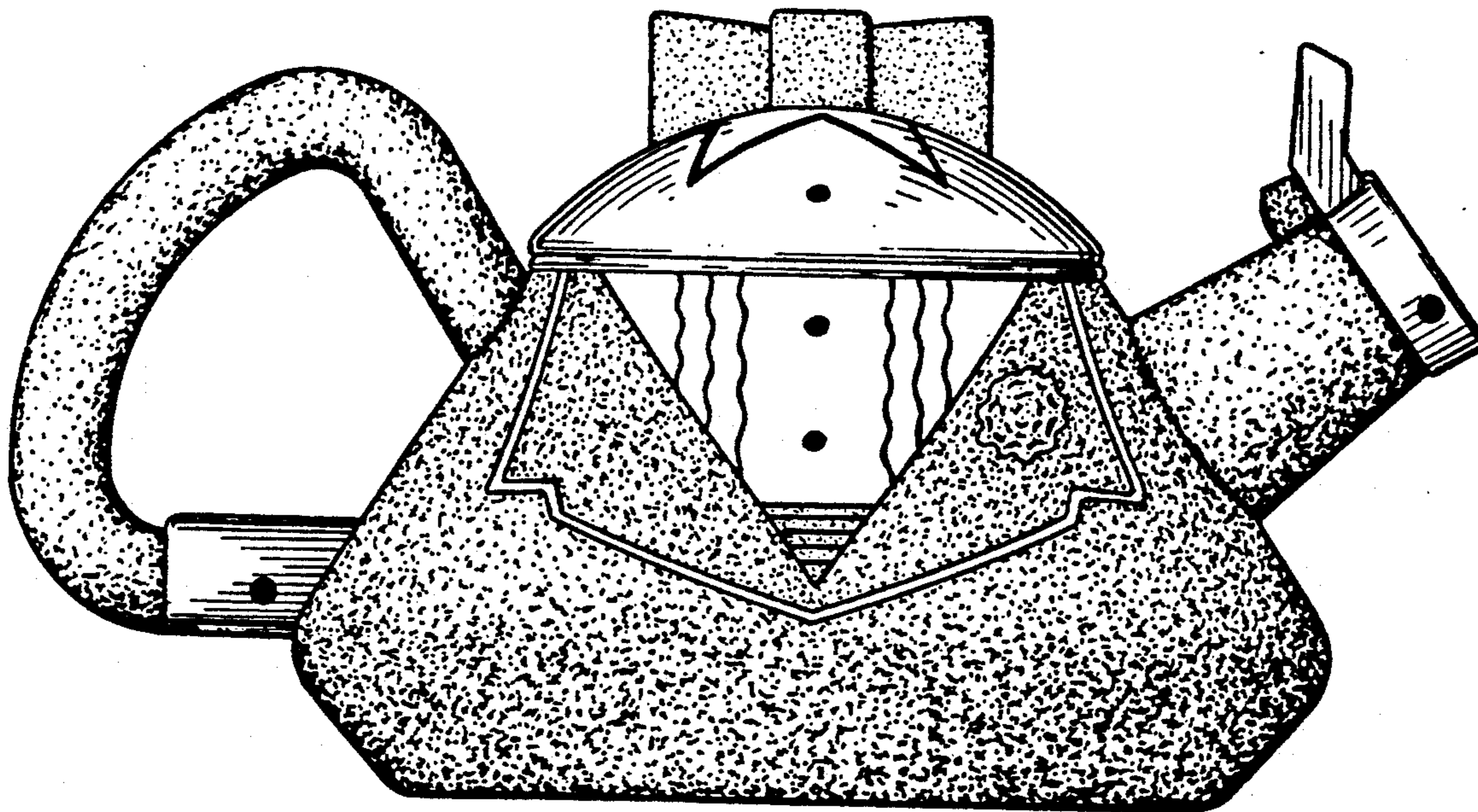

The bottom plan view is plain and unornamented.



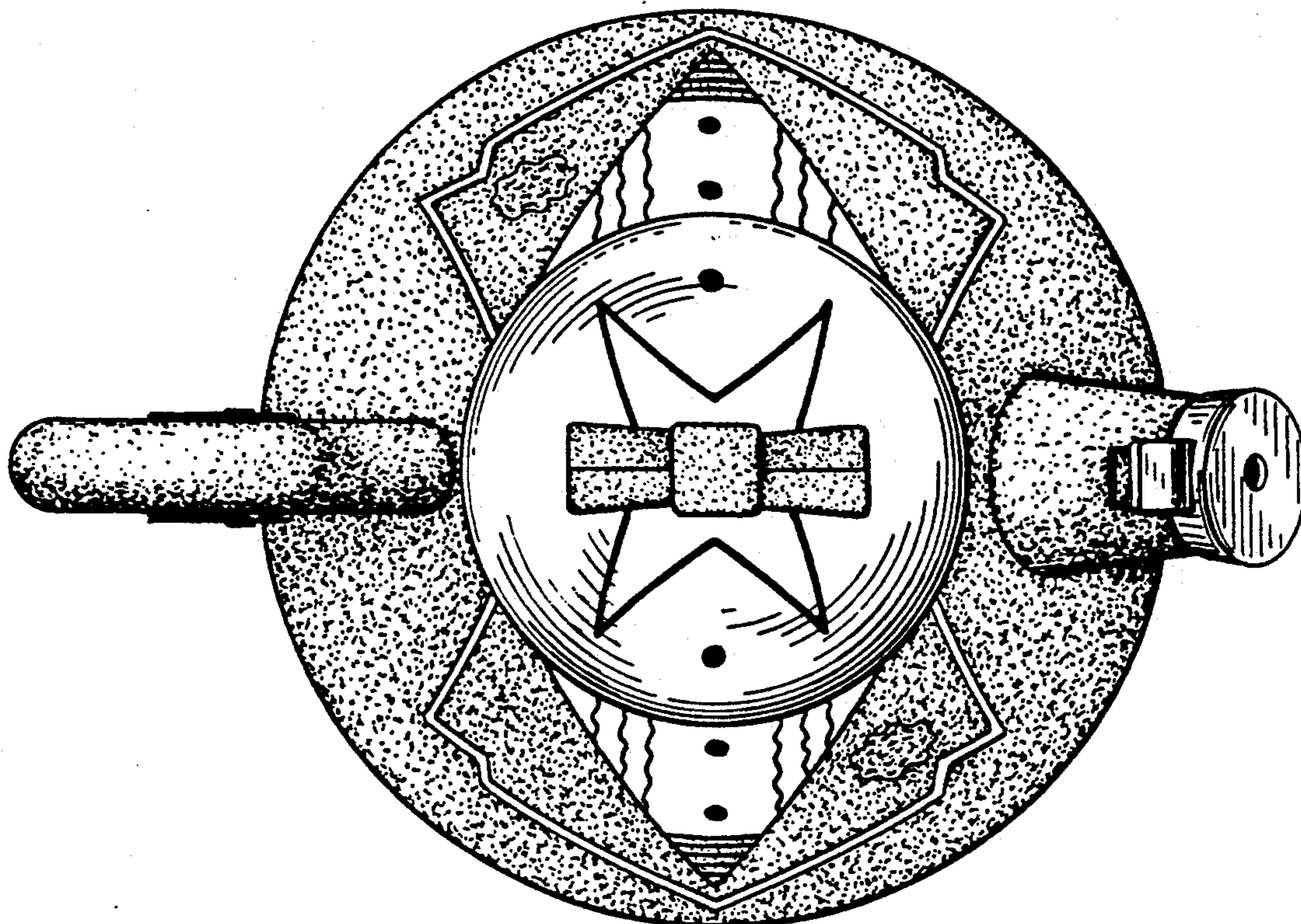

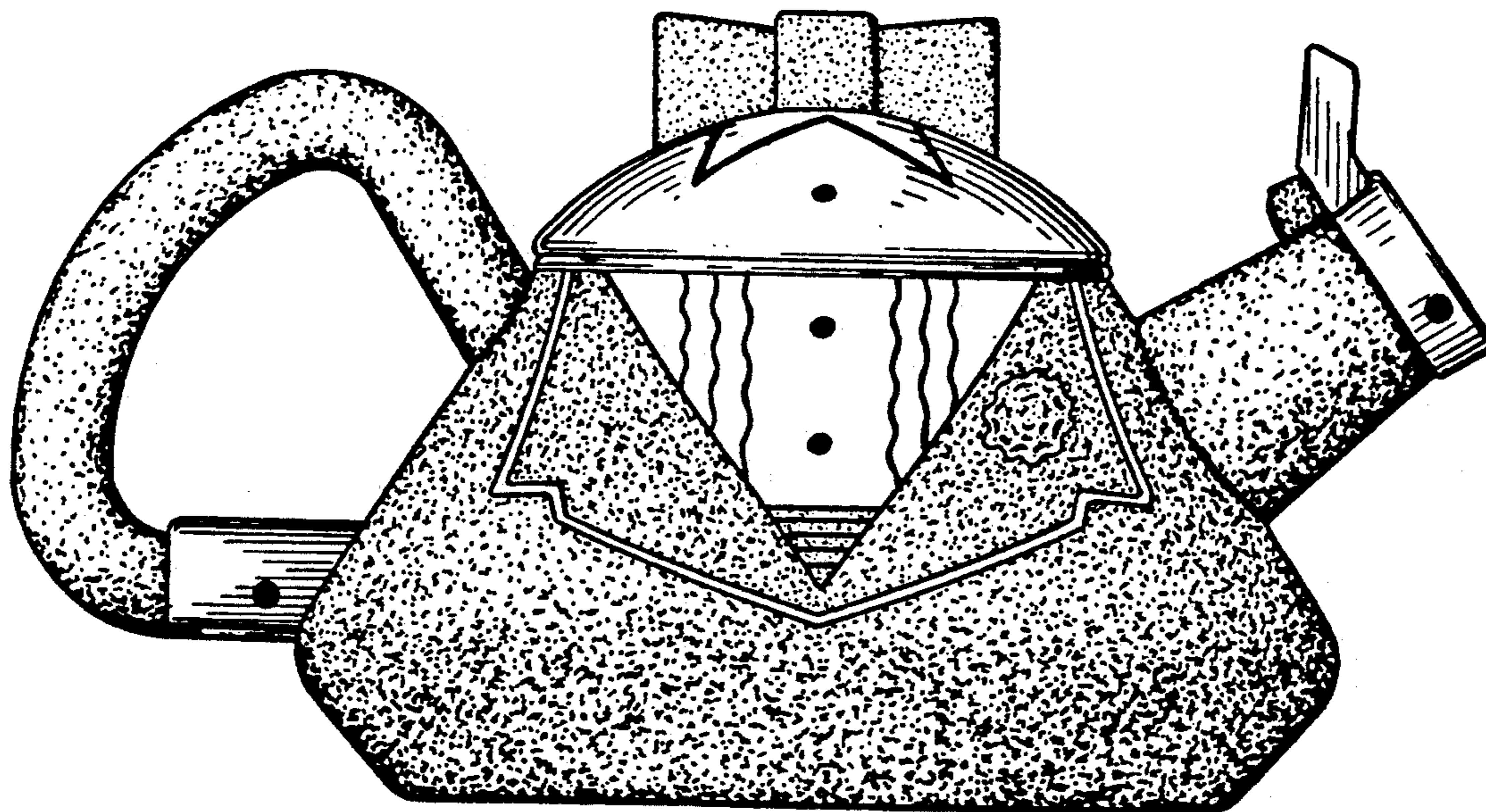

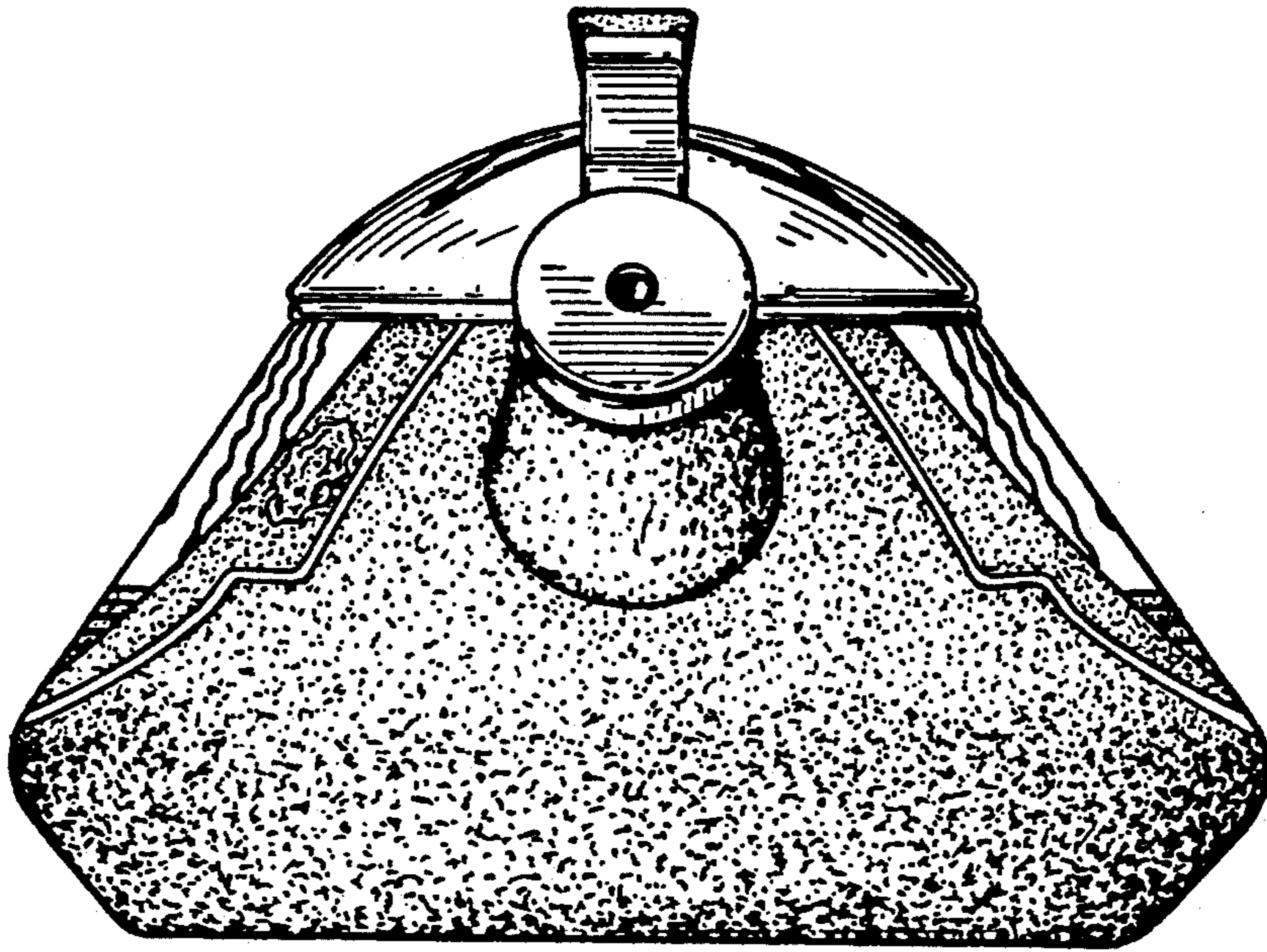

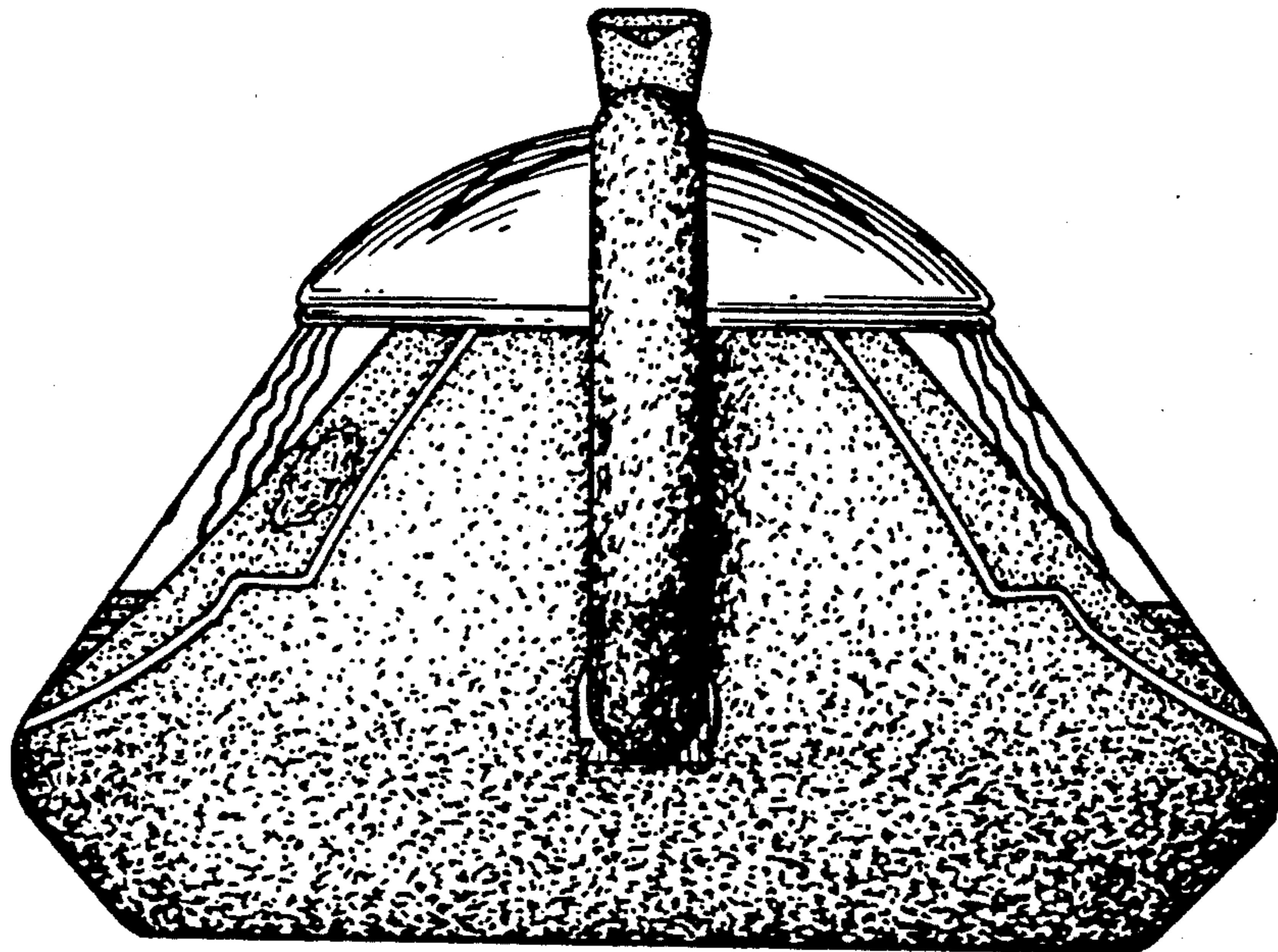
