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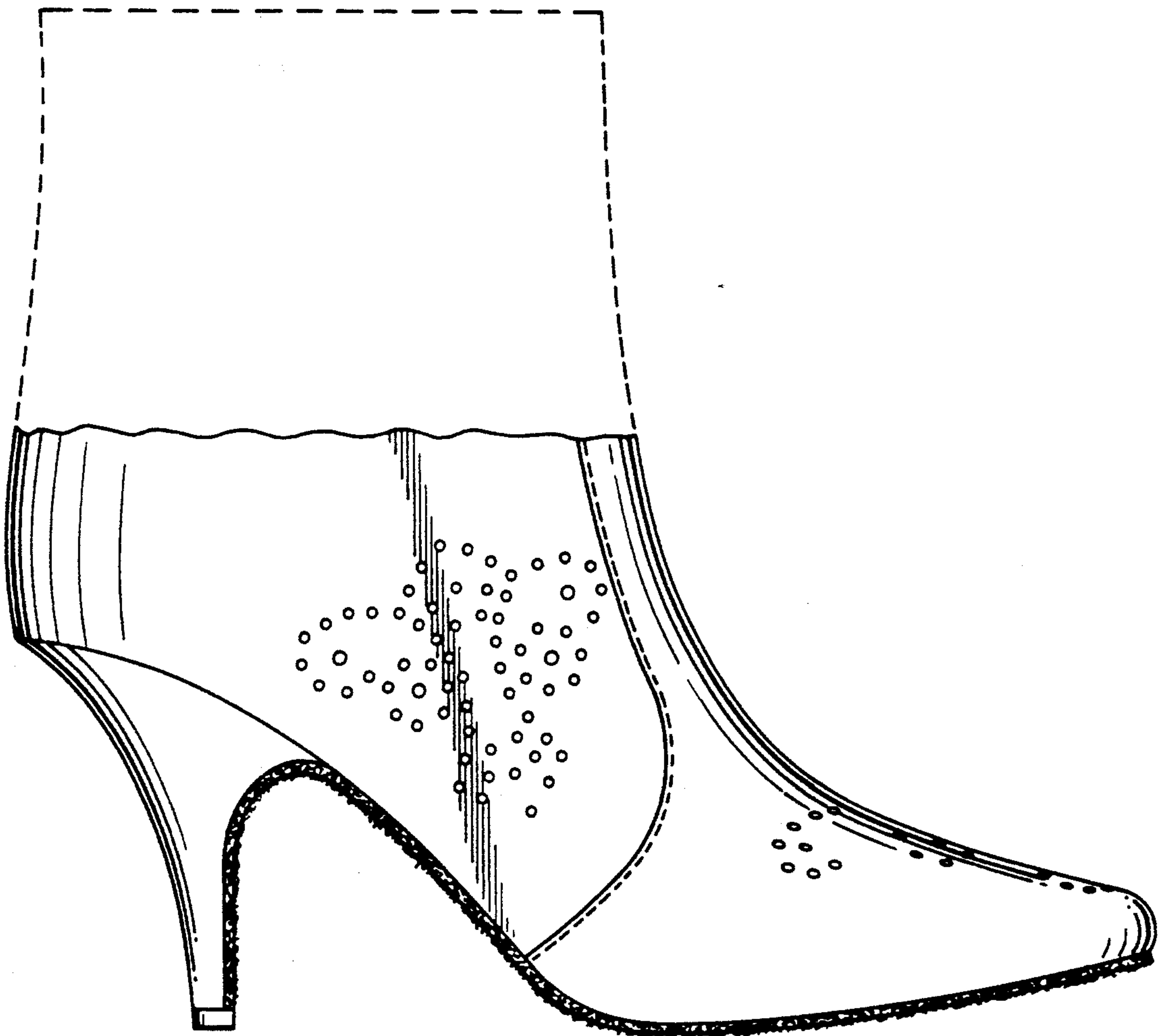
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left-side elevational view of a lower portion of a dancing shoe showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right-side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken line showing the upper collar is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed invention.



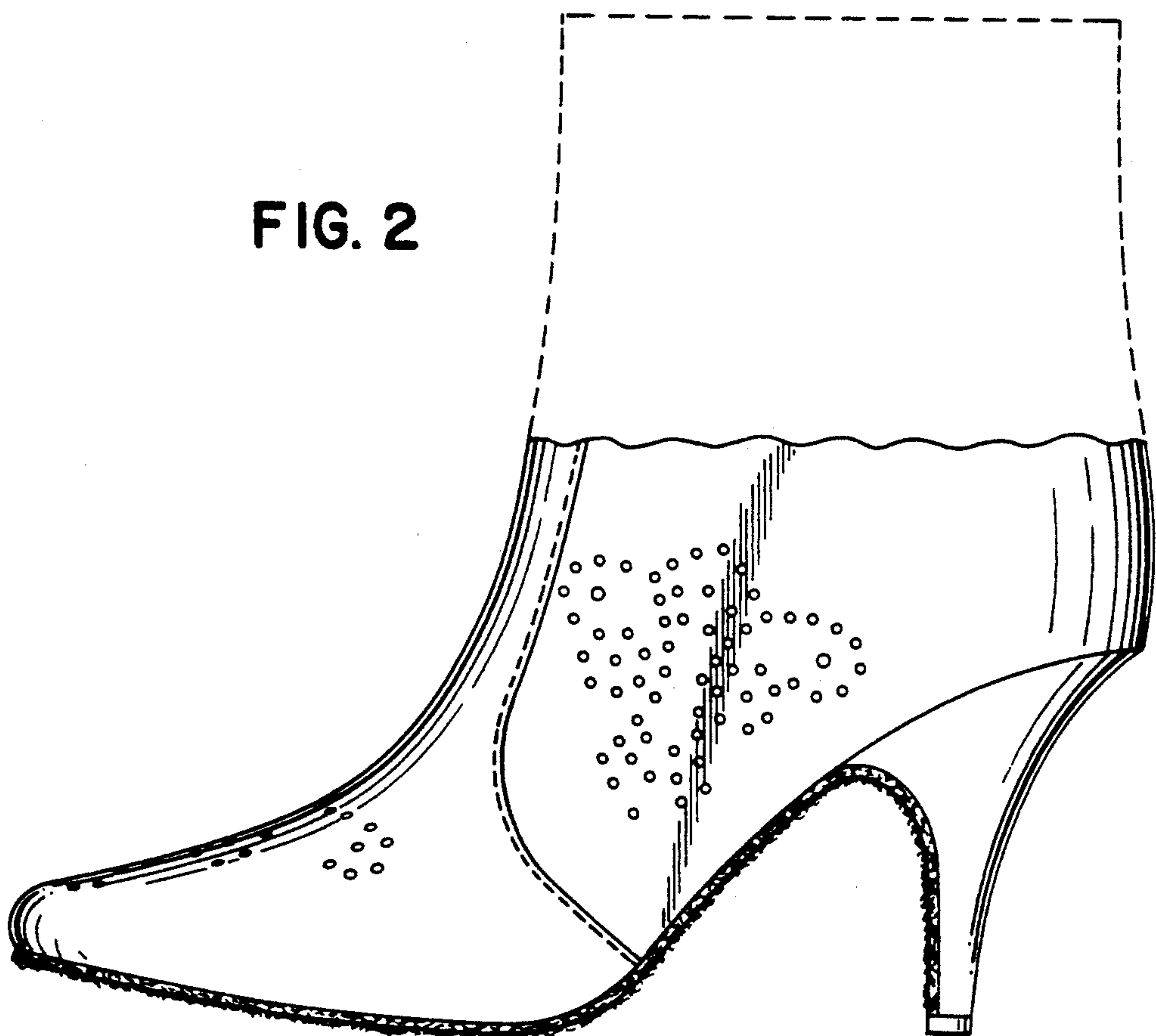
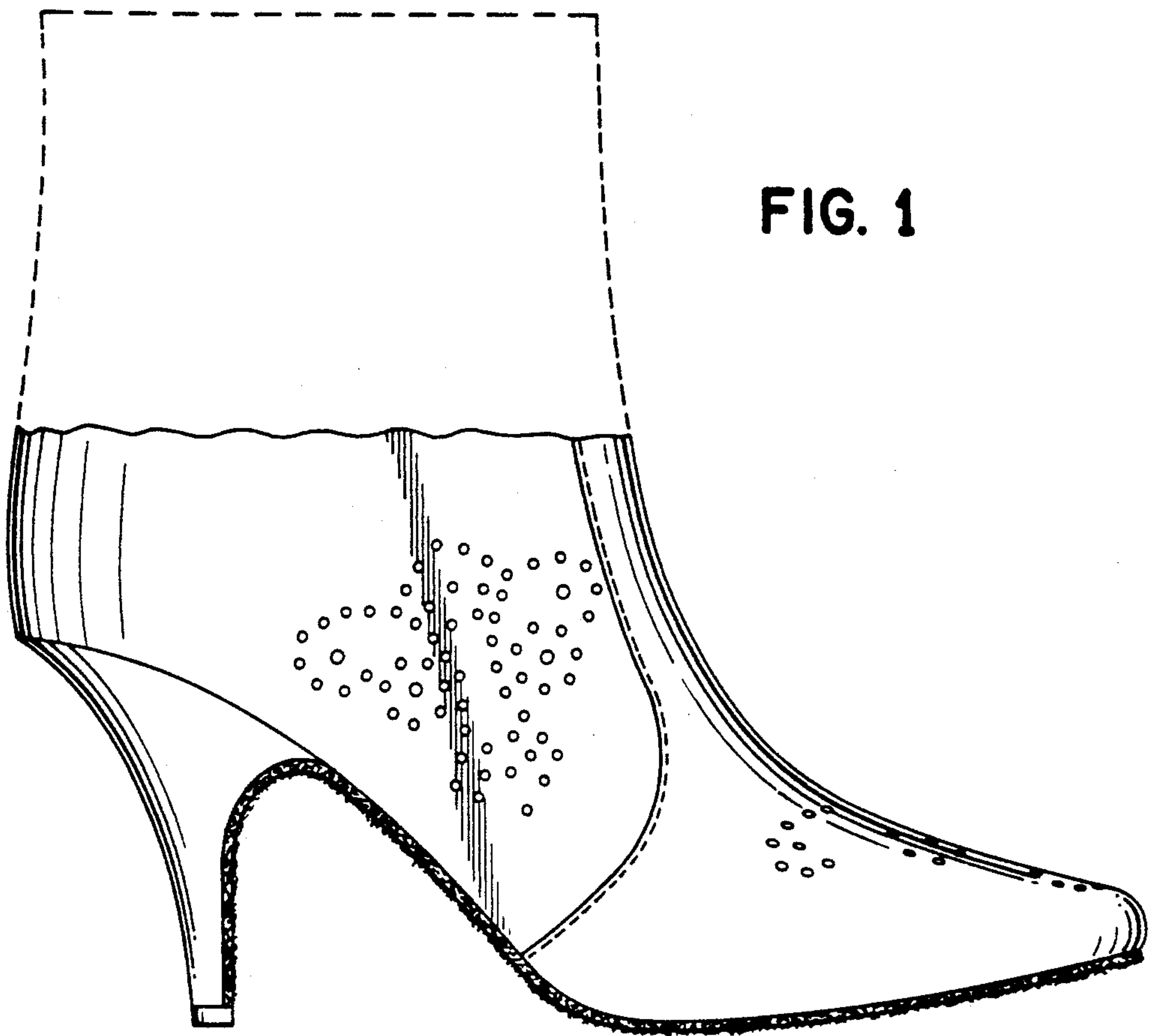

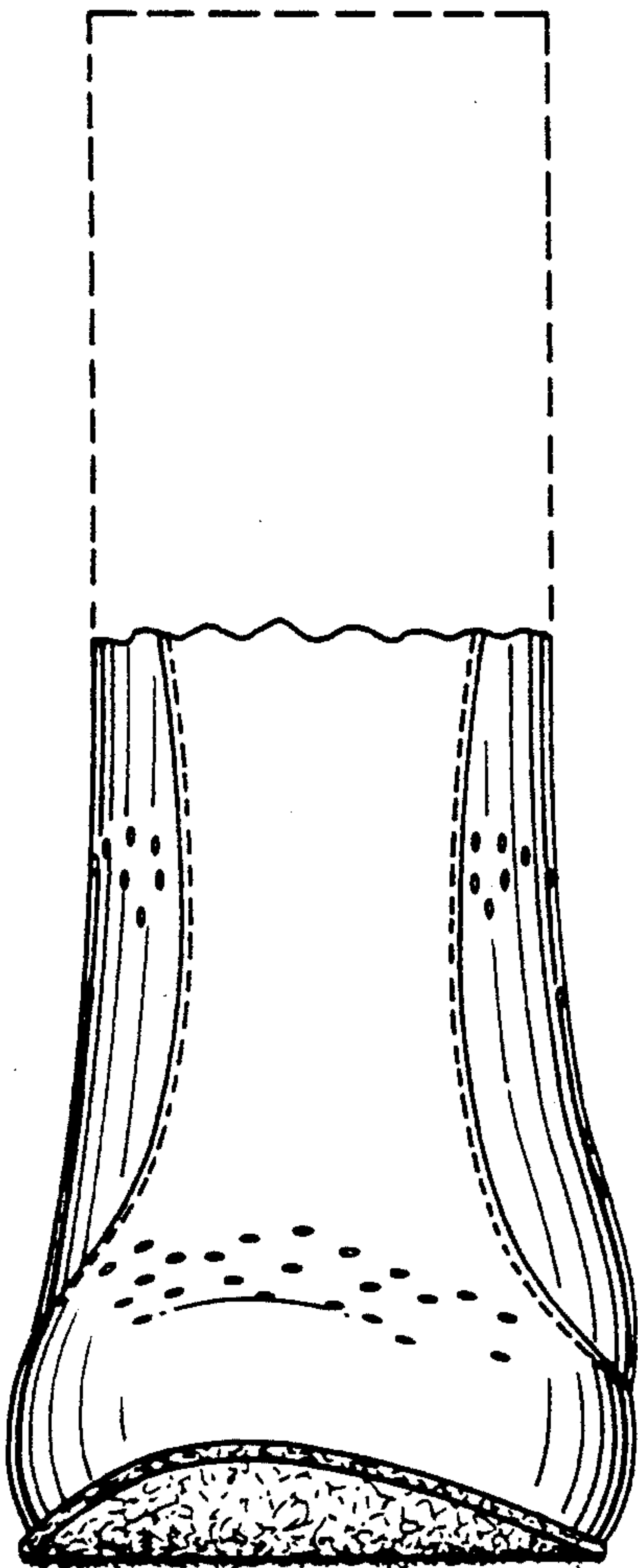

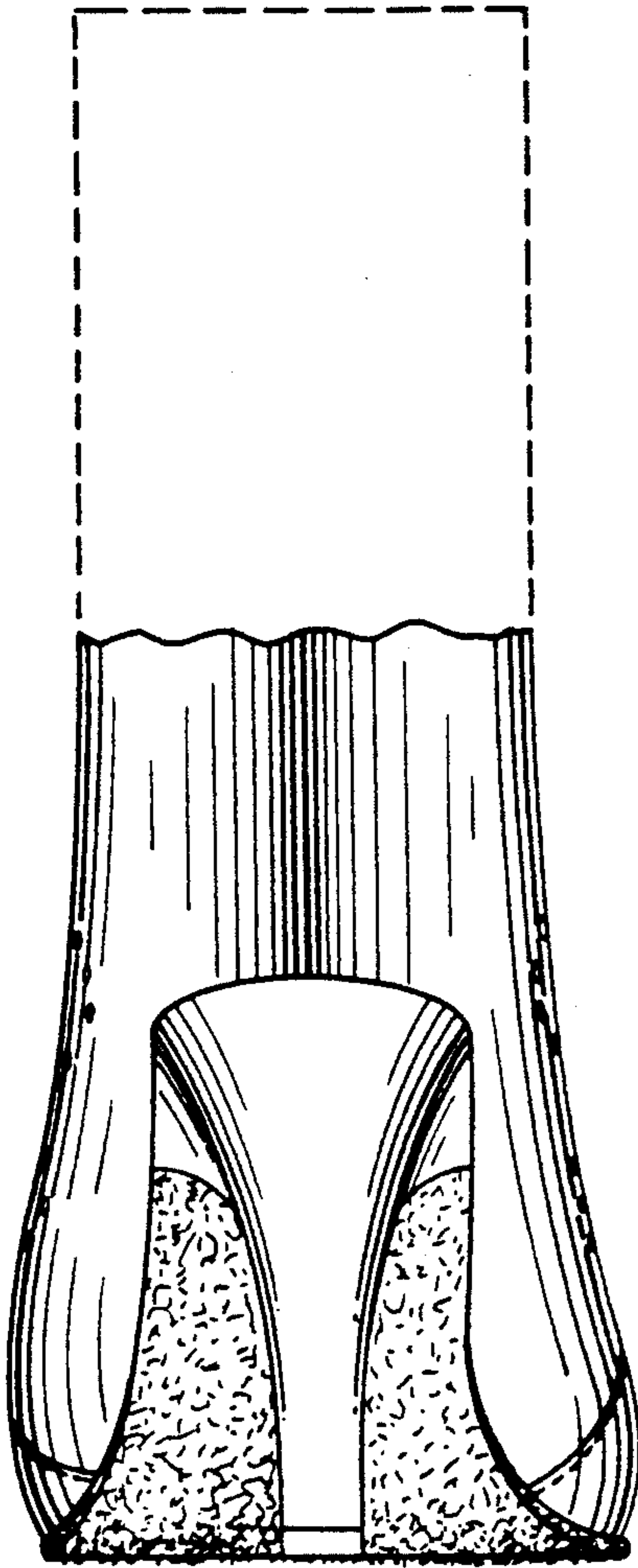
