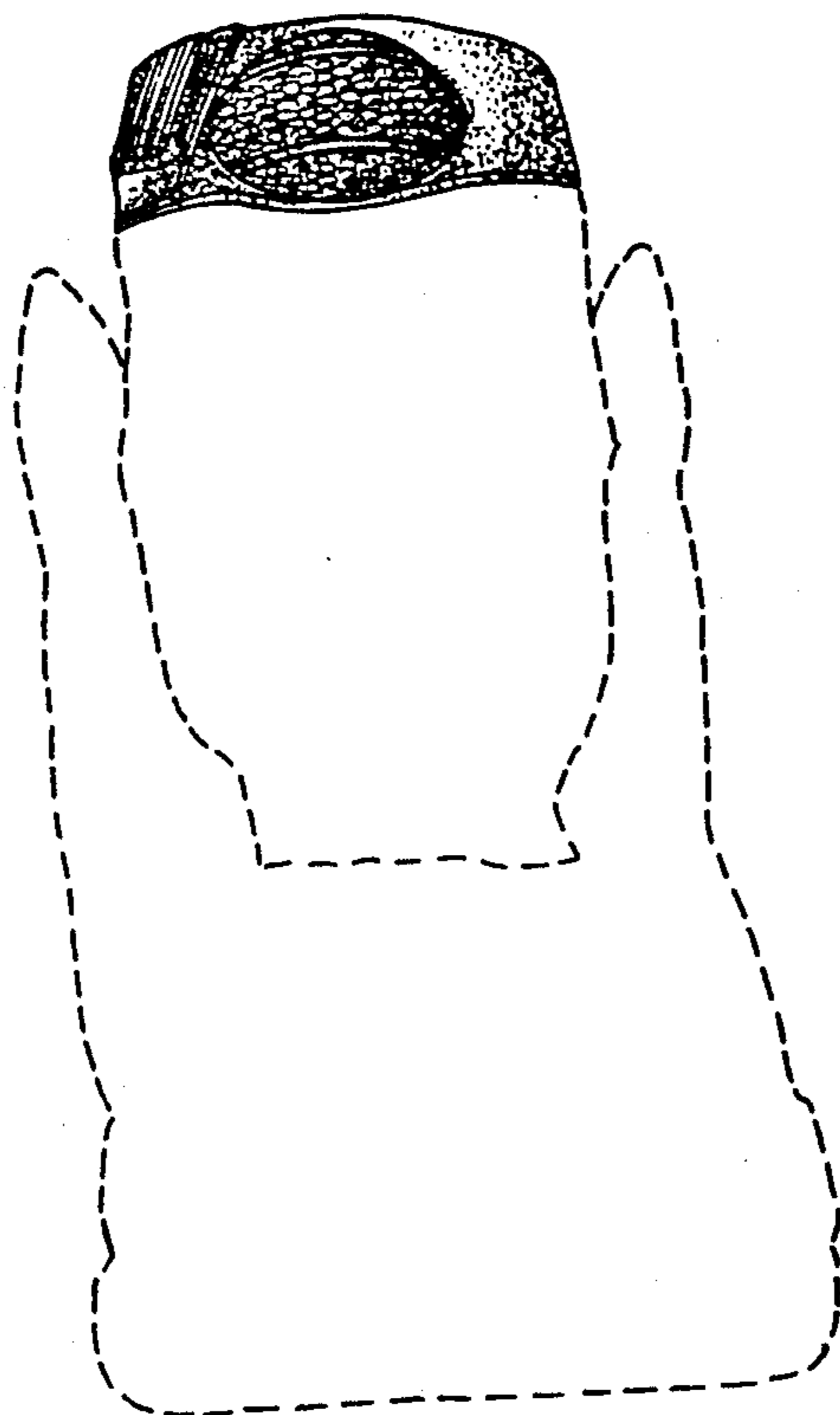

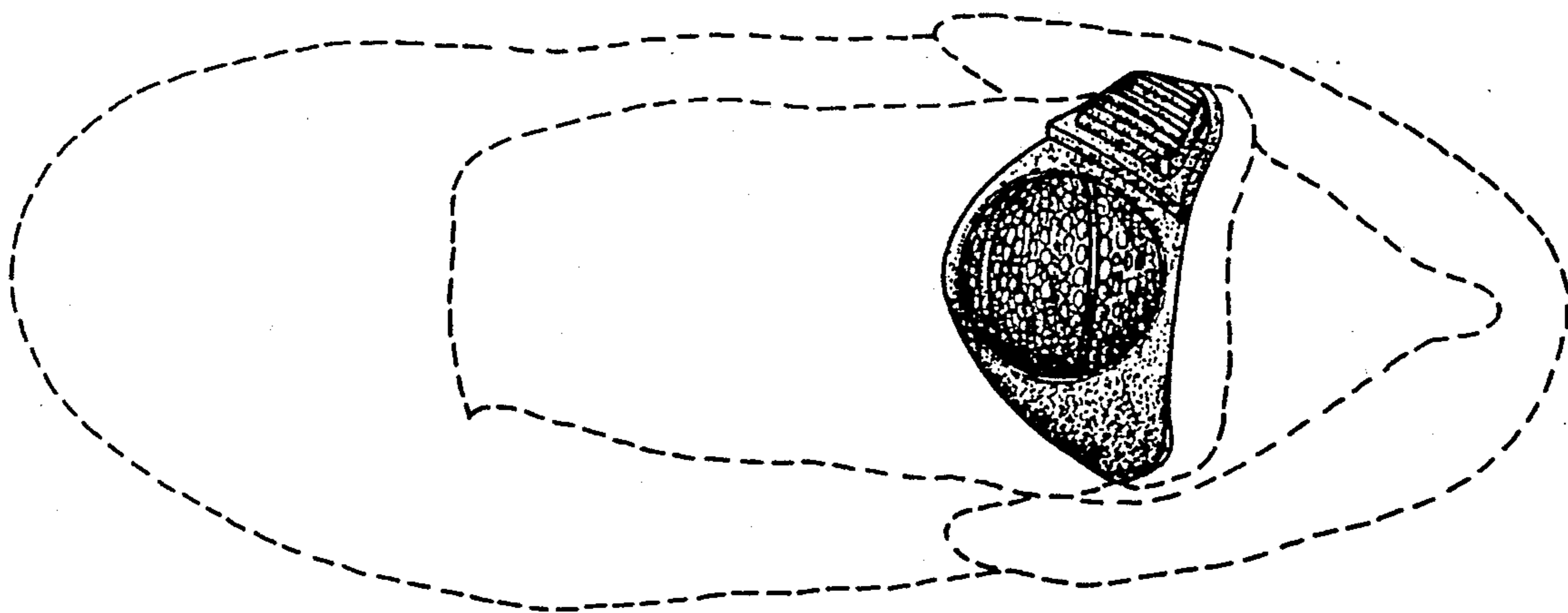

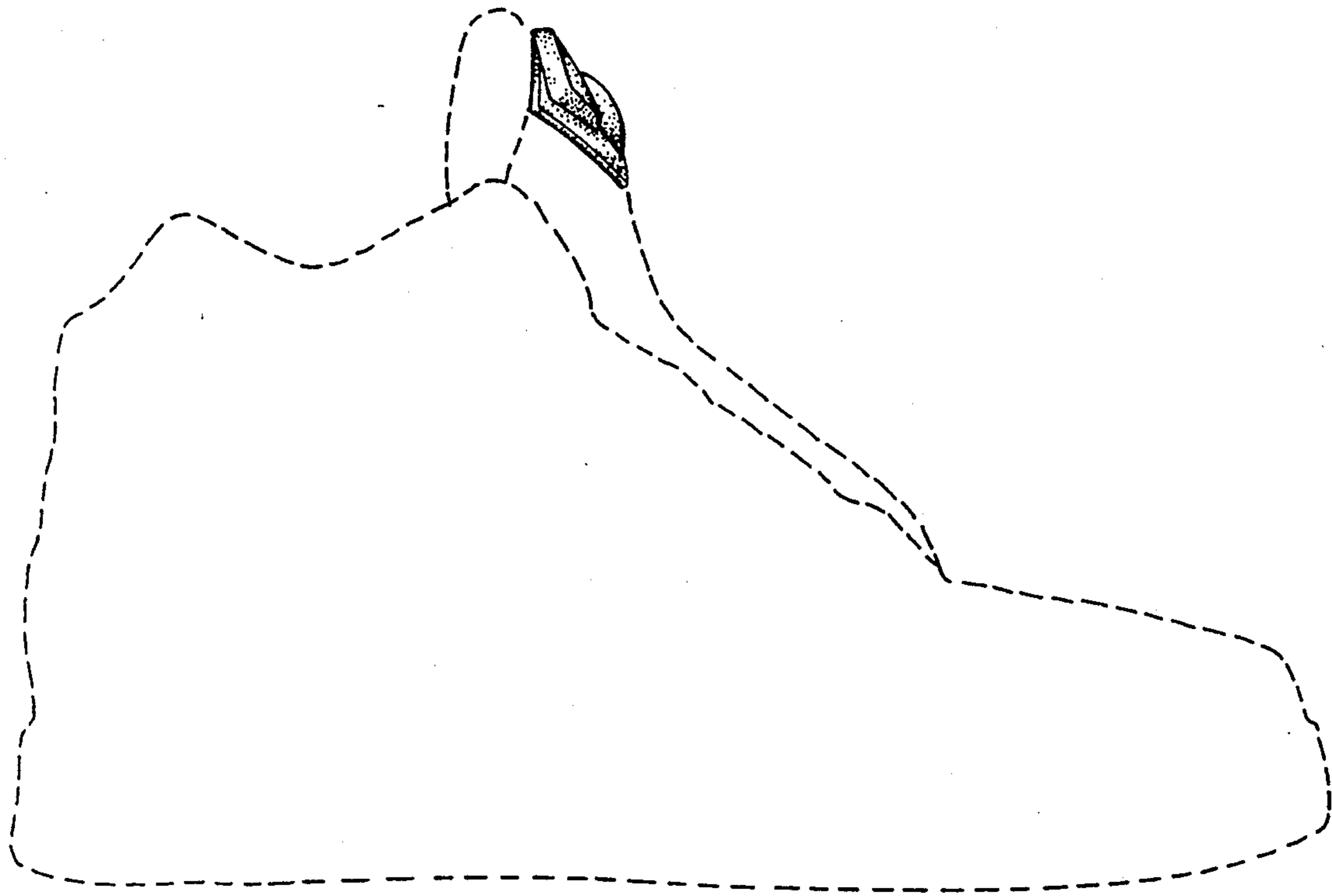

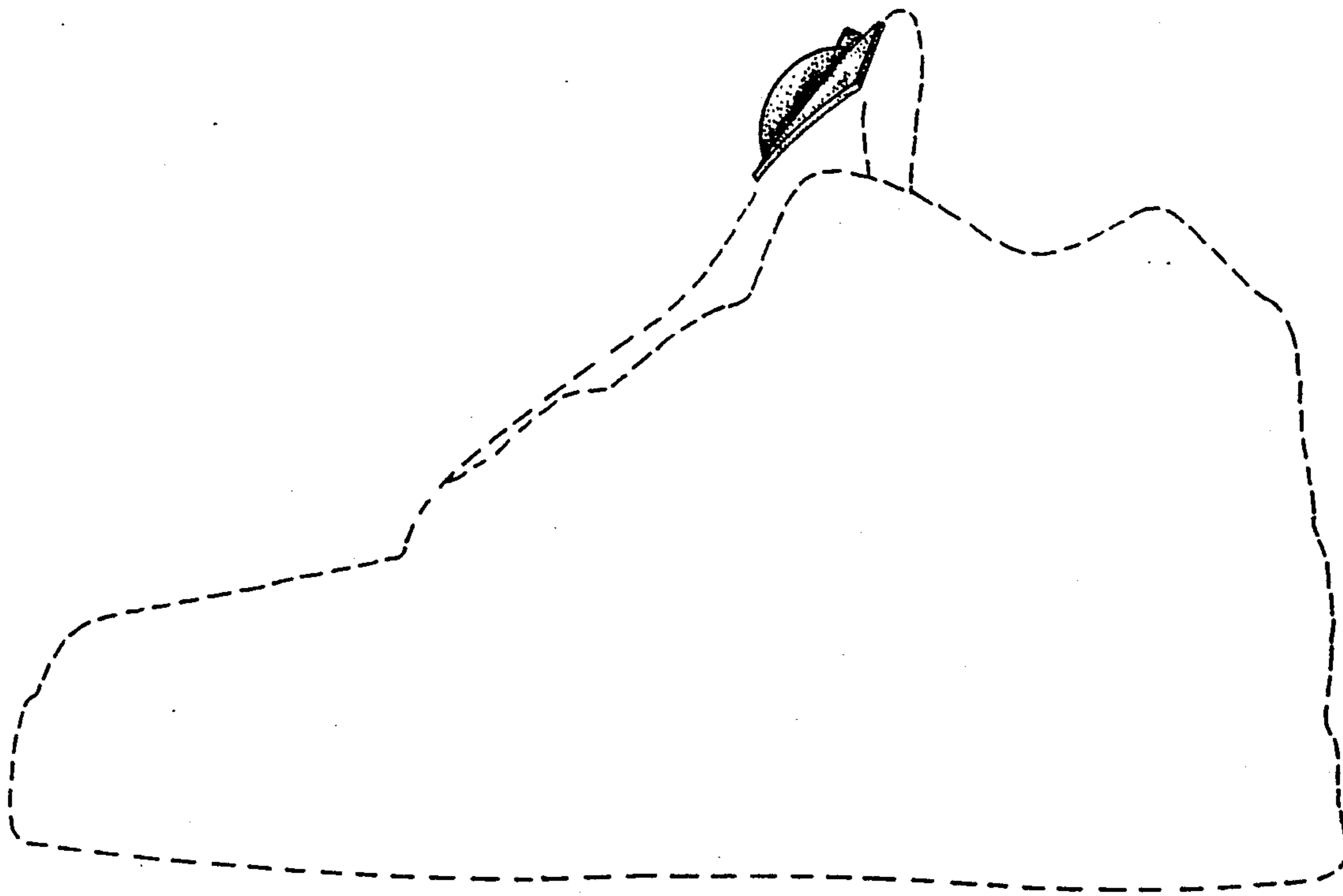

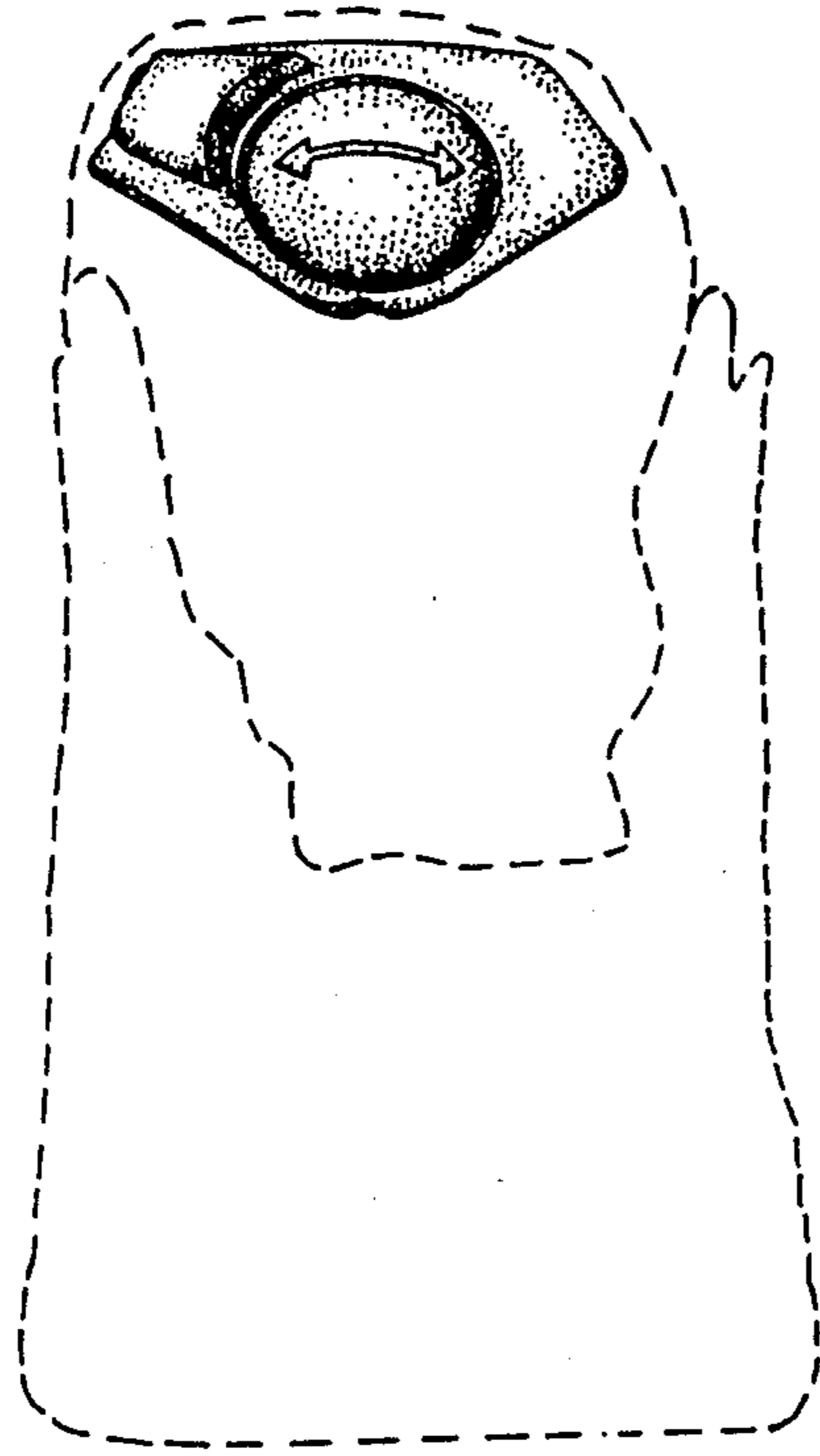

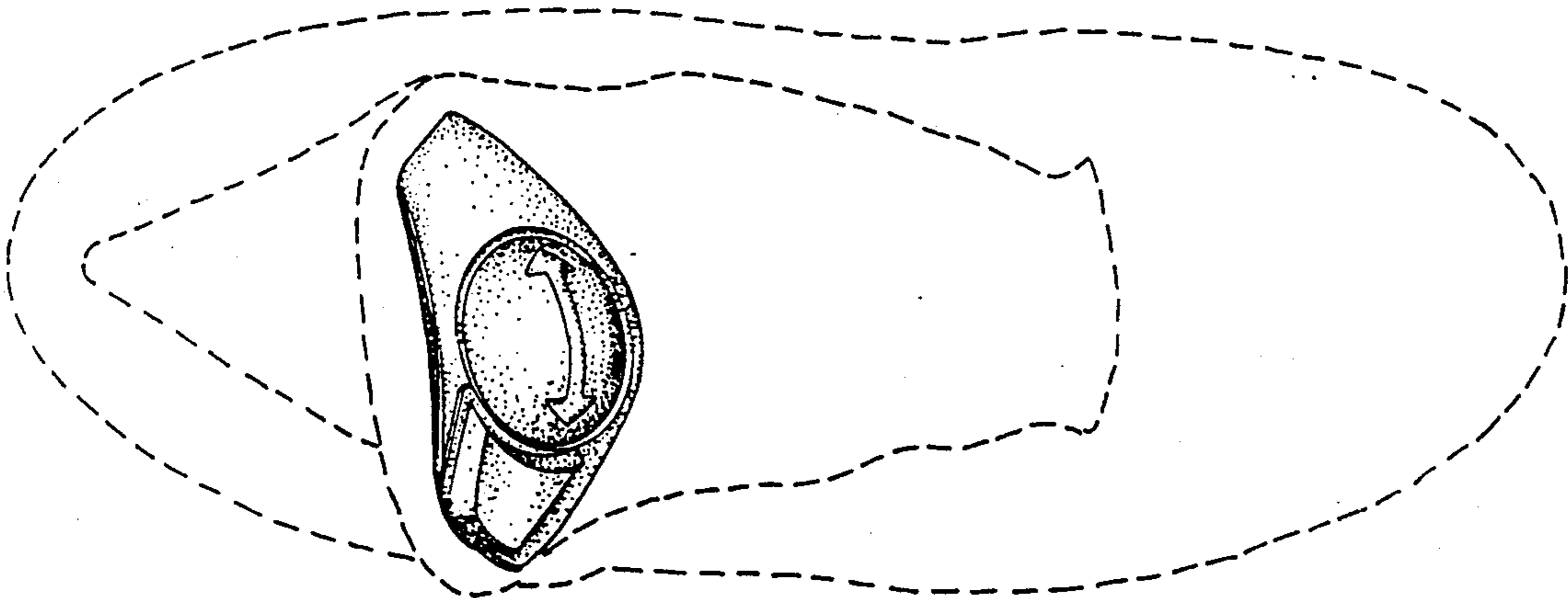

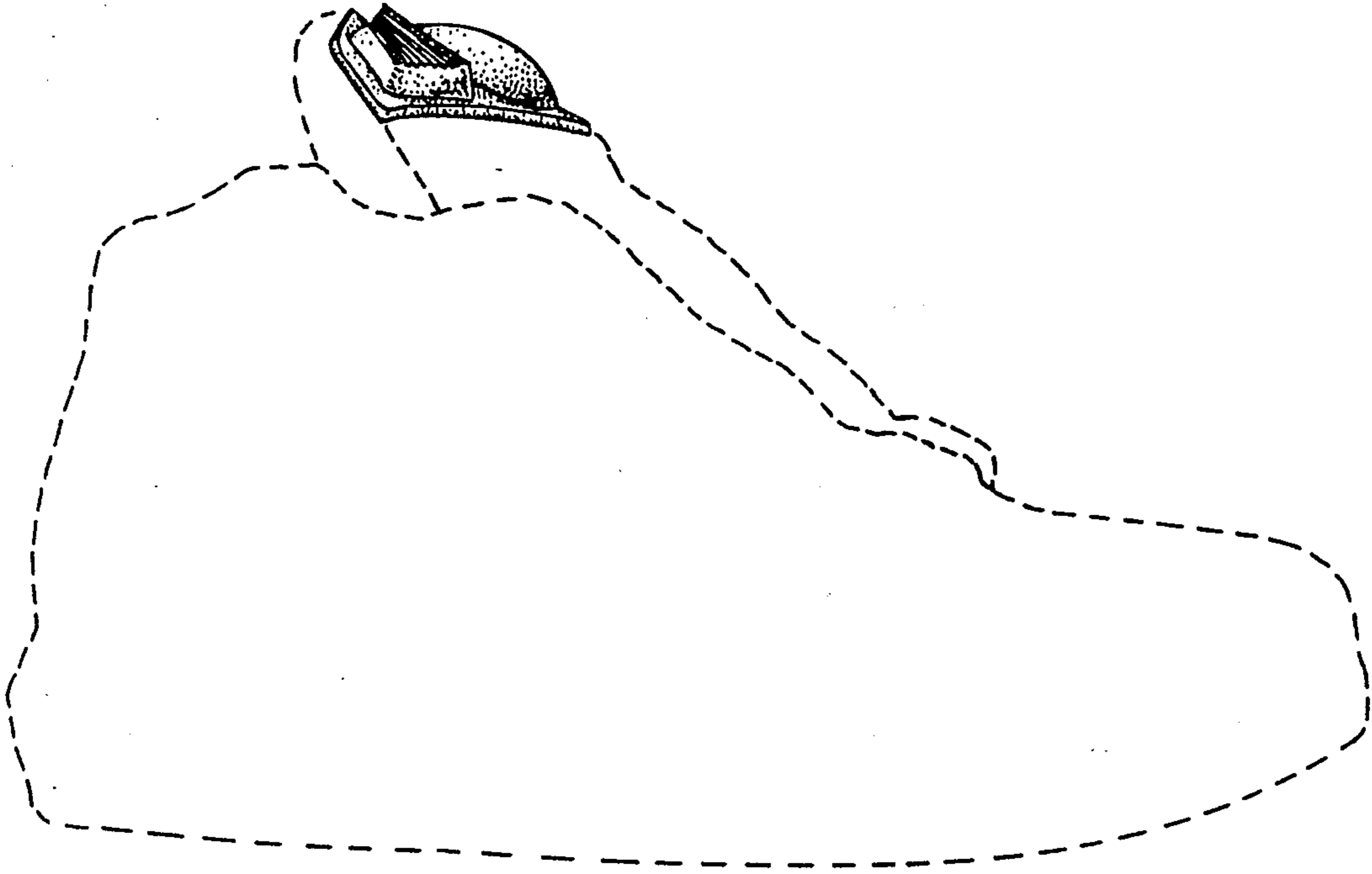

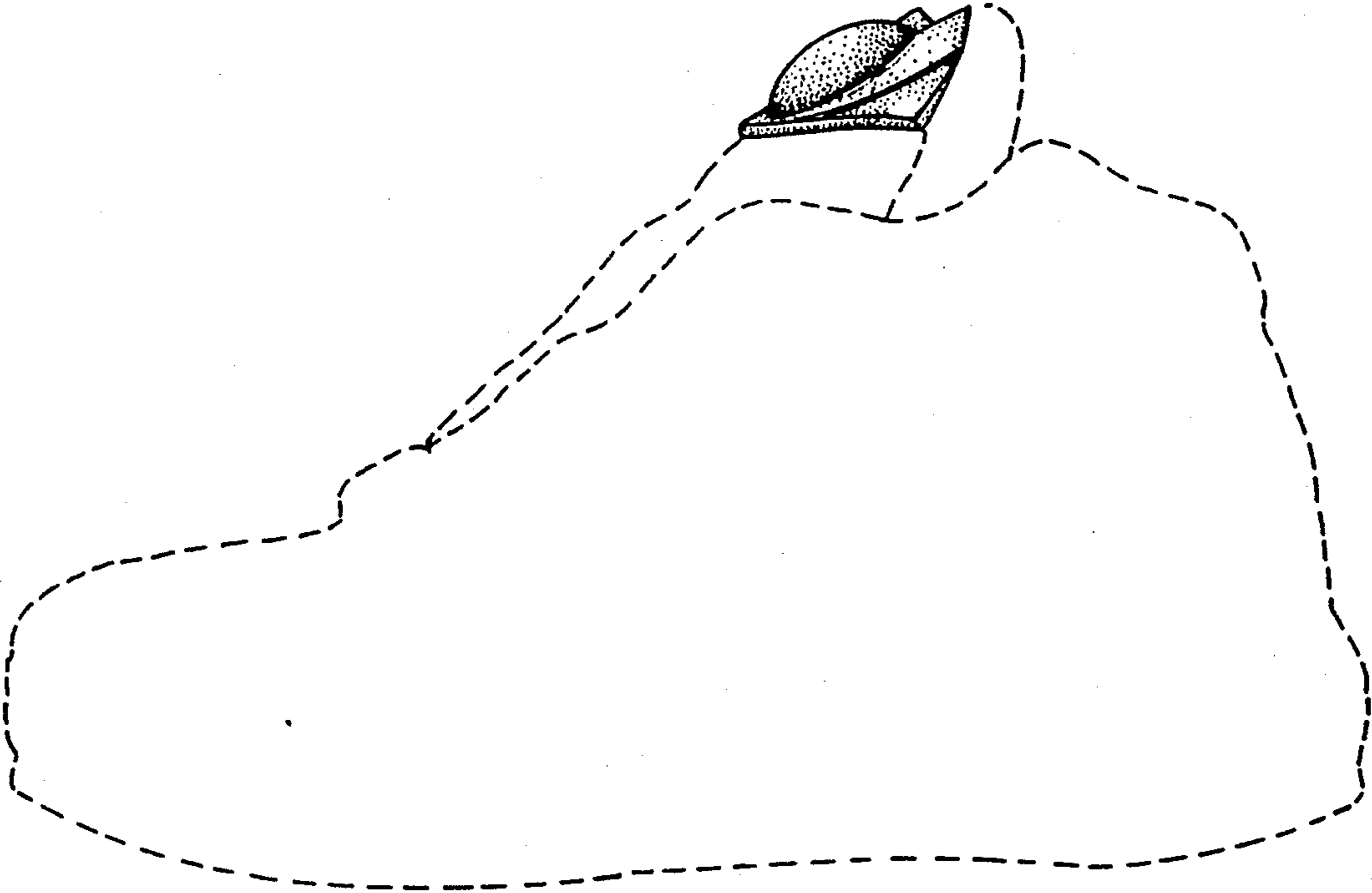

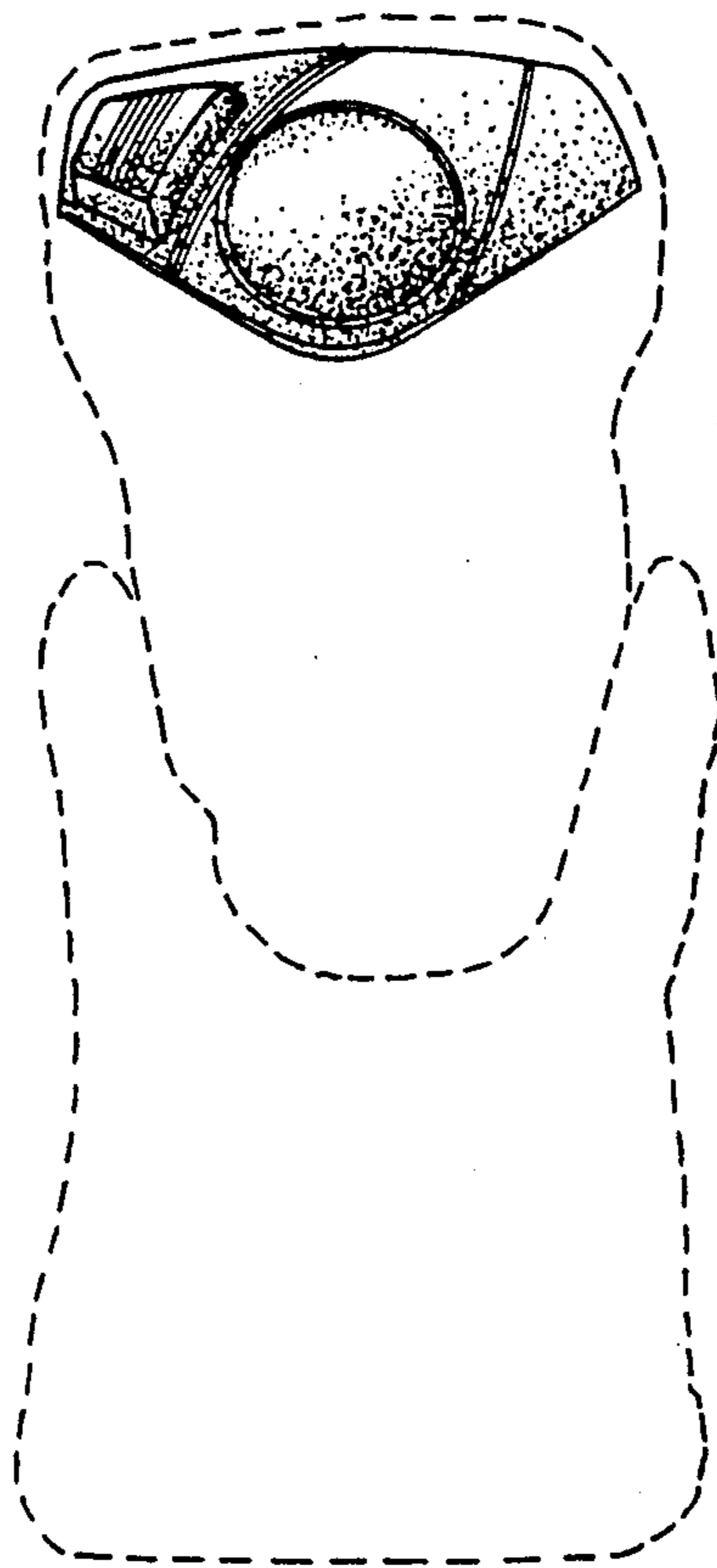

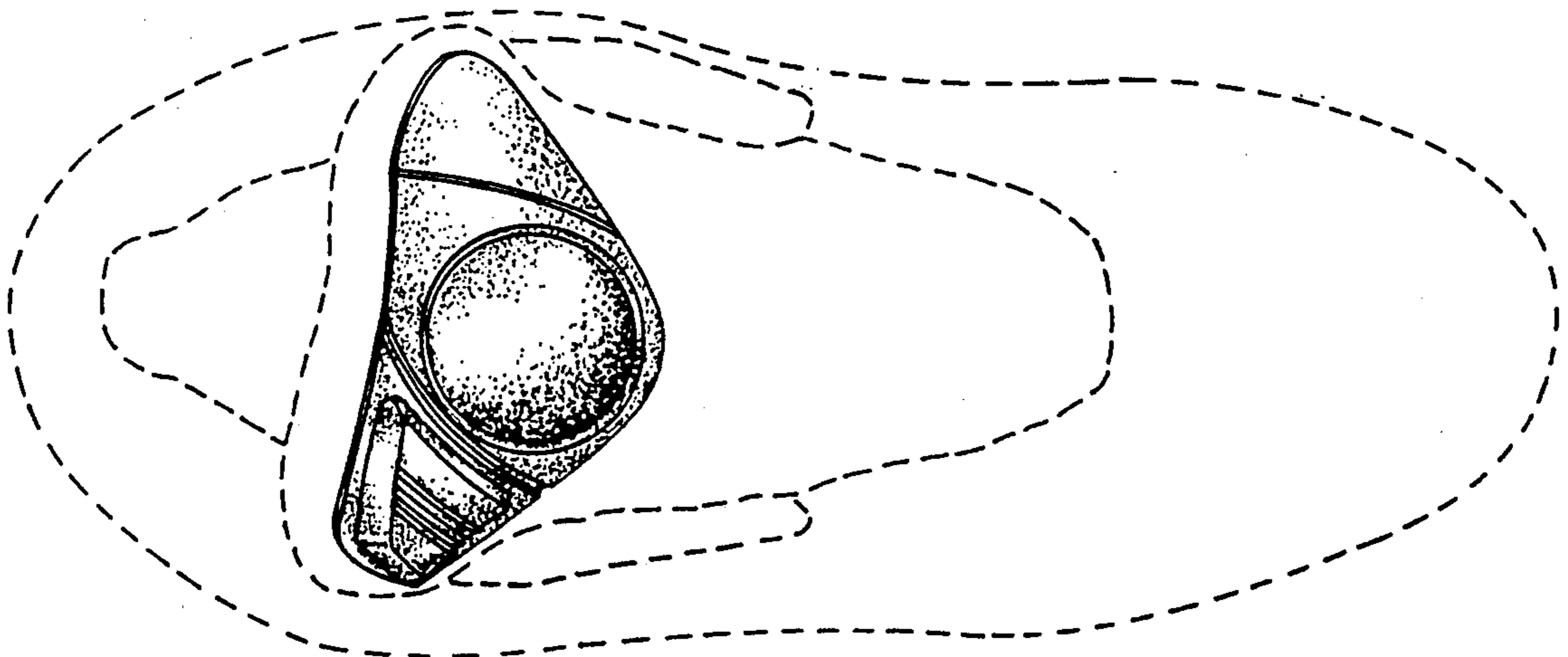
