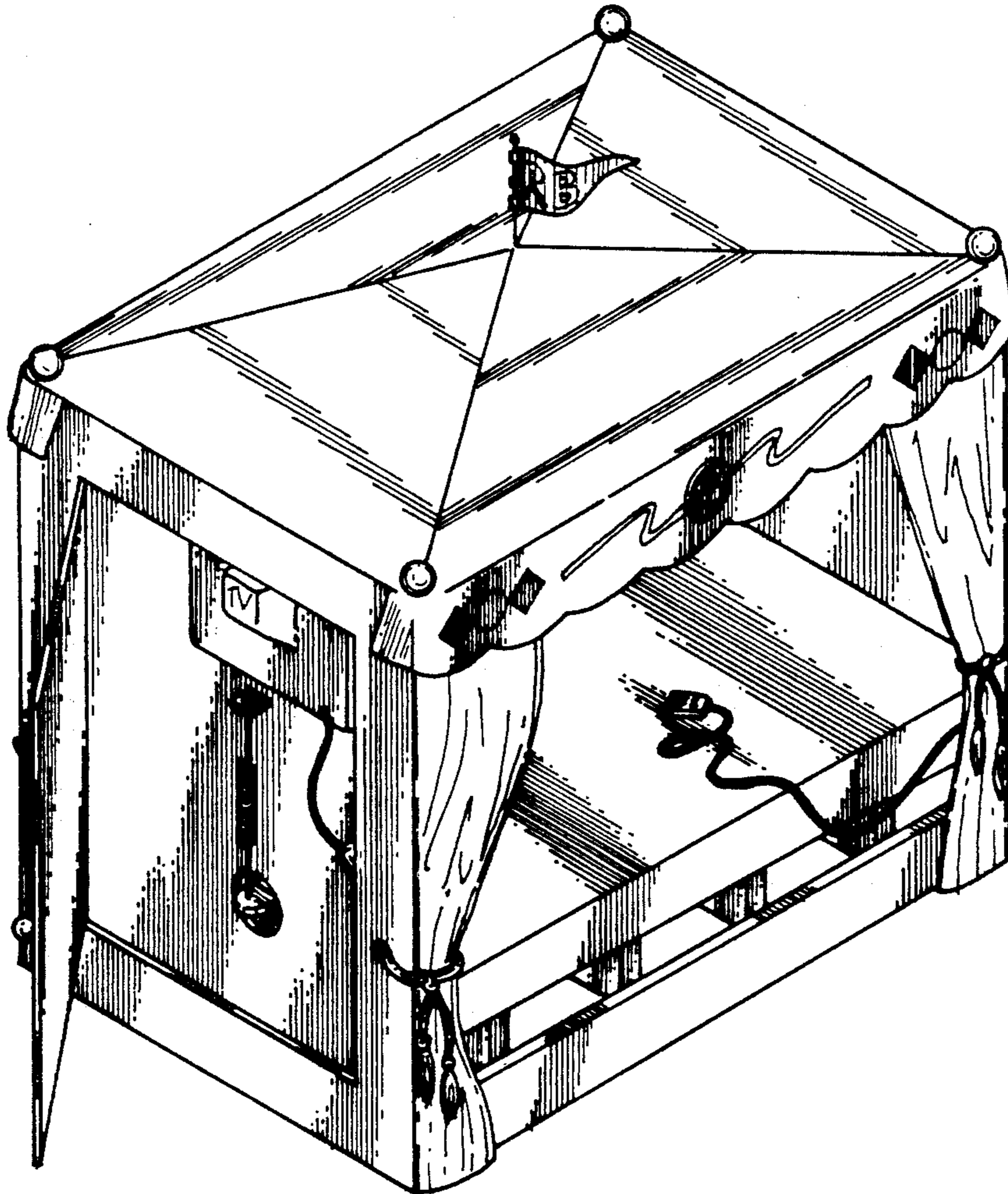

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bed, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and left side perspective view of the bed embodying the design of the present invention in the open configuration;
FIG. 2 is a right end elevational view thereof, the end opposite being a mirror image of the end shown in FIG. 2 when in the closed configuration;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown in FIG. 3;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.



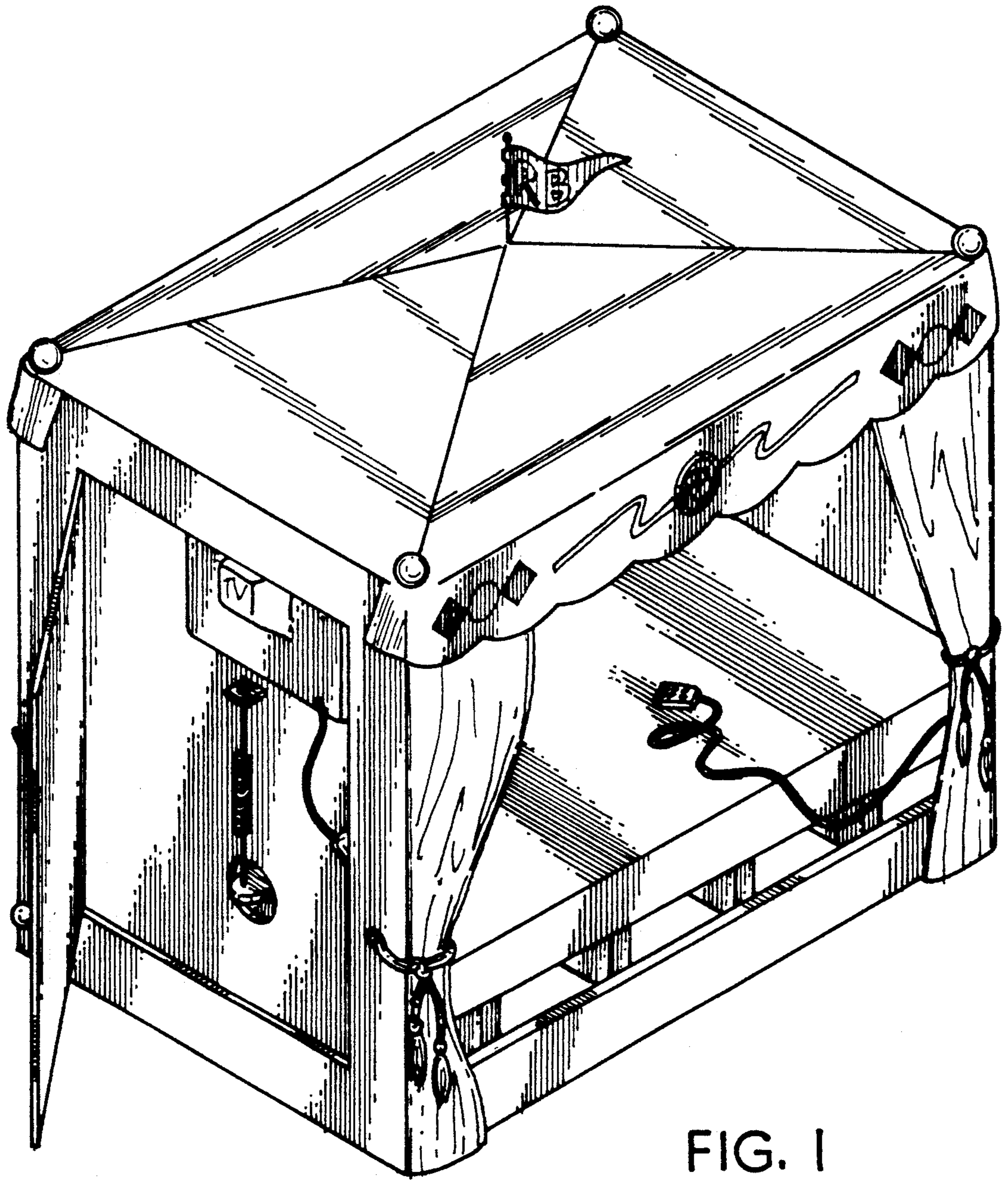

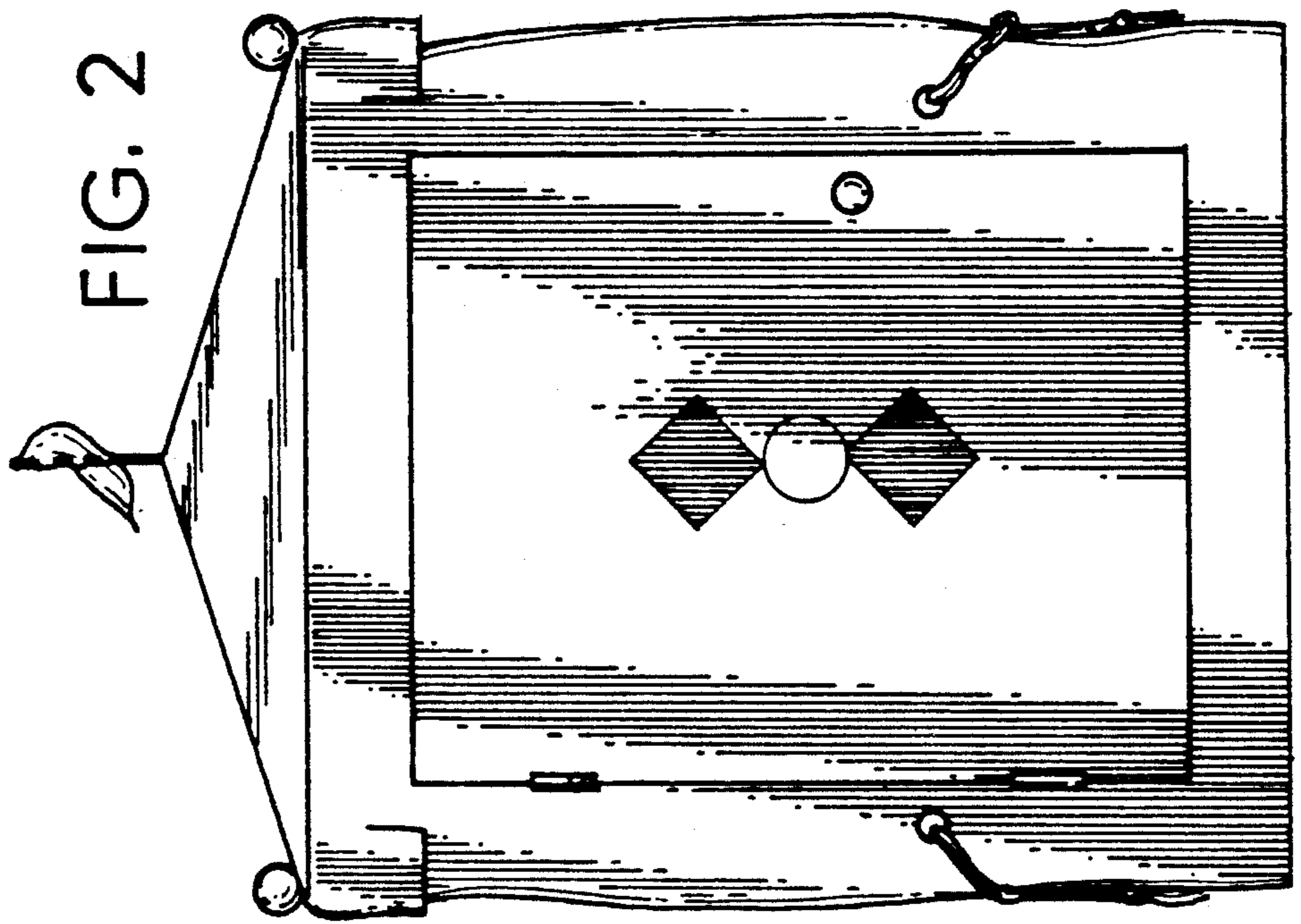
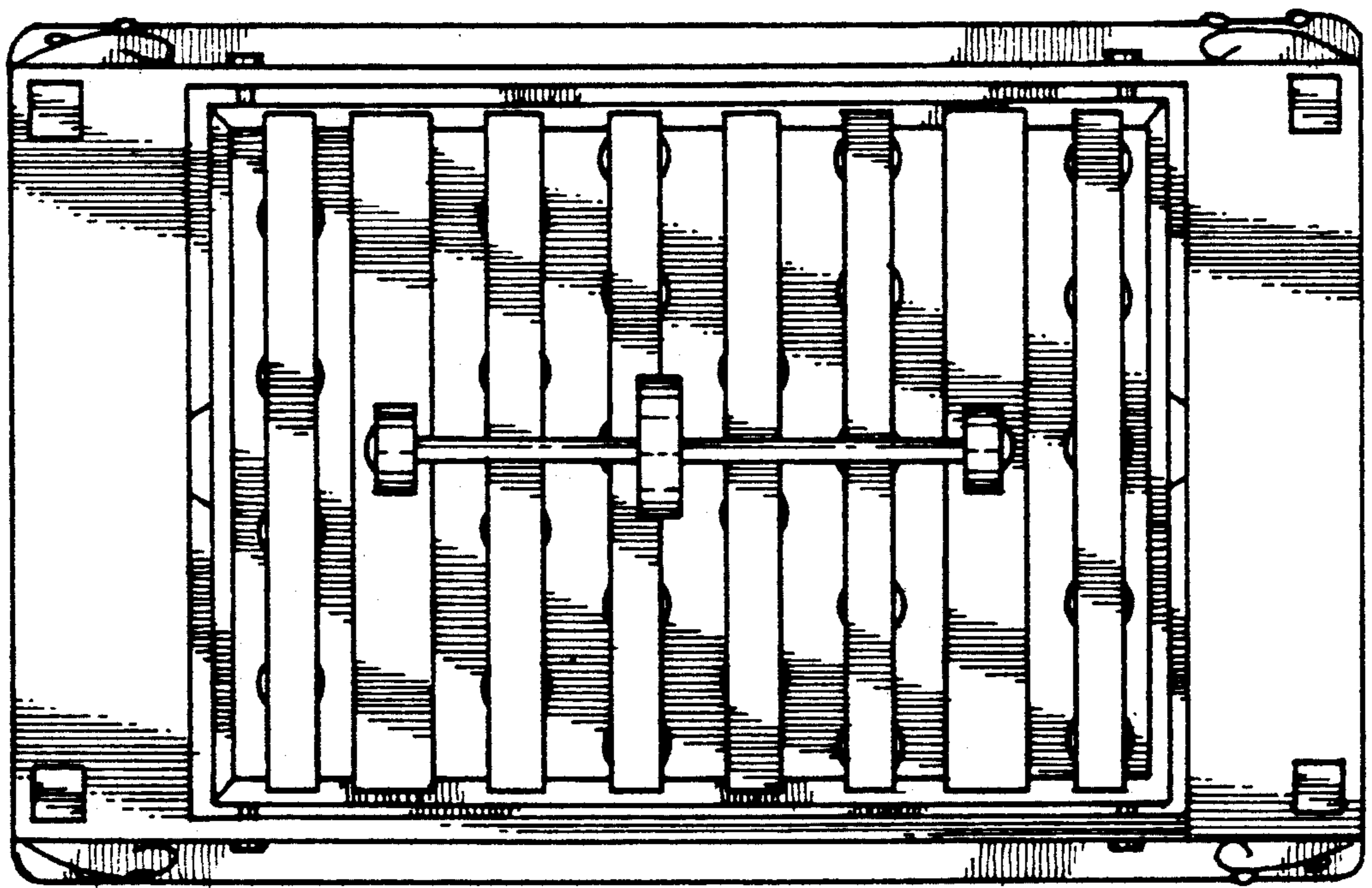

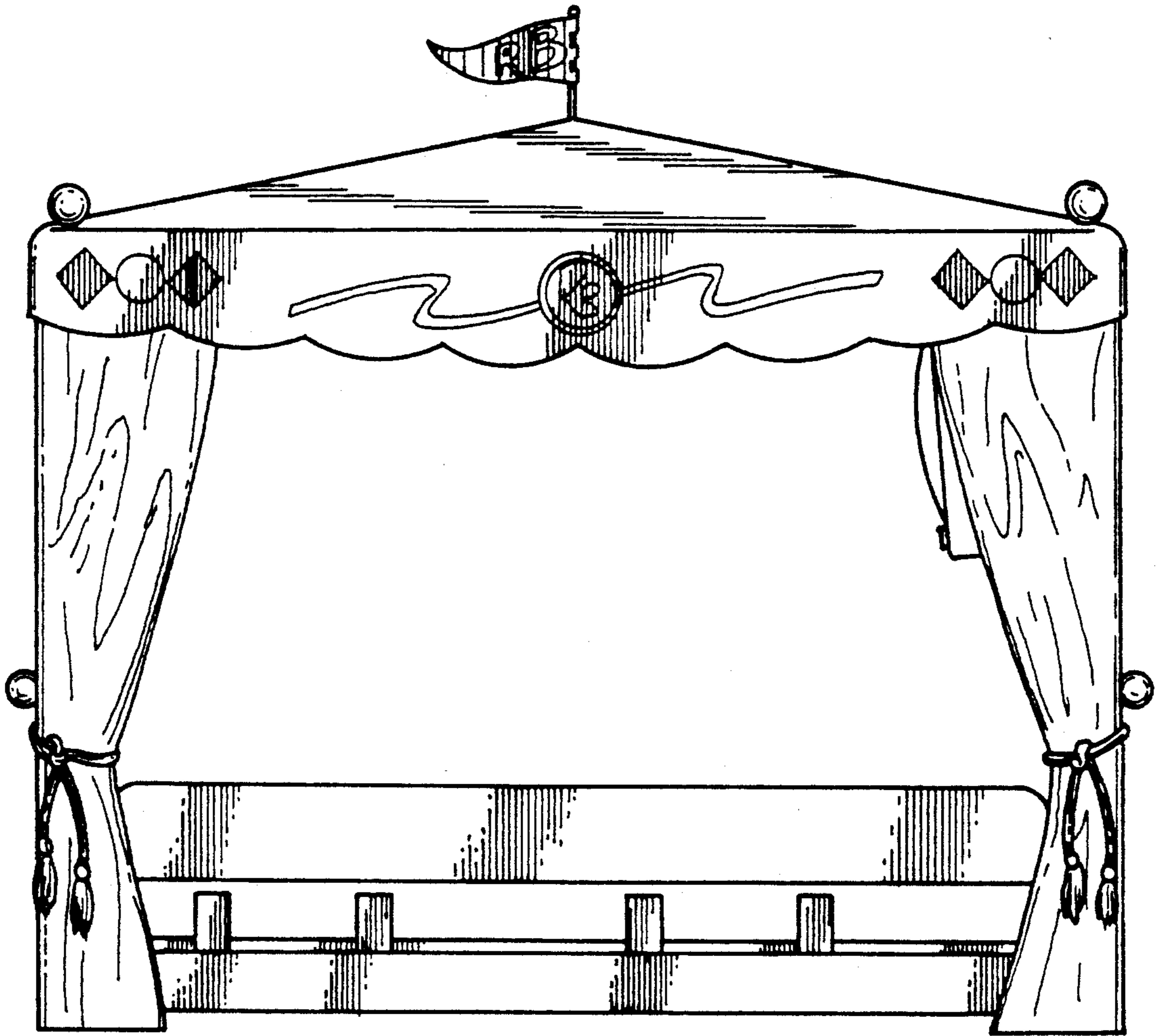
