FIG. 16 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 17 is a left side elevational view of an alternate embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 18 is a right side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 19 is a front elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 20 is a top plan view thereof.


The broken line showing a shoe in the figures is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.









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







