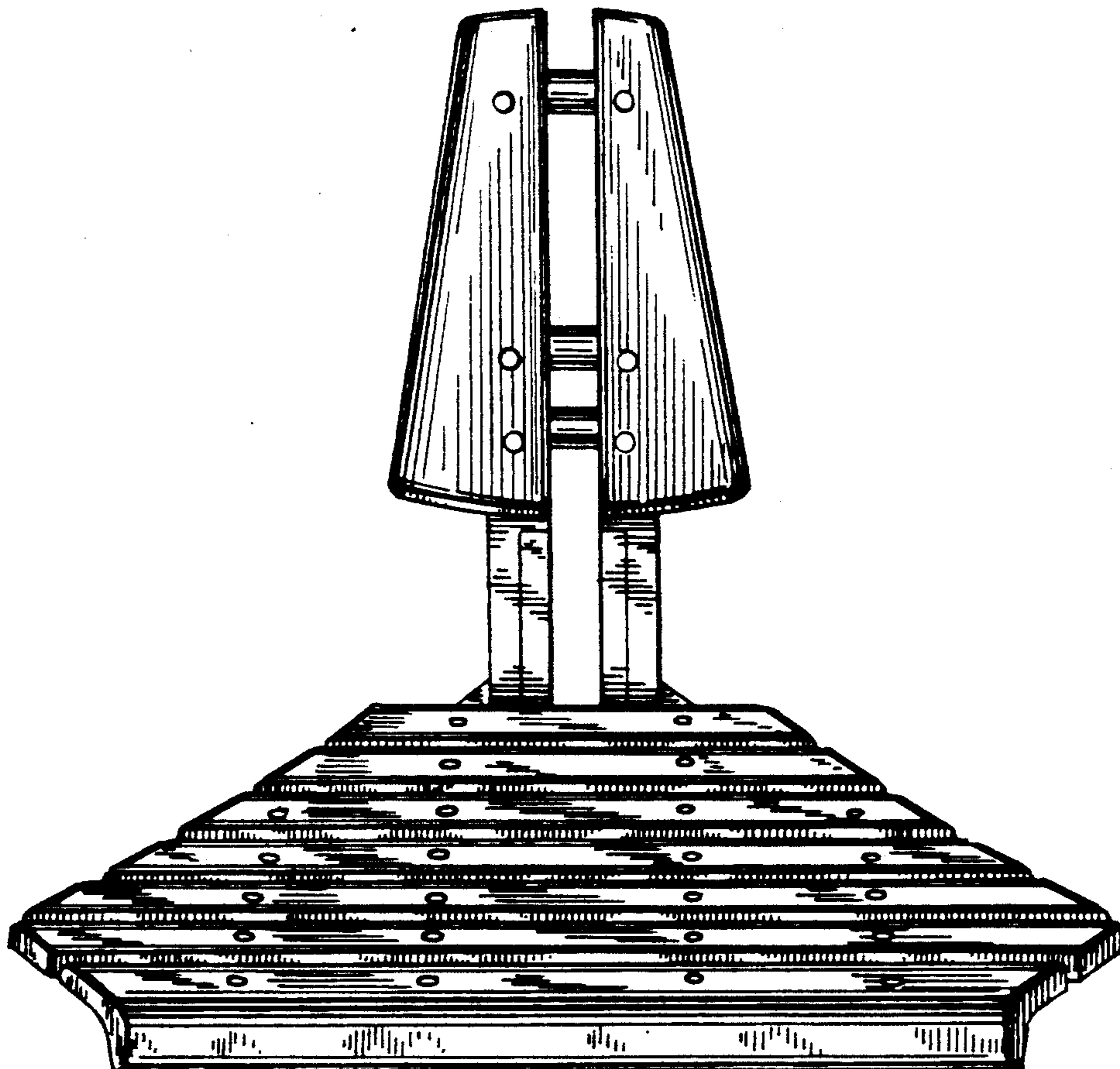

The ornamental design for a seat, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top and front of a seat showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being the mirror image of the right side shown; and, FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 2.



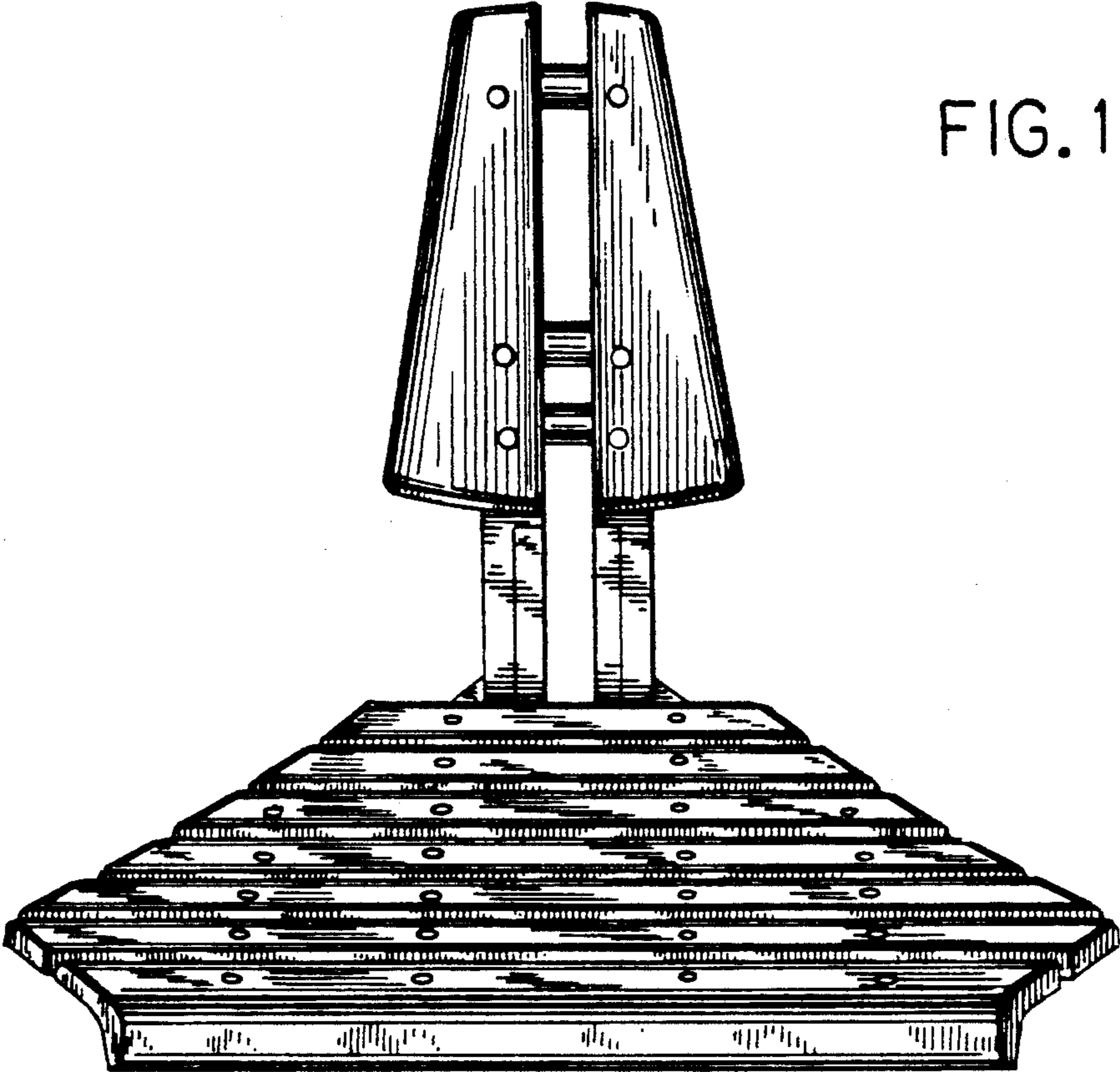

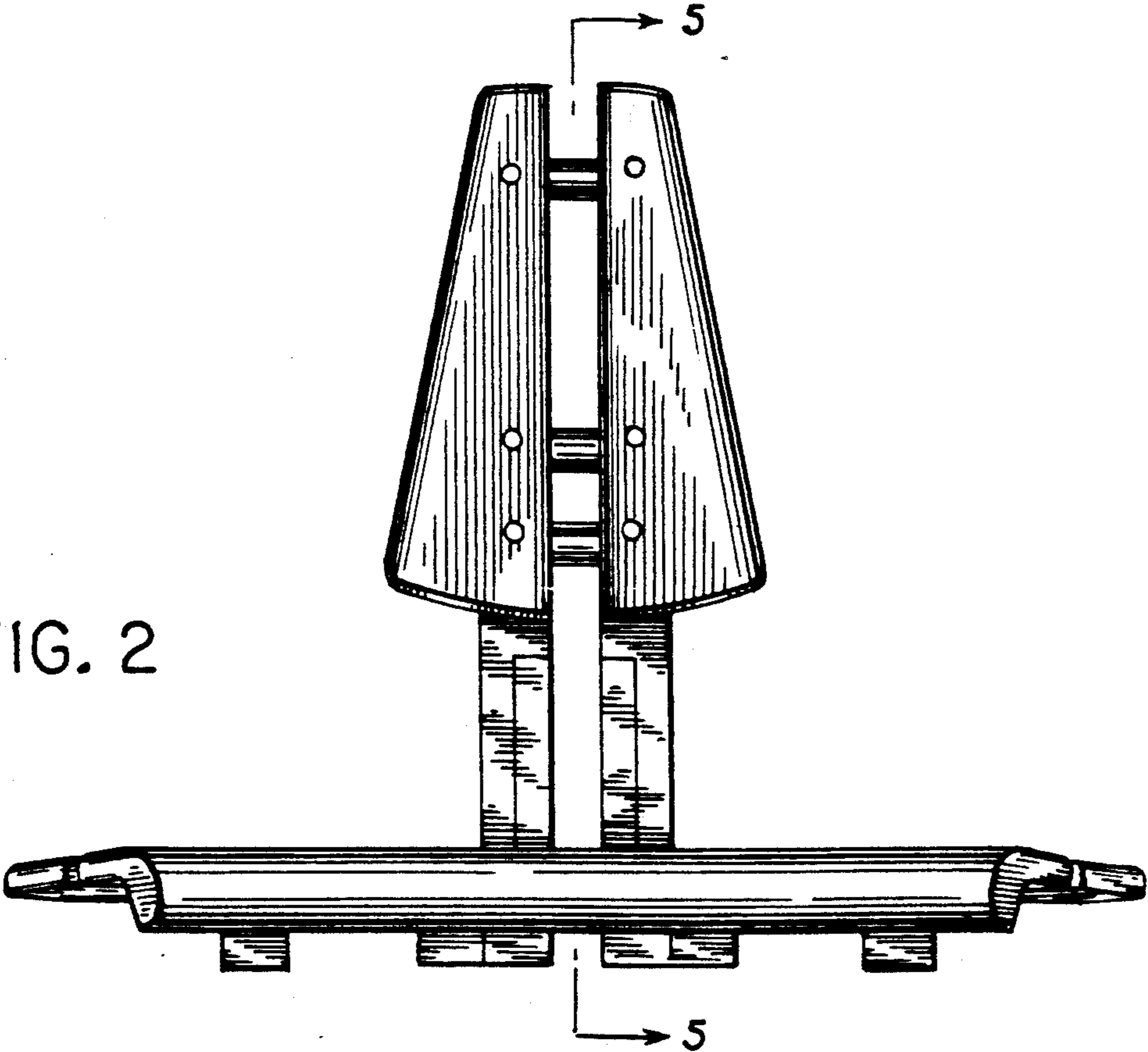

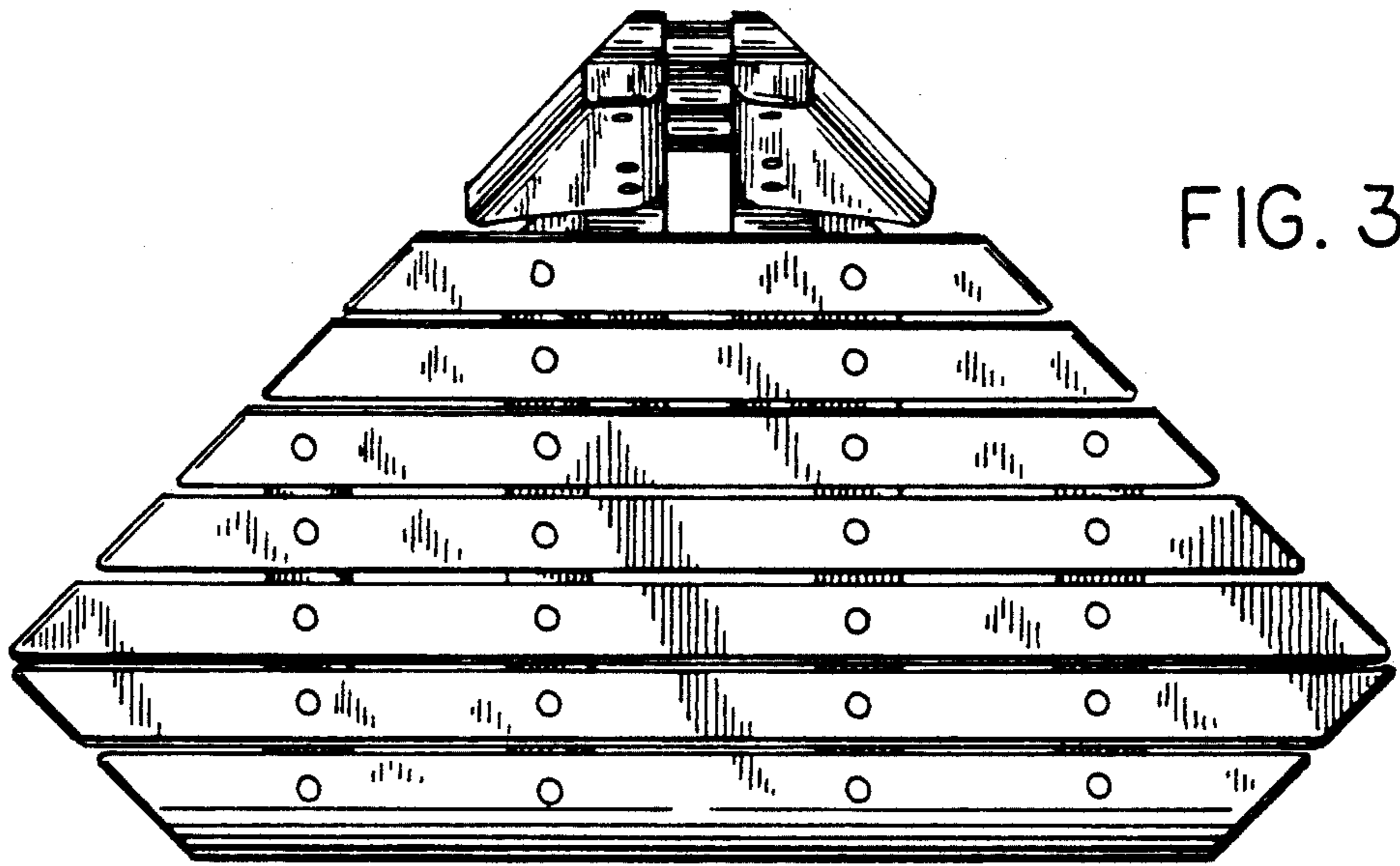

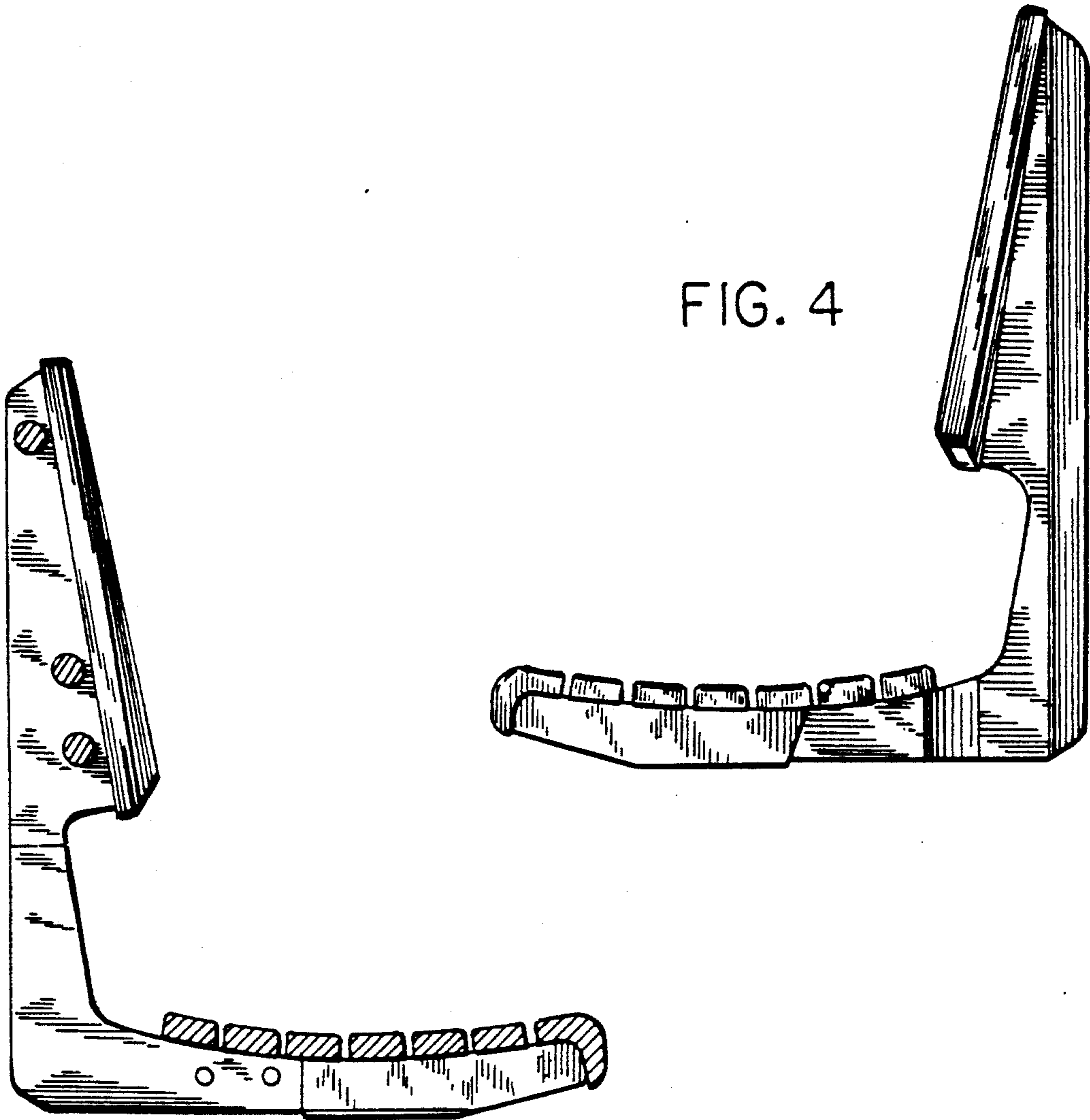
