DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left, front perspective view of an exterior shell of a vehicle aerodynamic fairing showing my new design, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

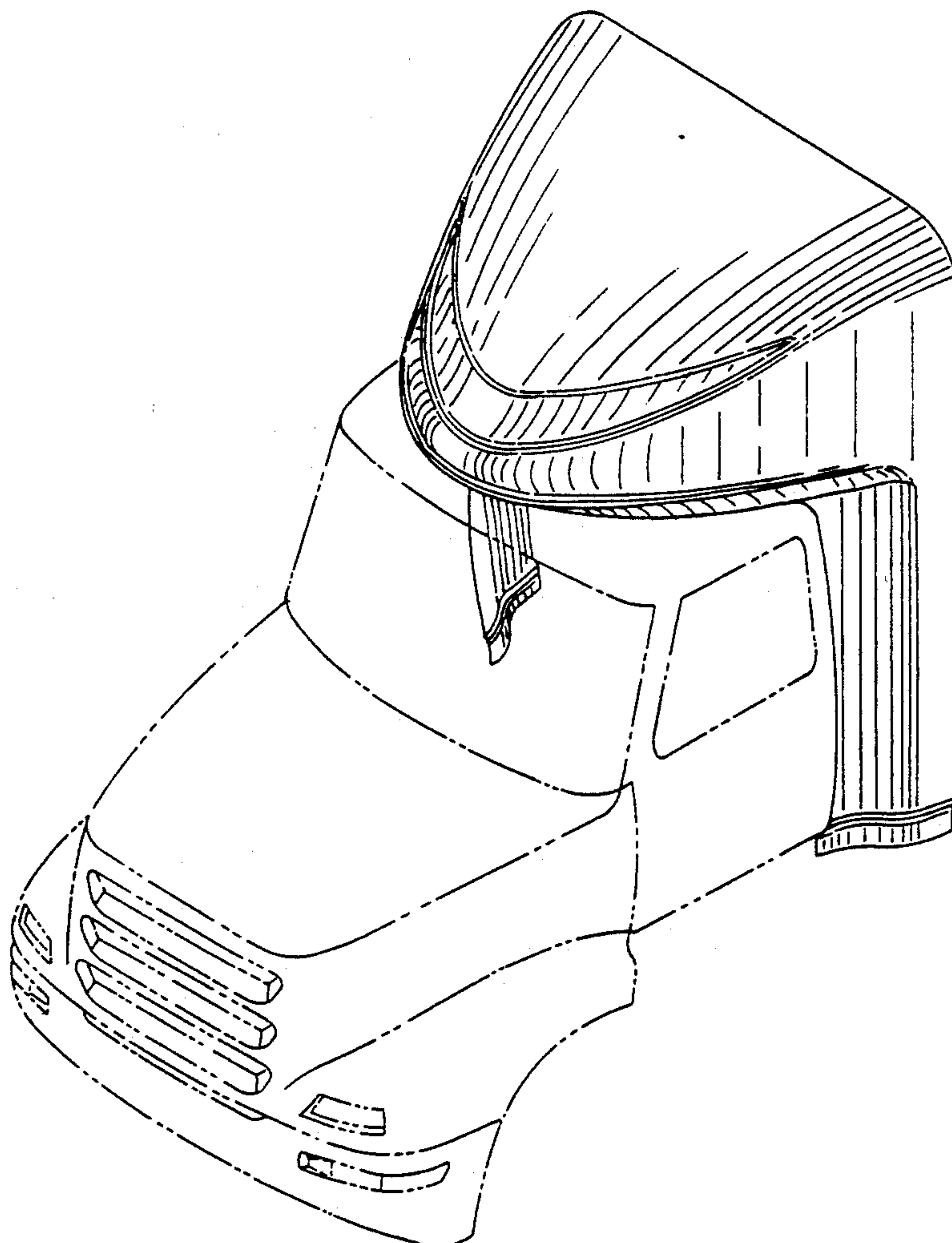

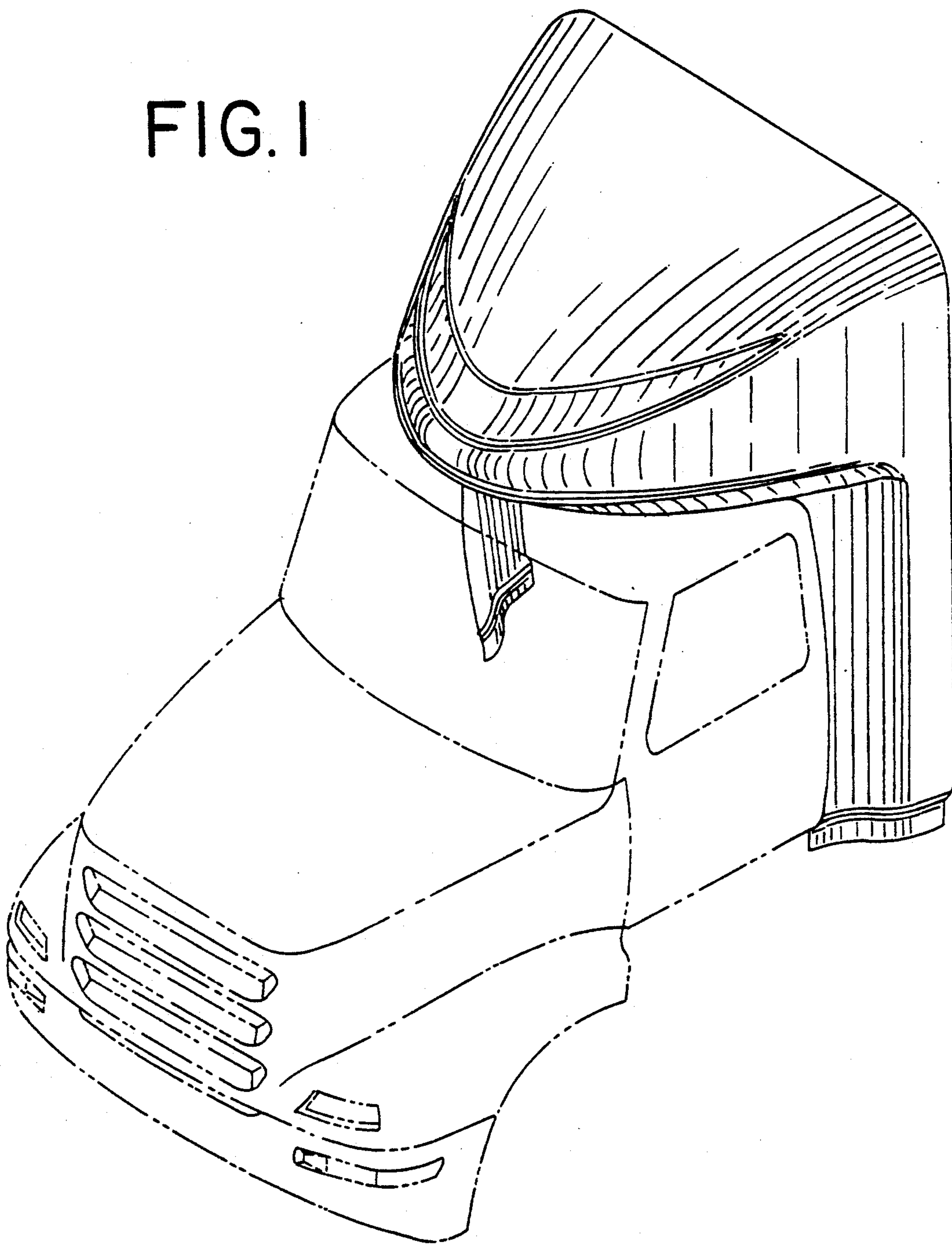

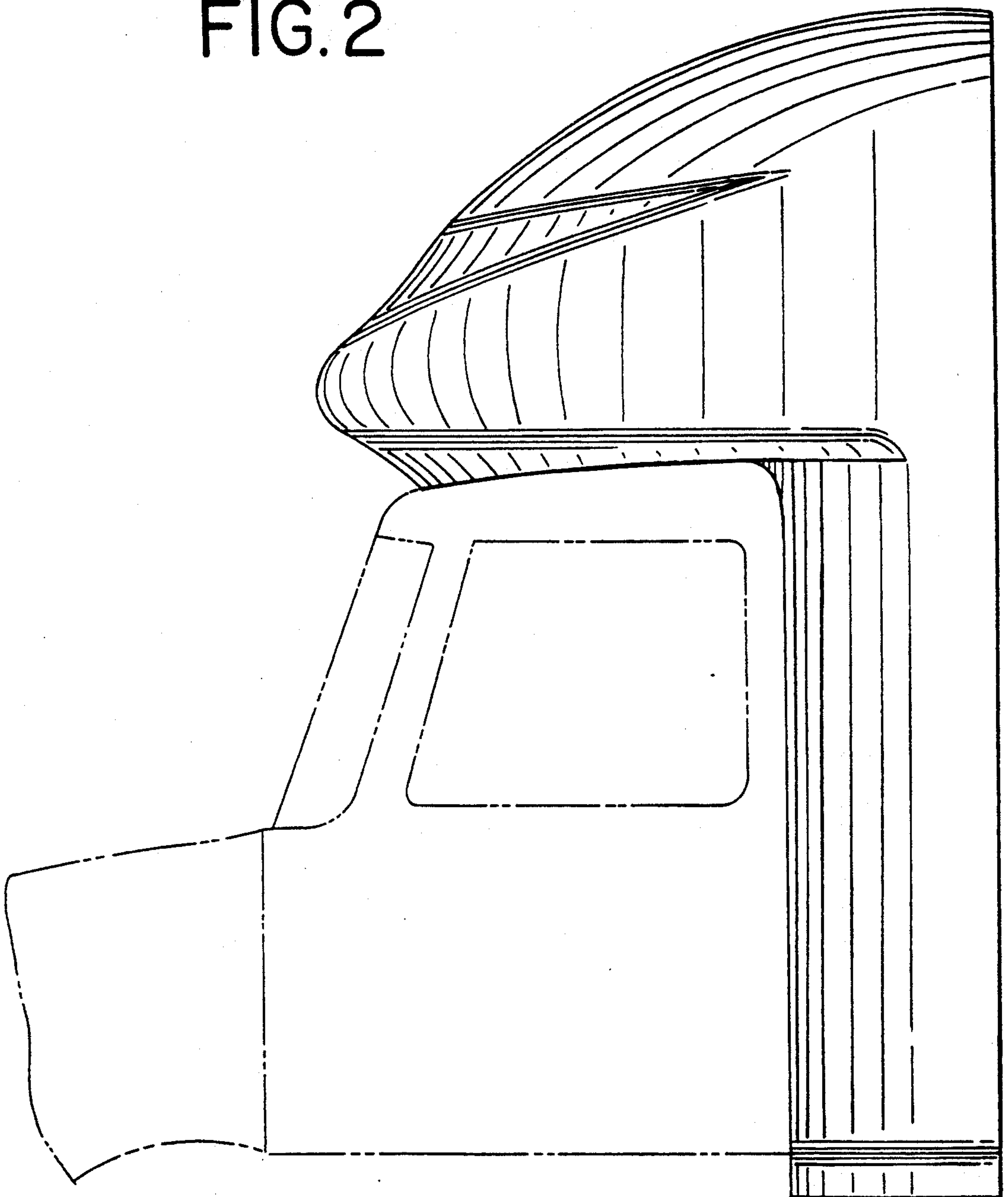

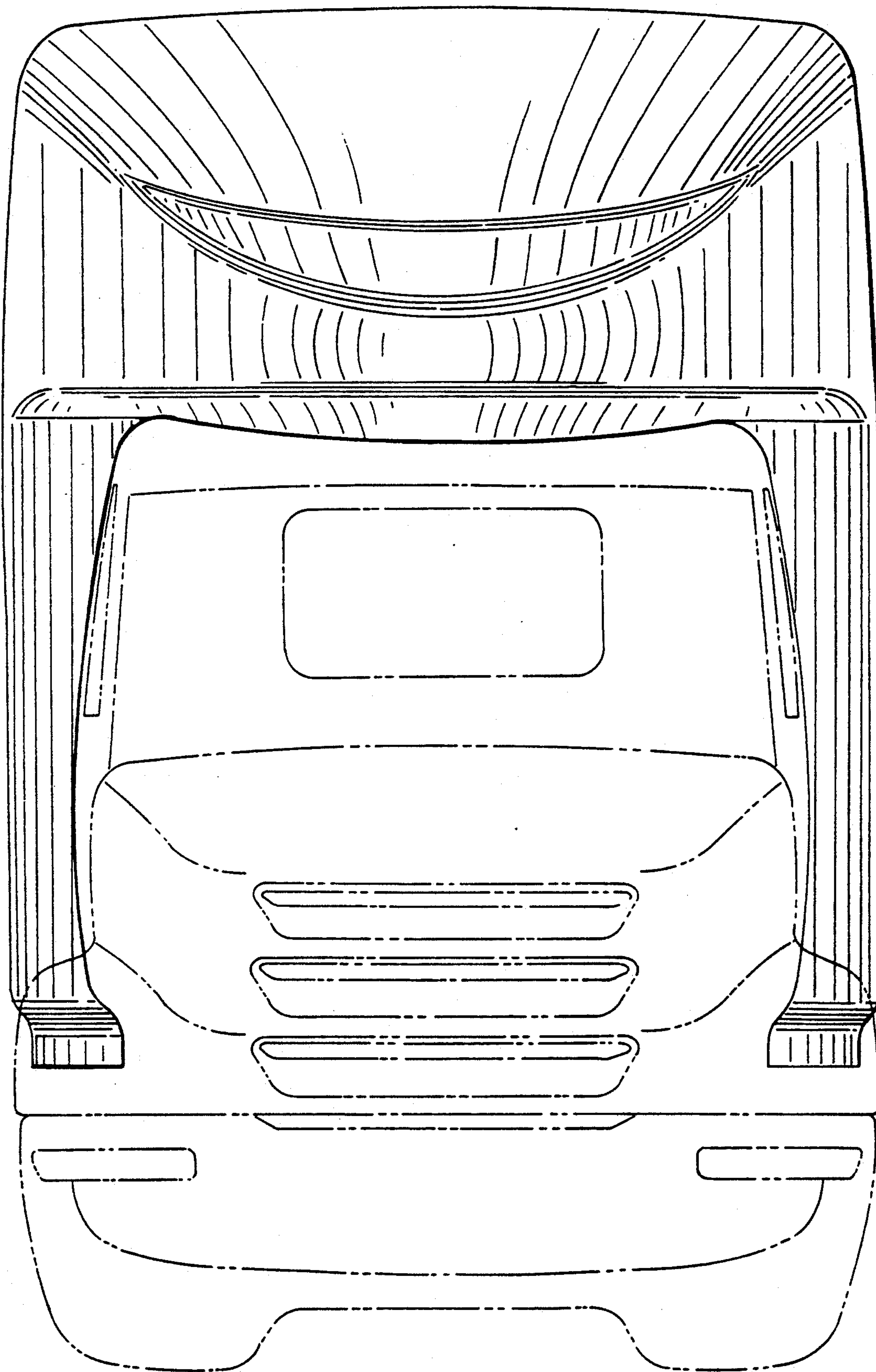
