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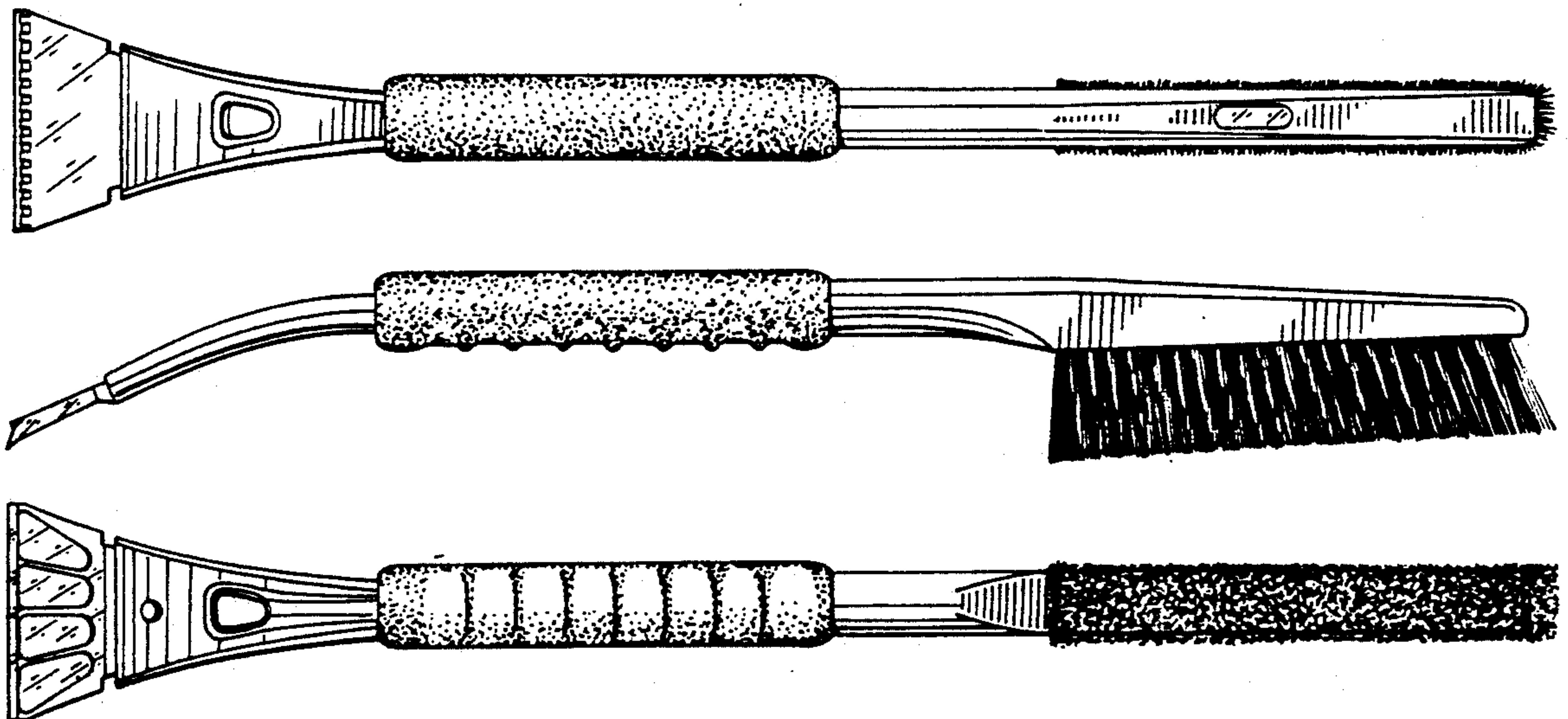

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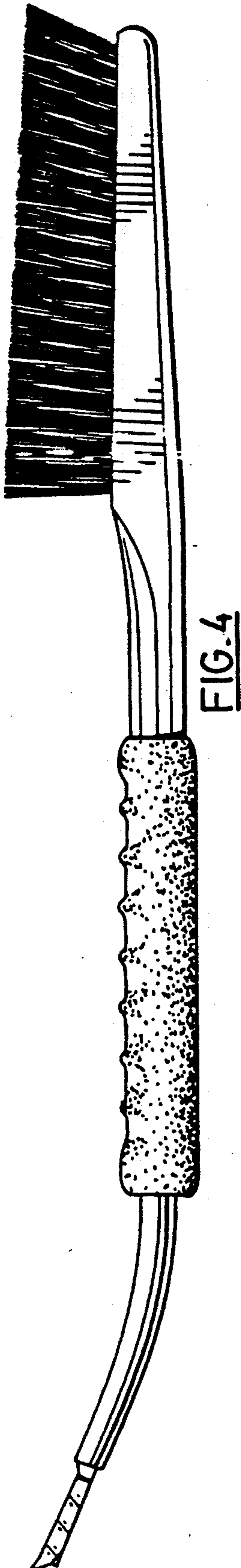
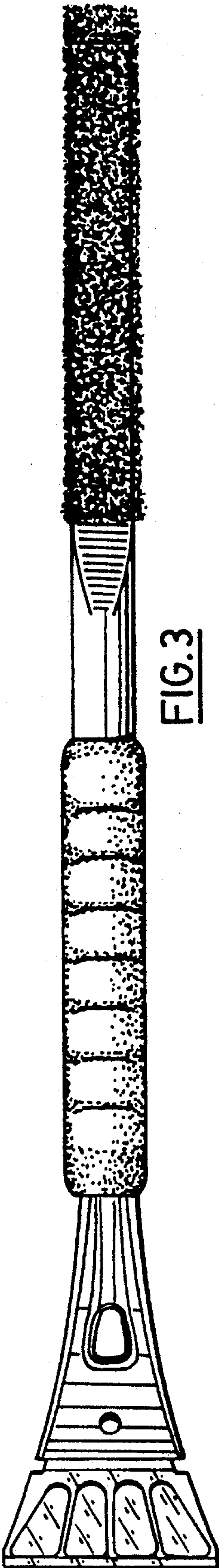
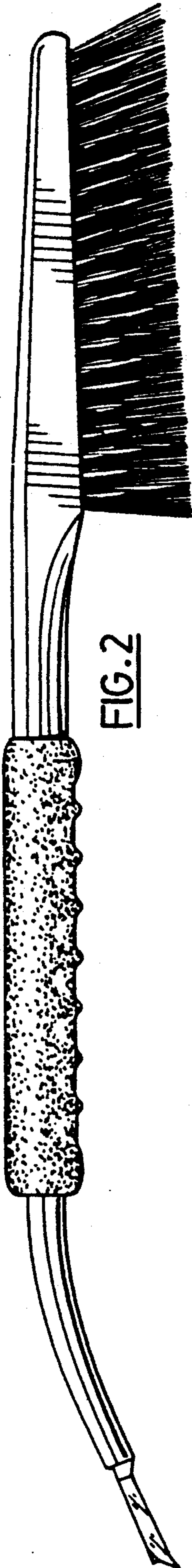
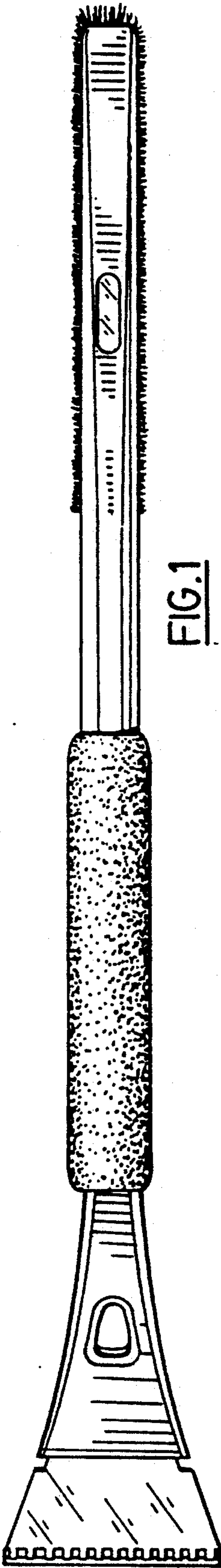

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combination snow brush
and ice scraper showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevation showing the opposite side to
that illustrated in FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is an end view of a first end thereof; and,

trated in FIG. 5.





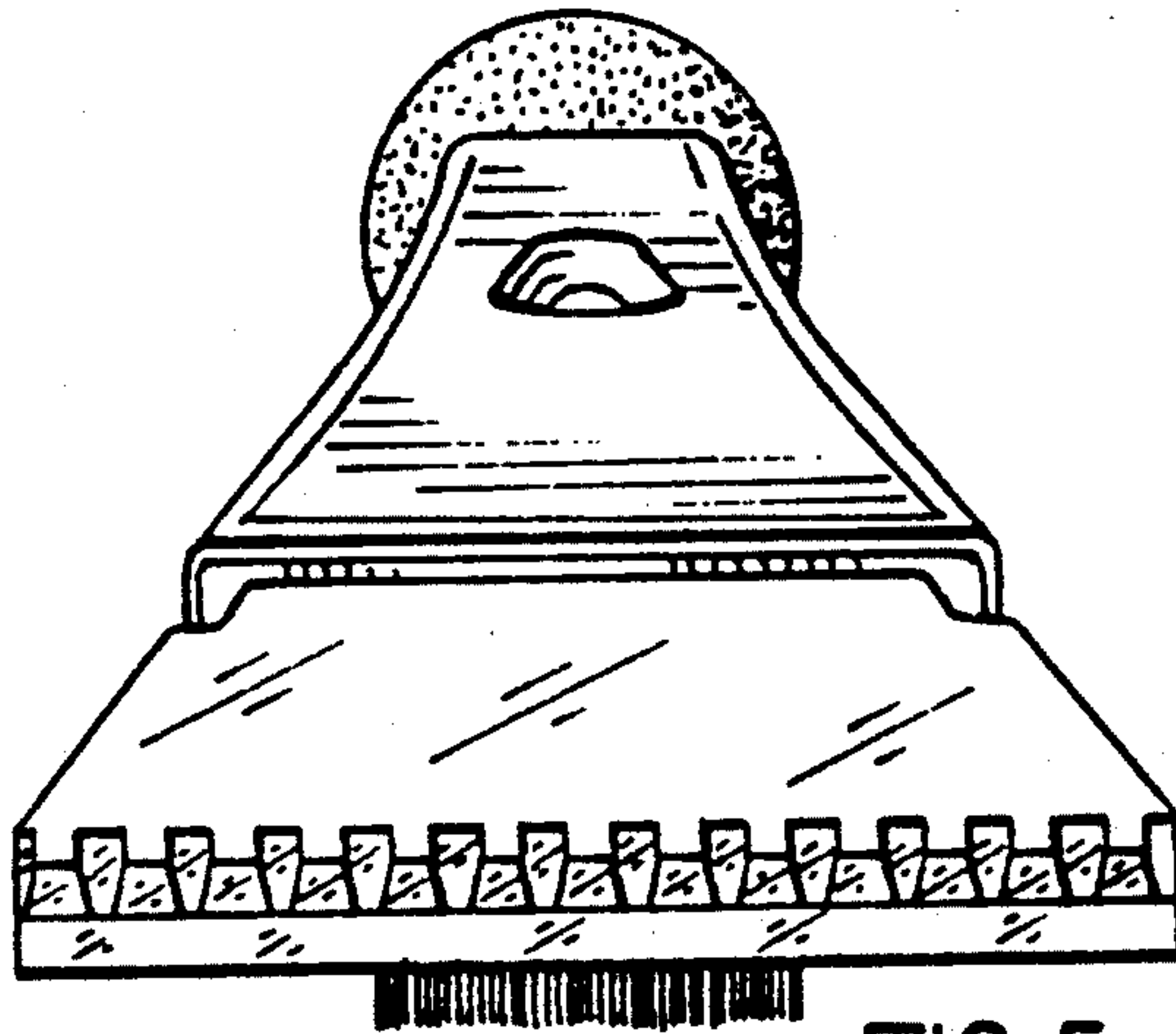

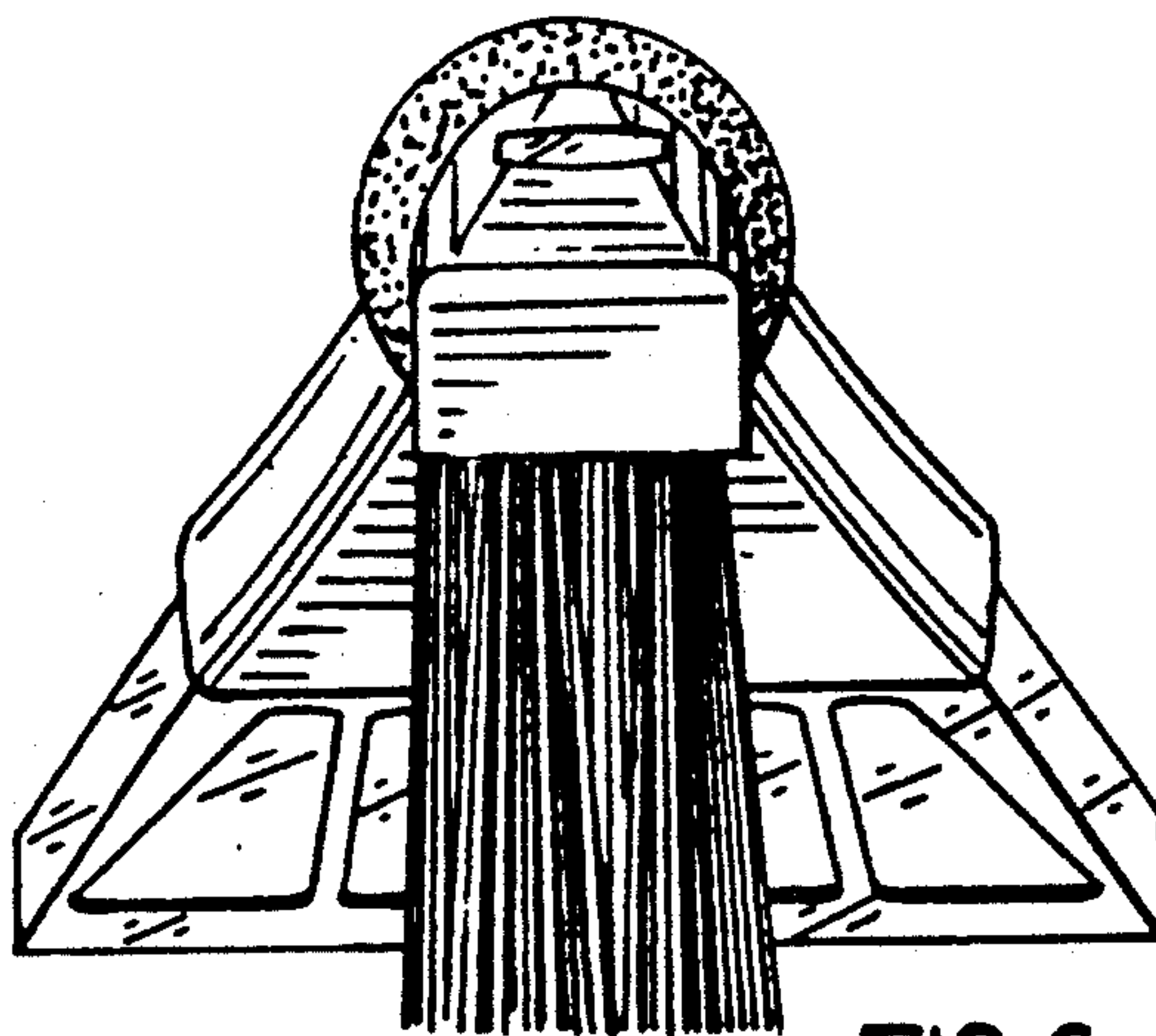
