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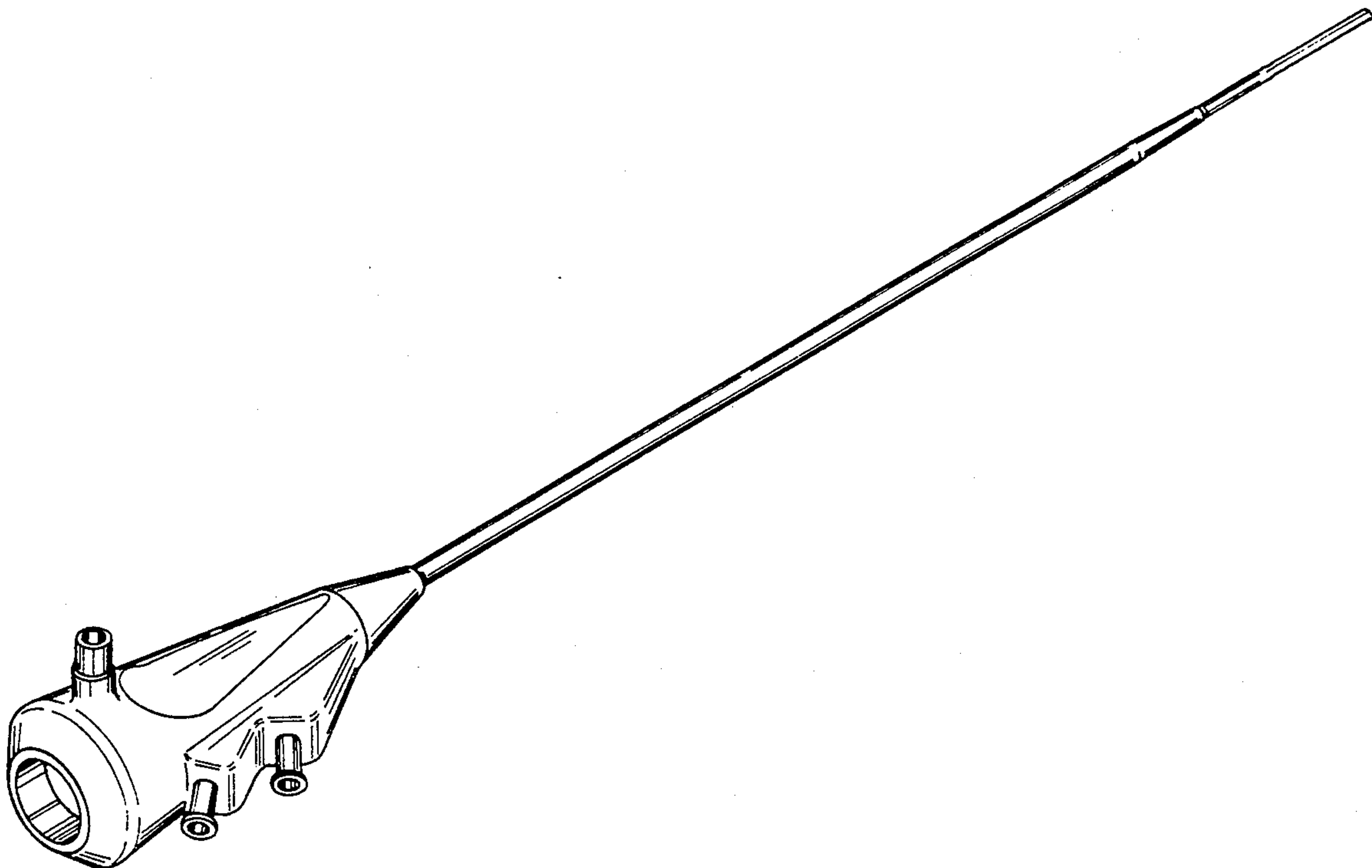

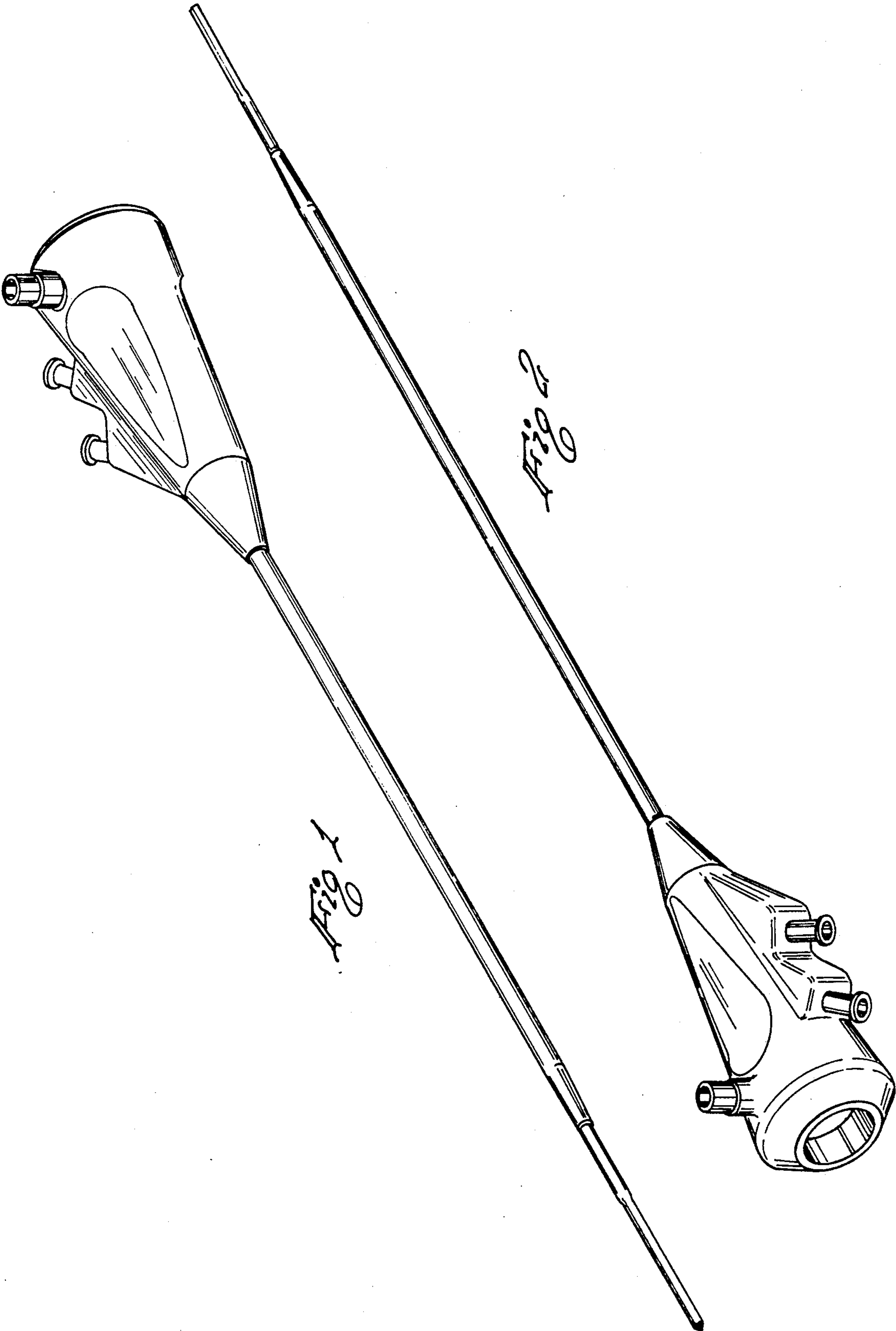

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a mini-rigid ureteroscope showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view of a mini-rigid ureteroscope or the like showing my new design;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view with the tube broken away for ease of illustration;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view thereof.





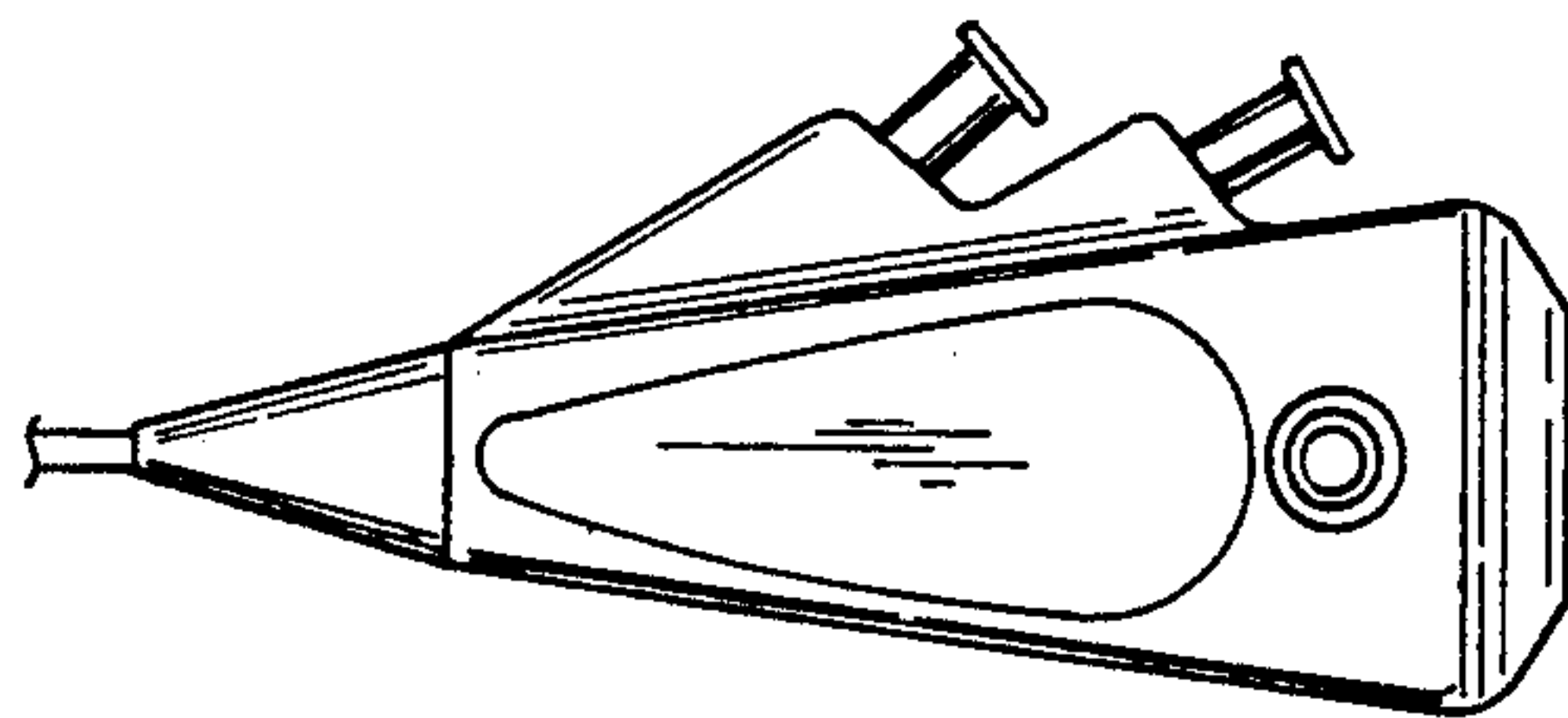

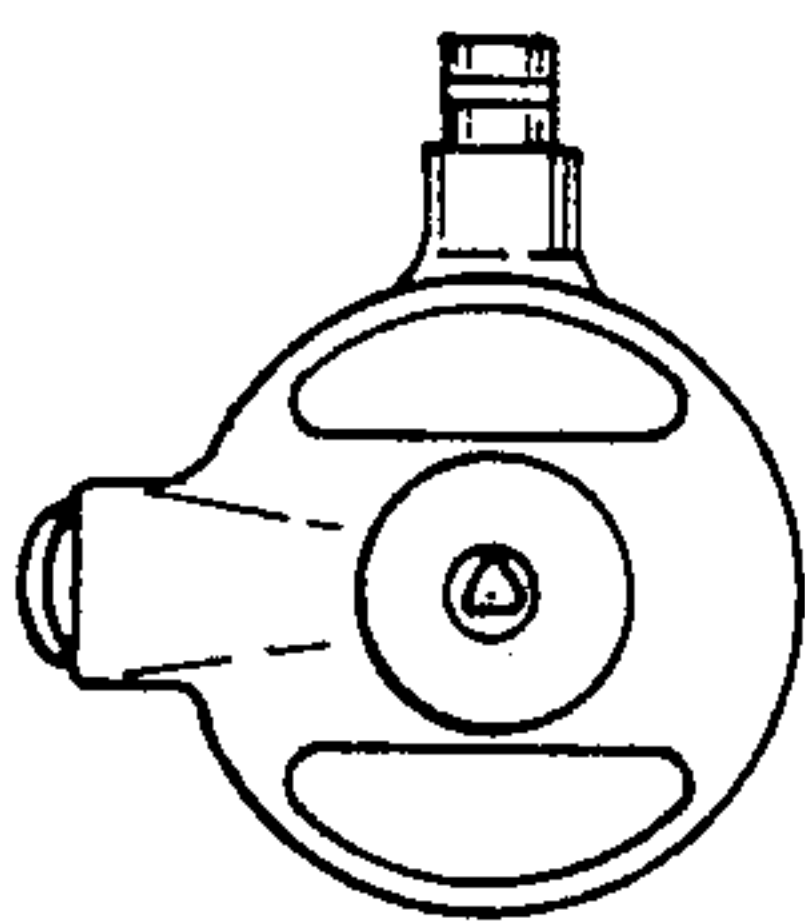

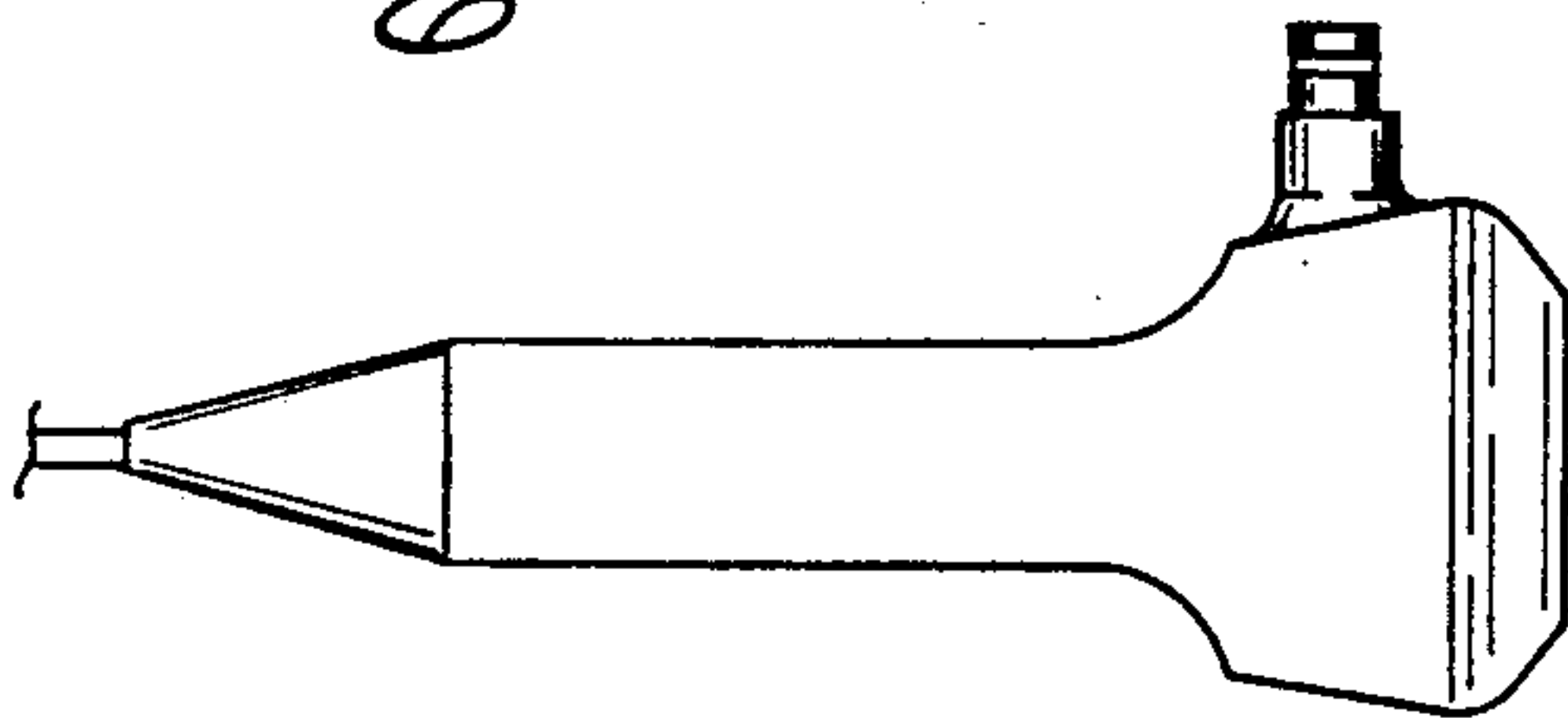

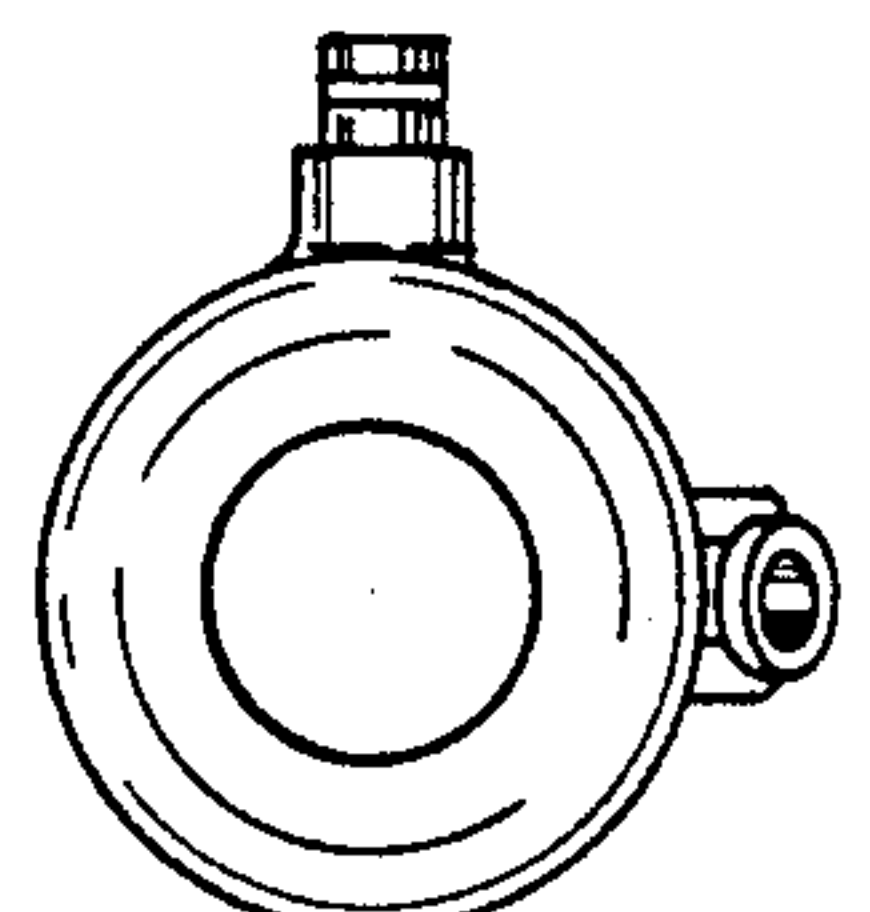

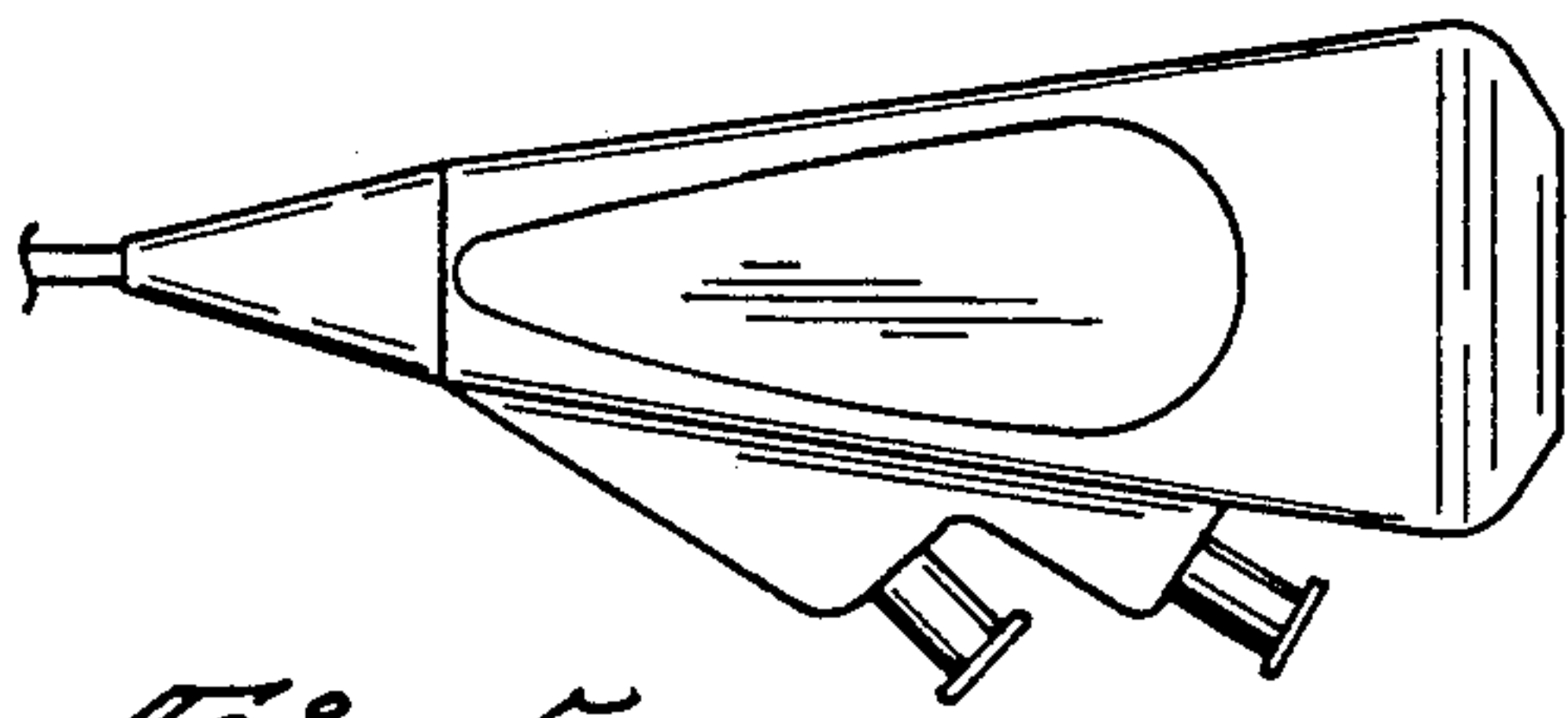

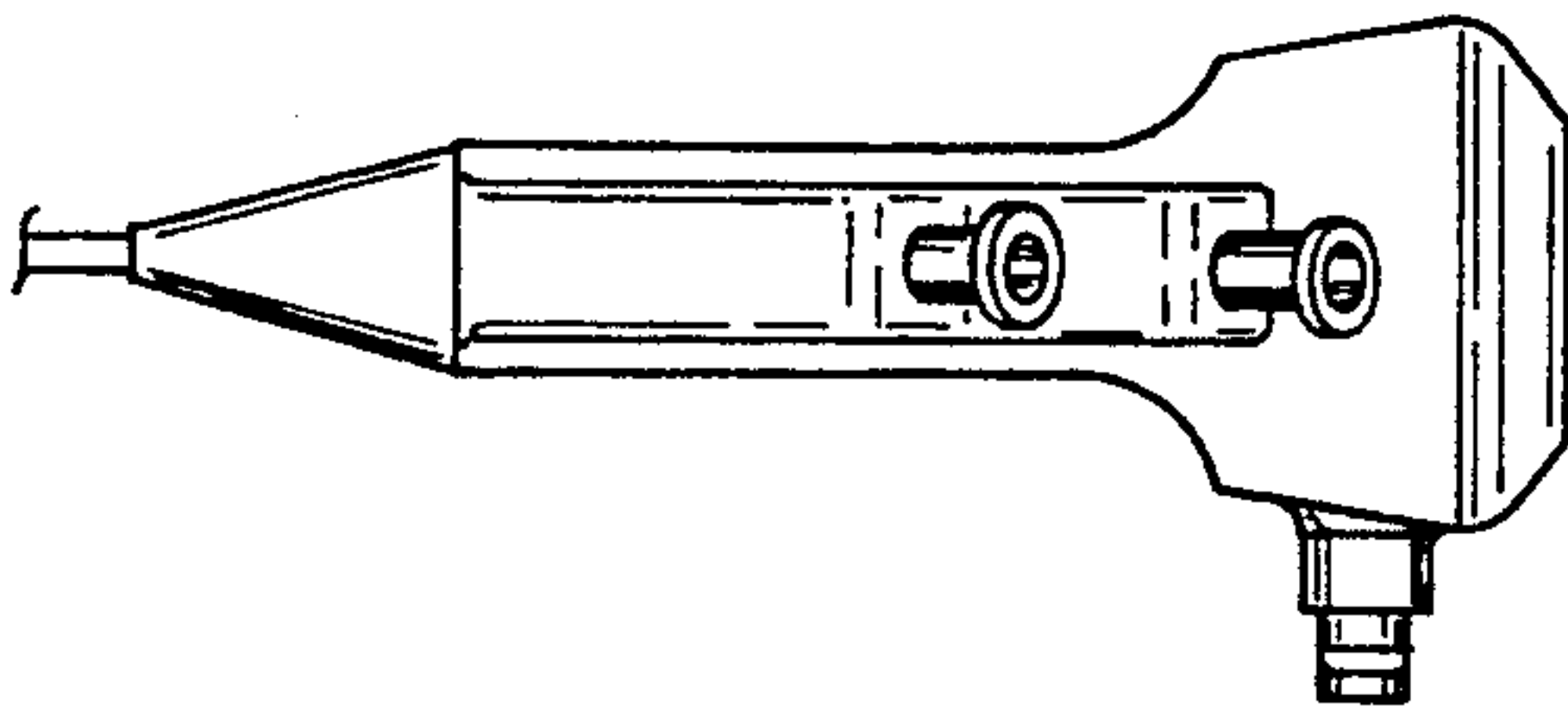
